:Waziri wa Habari, Mawasiliano na Uchumi wa Dijitali anasema vituo hivyo, ambavyo vitakuwa vimeunganishwa intaneti, wakufunzi na kompyuta, vitawaongoza wanafunzi kuelekea enzi ya dijitali ambapo wanaweza kujipatia mapato na kuathiri ulimwengu wa kidijitali

NA FLORENCE KINYUA NA FRANCIS ANJILWA (KNA)

Serikali inapanga kuanzisha angalau vituo 1,450 vya kidijitali katika kila wadi kote nchini ili kuwawezesha vijana kupata ujuzi wa dijitali, kusaidia kuziba pengo lilipo, na kupunguza viwango vya uhaba wa ajira.

Waziri la Habari, Mawasiliano na Uchumi wa Kidijitali Eliud Owalo alifichua kuwa mipango pia iko mbioni kufanikisha vituo hivyo kuwawezesha vijana kupata ujuzi wa dijitali.

Owalo alisema vijana wataweza kupata ulimwengu kidijitali, kufanya kazi, na kupata riziki na kuendeleza jamii kupitia jukwaa.

“Kupitia ICT, tutatengeneza ajira kwa vijana,” aliongeza. Vituo hivyo, alisema Waziri, vitakuwa na

“Tunataka watu waunganishwe na Australia, Singapore, na Kanada kufanya kazi wakiwa vijijini kwa sababu dunia ni kijiji cha kimataifa,” alibainisha Owalo. Alitangaza kwamba Serikali inaanunua simu za kisasa za bei nafuu ili kuwawezesha wananchi kupata huduma zote za serikali zinazopa-

tikana kwenye e-citizen.

“Tunalenga kuzuia wazazi kupata huduma muhimu kutokana na hongo katika ofisi za serikali kwa kutoa huduma zote muhimu kwa urahisi kupitia simu za kisasa,” alisema.

Wakati huo huo, Waziri aliwasilhi wanafunzi kutia bidii katika masomo yao na kuacha tabia ambazo zinaweza kuhatarisha kufanikiwa kwao maishani.

“Elimu ndiyo urithi wa pekee unaoweza kupata kutoka kwa wazazi wako, hivyo chagua marafiki wako kwa busara na ufanye kazi kwa bidii kwa ajili ya maisha yako

ya baadaye” alisema.

Waziri huyo alisisitiza kwamba elimu ndiyo uwekezaji wa thamani zaidi ambao mtoto anaweza kupokea kutoka kwa wazazi wake, na kwamba nidhamu, kujitolea, na kupenda vitabu ni muhimu.

Alisema kufaulu vyema ndiyo njia pekee ya kuonyesha shukurani kwa wazazi kwa upande wa wanafunzi.

Shule za msingi za umma 5,421 kote nchini zimepokea Sh2.6 bilioni ikiwa ni awamu ya kwanza ya kwanza ya mpango wa ufadhili uliobuniwa kusaidia taasisi hizi za masomo kuboresha matokeo katika masomo.

Kupitia kitita hicho, ambacho ni ruzuku inayofadhiliwa na Wizara

ya Elimu kupitia Mpango wa Elimu ya Msingi ya Kenya (KPEEL), kila shule itapokea Sh 480,000 ikiwa ni awamu ya kwanza ya Sh1.2 milioni, ambazo zitatengewa kila taasisi ya mafunzo katika awamu tatu.

Mkurugenzi katika Wizara ya Elimu, Bw Ndung'u Wainaina, anasema nia ya kufadhili shule hizo zilizochoaguliwa ilitokana na

Ripoti ya Mfumo wa Kitaifa wa Kufuatilia Mafanikio ya Wanafunzi (NASMLA) ya 2018, ambayo ilitambua baadhi ya shule kuwa nyuma katika masomo.

“Katika utafiti huu, baadhi ya kaunti zilionekana kuwa nyuma ikilinganishwa na utendakazi katika kaunti zingine, na tukadhani tunafaa kuzisaidia ili kupunguza tofauti,” alisema.

Bw Wainaina alisema hayo katika Shule ya Msingi ya Chuo Kikuu cha Maasai Mara katika Kaunti ya Narok baada ya kutathmini hali ya utekelezaji wa shule hiyo kwa kuzingatia vipaumbele vyake. Mkurugenzi huyo alisema Wizara imetayarisha shule za msingi zilizoathirika kuhusu jinsi

hiyo na siku ya kutoa zawadi.

