Serikali kuanzisha vituo vya kurekebisha waraibu wa vileo

Waziri wa Mambo ya Ndani na Utawala wa Kitaifa Kithure Kindiki anasema kuwa serikali imejitolea kupambana na pombe haramu na dawa za kulevya nchini

Serikali ya Kitaifa inashirikiana na serikali za kaunti kuanzisha vituo kadhaa vya matibabu na urekebishaji katika kaunti zote 47, vyakutoa huduma za bei nafuu, zinazofadhiliwa na umma kwa wananchi wanaopokea matibabu na kurekebishwa kutokana na matumizi ya dawa za kulevya.

Akizungumza wakati wa ziara ya ukaguzi katika Kituo cha Tiba na Urekebishaji Miritini, Mombasa ili kutathmini maendeleo ya ujenzi huo, Waziri wa Mambo ya Ndani na Utawala wa Kitaifa Prof. Kindiki alisema kampeni hiyo inahusisha kuangamiza usambazaji na matumizi. Kindiki alikagua Kituo cha Matibabu na Urekebishaji wa Dawa za Miritini na kubaini mahitaji ya haraka na ya muda mfupi ili kuharakisha kukamilika kwake.

Kituo cha Miritini kitagharimu Sh1.3 bilioni kitakapokamilika, huku Sh166 milioni tayari zikiwa tayari zimetolewa. Akitathmini maendeleo, Waziri alitaja kuwa ekari 13 za ardhi zilizotengwa zilikusudiwa kwa ajili

ya ujenzi wa kituo cha kisasa cha matibabu na urekebishaji wa watu walioathirika na pombe, dawa za kulevya na dawa za kisaikolojia. Alibainisha mipango ya kupanua malazi kutoka kwa wagonjwa 50 ili kuchukua zaidi, kwani kituo hicho kwa sasa kinahudumia wagonjwa wasiopungua 300 kila siku. “Tutaweka mabweni, vituo vya mafunzo, na nyumba za wafanyikazi kwa madaktari wetu kukaa hapa,” akaongeza. Prof. Kindiki alitaja vipengele vitatu vya mpango huo: matibabu, urekebishaji, na kuunganishwa tena, akisisitiza haja ya kituo cha

mafunzo ambapo wagonjwa, mara baada ya kutibiwa kikamilifu, wanaweza kujiandikisha katika kozi ili kupata ujuzi wa kiufundi. “Tunafanya kazi na Mamlaka ya Kitaifa ya Viwanda na Mafunzo ili kuthibitisha kituo chetu cha mafunzo hapa kwa ajili ya mpango wa kujumuishwa upya.

Zaidi ya hayo, tunafikiria kuanzisha mfuko mdogo ili kutoa mtaji wa kuanzia kwa wagonjwa hao ambao wamepata ujuzi sahihi ili kujumuika katika jamii,” aliongeza. Waziri alisisitiza kuwa kukandamiza mahitaji, pamoja na matibabu, urekebishaji, na kuunganishwa

tena kwa waraibu, bado ni lengo kuu la serikali, akibainisha kuwa uraibu wa dawa za kulevya unaleta tishio kubwa kwa tija ya taifa. “Tumeainisha utengenezaji, uuzaji, utumiaji na utumiaji wa dawa za kulevya na pombe haramu kama tishio la kitaifa, na tutatumia rasilimali zote zilizopo kupambana na maovu haya na kukomboa kizazi chetu,” alisema. Alisema kituo cha Miritini kitatoa programu za matibabu, urekebishaji na kuwarejesha katika jamii, ikiwa ni pamoja na ku-

wapa mafunzo wagonjwa waliopona katika ujuzi wa ufundi wa uashi, ushonaji na uhandisi, sambamba na kuwapatia mtaji wa kuanzisha biashara ndogo ndogo zinazoendana na ujuzi wao. “Kituo hiki tayari kinafanya kazi, kinahudumia wagonjwa 50 na wagonjwa wa nje 300 bila malipo. Hata hivyo, baada ya kukamilika, uwezo utaongezeka mara tano,” alisema. Alitoa onyo kali kwa wanalanguzi wa dawa za kulevya, akisema kuwa serikali inazingatia athari wanazosababisha kwa jamii kuwa kali kama zile zinazosababishwa na magaidi, akiahidi kushughulikia swala hilo kwa uangalifu. Aliwataka wanasiasa kujiepusha na kuingiza siasa

