

Simplification of the VAT Return Filing

Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA) wishes to remind all VAT registered taxpayers that the VAT return will be pre-filled with tax information available to KRA with effect from the **January 2024** tax period, to simplify the VAT return filing process and improve taxpayers' experience.

Any input VAT claim that is not validated through TIMS/eTIMS or against existing customs import declarations for import VAT claims will not be allowed. In this regard, we remind all taxpayers of their obligation to issue electronic tax invoices and transmit the invoice details to KRA as prescribed in law. The validity of electronic tax invoices can be confirmed by scanning the QR code or by entering the control unit invoice number in the invoice checker on the iTax Portal log-in page.

We further advise the VAT registered taxpayers that they are required to confirm the accuracy of the declaration before submission of the return since the pre-filled VAT return is a self-assessment return as prescribed in Section 28(4) of the Tax Procedures Act, CAP 469B. A step-by-step guide on filing of the auto-populated VAT return is available on the KRA website for reference.

KRA will continue to support and facilitate all taxpayers to comply with the electronic tax invoicing requirements.

Mpango kabambe wa Serikali wa kujenga nyumba 50,000 mjini Mombasa unazidi ku-shika kasi, kwani sehemu mbalimbali za ardhi zimetengwa kwa ajili ya Mpango wa Nyumba Nafuu (AHP).

Mpango wa Makazi ya bei nafuu (AHP) ni mojawapo ya miradi mikuu ya Utawala wa Kenya Kwanza, kama inavyopendekezwa katika Ajenda ya Mabadi-liko ya Kiuchumi ya Chini-Juu (BETA).

Baadhi ya maeneo yaliyopendekezwa ni pamoja na Ganjoni (ekari 2.1), Hobley (ekari sita), V.O.K (ekari 22), Shimo la Tewa (ekari 60), na Shirika la Nyumba la Taifa (NHC) (ekari 58 za ardhi Changamwe).

"AHP ni sehemu muhimu ya serikali hii lazima tu-hakikishe tunawapa wakaazi wetu nyumba nzuri na za bei nafuu," alisema Karanja.

Aliongeza: "Mpumo wa kimsingi wa AHP ni kwamba faida inaweza kuwekwa ndani kama kichocheo cha kiuchumi. Kila eneo bunge linatakiwa kuwa na angalau vitengo 200 kwa kuanzia."

Kupitia nyumba za kijamii zinazofikia Sh600,000, mtu anastahili kumiliki kitengo mara tu mnunuzi akilipa asilimia kumi. Ili kuhakikisha wa-fanyikazi wa Jua Kali wanufaika, AHP ina bidhaa 80 ambazo zinapaswa kutolewa na Jua Kali. Mafundi wa Jua Kali amba hawana vyeti watathibitishwa na mashirika husika ya seri-kali kwenye tovuti.

Suleiman Mwakisanga, Mwenyekiti wa Likoni Jua Kali, alisema vijana amba walikuwa wavivu sasa watapata fursa ya kufanya kazi katika AHP na kuboresha maisha yao.

Katibu wa Utawala wa Idara ya Nyumba na Maendeleo ya Miji, Bw. Hiram Kahiro, alisisitiza dhamira ya Serikali ya kutoa na kupa-makazi bora na ya bei nafuu kwa Wakenya wote.

SURGE IN IMPERSONATION OF KEBS INSPECTORS

Inakadirisha kuwa mji ulianza karibu 1922, na jengo la kwanza la kudumu la kibashara lilioanzishwa na serikali ya kikoloni katika miaka ya 1930.

Mji huo ulikuwa nyumbani kwa stesheni pekee ya treni katika eneo la Mlima Kenya, ambayo ilihifadhi uhai wake, shukrani kwa njia ya reli ya Nairobi-Nanyuki.

Katika miaka ya 1970 na 1980, mji huo ulijulikana sana kwa kuandaa kahawa, ngozi, samaki, kusaga unga, bohari za mafuta, yadi za mbao, na tasnia ya hoteli na burudani, inayoendeshwa kwa kiasi kikubwa na watu wanaofanya kazi katika viwanda.

Sagana ilijulikana kama "kimbilio la burudani" ambapo upendo wa kweli na haramu ulistawi. Sekta ya burudani ya jiji iliendeshwa kwa kiasi kikubwa na mtiririko inkubwa wa pesa kutoka kwa tasnia.

Wafanyabiashara kutoka

Meru, Embu, Isiolo, Nyeri, na Murang'a walitegemea njia ya reli kwa usafirishaji wa bidhaa kutoka Nairobi na Mombasa, huku mji huo ukiwa na safari nyingi za kuhifadhi.

Uchumi wa jiji hilo ulikuwa ni tapestry mahiri ya biashara, huduma, na uten-genezaji, na tasnia hizi ziliikuwa injini za maendeleo na utoroshaji wa usiku ambaao ulifanya mji huo kuwa maarufu. Viwanda vilivutia wafanyakazi wengi kutoka mbali kama Bonde la Ufa na Magharibi mwa Kenya.

