Mamlaka ya Kitaifa ya Kupambana na Matumizi Mabaya ya Pombe na Madawa ya Kulevya (NACADA) imeanzisha msako mkali ili kutekeleza kanuni kuhusu uwekaji wa baa na vituo vingine vya kusambaza pombe karibu na taasisi za elimu au maeneo yanayohudumia watu walio chini ya umri wa miaka kumi na minane. Katika taarifa yake kwa vyombo vya habari, Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa NACADA Dkt. Antony Omerikwe alisisitiza kuwa, mpango huo unatokana na Sheria ya Kudhibiti Vinywaji Vileo ya mwaka 2010. Sheria hii inaagiza kwamba, taasisi hizo lazima ziwe umbali wa angalau mita 300 kutoka kwa shule ya malezi, shule za msingi, sekondari au nyinginezo. taasisi za elimu zinazohudumia watu umri wa chini ya



miaka kumi na minane. Dkt Omerikwe aliangazia kuwa msako huo utafanywa kwa ushirikiano na mashirika mbalimbali ya serikali ya kitaifa na kaunti ili kuhakikisha utiifu mkali wa matakwa hayo ya kisheria. Alibainisha kuwa juhudi hizi ni ukumbusho kwa jamii juu ya jukumu lao katika kukuza maendeleo salama na ustawi wa watoto.

Zaidi ya hayo, NACADA imeamuru kuondolewa mara moja kwa mabango yote yanayotangaza vinywaji vyenye kileo karibu na taasisi za masomo. Dkt Omerikwe alidokeza kuwa, licha ya marufuku ya kisheria dhidi ya matangazo ya kupotosha au ya udanganyifu, mabango hayo yalikuwa yanawekwa karibu na shule, na kuleta hisia potofu kuhusu sifa, hatari za kiafya,

au athari za kijamii za vileo. Kwa mujibu wa Kanuni za Kukuza Vinywaji Vileo, NACADA itashirikiana na washikadau wengine kuondoa mabango yote yanayohusiana na vileo karibu na taasisi za elimu. Dkt Omerikwe alisisitiza kuwa shule zinapaswa kuwa mazingira salama yanayofaa kujifunza na ukuaji wa kibinafsi, bila vishawishi vinavyoweza kuhimiza tabia mbaya. Kuwepo kwa matangazo ya pombe karibu na taasisi za elimu kunadhoofisha juhudi hizi kwa kuhalalisha unywaji wa pombe na kuuonyesha kuwa wa kuvutia na wa kuvutia. Dkt Omerikwe alitoa wito kwa mashirika yote ya utangazaji na biashara kutekeleza wajibu wa kijamii.

ghushi. Naomba benki kupata wakadiriaji ardhi na mawakili wao kufanya uangalizi unaoostahili katika kuhoji hati miliki za ardhi,” Wahome alishauri.

Waziri huyo pia alifichua kuwa hatimiliki milioni 12.6 kote nchini zinahitajika kuingizwa katika Mfumo wa Kitaifa wa Kusimamia Taarifa za Ardhi (NLIMS).



Serikali imetoa Sh1.5 bilioni kwa basari na ruzuku kwa vikundi vya kuleta usawa katika kaunti zote 47 kupitia Hazina ya Serikali ya Kitaifa ya Kuleta Usawa (NGAAF).

Katibu wa Idara ya Jinsia Bi Anne Wang'ombe alisema fedha hizo kwa robo ya tatu na nne ya mwaka wa fedha wa 2023/2024 zitagharamia basari za shule kwa wanafunzi kutoka familia zilizo katika mazingira magumu.

Katibu alisisitiza dhamira isiyoyumba ya serikali ya kuboresha maisha na kuongeza ufikiaji wa vifaa na huduma za kifedha.