katika juhudi za serikali za kuzuia matumizi ya vileo haramu akisisitiza kuwa ni suala la sheria. Kuhusu usalama, aliangazia uhusiano wa moja kwa moja kati ya matumizi ya dawa za kulevya, ulevi, na ongezeko la uhalifu. Alifichua mipango ya kuongeza uwezo wa Walinzi wa Pwani ya Kenya na Wanamaji wa Kenya ili kushika doria katika eneo la bahari ipasavyo, kuzuia boti ndogo zinazopakia dawa kutoka kwa meli kwenye bahari kuu. “Tumefunga angalau maduka 20,000 ya pombe yanayofanyika kazi bila leseni na viwanda 14 vinavyozalisha vinywaji haramu nchini,” alifichua. Mwenyekiti wa NACADA Stephen Mairori ni miongoni mwa waliokuwepo.

wote unaenda kwa serikali ya kitaifa, asilimia 20 kaunti na asilimia 10 kwa jamii katika maeneo ya uchimbaji madini. Asilimia moja ya ziada ya mauzo ya jumla kutoka kwa uwekezaji wa madini ingeenda kwa jamii kwa ajili ya miradi chini ya mfumo wa Kamati za Makubaliano ya Maendeleo ya Jamii (CDAC). Waziri alisema kuwa ubia wa uchimbaji madini lazima uwe wa manufaa kwa jamii na athari zake zinapaswa kuwa katika kuboresha maisha yao. “Kaunti ya Kilifi inatazamiwa kupokea nyongeza ya Sh 950 milioni kama mapato kutokana na shughuli za uchimbaji madini. Pesa hizi zinaweza kutumika kuboresha vifaa na kusaidia kaunti kurahisisha utoaji huduma,” akasema. Mvurya aliongeza kuwa, pesa zaidi zinatarajiwa kuingia katika kaunti za uchimbaji madini kwani jamii za maeneo ya uchimbaji madini pia zitapata mgao wao wa mrabaha. Kulingana na thamani na wingi wa madini yaliyotumiwa na wawekezaji, Waziri alifichua kuwa asilimia moja ya mauzo ya jumla inaweza kugeuka kuwa mamia ya mamilioni. Alisema kwamba, majaliwa ya madini ya Kenya kimsingi

yanalenga kusaidia kuinua jamii na kuboresha maisha ya wakaazi ambapo madini hayo yanapatikana. Waziri huyo aliongeza kuwa, mageuzi katika sekta ya madini yananiwa kufanya uchimbaji kuwa na faida na manufaa kwa wachimbaji, jamii na serikali katika ngazi za kaunti na kitaifa.

“Madini lazima yawe na matokeo chanya kwa jamii na hii ndiyo sababu sekta inaboreshwa ili kuhakikisha watu wanapata manufaa yanayoonekana,” alifafanua. Mkutano huo wa Nyari pia ulihudhuriwa na Gavana wa Kilifi Gideon Mung’aro, Mbunge wa Ganze Tungule Charo na Wabunge wa Bunge la Kaunti.

Maafisa wa serikali ya kitaifa katika kaunti hiyo wakiongozwa na Kamishna wa Kaunti Josephat Biwott pia walikuwepo. Gavana Mung’aro alisema kaunti hiyo itatumia mapato yatokanayo na mirahaba ya uchimbaji madini kuendeleza kimsingi huduma za kijamii, miundombinu na vifaa vya umma kwa jamii katika maeneo ya uchimbaji madini ya Ganze, Mtondia na Kitengeni. Alisema fedha hizo zitaanzisha hospitali ya vitanda 50 huko Kitengeni na kupanua vituo vya Bamba na Kalolenyi. “Kaunti itarudisha pesa hizi ili kuboresha vifaa na huduma katika maeneo mengi ya uchimbaji madini ambapo mrabaha unatoka,” alisema.

