Serikali imechukua hatua madhubuti kuhakikisha Shule za Sekondari Msingi zinakuwa na miundombinu muhimu ifikapo mwaka 2025, wakati wanafunzi wa darasa la tisa watakapojiunga na Shule ya Sekondari Msingi. Waziri wa Elimu, Ezekiel Machogu alisema katika mwaka huu wa kifedha, Sh3.9 bilioni zimetengwa kwa ajili ya ujenzi wa madarasa ya Shule ya Sekondari Msingi.

"Aidha, Benki ya Dunia itatoa Sh9 bilioni zaidi kwa ajili ya kusaidia ujenzi wa madarasa 9,000. Hili pamoja na msaada wa Hazina ya Serikali ya Kitaifa ya Ustawi wa Maeneo Bunge, utatuhakikishia kuwa tutakuwa na vyumba 15,021 vinavyohitajika kwa ajili ya wanafunzi wa darasa la 9 ifikapo mwaka 2025.," Machogu alieleza. Akizungumza katika Shule ya Lenana wakati wa kutangaza matokeo ya uteuzi wa wanafunzi wanaoijiunga Kidato cha Kwanza, Machogu aliwataka Wakuu wa Shule na Bodi za

Usimamizi (BoM) kutumia kwa uanagalifu fedha zote zinazotolewa kwa shule kwa malengo yaliyokusudiwa. "Matumizi haya ya kimkakati sio tu yatatusukuma kufikia mpito wa asilimia 100 lakini pia kuchangia katika uboreshaji wa mazingira ya kujifunza, kuhakikisha kupatikana kwa haki ya elimu ya msingi," Machogu alisema. Waziri huyo alieleza kuwa, Wizara ya Elimu inaendelea na mabadiliko ya kimtazamo katika mfumo wake wa

sababu ya ubora wake, lakini biashara ya uchuuzi ina nia ya kuharakisha mapato hatimaye inahatarisha ubora," alisema Kamau. "Kuna viwanda vimepungua kati ya kilo milioni tatu hadi tano lakini kwa ujumla, ukiangalia hasara hasa kwa wakulima wadogo, tunazungumzia hasara ya Sh53.5 bilioni zinazopotea za wakulima," aliongeza. Uchuuzi wa majani mabichi ni kinyume cha sheria kwa mujibu wa Kifungu cha 6(4) cha Sheria ya Chai ya mwaka 2020.

Vifungu vya Sheria hiyo vinakataza mkulima kuuza majani mabichi kwa mtu yeyote isipokuwa kiwanda cha chai alichokidishwa.

Vile vile, kiwanda cha chai kinaweza tu kununua majani mabichi kutoka kwa wakulima wake wa chai waliosajiliwa. Kwa mujibu wa kanuni hizo, iwapo mkulima atauza chai kwa kiwanda kingine ambako hawajasajiliwa adhabu yake ni Sh100,000 au kifungu cha miezi sita jela.

Na kiwanda kikinunua chai kwa mkulima ambaye hajasajiliwa chini ya kiwanda hicho, faini yake ni Sh5 milioni au kifungu cha miaka mitatu jela. Gari ambalo limekuwa likisafirisha chai hiyo pia linaweza kutwaliwa na serikali kwa mujibu wa kanuni. "Tunajaribu kuwaelimisha wakulima na vile viwanda vinavyotumia chai hii ili waelewe kuwa kinachofanyika ni kosa,"

mwenyekiti huyo alisema. "Serikali inatoa ruzuku kwa mkulima kwa ajili ya mbolea na hivyo itakuwa si haki kwa mkulima kupokea mbolea kutoka serikalini na kiwandani kisha kupeleka mazao yake kwa mtu mwingine.

Na haya ni baadhi ya maeoneo ambayo tunazungumza na wakulima ili tuweze kupata njia ya kusonga mbele," Kamau alisema.