Bi Wang'ombe alitoa tangazo hilo katika Kaunti ya Kisumu alipoongoza ugawaji wa hundi kwa makundi mbalimbali yaliyo hatarini iliyoandaliwa na Ofisi ya Mwakilishi wa

Baadhi ya vikundi 2,000 vilivyosajiliwa vinatezamiwa kupokea ruzuku za thamani ya Sh413 milioni kusaidia shughuli za kijamii na kiuchumi pamoja na mipango ya kuongeza thamani.

"Ruzuku inakusudiwa kuongeza viwango vya mapato vinavyoweza ku-

tumika kwa walengwa kwa ajili ya kuboresha maisha kupitia maendeleo ya biashara," katibu alisema.

Wanakikundi ambao wanatazamiwa kufaidika na ruzuku ni wale waliofaulu kutuma maombi yao na kutimiza vigezo vya kupata ufadhili kupitia ofisi za kaunti ya NGAAF.

Takriban wanafunzi 25,000 kutoka kote nchini pia wanatazamiwa kunufaika na basari na mgao wa masomo wa jumla ya Sh273 milioni kusaidia elimu na ukuzaji ujuzi wao.

Hazina hiyo imetoa Sh677 milioni kutekeleza miradi na programu mbalimbali ambazo zitaifaidi wakazi katika jamii zilichogaguliwa katika kaunti 47.

"NGAAF itaendelea kusaidia kuzuia na kukabiliana na unyanyasaji wa kijinsia kupitia ujenzi wa vituo vya GBV, kukuza vipaji, utoaji wa huduma za maji, na huduma zingine za kijamii zinazokusudiwa kuweka mazingira wezeshi kwa biashara kustawi," Wang'ombe alisema.

Kupitia pesa hizo, NGAAF imetenga Sh137 milioni kwa elimu ya uraia ili kuhamasisha jamii kuhusu mipango na sera mbalimbali za serikali.

# Mabwawa ya Arror na Kimwarer kuzinduliwa upya, kuleta afueni Kerio

Mabwawa ya mamiloni ya pesa ya Arror na Kimwarer, yanayotazamiwa kutatua uhaba wa maji katika eneo linalokabilwa na ukame la Bonde la Kerio, yatazinduliwa upya hivi karibuni.

Mark Chesergon, Mwenyekiti wa Bodi ya Mamlaka ya Ustawishaji wa Bonde la Kerio (KVDA), alisema kuwa Mamlaka iko katika harakati za kuunda mwongozo wa utekelezaji wa miradi hii ya mabwawa makubwa. Miradi hii, ambayo ilizua utata mkubwa wakati wa utawala uliopita, inatarajiwa kuendelea kwa mafanikio wakati huu.

Chesergon, bila kutaja muda halisi wa kuanza kwa miradi hiyo ya Sh 63 bilioni ya unyunyuzaji na kuzalisha umeme kutoka majini, alisema kuwa Baraza la Mawaziri liliidhinisha mikataba ya kuanza kwa utekelezaji wa mabwawa, yatakayojengwa katika Kaunti ya Elgeyo-Marakwet.

“Baraza la Mawaziri limeidhinisha mikataba ya kufufua mabwawa ya Arror na Kimwarer.

**Asilimia 50 ya vidimbwi na mabwawa madogo yamekamilika na yamevuna maji ya mvua**

Kama mamlaka, tumeunda mwongozo ambao utatumia kwa uzinduzi wa utekelezaji wake tutakapokuwa tayari,” mwenyekiti wa bodi alisema.

Mwenyekiti huyo aliyasema hayo alipokuwa akiongoza Bodi ya KVDA, usimamizi na wadau wengine katika zoezi la upandaji miti. Wakati wa hafla hiyo, miche 200,000 ya miti na matunda ya aina mbalimbali ilisambazwa na kupandwa Chepyor, kaunti ndogo ya Keiyo Kaskazini.

Utata uliozingira miradi hiyo miwili ulisababisha kufutwa kwa mradi wa maji wa Kimwarer na kupunguzwa kwa mradi wa Bwawa la Arror.