Ufanisi wa utendakazi katika Bandari ya Mombasa umevutia shehena na kufanya mapato kuongezeka mwaka huu. Kulingana na takwimu za 2023 zilizotolewa na Mamlaka ya Bandari ya Kenya (KPA), katika nusu ya kwanza ya 2024, KPA imeandikisha mapato halisi ya Sh33.7 bilioni ikilinganishwa na Sh27 bilioni katika kipindi kama hicho 2023 huku kukiwa na mashambulio dhidi ya meli katika Red Sea, na hivyo kulazimisha meli za mizigo kutumia njia ndefu. Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa KPA Kapteni William Ruto, alipokuwa akiitoa Mapitio ya Mwaka ya KPA na Takwimu za 2023, alisema kuwa licha ya hatari za kimataifa kuathiri uzalishaji, utendakazi wa bandari ulikuwa thabiti, huku mizigo ikiongezeka kwa asilimia 6.2 hadi kufikia tani milioni 35.98 (MT) mnamo 2023 kutoka MT milioni 33.88 mnamo 2022. Bandari ilihudumia MT

milioni 2.33 za shehena ya kontena, ikichukua asilimia 50.4 ya mizigo yote iliyohudumiwa. Trafiki ya makontena pia ilionyesha ukuaji wa tarakimu mbili wa asilimia 11.9, na kusajili vitengo sawa vya futi ishirini (TEUs) milioni 1.62 mnamo 2023 ikilinganishwa na TEU milioni 1.45 zilizopatikana mwaka wa 2022. Idadi ya meli zinazotia nanga katika bandari ya Mombasa ilipanda hadi 1,835 mwaka wa 2023 kutoka 1,561 zilizosa-

jiliwa mwaka wa 2022. Mkuu huyo wa KPA alibainisha kuwa kupanda kwa shehena ya kontena kumekuwa thabiti mwaka mzima na rekodi za juu zilizoshuhudiwa Mei katika TEU 155,204 na Desemba katika TEU 152,326 mtawalia. "Hii inaashiria kwamba ufanisi mkubwa wa kiuchumi katika eneo hili, sanjari na matumizi makubwa, una ushawishi wa moja kwa moja kwa kiasi kinachoshughulikiwa katika Bandari," Kapteni Ruto alisema. "Sehemu ya soko la usafiri wa umma ilifanya vyema kwa kuchapisha ukuaji unaoonekana wa asilimia 11.5, na kurekodi MT milioni 11.41 katika 2023 kutoka MT milioni 10.23 iliyosajiliwa mwaka wa 2022. Huu ni ushahidi wa ujasiri wetu katika kukabiliana na ushindani unaoongezeka kila wakati," aliongeza. Hata hivyo, kulikuwa na kupungua kutoka asilimia 71.5 ya hisa ya soko ya Uganda nchi ya upitishaji wa KPA mwaka 2022 hadi asilimia 62.3.

Bi. Nakhumicha alieleza kuwa uwekezaji wa awali katika miundombinu na vifaa vya kuendesha mageuzi ya kidijitali unaweza kuwa ghali na unaweza kuwa wa

kikwazo kwa kiasi fulani. "Lakini sote tunaweza kukubaliana kwamba pale ambapo tume-sambaza teknolojia hizi, matokeo yametonyesha kuwa sawa," alisema Nakhumicha. Waziri huyo alieleza zaidi kuwa serikali inaanini kwa dhiti kwamba ushirikiano na washirika wa maendeleo kama vile Shirika la Afya Duniani (WHO) unaweza kuongeza matumizi ya teknolojia na kuongeza ufanisi. "Ningependa kushukuru kwa dhiti WHO kwa kujibu ombi letu la msaada katika eneo hili, na vidonge 940 ni msaada mkubwa kwa kazi ya Mpango wa Kitaifa wa Chanjo na Chanjo," Nakhumicha alisema. Waziri huyo alieleza kuwa utoaji wa huduma bora za afya ya mama na mtoto ni sehemu muhimu ya lengo la Wizara ya Afya ili kuimarisha huduma ya afya ya msingi kama inavyolenga kutokomeza vifo vya mama na mtoto.