Inaonyesha dhamira yetu ya kukuza elimu iliyokamilika ambayo inapita zaidi ya mitihani, tukitilia mkazo zaidi ujuzi na ukuzaji kamili wa wanafunzi. Mfumo huo mpya, ambao utekelezaji wake ulianza mnamo 2017 utawafanya washiriki wake wa kwanza kujiunga na darasa la 8 katika Shule ya Sekondari Msingi Januari 2024 na darasa la 9 mnamo 2025," Machogu alieleza. Alisema kwa kuzingatia mapendekezo ya Jopo Kazi la Rais kuhusu Mageuzi ya Elimu, Darasa la 8 na Darasa la 9 la Shule ya Sekondari Msingi itafanyika katika

shule za msingi zilizopo. "Ikumbukwe kwamba, asilimia 93 ya mawasilisho yaliyopokelewa na Jopo Kazi kutoka kwa washikadau mbalimbali yali- pendeketeza Shule za Vijana ziandaliwe katika shule za msingi zilizopo. Ni asilimia tano pekee ya mawasilisho yaliyopendekeza kuandaliwa kwa Shule ya Sekondari Msingi katika shule za upili zilizopo, huku asilimia mbili ikipendekeza shule mpya kwa Shule Sekondari Msingi.

Waziri alieleza kuwa, kila njia itatoa seti ya kipekee ya masomo na uzoefu wa kujifunza ambao unalingana na njia mahususi za kazi. "Katika suala hili, miongozo ya Shule ya Juu ya upangaji itakuwa tayari ifikapo Aprili 2024 na BOM zinatarajiwa kujiandaa kwa utekelezaji wa mtaala wa CBC," alisema. Aliendelea, "Tunaendelea kufanyia kazi utekelezaji wa mapendekezo mbalimbali ambayo Jopo Kazi lilitoa, kwa ajili ya utekelezaji mzuri wa CBC.

REGULATORY IMPACT STATEMENT ON THE DRAFT CLIMATE CHANGE (CARBON MARKETS) REGULATIONS, 2023

Pursuant to Section 8 of the Statutory Instruments Act, 2013, the Cabinet Secretary, Ministry for Environment, Climate Change and Forestry notifies the General Public that a Regulatory Impact Statement on the Draft Climate Change (Carbon Markets) Regulations, 2023 has been prepared to assess the impact of the Regulations on the public.

The Draft Regulations are made by the Cabinet Secretary pursuant to Sections 23A (2), 23E (9) and 23I of the Climate Change Act, 2016 and they operationalize salient provisions of the said Act. The objectives of the Draft Regulations are to:

- provide a framework for implementation of carbon market projects;
- create incentives and implement initiatives to support Greenhouse Gas emissions reduction and removal targets in line with Nationally Determined Contributions; and
- provide guidance on the annual social contribution for carbon market projects.

This is therefore to request the public and all persons likely to be affected by the Draft Regulations to submit written memorandum on the Draft Regulations to reach the undersigned within Twenty Eight (28) days from the date of publication of the Gazette notice.

The hardcopies of the written memoranda may be submitted to the Office of the Principal Secretary, State Department for Environment and Climate Change, NHIF Building, Ragati Road, P.O. Sh2.9 bilioni kugawiwa kaunti zenye madini kama mirahaba ya uchimbaji

Kaunti zenye utajiri mkubwa wa madini zinatazamiwa kuvuna, huku serikali ikitenga Sh2.9 bilioni kwa ajili ya kulipwa kama mirahaba ya uchimbaji kwa kaunti zenye madini. Waziri wa Madini, Uchumi wa Bluu na Masuala ya Bahari, Salim Mvurya alitangaza kuwa, fedha hizi zimetengwa kwa mwaka wa kifedha wa 2023/24.

Zitagawiwa kwa kaunti ili kuongeza mapato yao kutoka kwa hazina kama mgao wa usawa. Waziri alitoa tangazo hili alipokuwa akihutubia wakazi katika kijiji cha Kishushe, Wundanyi, Kaunti ya Taita-Taveta.