Kufuatia mkutano kati ya Rais William Ruto na mwenzake wa Italia Sergio Mattarella mnamo Machi 2023 ambapo Rais alitangaza kwamba Kenya ilikubaliana na Italia kuhusu kufufuliwa kwa miradi hiyo miwili iliyokwama, maafisa wakuu wa serikali wamekuwa wakitembelea maeneo ambayo mabwawa yanapendekezwa kujengwa.

Mwenyekiti huyo aliongeza kuwa KVDA pia inatekeleza miradi mingine kadhaa ya maji na unyunyuzaji.

# Kilimo cha konokono, safari ya Wangui kutoka Nakuru hadi ugenini

About 15 kilometers from Nakuru town, there's a whirlwind of activity at Wangui Waweru's farm, where she rears what she considers a delicacy but which many Kenyans deem inedible and disgusting.

As Ms. Waweru plies her snail farming activities, barely a kilometer from the Lanet Airstrip, she remains optimistic about the planned upgrade of the facility. She hopes that the region's airspace will become busier and dreams of the day when the blossoming air transport will enable her to deliver her farm produce to different parts of the world.

A 10m-by-10m greenhouse, serving as the snail farm, stands conspicuously in her compound. Ms. Waweru has partitioned the snail house into four rooms, each containing several plastic basins covered with fine wire mesh to keep predators at bay.

Ms. Waweru discovered snail rearing as a farming business opportunity during a visit to Kisumu to sell farm produce thirteen years ago, and she hasn't looked back since.

"Marketing my farm produce at the time was one of the hardest challenges I faced as a farmer. I spent many sleepless nights thinking about costs and where to sell since most farmers harvest their farm produce simultaneously, creating a marketing challenge."

"The idea to venture into snail farming came about during one of my trips to Kisumu to sell farm

produce. I visited a snail farmer who shared a few tips on rearing them as well as potential markets. She took me to the farm where she had bought them, and I immediately developed an interest in rearing the snails," she recalls.

Upon returning to Nakuru, Waweru decided to give snail farming a try. She realized the need for empowerment and thus began by enrolling in a course at the Kenya Wildlife Service (KWS) training institute.

Armed with the necessary knowledge, Ms. Waweru set up a greenhouse where she would breed the slimy 'delicacy'. She invested Sh30,000 from her savings to buy greenhouse polythene, wire

mesh, and 100 plastic basins. She then procured a permit from the Kenya Wildlife Service for Sh1,500 and started her business.

Her primary customers are expatriates from Europe, Asia, and West Africa who, unlike the locals, have developed a taste for what locals consider unpalatable.

"Africa is home to the largest species of snails in the world, the Giant African

land snail," Waweru says, adding that snails are easy and cheap to keep and maintain.

"When you target the right market and customers, snail farming can be a very rewarding business."

The Giant African snails thrive in hot and humid environments like that in Lanet. Snails have an average lifespan of 5-7 years, but with good management, they can live up to 10 years," she explains.

Ms. Waweru, a mother of three, keeps 4,500 snails of the



Giant African land variety (Achatinide fulica), which she sells at between Sh2,000 to Sh3,000 per kilo. On average, she sells 30 kilograms of the slimy creatures per month.

The farmer explains that snails are a common delicacy among communities in West Africa, and she has established a niche market among Ghanaians, Cameroonians, Nigerians, Senegalese, Sierra Leoneans, and the Togolese, as well as South Americans and Asians in the country.

The Kenya Wildlife Conservation and Management Act 2013 allows communities to farm animals such as snails, ostriches, snakes, and crocodiles. Before a permit is issued, the Kenya Wildlife Service (KWS) sends a research team to assess the facility. Part of the KWS's task involves periodic monitoring of snail farm management. Before selling snails for consumption in hotels or for the export market, one must be certified. In addition, farmers must make quarterly reports to KWS.

She feeds the slimy creatures on vegetables like cabbages and fruit pieces, particularly watermelons. The vegetables should preferably be organic. The creatures also require plenty of water and calcium to strengthen their shells.