Why Attorney General's office cannot be independent of the executive

In recent legislative developments, amendments to the Office of the Attorney General Act, 2012 have drawn public and media scrutiny. The Statute Law (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill, 2023, approved by the National Assembly on March 20, 2024, awaits Presidential assent to become law.

Significantly, these amendments grant the Attorney General significant human resource powers previously held by the Public Service Commission, particularly in matters of recruitment, appointment, promotion, and discipline of the Solicitor General, Deputy Solicitors General, States Counsel, and other staff within the Office of the Attorney General.

A key consideration emerging from these changes is whether the Attorney-General can maintain independence from the national Executive, akin to the Director of Public Prosecutions (DPP).

Currently, the national Executive, as defined by the Constitution, includes the President, Deputy President, Cabinet Secretaries, and notably, the Attorney General. The President holds the constitutional authority to direct and coordinate the functions of the national Executive, including the Office of the Attorney General.

Unlike the DPP, who operates independently according to Ar-

article 157(10) of the Constitution, the Attorney General, whose office is established under Article 156 of the Constitution, is inherently integrated into the national executive framework, as there is no Constitutional provision that grants the Attorney General independence similar to that of the DPP. This integration precludes complete autonomy from the Executive, as the Attorney General and Cabinet Secretaries are individually and collectively accountable to the President for their actions and functions.

The proposed amendments seek to redistribute human resource management functions from the Public Service Commission to the Attorney General, facilitated by an advisory board. This move challenges the constitutional mandate of the Commission, which is tasked with setting norms and standards for the management of human resources in the public service under Article 234 of the Constitution.

Delinking the Office of

the Attorney General from the mandate of the Public Service Commission carries significant implications for staff and operations of the office. But what are the practical implications of this separation for the Attorney General's office and its staff?

As the Public Service Commission has been portrayed negatively, compelling the Office of the Attorney General to pursue legislative separation, it is crucial to provide the repercussions of such a statutory detachment from the Commission's perspective. After delinking, all staff of the Office of the Attorney General will initially remain seconded from the Public Service Commission until the office is officially designated as a public service for pension purposes. Subsequently, the Public Service Commission will oversee the transfer of service of all the staff members to the newly independent Office of the Attorney General.

Following this disengagement from the Commission's author-

ity, State Counsel, apart from those within the Office of the Attorney General, will require approval from the Commission for deployment elsewhere within the public service. Staff members currently assigned to the Office of the Attorney General will have to choose between transferring their services to the autonomous Office of the Attorney General or remaining under the Commission's mandate as government employees.

Moreover, State Counsel currently seconded to State Corporations and other agencies will have to choose between returning to the Office of the Attorney General or accepting full-time positions within their current organizations, as their secondment ends upon the delinking of the Office of the Attorney General. Additionally, the Attorney General will lose the authority to second officers to State Corporations and agencies without prior approval of the Commission, as these entities fall within the Commission's jurisdiction.

The Attorney General's ability to deploy State Counsel to Ministries, Departments, and Agencies (MDAs) will immediately terminate, as positions within MDAs are mandated to

be filled through competitive recruitment processes by the Public Service Commission.

Consequently, the Office of the Attorney General will operate akin to a private law firm, responding to Ministry directives through Legal Officers appointed by the Commission. The establishment of a pension scheme for the Office of the Attorney General and the creation of legal departments within Ministries will carry significant financial implications that might necessitate the generation of "a money bill" for the government.

The proposed amendment strips the President of the authority to appoint the Solicitor General, transferring this responsibility to the Attorney General based on recommendations of the advisory board. This shift alters the Solicitor General's status from a Presidential appointee, equal to a Principal Secretary, to an ordinary public officer appointed by the Attorney General.

Moreover, the proposed changes alter the recruitment process for the position of the Solicitor General, diminishing the President's and the National Assembly's role in the appointment. This shift raises questions about the broader implications for executive and legislative authority and ultimately constitutional adherence.