Aliongoza utoaji wa hundi ya Sh20 milioni ya Uwajibikaji kwa Jamii (CSR) ili kusaidia miradi ya maendeleo katika eneo hilo. Kiasi hiki ni sehemu ya hazina ya Sh30-milioni ambayo mwekezaji wa ndani wa madini ya chuma analazimika kutoa kwa jamii kama sehemu ya mpango wa



Waziri wa Madini, Uvuvi na Masuala ya Baharini, Salim Mvurya (wa tatu kushoto) akiandamana na Karibu wa Madini, Elijah Mwangi (wa pili kushoto) akimkabidhi Gavana wa Kaunti ya Taita Taveta Andrew Mwadime (wa nne kushoto) hundi ya Sh20 milioni. na viongozi wengine wa bunge la kaunti na taifa kama sehemu ya juhudi za CSR zinazofanywa na kampuni ya uchimbaji madini ya Kishushe.

wa CSR. Lengo ni kukuza maendeleo na kuunga mkono miradi mingine ya kimaendeleo iliyoanzishwa na jamii. Mvurya alisema ukaguzi ulifanyika mnamo 2016 kwa makampuni yote ya madini ambayo yamekuwa yakipeleka mirabaha yao serikalini. Baada ya hesabu kutoka kwa mapato yaliyopokelewa kutoka kwa kampuni za uchimbaji madini katika kaunti 32,

serikali ililipa Sh2.9 bilioni ambazo zingelipwa katika kaunti hizo. "Tumetenga Sh2.9 bilioni ambapo mrabaha kutokana na shughuli za uchimbaji madini umekusanywa," alisema Mvurya. Kaunti ya Taita-Taveta itapokea Sh55 milioni kutoka kwa kiasi hiki, huku sehemu nzuri ya mgao huo ikitarajiwa kwenda kwa shughuli za maendeleo katika jamii za maeneo ya

uchimbaji madini. Waziri pia alifichua kuwa Wizara ilitengeneza kanuni na mfumo wa ugawanaji mapato ambao utaongoza na kueleza mbinu za kugawana fedha za mrabaha na jamii.

Mvurya aliandamana na Katibu-Idara ya Madini Elijah Mwangi, Gavana wa Taita Taveta Andrew Mwadime, Naibu Gavana Christine Kilalo, na Mbunge wa Wundanyi Danson Mwashako.

KenInvest yazindua Mpango Mkakati 2023-2027 kuinua mazingira ya uwekezaji

Mamlaka ya Uwekezaji nchini Kenya (KenInvest) imezindua hatua za kina za kuimarisha mazingira ya uwekezaji kupitia uzinduzi wa Mpango Mkakati wake wa 2023-2027, unaolenga kuvutia uwekezaji na kuchochea uwekezaji nchini. Kuzinduliwa kwa Mpango Mkakati kunafuatia kuchapishwa kwa rasimu ya mswada wa kukuza na kuwezesha uwekezaji na KenInvest, ambayo sasa iko wazi kwa ushiriki wa umma. Hatua hii inadhahirisha dhamira ya serikali ya kuweka mazingira wezeshi kwa uwekezaji nchini. Mradi wa Support to CoM SSA unafadhiliwa kwa pamoja na Umoja wa Ulaya na Ujerumani na unatekelezwa kwa pamoja na GIZ nchini Kenya. Maabara za jiji ni michakato iliyo pangwa ambayo inaleta pamoja wadau tofauti, kama vile serikali, mashirika ya kiraia, na wasomi, ili kuzalisha na kutumia ujuzi katika kushughulikia masuala changamano ya maji. Kupitia mradi huo, suluhu madhubuti ya changamoto za mafuriko ya maji na kukabiliana na hali ya hewa katika jiji la pwani itaendeleza kupitia mchakato ulioandaliwa na shirikishi unaohusisha kaunti, wasomi, mashirika ya

Utafiti uliofanywa na Baraza la Kitaifa la Idadi ya Watu na Maendeleo (NCPD) umeonyesha kuwa, visa vya mimba za utotoni nchini vimepungua kwa kiwango kikubwa tangu 2022. Mkurugenzi Mkuu (DG) wa NCPD, Dkt Mohamed Sheikh, alibainisha kuwa mnamo 2022, kiwango cha kitaifa cha mimba za utotoni kilifikia asilimia 15, chini ya asilimia 18 ya mwaka uliopita. Wakati wa warsha katika mji wa Nanyuki ya kugagua ahadi zilizotolewa na nchi katika Kongamano la Kimataifa la Idadi ya Watu na Maendeleo (ICPD), hotuba ya Dkt Sheikh, iliyotolewa kwa niaba yake na Margaret Muthoni ambaye ni Mkurugenzi wa Huduma za Biashara wa NCPD, ilionyesha kwamba kiwango cha vijana mimba zilifautiana kutoka kata moja hadi nyingine. Miongoni