Shule hiyo, ambayo kwa miaka mingi imekuwa mojawapo ya zilizofanya vyema zaidi katika kaunti hiyo itapokea kituo cha dijitali pia, hatua itakayosaidia kurejea katika hali yake ya kufanya vyema masomoni.

“Tutasaidia shule yenu kuwa na kituo cha dijitali kwa sababu ninafahamu kuwa inakabiliwa na changamoto fulani kuhusu miundombinu

lakini ndani ya mwezi mmoja tutakuwa na kituo cha kidijitali hapa” alisema waziri. Alisema kuwa kompyuta na wakufunzi watatolewa hadi shule ipate walimu wake.

Kwa upande mwingine, Mbunge wa Kandara Chege Njuguna aliwataka wazazi hao kuhusika kikamilifu katika maisha ya wavulana wao na kutoa ushauri wakati wa likizo ya Aprili.

Kwa mfano, “kuwa na mazungumzo na mtoto wako, mwonyeshe upande mzuri na mbaya

wa maisha na umuonyeshe hatari za kujihusisha na tabia isiyo ya kijamii ambayo itaharibu na kuharibu maisha yao” alisema.

Kama mzazi, ni muhimu kusikiliza na kushughulikia kwa makini wasiwasi wowote ambao mtoto wako anaweza kuwa nao kuhusu matumizi mabaya ya pombe au dawa za kulevya. Aliyekuwepo pia wakati wa hafla hiyo ni Mwenyekiti wa bodi ya KRA Anthony Mwaura, MCA John Munyua miongoni mwa wengine.

Wizara yatenga Sh 2.6b kushughulikia tofauti za masomo shule za msingi

ya kuwa mpango wa kuboresha shule (SIP) ili kutumia vyema ufaadhili huo.

“Na katika SIP hii, shule zilichoguliwa ziliweza kubainisha vipaumbele ambavyo vilidhani iwapo vitasaidiwa na kutekeleza vipaumbele hivyo, basi zingewafanya kuboresha matokeo katika shule hizo na hiyo ndiyo mipango tuliyo nayo sasa. Kuzisaidia,” alisisitiza Wainaina.

Alieleza kuwa fedha hizo zitatolewa kwa shule hizo kwa awamu tatu, huku akibainisha kuwa awamu ya kwanza ya Sh 480,000 ilitolewa kwa shule zilizoandaa Mpango wa Uboreshaji wa Shule.

“Baada ya shule kutekeleza vipaumbele vitatu kati ya vitano, tutazipa awamu ya pili ya dola za Amerika 3,000. Tutakuwa na awamu ya tatu na ya mwisho ya dola 3,000 za Am Erika,” alisema

Ndung’u.

Aidha, Mkurugenzi huyo alisema Wizara imebuni Mpango wa kufadhili Elimu ili kuhakikisha wanafunzi maskini wanasaidiwa kuendelea na elimu ya sekondari.

Alisema chini ya mpango wa KPEEL, Wizara imetoa ufaadhili wa masomo kwa takriban wanafunzi 34,000.

Bw. Wainaina pia alidokeza kuwa kupitia Mpango wa KPEEL, Wizara imeanza kuanza upya zana za wakufunzi katika Vyuo vya Ualimu vya Msingi vya Umma kuhusu Mtaala Unaozingatia Umahiri. Alisema vile vile wanaanzisha vituo ili kuwivezesha Vyuo hivyo kukumbatia ICT ili kumimarisha mafunzo na usimamizi wao, kutoa wakufunzi na kompyuta mpakato pamoja na kuvipatia vyuo hivyo vitabu muhimu vya rejea ili kurahisisha mafunzo kwa vitendo.

Mombasa yazindua mradi kutenganisha taka kutatua uchafuzi

Wakaazi wa Kaunti Ndogo za Likoni na Mvita, Mombasa wanafahamu na mradi wa ukusanyaji na ukarabati wa taka unaofanywa na Serikali ya Kaunti hiyo. Mradi huo utatekelezwa kupitia Utambulisho na Maandalizi ya Mradi wa Bahari Safi (COPIP), ambao ni mradi wa majaribio unaofadhiliwa na Benki ya Uwekezaji ya Ulaya (EIB) kwa ushirikiano na Idara ya Mazingira na Utawala. Inahusisha ukusanyaji wa taka ili yotenganishwa.