Ms. Waweru says the mollusks contain 15 per cent proteins, 2.4 per cent fat, and 80 per cent water. In addition, they are rich in fatty acids, calcium, iron, selenium, magnesium, and vitamins E, A, K, and B12.

"Snail meat is very safe as the moist soil in which they remain buried during the day to stay safe from predators is sterilized to avoid contamination or bacterial infections.

"It has very rich qualities and tastes like gizzards. It is easy to prepare. One needs to boil it for five minutes to get rid of the mucus. Once boiled, you can fry it with tomatoes and onions.

"To enhance food security, Kenyans need to diversify their choice of foods. Snails are plentiful in counties where people are either starving or malnourished," she observed.

Giant African land snails are hermaphrodites, which means that they have the reproductive organs for both male and female. A snail produces 300 to 500 eggs in three months, which hatch after 11 to 15 days, enabling one to increase their population faster.

According to Waweru, snails mature after six months. They grow big, but after another six months, their growth stagnates again.

Snails are quite vulnerable to predators such as lizards, caterpillars, rats, ground beetles, termites, and spiders. Flies, on the other hand, lay eggs, and the maggots end up eating the snails, she said.

Apart from consumption, Wangui explains that snails are a good skin treatment regime as the slime they produce (known as mucin once it has been processed) is used to produce skin care products.

Snail mucin contains antioxidants that may help reduce signs of aging like wrinkles, uneven skin tone, and sagging.

Studies indicate that snail mucin helps with skin regeneration and protects against damaging free radicals. Snail mucin also hydrates, boosts collagen production, heals wounds, and even soothes irritation.

"Lazima tuhakikishe mwonekano mzuri kupi-

tia utumiaji wa mbinu ikijumuisha majukwaa ya mitandao ya kijamii, sauti, uuzaji wa kidijitali, uhusiano na vyombo vya habari na utangazaji," alisema.

Akizungumza katika kongamano hilo, Mkurugenzi wa Mawasiliano katika Baraza la Magavana Yvonne Ogwang alihimiza timu hiyo kutumia taasisi hiyo kwa kushiriki hadithi za mafanikio kutoka kaunti. Ilibainika kuwa taasisi hiyo ni kitovu muhimu cha usimamizi wa maarifa ambacho huweka kumbukumbu na kubadilishana mbinu bora zilizokusanywa kutoka kwa sekta zote za ugatuzi.

Kwamujibuwa Kanuniya 21 ya Kanuniza Usimamizina Uratibuwa Mazingira (Tathmini ya Athari na Ukaguzi) za 2003, Mamlakaya Kitaifa ya Usimamiziwa Mazingira (NEMA) imepokea Ripoti ya Utafitiwa Tathmini ya Athari kwa Mazingira kwa mradi uliyoendelezwa hapo juu.

Mtetezi wa Wakala wa Maendeleo ya Ujenzi wa Maji wa Tanathi inanuia kujenga bwawa ambalo litahusisha usambazaji wa mtiririko wa mvuto wa maji yaliyosafishwa. Uwezo wa muundo wa bwawa linalopendekezwa ni 74167M<sup>3</sup> / siku. Bwawa linalopendekezwa litazamisha bwawa la mito miwili iliyopo na hivyo uzalishaji wa sasa (12000M<sup>3</sup>/siku) wa bwawa la mito miwili iliyopo utapotea. Aina ya bwawa iliyochaguliwa ni Bwawa la Saruji Roller Liliyounganishwa (RCC) lenye urefu wa muundo wa mita 39.3 na njia ya kumwagika ya kupita kiasi ya Ogee Spillway (126m) na bonde la kutuliza. Maji mabichi kutoka mto mmoja yatasambazwa hadi Namanga Water Works kwa matibabu kabla ya kusambazwa kwa watumiaji. Mradi huo utapatikana katika mji wa Namanga katika Kaunti ya Kajiado.