mwa ahadi ambazo Kenya ilitoa katika kongamano la ICPD 2019 jijini Nairobi, ni kukomesha tishio mara tatu la VVU na Ukimwi miongoni mwa vijana, Ukeketaji (FGM), na mimba za utotoni. "Kuna tofauti kubwa katika kaunti, huku Samburu ikiripoti zaidi ya nusu ya asilimia 50.1 ya vijana waliojifungua au kupata mimba ya mtoto wa kwanza ikilinganishwa na Nyeri ambayo iliripoti kiwango cha asilimia 4.5," alisema DG. Dkt Sheikh aliona kuwa katika Kaunti ya Laikipia, kiwango cha mimba za utotoni kilifikia asilimia 9, ikiwa imesalia juu kwa muda mrefu huku takriban robo ya mimba zote katika kaunti hiyo kuanzia 2016 hadi 2022 zikitokea miongoni mwa vijana wa umri wa miaka 10-19. miaka. "Mwaka wa 2022 pekee, vijana 260 kutoka Laikipia walipata ujauzito," aliongeza.

Pursuant to Regulation 21 of the Environmental Management and Coordination (Impact Assessment and Audit) Regulations, 2003, the National Environment Management Authority (NEMA) has received an Environmental Impact Assessment Study Report for the above proposed project.

The proponent **Central Rift Valley & Lake Victoria North Works Development Agencies** intends to construct a dam which will involve gravity flow distribution of treated water. The design capacity of the proposed dam is 74167M³/day. The proposed dam will submerge the existing two rivers dam and therefore the current production (12000M³/day) of the existing two rivers dam will be lost. The selected dam type is Roller Compacted Concrete Dam(RCC)of structural height 39.3m high with an Overflow Ogee Spillway(126m) stepped spillway chute and a stilling basin. Other key features of the proposed dam include: Riverbed Elevation(2150masl), Storage Level(2173.55masl), Full Supply Level(NWL):2180.3Masl), maximum water level at floods (2182.80masl), Dam Crest Level (2184.3masl),Dead Storage 6.62Mm³, Live Storage 9.06Mm³,Total Dam Volume 15.686Mm³, Area Inundated at Full Supply Level 1.74Km². The raw water from the two rivers dam will be transmitted to the Sosiani Water Treatment Works for treatment before distribution to consumers. The project will be located in Eldoret town Uasin Gishu County

The following are the anticipated impacts and proposed mitigation measures:

Loss Of Biodiversity (Flora)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Where possible, clearing of vegetation more so the indigenous trees need to be avoided during construction as much as possible Where clearing of trees is inevitable, the land should be landscaped and planted with as much indigenous vegetation as possible so as to restore the lost biodiversity. The extent of clearing within the work stations should be clearly marked. Instruct all construction workers to restrict clearing to the marked areas and not to work outside defined areas. Avoid introduction of invasive alien species in the landscaping activities.

Serikali ya Kaunti ya Nakuru inawataka wakulima kuwa waangalifu na wasiwe waathiriwa wa wafanyabiashara wasio waaminifu ambao wameunda vikundi vya biashara ya mbegu ghushi na pembejeo duni za kilimo. Naye Waziri wa Kilimo, Mifugo na Uvuvi wa Kaunti Leonard Bor alisisitiza kwamba, matumizi ya mbegu na mbolea zilizoidhinishwa ni muhimu ili kuhakikisha usalama wa chakula, hasa wakati wa mvua za kutosha. Bw. Bor aliwashauri wakulima kujiepusha na ununuzi wa mbegu zilizo-pakiwa kwenye kontena zisizo na lebo, akibainisha kuwa wafanyabiashara hao hawakuwa na leseni zinazohitajika kutoka kwa Huduma ya Ukaguzi wa Afya ya Mimea (KEPHIS) ili kuhifadhi mbegu zilizoidhinishwa. bora zilizoidhinishwa na taarifa zao. Kwa hivyo, Serikali ya Kaunti ya Nakuru imeazimia kushirikiana na Kampuni ya Kenya Seed kutoa mafunzo na kuandaa siku za shamba za wakulima kama hatua ya kukabiliana na tishio la mbegu ghushi na ubora duni wa pembejeo za kilimo," akafichua. CECM ilionyesha kuwa ufuatiliaji wa mbegu zilizoidhinishwa ni rahisi. Aliwashauri wakulima kutunza pakiti na stakabadhi kwani hizo zinaweza kuhitajika kama ushahidi endapo kuna tuhuma za mbegu feki. "Ili kufanikiwa kupambana na mbegu mbovu, mkulima anafaa kuangalia pakiti na wataona nembo ya KEPHIS. Mara tu wanapoikwaruza, watapata nambari ya mfuatano ambayo inaweza kutumwa kwa msimbo ambao