Hata hivyo, kudorora kwa taratibu kwa mtandao wa usafiri wa reli nchini, ambaao ulianza miaka ya 1980, na kulemaza mojawapo ya miundomsingi ya zamani ya uchukuzi nchini Kenya, hakujamuacha Sagana.

Kitovu cha viwanda kili-choibuka cha miaka ya 1970 na 1980 kilikufa polepole, na kuacha nyuma njia ya kukata tamaa kutoka kwa wamiliki wa biashara ambaao walikuwa wamewekeza katika mji huo.

Leo, mji umevaa historia yake kama beji ya kujivunia, na maghala yake tupu na milango iliyofungwa kwa viwanda vilivyokuwa vyema vinavyozungumza mengi ya zamani zake za utukufu.

Kwa Jeremiah Makimi, Mbunge wa Wadi ya Kariti katika Bunge la Kaunti (MCA), tofali tupu na chokaa ni ukumbusho uliokwama wa enzi ya mafanikio ya zamani.

Kila wanafunzi kutoka kaunti hizo mbili alipokea kiwango cha juu cha Sh50,000 kila mwaka kugharamia masomo yake ya miaka minne.

Akizungumza katika hafla ya utoaji wa tizo hizo iliyofanyika katika viwanja vya hoteli ya kampuni hiyo, Makamu Mwenyekiti wa taasisi hiyo, Balozi Joshua Terer, alisitisiza kuwa elimu bora inahitaji msingi imara na uwekezaji wa mitaji kwa vijana ili kupata ujuzi na kufanya maamuzi sahihi.

"Elimu ina jukumu muhimu katika siku zijazo za jamii yetu. Katika Finlays Community Trust, tunatambua na kuthamini hitaji la jumuiya ya mtaji wa kibinadamu, na kutoa ufadhili wa masomo ni mojawapo ya njia za kuaminika za kukuza ukuaji wa muda mrefu na uendelevu katika eneo hilo.

Kwa kuwa elimu ni rasili-mali ambayo hakuna mtu anayeweza kuwanyang'anya watoto katika jamii yetu, tumeji-panga kuhakikisha wanaipata,"

alisema Balozi Terer. Aliwahakikisha wazazi wa wanafunzi hao 20 kwamba kampuni hiyo itaendelea kusaidia wanafunzi wanaofanya vyema katika mtihani wao wa kitaifa wa KCSE.

Sammy Kirui alifichua kuwa ufadhili huo unatolewa kwa ufaulu na mwaka huu waliutunuku wanafunzi 20 wa hali ya juu na wasiojiweza kati ya 100 walijotumua maombi yao wame-pata katika ya alama 407 na 379 katika KCPE ya 2023 na kuch-aguliwa. kujinga na shule za sekondari kote nchini.

Alisema msaada unaotolewa na Trust ni shukran kwa wafanyakazi wao na jamii jirani.

Mkurugenzi wa Elimu Kaunti ya Kericho Julius Ngoneshi ali-wambia wanafunzi walipata ufadhili huo wafanye kazi kwa bidii katika masomo yao na kuacha tabia mbaya kwani wali-kuwa na bahati ya kuchaguliwa kuendelea na masomo yao ya shule ya upili kujitolewa.

Wakati wa hafla hiyo mlezi wa Trusts Simon Hutchinson alisema wataendelea kufanya kazi na jamii za eneo hilo ili kuboresha mahitaji ya elimu ya watoto katika kaunti za Kericho na Bomet.

ikilenga kusaidia wanafunzi wengi wenye ujuzi kutoka katika mazingira magumu ya kifedha.

Akizungumza wakati aktunuku buraza hizo, Gavana Prof. Hillary Barchok aliwapongeza wanufaika hao kwa kuchapisha matokeo bora licha ya mazingira

magumu wanayotoka.

"Programu hii inalenga kuwawezesha wanafunzi mahiri na wenye bidii kama nyinyi ili maisha yenu ya baadaye yawe bora zaidi kuliyo yenu leo," Gavana Barchok aliwambia walengwa walioandamana na wazazi na walezi wao kwa hafla hiyo

ya kupendeza iliyoandaliwa katika Uwanja wa Michezo wa Bomet Green.

"Mwaka huu, tumetenga Sh 141millioni kwa ajili ya programu hii kati ya hizo Sh milioni 116 zitagharamia programu za ufadhili wa masomo ya shule za sekondari kamili na nusu huku Sh milioni 25 zitagharamia programu za ufadhili kamili na sehemu za Vyuo vya Ufundu na Ufundu," Prof Barchok aliongeza.

Hafla hiyo ilihudhuriwa na wageni watatu maalum ambao hapo awali walina-faika na programu kamili ya ufadhili wa masomo katika Emmanuel Kipkirui wa Shule ya Sekondari ya Kamungei aliyeypata A, Sandyabel Kibet wa Shule ya Upili ya Baringo na Enock Kipyegon, ambao wote walipata alama ya wastani ya A- katika shule ya upili. matokeo ya KCSE yaliyotolewa hivi majuzi.