Wito wa Rais William Ruto wa kuongeza hisa za mataifa ya Afrika katika Benki ya Maendeleo ya Afrika (AfDB) ili kukuza uwezo wa kukopesha wa benki hiyo ya kikanda un-aonyesha dharura iliyopo.

Akihutubia wajumbe katika Mkutano wa 59 wa kila Mwaka wa AfDB uliofanyika katika Kituo cha Kimataifa cha Mikutano cha Kenyatta, Rais Ruto alisisitiza jukumu kuu la benki hiyo katika kushughulikia mahitaji makubwa ya kifedha barani kote.

Akisisitiza mae-neo muhimu kama vile utoshelevu wa chakula, miundombinu, uwezeshaji wa vijana na wanawake, na ujasiriamali, Rais Ruto alisisitiza umuhimu kwa mataifa kuimarisha hisa zao ndani ya AfDB.

Ombi lake linaendana na hatua ya pamoja, akisisitiza kwamba kuimarisha rasilimali za taasisi hiyo ni muhimu ili iweze kusaidia kikamilifu nchi za Kiafrika katika juhudi zao za kimaendeleo.

Vile vile, wito wa Rais Ruto wa kujaza tena kwa mara ya 17 kwa Hazina ya Maendeleo ya Afrika, kwa kiwango cha angalau dola bilioni 25, unasisitiza umuhimu wa kuimarisha uwezo wa benki hiyo kupanua ufadhili wa masharti nafuu kwa mataifa ya Kiafrika yenye maendeleo duni.

Katika wito wake wa utangulizi wa kuchukuliwa hatua, Rais Ruto alihimiza ushirikiano na kujitolea katika kutumia mifumo ya kifedha ili kuendeleza maendeleo ya kijamii na kiuchumi barani Afrika.


wa maendeleo kuongeza uwekezaji wao katika taasisi kuu za kifedha za maendeleo ya bara letu,” alisema.

Ruto alisema bara hili limetajwa kwa njia hasi kwa muda mrefu sana na akatoa wito kwa Benki hiyo kuandika simulizi mpya kuhusu shirika la mikopoa Afrika kwa kuweka habari katika mfumo wake. “Pato Letu halikadiriwi ipasavyo na rasilimali zetu kubwa kama vile nishati na asilimia 60 ya ardhi inayofaa kwa kilimo haihesabiwi,” Rais alisema, na kuongeza kuwa bara hili linakabiliwa na kizuizi kigumu cha mfumo wa kifedha wa kimataifa ambao kimsingi hauhusishi matarajio ya bara. “Tunakopa mara kwa mara kutoka kwa

masoko ya kimataifa kwa viwango vya juu zaidi ya vile vinavyolipwa na ulimwengu wote, mara nyingi hadi mara 8 hadi 10 zaidi. Viwango hivi vinasemekana kuwa kinga ya hatari, jambo ambalo hautumiki wakati wa kuzingatia uchimbaji wa madini, hata katika mae-neo yenye migogoro inayo-endelea,” alisema.

Alisema kuna haja kwa bara la Afrika kuendeleza haraka na kutekeleza mageuzi ambayo yatasukuma ustawi wa nchi na maisha ya watu wa bara hili.

Ruto alieleza imani kwamba haja ya dharura inavuma sana miongoni mwa viongozi wa Afrika ambao walikuwa wakipiga hatua kukuza Pato la Taifa la nchi za bara (GDP).

Bi Marie Bettings kutoka shirika la World Vision Canada alisema kuwa kuongezeka kwa matatizo yatokanayo na mabadiliko ya tabia nchi na kupanda kwa gharama ya chakula kumesababisha changamoto ya utapiamlo ambayo huathiri watu wanaoishi katika mazingira magumu hususan wanawake na wasichana.

Alieleza kuwa lishe duni na ukosefu wa chakula cha kutosha huathiri elimu ya watoto, huku pia wakikabiliwa na magonjwa mbalimbali kwa sababu ya kinga dhaifu.