ghushi itaachwa ishamiri, itakuwa tishio kwa tasnia ya mbegu ambayo inapoteza mamilioni ya pesa katika mauzo ya kila mwaka. Aliwaambia wakulima kununua mbegu zinazopendekezwa kwa maeneo yao kwa kuwa kila mkoa una mbegu zilizotengenezwa mahususi kulingana na hali ya hewa yake. Bw Bor pia alishauri wakulima kuruhusu upimaji wa udongo mara kwa mara ili kubaini aina na wingi wa mbolea ya kutumia. CECM iliona kuwa Kampuni ya Mbegu ya Kenya inatoa jalada pana la zaidi ya aina 60 za mbegu zilizoidhinishwa, iliyoundwa kwa maeneo mbalimbali ya ikolojia ya kilimo katika eneo hili. Kampuni hiyo aliongeza, inadhibiti zaidi ya asilimia 80 ya soko la mahindi ya mbegu nchini Kenya. Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa KEPHIS Prof Theophilus Mutui awali aliwaonya wafanyabiashara wa kilimo cha kilimo akisema watakapatikana wakuiza mbegu ghushi wanakabiliwa na faini ya hadi Sh1 milioni na kifungo cha hadi miaka miwili jela katika hatua mpya ya serikali ya kuwaondoa wafanyabiashara wasio waaminifu sokoni. Prof Mutui alisema shirika hilo limepokea malalamishi kutoka kwa wakulima kuhusu uzaji wa mbegu ghushi na wafanyabiashara. Kwa mfano, tuna mchakato wa kutoa zabuni ambao unaendelea kuweka uwanja mkubwa hapa kwenye uwanja wa maonyesho kwa gharama ya kati ya Sh1.5- Sh1.8 bilioni," Sang alisema wakati wa kuanzishwa kwa Mpango Shirikishi wa Maendeleo wa Kaunti ya 2023-2027. Uwanja wa Eliud Kipchoge mjini Kapsabet. Gavana huyo aliongeza kuwa kuna barabara nyingi zinazofanywa na serikali ya kitaifa katika Kaunti ya Nandi ikijumuisha soko linalopendekezwa la mamilioni ya manispaa. "Tuna barabara zinazofanywa na Serikali ya Kaunti ya Nandi na zingine na serikali ya kitaifa

kufanya uwekezaji mkubwa ambao ni lazima kunaswa katika CIDP," alisema. Gavana alisisitiza kuwa CIDP iliyoidhinishwa haitaonyesha tu maendeleo yanayofanywa na Serikali ya Kaunti bali pia maendeleo yanayofanywa na serikali ya kitaifa na kusifu timu hiyo kutoka serikali ya kitaifa katika ngazi ya kaunti na Hazina ya Kitaifa kwa jukumu lao muhimu katika kuunda Nandi CIDP. "Ajenda yangu kama kiongozi wa timu itakuwa kuhakikisha kwamba washirika wote wa maendeleo kutoka kitaifa, mashirika ya kidini, na NGO wanapata ajenda yao kwa mafanikio Nandi," Sang alisema.