Angalau kaya 800 katika maeneo yaliyochaguliwa zimetambuliwa kutenganisha taka kwa kutumia mapipa matatu kutenganisha taka kavu, mvua na hatari. Wakati wa uzinduzi, vifaa vya kinga (glovu, barakoa, na buti za usalama), mapipa matatu, bin liner, na tuk-tuk ya umeme vilikabidhiwa kwa vijana na wanawake katika vikundi vya kudhibiti taka ili kukuza urahisi wa usafirishaji.

Mpango huo pia utajumuisha vipindi vya matibabu bila malipo na utoaji wa dawa muhimu zilizowekwa mahususi kwa watu wenye Ulemavu.

Akizungumza katika Shule ya Watu Wenye Ulemavu wa Akili Garissa wakati wa kuadhimisha siku ya uelewa wa ugonjwa wa Tawahudi duniani, Afisa Mkuu Mtendaji wa NCPWD, Harun Hassan alisema kuwa watu wenye ulemavu wametengwa kwa muda mrefu, na wanaendelea na mipango ya kuwasaidia katika siku zijazo.

Baraza pia lilitoa kambi za matibabu bila malipo, tathmini za ulemavu, tathmini za elimu, na vipindi vya tiba kwa watu wenye ulemavu wali-ohudhuria hafla hiyo.



Afisa Mtendaji Mkuu wa NCPWD, Harun Hassan akizungumza mjini Garissa wakati wa kuadhimisha siku ya uhamasishaji kuhusu ugonjwa wa Autism duniani. Alisema mipango inaendelea kushirikiana na hospitali zote za kaunti kutoa huduma za matibabu bila malipo kwa walemavu (PWD).

alisema kuwa bunge litaandaa mswada wa kuhakikisha kuwa walezi wote wa walemavu wanalipwa posho na serikali.

Vile vile, Dekow alisema kuwa ataanzisha zahanati maalum katika Shule ya Walemavu wa Akili ya Garissa ili kuwawezesha wanafunzi hao kupata huduma za matibabu kwa urahisi bila kupitia hospitali za kawaida ambazo wakati mwingine huwa na msongamano wa watu na kuwanyima huduma maalum wanazohitaji.

Alitoa wito kwa Tasisi ya Elimu Maalum ya Kenya (KISE) kupeleka walimu zaidi katika kituo hicho kinapotarajia kuwa na usajili wa juu zaidi muhula ujao.

“Tunataka wale wote wanaowahudumia watu wenye ulemavu mkubwa walipwe na serikali. Ninataka kutoa wito kwa wazazi ambao wana watoto wenye mahitaji maalum kuwaandikisha hapa tunaposhirikiana na washirika wote kuhakikisha kwamba tunatoa rasimilali za kutosha kwa ajili yao,” Dekow alisema.

Hivyo basi, Waziri huyo aliwataka wanafunzi kote nchini kukumbatia taasisi

za TVET ili kujipatia ujuzi unaofaa kwa soko la ajira ndani na nje ya nchi.

“Serikali imehakikisha maeneobunge yote yanakuwa na taasisi ya TVET ili kuhakikisha kuwa tuna kizazi kipya chenye ujuzi wa soko la ajira ndani na nje ya nchi,” Waziri Machogu alisema.

“Tayari, serikali imetoa Sh23 bilioni mgao wa shule za upili za umma, kumaliza mzozo wa

kifedha uliodumu, ambao ulitishia kutatiza shughuli katika taasisi hizo,” aliongeza.

Waziri huyo ambaye pia alithibitisha tena dhamira

ya serikali ya kuboresha miundomsingi ya shule, aliwazawadia shule za wasichana za Kolanya na St Pauls Amukura hundi ya Sh10 milioni kila moja ili kuboresha miundombinu kukidhi viwango vya wanafunzi katika shule hizo mbili.

Machogu pia alitoa wito kwa wazazi kutumia taasisi mbalimbali za TVET kuwapa watoto wao ujuzi unaoendana na soko la ajira. “Ulimwengu mzima sasa unaelekea tena kwenye kozi za kiufundi na ndiyo maana tumetilia

mkazo mafunzo ya TVET ili kutimiza ndoto ya CBC pamoja na kufikia maono ya 2030,” waziri alieleza.

Kauli yake inajiri huku Mbunge wa Teso kusini Mary Emase, akiitaka serikali kuwapandisha vyeo walimu kama kichocho cha kufaulu kwa ujumla shuleni.