Martha Nyang'aya kutoka shirika la Nutrition International alisema licha ya juhudi mbalimbali za kupambana na utapiamlo katika kaunti hiyo, kudumaa miongoni mwa watoto kumefikia asilimia 22, uzani mdogo kwa asilimia 15, huku kiwango cha uzani kwa uregu kikifikia asilimia tano, jambo ambalo alisema linatia wasiwasi na linahitaji juhudi nyingi.

Alisema kuna haja ya kufafanua upya utoshelevu wa chakula akisema Kenya ni mojawapo ya nchi saba barani Af-



rika ambayo imeshuhudia hali inayoongezeka ya utapiamlo

ikidhihirika katika kudumaa na kuongezeka kwa upungufu wa virutubishi, akisema asilimia 42 ya wasichana waliobalehe wana upungufu wa madini ya chuma.

Bi Nyang'aya alidokeza kuwa ingawa takwimu zinaonyesha kuwa Kaunti ya Elgeyo Marakwet ina zaidi ya asilimia 80 ya chakula, chakula hicho hupatikana hasa msimu wa uvunaji ambao baadaye huuzwa akisema hata vyanzo vya protini kama mayai hazitumiwi ndani ya familia bali huuzwa kukidhi mahitaji ya kifedha.

Alisikitika kuwa asilimia 12 ya wasichana wenye upungufu wa madini ya chuma hupata mimba kati ya umri wa miaka 12-14 na baadaye kukatiza masomo na hivyo kuzidisha changamoto ya utapiamlo na kudumaa.

Alitoa wito wa juhudi za pamoja kushughulikia masuala yanayoathiri maendeleo ya wasichana kwa njia kamili, akisema japo wahusika wa unyanyasaji wa kijinsia wanapaswa kukamatwa, kuna haja ya kuwawezesha wasichana kukaidi wanaendeleza unyanyazaji huo.

“Watumiaji wote na watumiaji watarajiwa wa huduma za usalama za kibinafsi lazima wahakikishe kuwa kampuni za ulinzi zinaajiri tu maafisa wa ulinzi wa kibinafsi ambao wanatimiza mahitaji ya kisheria.

“Kwa sasa shughuli ya kuwaondoa au kuwafuta walinzi feki ambao hawana tajriba zinaendelea. Hatua hii inalenga kuhakikisha kuwa wale wanaoajiriwa wana tajriba na wale ambao wanatimiza mahitaji ya

Mahamed alisema kuwa Nambari ya Kikosi cha Walinzi (GFN) inatumika kama cheti rasmi kwamba mlinzi wa kibinafsi alikuwa amepata mafunzo yanayofaa na alipewa leseni na kusajiliwa na

mamlaka husika.

Mtu yeyote anayepatikana na hatia ya kumwajiri mlinzi ambaye hajasajiliwa atachukuliwa hatua kisheria na kupewa adhabu ya kulipa faini ya Sh500,000 akipatikana na hatia.

Zaidi ya hayo, kutumia huduma za kampuni ya ulinzi ya kibinafsi ambayo

hajasajiliwa ni kinyume cha sheria na ni kosa ambalo linaweza kuadhibiwa kwa faini ya Sh2 milioni au kifungo, kama itakavyoamuliwa na mahakama.

Kampuni za ulinzi za kibinafsi ambazo zitashindwa kutii mwongozo huu pia zitapoteza usajili wao, leseni kuchukuliwa na kutozwa

faini kama ilivyobainishwa katika sheria.

Bw Mahamed pia aliwaagiza walinzi wote wawe na GFN na kutimiza mahitaji mengine yote utumishi wao kama walinzi wa kibinafsi, akisisitiza kwamba hitaji hili lilibainishwa katika notisi ya kisheria ya Novemba, 2, 2023. “Notisi inasalia kuwa halali, inatumika,

na inawaamuru watoa huduma wote wa usalama wa kibinafsi kuajiri tu au kushirikisha maafisa wa usalama wa kibinafsi ambao wamepitia mafunzo, wamepita ukaguzi wa usalama, wamesajiliwa, na wana GFN iliyotolewa na mamlaka,” Bw. Mahamed alifanua.