Usajili wa kidijitali wa familia katika Kaunti ya Nyamira unaendelea ili kupisha usambazaji mkubwa wa Vyandarua vilivyotiwa Viua wadudu (ITNs) katika eneo lenye malaria. Kaimu Waziri wa Afya wa Kaunti Bernard Maina ambaye pia anasimamia Biashara, alithibitisha kuwa wamezindua rasmi usajili wa kidijitali katika familia ili wanufaike na mpango mkubwa wa usambazaji wa ITN. Maina alisema kaunti hiyo inalenga kusajili watu 548,000 na akatoa wito

kwa wakazi wote kuku-bali kusajiliwa kidijitali, ikihitaji vitambulisho pekee na nambari za simu za rununu kwa vyandarua. Bw Maina alithibitisha kuwa Wahamasishaji wa Afya ya Jami (CHP) wamepeleka mafunzo ya kina kuhusu jinsi ya kushughulikia vifaa vya usajili wa kidijitali, uhamasishaji kwa wakazi umefanyika vya kutosha, na zoezi hilo limepangwa kumalizika tarehe 24 Disemba. CHPs zitaambatana na kijiji wazee na watu wanaofahamika kwa wakazi ili wao (wakazi) watoe maelezo yao kwa ajili ya kujiandikisha.

KPCU mpya inakanusha madai ya kuhusika katika wizi wa kahawa

Kampuni ya New Kenya Planters Cooperative Union (KPCU) imekanusha madai kuwa ndiyo ilihusika na wizi wa maharagwe ya kahawa kutoka kwa viwanda katika Kaunti ya Meru. Haya yanajiri baada ya kisa cha wiki mbili zilizopita ambapo kahawa yenye thamani ya mamilioni ya pesa ilibwa kutoka kwa Chama cha Ushirika cha Wakulima wa Kaguru huko Imenti Kusini. Kufuatia kisa hicho, Mwenyekiti wa Chama cha Wasagaji Kahawa Kaunti ya Meru, Zablon Mbabu alidai mmoja wa wakurugenzi Wapya wa KPCU katika Kaunti ya Meru ndiye aliyehusika na wizi huo kwa vile gunia moja lililokuwa limesalia eneo la tukio lilikuwa na jina lake. Lakini akizungumza na wanahabari, Mwenyekiti wa New KPCU, Daniel Chemnoo, alisema New KPCU ni shirika la serikali ambalo madhumuni yake ni kusaga na kuuza kahawa ya wakulima kote nchini. "KPCU mpya ilisajiliwa mnamo 2019 kwa usagaji, uuzaji na kutoa fedha za cherry kuboresha uzal-

ishaji wa kahawa nchini ambao kwa sasa unafikia tani 51,000 kutoka kwa tani 132,000 za juu takriban miaka 32 iliyopita," alisema. Kwa hivyo, kama shirika, tunatofautiana kabisa na matamshi ya Bw Mbabu yaliyohusisha wizi wa kahawa na kuja kwa KPCU Mpya," akasema Bw Chemnoo. Aliongeza kuwa mwaka

jana, Waziri wa Mambo ya Ndani ya Nchi na Taifa, Profesa Kithure Kindiki alivitaka viwanda vyote vya kahawa na mashamba ya mashambani kutafuta usalama kutoka kwa polisi pindi wanapokuwa na kahawa kwenye maduka yao na kwamba vyama vyote vya ushirika vinapaswa kulipitisha hilo muda mrefu

ili kuzuia majaribio ya wizi. "Vyama vyote vya ushirika vya wakulima vinahitaji kuwa na majengo yao na kwa hivyo kama KPCU mpya hatuna mkono katika kile kilichotokea katika Chama cha Ushirika cha Wakulima wa Kaguru," Bw Chemnoo alisema. Aliuliza, "Inakuwaje walikuwa wakihifadhi kahawa, na hawakuwa na usalama mzuri wa kiwanda?" Bw Chemnoo alitaja madai ya Bw Mbabu kuwa habari zisizo na msingi ambazo zilikuwa na lengo la kuharibu sifa zao. Aliongeza, "Tunataka kuwaambia watu kwamba kama chombo tunauza kahawa kutoka kote nchini na hatuko tayari kutambulishwa na shughuli ambazo hazituhusu. Yeyote mwenye taarifa hasi lazima athibitishwe au aombe radhi tusije tukamshtaki." Lakini katika kujibu kwa haraka, Bw Mbabu alishikilia kuwa mtu ambaye jina lake lilionekana kwenye gunia lililoangushwa katika eneo la uhalifu alikuwa mshukiwa mkuu na kwamba alikuwa tayari kusema hivyo hata katika mahakama ya sheria.