“Tuna walimu wenye shahada ya uzamifu lakini bado wako shule ya msingi, ni wakati wa wizara kuangalia upya suala hili na kutekeleza mapendekezo ya jopo kazi la kupandishwa vyeo walimu,” alisema Emase.

The other parameters of the dam include embankment fill 78,278.94m³, height 12.50m, spillway width 15m, spillway length 18m, associated facilities and amenities. The project will be located between Goliba and Kithimani Town, Yatta Sub-County, Machakos County.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION ON THE DRAFT VETERINARY PRACTICE BILL 2024 (THE REVIEWED VETERINARY SURGEONS AND VETERINARY PARAPROFESSIONALS ACT 2011)

Effective delivery of Veterinary services is important for the development of the Animal Resource Industry in Kenya comprising livestock, wildlife, farmed wildlife, companion and aquatic animal species. The Animal Resource Industry has been identified as a priority key social economic enterprise in Kenya under the Bottom-Up Economic Transformation Agenda. The industry plays an important role in the national economy with a direct contribution of about 42 percent to the agricultural GDP and 12 percent to the national GDP (FAOSTAT, 2005). It plays a crucial role in ensuring food and nutritional security; supporting animal resource-based livelihoods and generating national income for the Kenyan population; enhancing production and productivity of animal resources; strengthening commercialization and market access of animal resources; improving Resilience for ASAL communities; and enhancing animal resource industry data management.

Following the promulgation of the Kenya Constitution 2010 and subsequent review, development and amendments of key policy instruments to align them to the Constitution, and the need to address the modern challenges faced in the Animal Resource Industry, harmonize and consolidate laws, the State Department for Livestock Development in collaboration with key stakeholders has reviewed the VSP Act 2011 and developed a Draft Veterinary Practice Bill 2024. The Bill is to provide for the establishment of the Kenya Veterinary Council; to provide for the training, registration, licensing, practice and employment of veterinary surgeons, veterinary para-professionals and veterinary specialists; to provide for the regulation of animal health training institutions; for the regulation of animal health and welfare; to provide for the establishment of the Veterinary Medicines and Vaccines Authority, for the regulation of veterinary pharmacy; to provide for the regulation of veterinary medicines, vaccines and other biologicals, nutrients and for connected purposes. Thus, a highly skilled human resource is required to provide services at all levels of the Animal Resource Industry development as provided in the Sessional Paper No. 2 and 3 of 2021 on the Veterinary Policy and the National Livestock Policy respectively.

In compliance with the provisions of the Statutory Instruments Act No. 23 of 2013, the Ministry announces to public availability of the above draft Bill on the websites of the Ministries of Agriculture and Livestock Development (www.kilimo.go.ke) and Information, Communication and Technology (www.ict.go.ke) for access and perusal.

The Public Service Commission, pursuant to the provisions of Section 48, 76 and 92 of the Public Service Commission Act, 2017, has developed **Draft Public Service Commission (Affirmative Action) Regulations, 2024** and Reviewed the **Public Service Commission (Removal of the Director of Public Prosecutions) Regulations, 2024**.



The Affirmative Action Draft Regulations is aimed at giving effect to the Constitutional requirement regarding inclusivity in terms of gender, Kenya's diverse communities, persons with disabilities and the youth in the public service. On the other hand, the Reviewed Draft Regulations on Removal of the Director of Public Prosecutions is as provided for under Article 158 of the Constitution and will provide for a framework for consideration of petitions for the removal of the Director of Public Prosecutions.

The Commission, therefore, invites stakeholders and the public in general to submit their views through written memoranda on the two Regulations.

Wizara ya Ushirika na Maendeleo ya Biashara Ndogo na za Kati (MSME) imeagiza vyama vya ushirika vya kahawa kuorodhesha na kuthibitisha madeni yao ili kusaidia Serikali kutenga pesa katika bajeti ijayo ili kuvinusuru na kufuta madeni vinavyodaiwa ili kufufua vinavyotatizika.

Waziri, Simon Chelugui, alibainisha kuwa kuorodhesha madeni hayo kutai-patia Serikali taarifa sahihi kuhusu kiasi kinachohitajika ili kuyalipa.