Serikali imeanzisha mpango wa ruzuku ili kupunguza kiasi cha pesa kinachotumika kwa uagizaji wa mafuta ya kupikia nchini. Ili kufikia lengo hili, imeanza mpango kabambe wa kukuza kilimo cha alizeti katika angalau kaunti 30 kote nchini. Ikizingatiwa kuwa Kenya hutumia angalau Sh160 bilioni kila mwaka kuagiza mafuta ya kupikia kutoka hasa mataifa ya Kusini-Mashariki mwa Asia, Dkt. Dominic Menjo, Mshauri wa Usalama wa Chakula katika Ofisi ya Rais, alisema kuwa serikali inashirikiana na kaunti 34 kupunguza uagizaji kupitia kupanda alizeti. Menjo alieleza kuwa Serikali ilianzisha Mradi wa Kukuza Mazao ya Mafuta ya Kupikia (EO-CPP) mwaka jana, ukiwa na lengo kuu la kukuza uzalishaji wa zao la mafuta ya kula katika kaunti mbalimbali. “Tulipoanzisha mradi huu, Kampuni ya Kenya Seed ilikuwa na tani 70 pekee, ambazo zingeweza kuchukua takriban ekari 25,000. Tukitegemea alizeti pekee, nchi itahitaji takriban ekari milioni tano. Tangu tunaagiza tani milioni moja za metriki na kila ekari inazalisha takriban lita 200, nchi imenunua takriban tani 500 za mbegu kutoka Zambia,” alifafanua. Alieleza kuwa tani 70 walizopata kutoka kwa Kampuni ya Kenya Seed tayari zimetolewa kwa wakulima katika Kaunti za Uasin Gishu na Trans Nzoia ili kuzidisha na kwamba kwa sasa serikali

inazinunua kupitia NCPB akiongeza kuwa mchakato huo unaendelea kwa sasa. “Tunaamini kuwa tani 70 pamoja na nyingine 30 walizopewa ADC kuzidisha zitapatia takriban kilo milioni 70 za mbegu ambazo tunaweza kupanda ekari milioni mbili za alizeti kwa ajili ya mvua fupi zinazoanza Oktoba mwaka huu,” alisema. Dkt Menjo aliahidi kuwa mwakani, nchi itakuwa na mafuta ya kutosha ya kula ambayo yatasaidia kupunguza uagizaji wa mafuta hayo kwa asilimia 50 na kuacha kuagiza kwa muda mrefu na kuwa muuzaji wa jumla ifikapo 2027. “Tunaagiza kutoka nje karibu asilimia 97 ya kile

Kenya to engage global partnerships at forthcoming IDA Africa Summit

There is no doubt that Kenya is one of the several nations with ambitious dreams of realizing economic prosperity. This is because sustainable economic growth is a necessary condition for broader development. Economic growth creates higher tax revenues, reduces government borrowing, and plays a key role in reducing debt-to-GDP ratios, all of which contribute to a more stable and prosperous economy. In the pursuit of economic development, external financing plays a crucial role, and Kenya recognizes the value of such partnerships.

In April this year, Kenya is gearing up to host one of the most significant global gatherings in the country—the International Development Association (IDA) Africa Summit, also dubbed as IDA21. This summit, organized by the Government of Kenya, will bring together African heads of state to discuss crucial matters like macroeconomic stability, fiscal management, domestic resource mobilization (DRM), and debt sustainability.

Kenya's commitment to reducing public debt and fostering economic growth is evident in its partnership with institutions like the World Bank and initiatives such as the IDA. Through programs like IDA21, Kenya aims to strengthen its fiscal policies, enhance DRM, and create an environment conducive to sustainable growth.

One of the most pressing issues facing many African countries, including Kenya, is the need to boost DRM. As highlighted by IDA data, tax revenues in many countries remain below 15 percent of GDP. This indicates a significant gap that needs to be addressed to finance crucial public services and development projects.

Kenya's efforts to tackle these challenges are commendable. The partnership with IDA and other financial institutions to implement reform programs, aimed at increasing tax revenue and prioritizing expenditures, is a step in the right direction. For example, the goal of reducing the fiscal deficit from 6.2 percent to 4.1 percent of GDP by 2023/24 demonstrates Kenya's commitment to fiscal discipline and sustainability.

Furthermore, Kenya's participation in the IDA Africa Summit signifies its eagerness to engage with international partners and harness external financing for accelerated development. Programs like IDA provide essential support through zero to low-interest loans and grants, which can catalyze economic growth, reduce inequalities, and improve the living conditions of the citizenry.