Kamati yazindua kampeni kuongeza uelewa wa kifafa, kupunguza unyanyapaa

Kamati ya Kitaifa ya Kuratibu Kifafa (NECC) inapigania kifafa kupewa kipaumbele sawa na magonjwa mengine yasiyoambukiza, na dawa zake ziwe nafuu zaidi. Akizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi wa kampeni ya uhamasishaji wa kifafa kwa jina "Angaza Kifafa" katika hospitali ya Murang'a Level V, Bw. Fredrick Beuchi, katibu wa kamati hiyo, alidokeza kuwa, ugonjwa wa kifafa unapata uangelizi mdogo ikilinganishwa na magonjwa mengine yasiyo ya kuambukiza (NCDs) na dawa zake bado hazizwezi kugharimuwa na wagonjwa wengi. Alisisitiza kuwa kwa sasa, NECC inajikita zaidi katika elimu na uhamasishaji kwa umma ili kupunguza unyanyapaa unaohusishwa na ugonjwa wa kifafa. Hata hivyo, kampeni hiyo pia inalenga kuhimiza matibabu, ikiangazia umuhimu wa kutoa mafunzo kwa wataalam zaidi wa matibabu waliobeba katika matibabu ya kifafa. "Tunahitaji kuwapa watoa huduma za afya mazoea ya

hivi karibuni ya utunzaji na maarifa katika utunzaji wa kifafa," Kamati ilisema. "Takwimu tunazofanya nazo kazi zinaweza idadi ya Wakenya wanaoishi na kifafa kuwa milioni 1.5 au wawili katika kila watu 100 walio na kifafa," Bw Beuchi aliongeza. NECC imekuwa ikifanya mazoezi wa mafunzo yanayolenga watoa huduma za afya ya msingi kwa kuanzia na wamasishaji wa afya ya jamii (CHPs). Katibu huyo alitaka serikali kuhakikisha kwamba dawa za kifafa zinapatikana katika vituo vyote vya afya ya msingi na kwamba zinaweza kununuliwa. Mwenyekiti wa Kamati ya Afya katika Bunge la Kaunti ya Murang'a, Dkt. Mwangi Kamau alitoa wito kwa wagonjwa na walezi wa wagonjwa wanaoishi. wenye kifafa kujitokeza na kutafuta matibabu ili kukomesha unyanyapaa unaohusishwa na ugonjwa huo na kuboresha maisha yao.

Kaunti ya Narok yaripoti kushuka kwa viwango vya ugonjwa wa Trakoma

Utafiti uliofanywa na Kaunti ya Narok kwa ushirikiano na Shirika la Afya Duniani (WHO) umefichua kupungua kwa kiwango cha maambukizi ya trakoma, kutoka asilimia 30 mwaka wa 2011 hadi asilimia 10 mnamo 2023. Akizungumza katika mkutano wa washikaduu wa afya uliofanyika Narok, Mkurugenzi wa Afya ya Umma wa Kaunti, Edward Ole Tankoi, alisema Narok ni mojawapo ya kaunti kumi na mbili zilizotambuliwa na ugonjwa wa trakoma nchini. Tankoi aliongeza kuwa, licha ya kaunti hiyo kupunguza maambukizi ya trakoma, imesalia kuwa miongoni mwa kaunti zinazotajwa kuwa katika hatari zaidi. Alisema kupungua huko kumechangiwa na mafanikio ya uhamasishaji wa umma kuhusu ugonjwa huo na kambi nyingi za matibabu zilizohikiliwa kutibu ugonjwa huo. "Kaunti ndogo zilizoathiriwa zaidi mwaka wa 2011 zilikuwa Kaunti za Trans Mara Magharibi, Trans Mara Mashariki na Narok Mashariki, hata hivyo, ugonjwa huo ume-pungua baada ya afua katika maeneo haya," alisema. Hata hivyo, Tankoi alisema licha ya kushuka kwa jumla, Kaunti Ndogo ya Narok Ma-