Akizungumza mjini Murang'a, Chelugui alisema Serikali imejitolea kufufua sekta ya kahawa, akibainisha kuwa njia mojawapo ya kufanya hivyo ni kufuta madeni wanayodaiwa wakulima kupitia vyama vyao vya ushirika.

Alieleza kuwa baada ya kupata takwimu sahihi ya madeni yote, wataomba kibali Bungeni ili fedha hizo zitengwe kwenye bajeti ijayo kufuta madeni hayo.

"Katika sekta ya maziwa, madeni yalifutwa, hivi sasa madeni katika sekta ya sukari yanashughulikiwea na sasa Serikali imejipanga kulipa madeni wanayodaiwa wakulima wa kahawa," alisema.

"Ninatoa wito kwa serikali za kaunti ambako kahawa inakuzwa kusaidia

katika kuorodhesha na kuthibitisha madeni ili kuharakisha mchakato huo," Waziri aliongeza.

Chelugui alisisitiza haja ya kufufua sekta ya ka-

Kahawa ni bidhaa ya pili kwa biashara duniani baada ya mafuta," Waziri

hawa akisema kwa kufanya hivyo mapato ya wakulima yataongezeka na pia kukuza ukuaji wa uchumi wa nchi.

"Kahawa ni bidhaa ya pili kwa biashara duniani baada ya mafuta. Zao la biashara linaingiza zaidi ya dola bilioni 625 kila mwaka lakini kwa bahati mbaya kinach-oenda kwa wakulima ni chini ya asilimia 25," alisema.

"Kama serikali, tuna-

taka kuwaondoa mawakala na mabroka 26 ambao wako kati ya wazalishaji na watumiaji wa kahawa," waziri aliongeza.

Mawakala hao, alisema, wamesababisha kushuka kwa thamani ya kahawa kwa asilimia 90 na kuwaacha wakulima kupata hasara.

"Katika siku za usoni, tunataka kuwaondoa mabroka wote na kuziba pengo kati ya wazalishaji na watumiaji. Hii itafanya mapato ya wakulima kuongezeka kwa kiasi kikubwa," aliongeza.

Chelugui alitoa wito kwa serikali za kaunti katika maeneo yanayolima kahawa kusaidia wakulima na miche bora ya kahawa ili kuongeza uzalishaji wa kahawa.

"Lengo letu ni kuongeza uzalishaji wa kahawa hadi zaidi ya tani 200,000 kila mwaka. Kwa sasa uzalishaji ni takriban tani 100,000 na uzalishaji mkubwa unaweza kupatikana kwa kutoa huduma za nyanjani kwa wakulima. Hili litafanywa na serikali za kaunti," akasema.

Waziri huyo aliendelea, "Wakulima pia wanahitaji pembejeo za hali ya juu na fedha ili kuongeza uzalishaji na serikali imetenga Sh8 bilioni ambazo zinaweza kufikiwa na wakulima kwa urahisi ili kuongeza uzalishaji.

KWA UFUPI

Sekta ya utalii yalenga ukuaji kupitia uwekezaji katika kaunti ya Narok

Waziri wa Utalii na Wanyamapori Alfred Mutua ametangaza kuwa Wizara yake imetenga Sh20 milioni kujenga eneo la kitamaduni na urithi huko Narok katika juhudi za kupanua sekta ya utalii.

Dkt Mutua, ambaye alizungumza katika hoteli ya Narok, alisema mpango huo unalenga kuongeza watalii wa kigeni kutoka milioni 2.5 hadi milioni 10 kwa mwaka nchini.

Waziri huyo aliandamana na Gavana wa Narok Patrick Ntutu na Katibu Mkuu wa Idara ya Wanyamapori Bi Sylvia Naseya, ambapo alisema kuwa ngazi mbili za serikali zitashirikiana kujenga vyoo katika mbuga za utalii ili kuboresha starehe za watalii. Katika azma ya kufanikisha hili, Dkt Mutua alisisitiza haja ya kuachana na bidhaa za kawaida za utalii na kufuata za kisasa zaidi za utalii.

"Bidhaa zetu hazijabadilika tangu mwaka 1970. Tunataka kutumia kila fursa ili tuweze kuwadumisha watalii nchini kwa siku nyingi zaidi," alisema

na kuongeza kuwa kadri watalii wanavyoendelea kubaki nchini ndivyo fedha zinavyoongezeka.