Critics might argue that Kenya should focus solely on domestic solutions for economic growth. However, in today's interconnected world, international partnerships are invaluable. They bring not just financial resources but also expertise, best practices, and access to global markets.

Moreover, the IDA Africa Summit presents a great opportunity for African countries to collaborate, share, and learn from each other. Discussions on DRM, fiscal sustainability, and debt management are crucial for the continent's economic future.

Some might express concerns about the potential risks of increased external financing and debt. This is a valid point, and one that should always be approached with caution. However, when managed effectively and transparently, external financing can be a powerful tool for any country's development.

As Kenya prepares to host the IDA Africa Summit, it is a moment of significance not just for the country but for the entire continent. The outcomes of this gathering could pave the way for improved fiscal policies, enhanced DRM, and strengthened institutions across Africa.

Benki ya Dunia, kwa ushirikiano na Mradi wa Pili wa Uboreshaji wa Makazi yasiyo Rasmi ya Kenya (KISIP 2), itajumuisha masuala ya Unyanyasaji wa Kijinsia katika miradi na operesheni zake zote. Bw. George Arwa, Mratibu wa Mradi wa Kitaifa wa KISIP2, alihutubia wafanyakazi kutoka Timu ya Kitaifa ya Uratibu wa Miradi (NPCT) wakati wa kufungwa kwa mafunzo ya siku mbili kuhusu Ukatili wa Kijinsia (GBV). Alisema kuwa wakati Serikali inatambua hatari kubwa zinazohusika na maovu hayo, KISIP 2 itakuwa imara na kuthibitisha dhamira yake ya kupunguza vitisho hivyo kwa watu wanaoishi na kufanya kazi katika maeneo ya mradi. Arwa aliongeza kuwa, mpango huu utahakikisha usalama na utu wa wakaazi, vibarua na watu wengine wanaohusika katika miradi hiyo. "Kuzuia unyanyasaji wa kijinsia, unyonyaji wa kingono, unyanyasaji, na unyanyasaji kunahitaji mkakati wa kina ambao unashughulikia mambo ya kimundo na kijamii yanayochangia dhuluma hizi," Mratibu wa Mradi alisema. Arwa alisema kuwa KISIP 2, Benki ya Dunia, na Agence Française de Développement

(AFD), ambao wanafadhili mradi huo, wanaanzisha mifumo thabiti ya kuripoti na mifumo ya usaidizi ili kuhakikisha Unyanyasaji wa Kijinsia, unyonyaji na unyanyasaji unafanyika haraka. kushughulikiwa, na wahusika kuwajibika. Huku akihimiza Timu za Uratibu wa Miradi ya Kaunti (CPCT), timu zinazosimamia, wanakandarasi, na washauri wanaofanya kazi katika miradi ya KISIP2 ili kuhakikisha kwamba inafuatwa na mahitaji ya Benki ya Dunia, Bw. Arwa alihakikisha kwamba "KISIP 2 imejitolea kwa dhati kukuza utamaduni wa kutovumilia kabisa ukatili wa kijinsia na unyonyaji." Kutokana na hali hiyo, Mratibu huyo alionya kuwa wahusika watawajibishwa, huku walionu-

surika wakipewa msaada unaohitajika ili kuponya na kujenga upya maisha yao. Aidha alizitaka NPCT na CPCT kuazimia kwa pamoja kujenga mustakabali ambapo kila mtu, bila kujali jinsia au historia, anaweza kustawi bila hofu ya unyanyasaji na unyonyaji. "Ahadi yetu ya kushughulikia GBV ndani ya KISIP 2 inaenea zaidi ya kufuata tu kanuni; ni sharti la kimaadili na onyesho la maadili yetu kama mradi. Tunatambua kuwa kufikia malengo yetu ya maendeleo kunategemea kuunda mazingira ambayo ni salama, jumuiishi, na yenye uwezo kwa wote," Mratibu wa Mradi alitangaza. Mafunzo ya GBV ni hitaji la lazima na Benki ya Dunia ambayo inaelekeza kuwa wafanyakazi wote wanaojishughulisha na miradi inayofadhiliwa na Taasisi ya

Bretton Woods, wachukuliwe kupitia mafunzo hayo. Maeneo ya mafunzo ni pamoja na maelezo ya kina ya jinsia na ngono, mahitaji ya Benki ya Dunia, unyanyasaji wa kijinsia dhidi ya watoto, aina za GBV na jinsi ya kuripoti kesi kama hizo, matibabu ya waathiriwa.