gharibi ilirekodi maambukizi ya asilimia 11.5 mwaka wa 2023 ambayo ni juu ya wastani wa kaunti ya asilimia 10. "Tutatekeleza usimamizi mkubwa wa madawa ya kulevya (MDA) katika Kaunti Ndogo ya Narok Magharibi ili kukabiliana na ugonjwa huo," aliongeza. Mkurugenzi huyo aliona kuwa maambukizi makubwa ya Trakoma katika Kaunti Ndogo ya Narok Magharibi yalitokana na ukosefu wa vyoo na kuongeza kuwa familia nyingi katika Kaunti Ndogo hazina choo cha shimo. Mratibu wa Huduma ya Macho katika Kaunti Bw. Rostan Lekuye alisema watazingatia wadi za Nair-karra na Siana ambazo zimeathiriwa pakubwa na trakoma. "Chanzo kikuu cha Trakoma ni haja kubwa wazi. Nzi wanaobeba bakteria kutoka kwenye kinyesi cha binadamu hugusana na macho ya binadamu na kusababisha ugonjwa huo," alieleza. Lekuye aliongeza kuwa lengo la MDA ya mwaka huu ni kupunguza maambukizi ya trakoma hadi chini ya asilimia 5 ambayo yameafikiwa katika kaunti ndogo zote isipokuwa kaunti ndogo za Narok Magharibi na Narok Kusini. Baadhi ya wafanyabiashara wa samaki wa Kaunti ya Nakuru wanat kila sababu ya kutabasamu baada ya kupokea mashine ya kutengeneza barafu iliyotolewa na serikali. Kikundi cha Reech Self Help Group kimeshuhudia kupungua kwa hasara kubwa baada ya kuvuna katika biashara yao ya samaki, kwani sasa wanazalisha barafu kwa ajili ya matumizi miongoni mwao na kuuzwa kwa wafanyabiashara wengine sokoni. Mashine ya kutengeneza barafu nje ya gridi ya taifa iliyofungwa kwa ushirikiano na Mpango wa Pili wa Kusaidia Maendeleo ya Sekta ya Kilimo (ASDSP) ya serikali ya kitaifa imewawezesha kuongeza akiba yao hadi kilo 1,200 kwa siku, kutoka chini ya 1,000 walizotumia. kwa hisa hapo awali. "Tumetatizika na biashara hii kwani tulikuwa tuki-

poteza takriban kilo 50 za samaki kila siku na kusababisha nakisi ya Sh15,000 katika mauzo ya kila siku. Kila wakati tuliposhindwa kusafisha hisa zetu, tulikuwa tukikimbilia kupata vipande vya barafu ili tu kupata foleni ndefu au hakuna flakes kabisa, kutokana na mahitaji makubwa," alibainisha Bi Beatrice Ngolobe, Mwenyekiti wa kikundi. Bi Ngolobe alibainisha kuwa tangu kukabidhiwa kwa mashine hiyo Oktoba mwaka huu, kikundi hicho kimeanza kupata faida, na kuwaacha na akiba ambayo wanakusudia kutumia kwa friza na vifaa vingine vya kuhifadhiya baridi siku zijazo.

"Mahitaji ya barafu yalikuwa makubwa sana hasa wakati wa kiangazi kwani tulishindana na wauza aiskrimu na soda ambao wanategemea mzalishaji mmoja, hapa mjini. Sasa tuna akaunti ya benki ambapo tunaokoa faida yetu ambayo sasa inafikia Sh360,000, kutoka Sh200,000," Pauline Anyango, mwanachama wa kikundi aliongeza. ASDSP, kupitia Serikali ya Kaunti ya Nakuru, inatoa huduma za ugani kwa wakulima na wafanyabiashara wa pareto, maziwa na minyororo ya thamani ya samaki. Kupitia kujenga uwezo na upanuzi wa rukuku kwa vikundi, mpango unaofadhiliwa na Serikali ya Uswidi unalenga kuondoa vikwazo vinavyozuia shughuli za kibiashara za kilimo huku ukiwapa wakulima na wafanyabiashara ubia wenye faida.