Alikariri kuwa eneo hilo litakuwa kituo ambapo wenyeji wataonyesha vitu vyao vya sanaa, muziki wa kitamaduni, na utamaduni wao, hivyo basi kujenga kivituo kikubwa cha watalii katika kaunti hiyo.

"Narok ni kubwa kuliko Hifadhi ya Kitaifa ya Maasai Mara. Ingawa hifadhi ya Kitaifa ni ya kipekee, kuna mengi zaidi ambayo tunaweza kuonyesha kutoka kwa kaunti zetu," aliendelea.

Sekta ya utalii pia itatambua makazi 15 ya jadi ya Wamasai ambayo yatatumika kama maeneo ya mfano kwa watalii kukaa wanapozuru kaunti hiyo.

"Watalii hawaji tu kuona wanyamapori, lakini pia wanataka kutangamana na Wamasai na kujua maisha yao. Hii inaweza kufanywa ikiwa tutakuwa na nyumba ya mfano ambapo wanakuja na kukaa siku kadhaa," alisema.

Trans Nzoia kuwapa wanafunzi wa shule za chekechea maziwa

Serikali ya Kaunti ya Trans Nzoia imezindua mpango wa maziwa bila malipo kwa shule za chekechea (ECDE).

Mpango huo unaolenga kuanufaiha watoto 41,000 wanaohudhuria shule za chekechea 434 kote katika kaunti hiyo, utagharimu Sh70m, huku kila mwanafunzi akipokea pakiti ya maziwa mara mbili kwa wiki.

Akizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi wa mpango huo katika Shule ya Msingi ya Kitale Township, Gavana George Ntembeya alisema kuwa utasaidia kukabiliana na changamoto ya utapiamlo miongoni mwa watoto na kuwahakikishia ustawi wao kwa ujumla huku wakitosheleza mahitaji yao ya kielimu. Ntembeya aliwataka walimu kusimamia mpango huo na kuhakikisha kuwa hakuna pakiti ya maziwa itakayotoka nje ya taasisi za masomo.

"Ninawaomba walimu kuilinda mpango huo ili kufikia malengo yaliyokusudiwa. Walimu wahakikishe hakuna mwanafunzi anayetoa maziwa nje ya eneo la shule. Maziwa haya yan-

alenga wanafunzi na yanapaswa kutumiwa shuleni pekee," alishauri.

Awali mpango huo ulijaribiwa katika vituo 50 vya kaunti kwa gharama ya Sh8 milioni.

Diwani wa Tiwani Daddy Were alipongeza Serikali ya Kaunti kwa kujitolea kuhakikisha kuwa sekta ya ECDE katika Trans Nzoia inakuwa miongoni mwa bora zaidi nchini.

Alitaja ujari wa hivi karibuni wa uzinduzi wa mpango huo kwa kazi ya kudumu na pensheni kuwa hatua nzuri. Haya yanajiri huku Kaunti ikiweka mipango ya kuajiri walimu 160 zaidi kwa masharti sawa.

Akikaribisha mpango huo wa maziwa bila malipo, Bw Were alisema mpango huo utahimiza watoto wengi zaidi kuwa shuleni na kukuza hamu ya elimu. Walioandamana na Gavana ni Katibu wa Kaunti Truphosa Amere na Mawaziri wa Kaunti Danstan Amboka (Kazi ya Umma), Janerose Mutama (Ardhi na Mipango Miji) na Stanley Kirui (Elimu).

utalii, elimu, utawala na ulinzi.

"Wakati wa mazungumzo yangu na Rais Nana Akufo-Addo, tumeona kwamba

mikataba hii ni muhimu katika mageuzi ya uhusiano wetu wa kidiplomasia, ambao umekitwa katika ushirikiano wa kihistoria,

mwema na wenye nguvu," alisema.

Alisema hayo wakati wa mkutano wa maandishi wa habari katika afisi ya Rais Akufo-Addo baada ya viongozi hao wawili kufanya mazungumzo katika ziara yake ya kitaifa nchini Ghana. Rais Ruto alipongeza uamuzi wa Ghana wa kuondoa hitaji la viza kwa Waafrika wote ifikapo mwisho wa mwaka, hatua inayolenga kuimarisha ushirikiano wa bara.

"Ahadi hii inawiana na moja ya malengo ya Eneo Huru la Biashara Huru la Bara la Afrika kuunda soko moja katika bara hili na kuen-deleza ukuaji wa uchumi, kubuni ajira na kuangamiza umaskini," alisema.