Wakati wa mafunzo, wafanyakazi pia huchukuliwa kupitia Kanuni za Maadili na sera za ulinzi wa data. Takwimu zinaonyesha kuwa GBV ni mojawapo ya ukiukwaji wa haki za binadamu ulioenea zaidi na uliofichwa ulimwenguni. Utafiti zaidi unaoonyesha kuwa tabia hiyo inaathiri watu wa jinsia zote, huku wengi wa wahasiriwa wakiwa ni wanawake na watoto wa chini ya umri. Mradi wa Pili wa Uboreshaji wa Makazi yasiyo Rasmi ya Kenya (KISIP 2) ni mradi wa Serikali ya Kenya (GOK) unaoifadhiliwa na Benki ya Dunia na Agence Française de Développement (AFD) kwa gharama ya Sh 31.7B. Ni mradi muhimu wa kuwezesha Dira ya 2030 unaozingatia ajenda ya Serikali ya kuwezesha wakazi katika kushiriki makazi yasiyo rasmi ndani ya kaunti zilizo-chaguliwa kufaidika kwa kupata huduma za kimsingi za miundombinu na usalama wa umiliki wa ardhi. Kupitia KISIP2, takriban makazi 200 yasiyo rasmi katika kaunti 33 yatanu-faika na ufadhili.

Mke wa Rais atoa matangi ya maji kwa shule 26 za Kajiado

Mkewe Rais, Rachel Ruto ametoa matangi ya maji kwa shule 26 katika eneo bunge la Kajiado Magharibi ili kuwawezesha kupata maji safi ya kunywa. Akizungumza katika Shule ya Msingi ya Kisaju wakati wa hafla ya kuadhimiisha Siku ya Maji Duniani, Mama wa Taifa alisisitiza umuhimu wa upatikanaji wa maji safi shuleni, kwani huathiri moja kwa moja afya ya wanafunzi, usafi na ufaulu wao kitaaluma. Bi Ruto alikariri kuwa kwa kutoa matangi ya maji kwa shule, wanafunzi wanapunguziwa mzigo wa uhaba wa maji, na hii inachangia uandikishwaji wa shule, uhafidhi, na mpito, kulingana na sera ya mpito ya asilimia 100. "Upatikanaji wa maji safi ni muhimu kwa afya na ustawi wa jamii zetu. Watoto wa shule wanahitaji maji ili kupunguza muda wanaotumia kutembea umbali mrefu kuyachukua," alisema. Aliongeza kuwa matangi hayo ya maji yataziwezesha shule hizo kuanzisha bustani za matunda na mboga mboga ili kuongeza lishe ya wanafunzi na

kutoa mafunzo kwa vitendo ili kusaidia Mtaala unaozingatia umahiri. Aidha Mke wa Rais alijitolea kuboresha ustawi wa wanafunzi kwa kushirikiana na viongozi na wabia ili kuhakikisha shule zote za umma za msingi na sekondari zinapata maji safi ya kunywa kwa kutoa matangi ya maji, visima, visima na visu. Bi Ruto alitoa wito kwa wakazi wa Kajiado kupanda miti ili kuhifadhi mazingira na kukabiliana na athari mbaya za mabadiliko ya hali ya anga. Alisema ili kufikia agizo la Rais la kupanda miti bilioni 15 kufikia 2032, ni lazima kila Mkenya aanze kwa kupanda miti nyumbani kwao. Viongozi wengine waliohudhuria hafla hiyo ni pamoja na Mbunge wa Kajiado Magharibi George Sunkuiya, Mwakilishi wa Wanawake Leah Sankaire, miongoni mwa wengine. Siku ya Maji Duniani inataka kuangazia shida ya maji duniani na kuongeza uelewa wa watu bilioni 2.2 wanaoishi bila kupata maji salama.

Kituo cha walemavu chapokea Sh1.8 milioni kutoka NFDK

Hazina ya Kitaifa ya Walemavu wa Kenya (NFDK) hutumia zaidi ya Sh300 milioni kila mwaka kununua zana za kufanya kazi na uhamaji kwa watu wenye ulemavu kote nchini. Kwa mujibu wa wadhamini wa Mfuko huo, shirika la serikali limetumia zaidi ya Sh1 bilioni katika miaka kumi iliyopita kusaidia taasisi maalum za elimu kwa ruzuku kwa shughuli mbalimbali, ikiwa ni pamoja na utekelezaji wa miradi inayoongoza. Wadhamini hao wakiongozwa na Makamu Mwenyekiti, Peter Nyakiamo, walitoa kauli hiyo katika Kituo cha Walemavu cha Magarini kilichopo Kijiji cha Mpirani Kitongoji cha Magarini, ambapo walitoa msaada wa vitu vyenye thamani ya Sh milioni 1.8 na kukabidhi hundi ya Sh300,000 kwa kituo hicho ili kukiwezesha kukamilisha mradi wake wa ufugaji kuku. Jumla ya walemavu 55 kutoka Kaunti Ndogo ya Magarini walipokea msaada huo ambao ni pamoja na viti vya magurudumu, viti vya mifupa, baiskeli tatu, mashine za kuosha magari, mashine za kuchomelea, cherehani,

saluni na kinyozi, tanki la maji na hundi zenye thamani ya Sh160,000. kununua mifugo kwa watu wanane wenye ulemavu. Kijiji cha Mpirani kinasifika kwa kuwa na watu wengi wenye ulemavu wa aina mbalimbali, huku takwimu zisizo rasmi zikionyesha kuwa kati ya wakazi hao takriban 2,000, takriban 250 kati yao wana ulemavu, hali iliyoyifanya Wizara ya Afya kufanya utafiti ili kubaini sababu. Utafiti huo ulifanyika mwaka jana baada ya vyombo vya habari kuangazia hali mbaya ya wanavijiji, lakini matokeo hayo bado hayajawekwa wazi, na wadhamini na viongozi wa mitaa wanatoa wito wa kutolewa kwa matokeo ili kuona kama hatua za kuzuia zinaweza kuchukuliwa. Akizungumza baada ya kukabidhi msaada huo, mmoja wa wadhamini hao, Dkt Mike Kisilu alisema kila mwaka Mfuko huo unasaidia walemavu zaidi ya 3,000 kwa vitendea kazi, shule maalum zipatazo 150 zikiwa na ruzuku ndogo ya Sh300,000 kila moja.

Uboru wa elimu katika kaunti ndogo 135 zinazolengwa nchini Kenya umeimarika kwa kiasi kikubwa katika miaka sita iliyopita, kutokana na mradi unaofadhiliwa na Benki ya Dunia. Kupitia Mradi wa Kuboresha Uboru wa Elimu ya Sekondari Kenya (SEQIP), kaunti ndogo kutoka kaunti 30 zilitambuliwa kupitia viengezo vikali vya uteuzi kutoka 2017 hadi Desemba 2023. Hatua muhimu, kama ilivyonyeshwa na Bw. Elijah Mungai, Mkurugenzi wa Uratibu na Utoaji Miradi katika Idara ya Jimbo la Elimu ya Msingi, ni pamoja na kupunguza uhaba wa

Mungai alitaja afua hiyo pia kuwa majaribio ya masomo ya utiririshaji wa moja kwa moja katika shule 10 za sate-laiti kutoka shule kuu mbili. Zaidi ya hayo, maendeleo ya kitaaluma ya walimu yaliimarishwa kupitia mfumo wa usaidizi wa walimu shuleni, na kunufaisha jumla ya walimu 51,950 katika shule za msingi 6,500 na shule za sekondari 2,000. Jumla ya vitabu 2,254,782 vya masomo ya Sayansi, Hisabati na Kiingereza viligaw-iwa kwa wanafunzi wote wa Darasa la 7 na 8 katika shule za msingi 7,852 na vingine 4,329,057 vilivyogawiwa kwa wanafunzi wa kidato cha I-IV katika shule za sekondari 2,147.