Notisi hiyo ni sehemu ya kanuni na hatua ambazo PSRA imetekeleza hivi karibuni zinazolenga kulinda ustawi wa walinzi wa kibinafsi nchini kote.

PSRA ilifanya usajili mkubwa wa wazi wa walinzi katika Bustani wa Uhuru jijini Nairobi mnamo Machi, ambao ulijumuisha utoaji wa Nambari za Kikosi cha Walinzi (GFNs).

# Barabara za mji wa Meru zarekebisha na mpango wa ukarabati unaoongozwa na vijana

Mamlaka ya Kitaifa ya Ujenzi (NCA), kwa ushirikiano na Shirika Lisilo la Kiserikali la Uwezesaji Barabara za Jamii (CORE-Kenya), inakarabati barabara za kufika katika mji wa Meru na kutoa mafunzo na kuwawezesha vijana kuwa wanakandarasi wa baadaye katika sekta ya ujenzi wa barabara.

Ili kufanikisha hili, vijana wamepitia vipindi vya mafunzo kuhusu mahitaji ya usajili wa NCA, taratibu na kanuni. Kwa mujibu wa George Kaluma, mhandisi wa CORE, mafunzo hayo yanalenga kuwapa vijana maarifa na ujuzi unaohitajika ili kusajiliwa kama wanakandarasi wadogo chini ya NCA kundi la VIII na baadaye kuendeleza kadiri wanavyoendelea kufanya kazi, hivyo kujiongeza kipato.

“Leo, tulikuwa na vikundi 15 vinavyopitia mafunzo kutoka NCA, na baadaye, vinatarajiwa kujiandikisha na bodi kama ilivyokubaliwa.” “Kwa hivyo tunatarajia kwamba katika wiki chache zijazo watasajiliwa lakini tunacho uhakika ni kwamba vikundi vyote vitafanya hivyo kwa urahisi kwa



kuwa tayari wanafahamu taratibu na mahitaji,” Bw Kaluma alisema.

Kufikia mwisho wa Juni, ambayo inaadhimisha miaka miwili ya kuwepo Meru, Bw Kaluma aliongeza, CORE inatarajia kuwa na vikundi 35 vilivyosajiliwa huku 20 katika mwaka wa kwanza na 15 katika mwaka wa pili. Mhandisi Antony Mwangi kutoka NCA alisema Mamlaka pia ilichukua washiriki katika mchakato wa usajili kwa wafanyakazi wenye ujuzi na wasio na ujuzi ambao shirika hilo hufanya bila malipo.

“Tayari tumewaambia wanachohitaji kwa usajili wao, na tunawahakikishia uungwaji mkono wetu katika mchakato mzima iwapo watakwama njiani,” alisema Bw Mwangi. Aliipongeza CORE kwa kuwapanga vijana hao katika vikundi na kuongeza kuwa kwa njia hii, watavutia zabuni nyingi zaidi ikizingatiwa kuwa wana wanawake pamoja na watu wenye ulemavu kuwa wanachama wao.

“Wanaposajiliwa, wanakuwa wanachama rasmi wa NCA na wanatambuliwa na seri-

kali kumaanisha kuwa wanaweza kupata zabuni kwa urahisi na kufanya kazi popote nchini kinyume na wanapokuwa nje tu na kufanya kazi kibinafsi,” Bw Mwangi alisema.

Alishukuru CORE-Kenya, Hazina ya Maendeleo ya Kijamii ya Japan (JSDF), Benki ya Dunia, na serikali ya kitaifa pamoja na Serikali ya Kaunti ya Meru kwa kutekeleza mpango huo ambao utawaacha vijana na chanzo cha riziki.

“Bila juhudi za washirika wote katika mradi huu, watu

hawa wote waliokusanyika hapa leo na wale ambao hawako hapa wanaweza kuwa wanahangaika huko nje. Lakini mnachofanya ni cha kupongezwa na asante kwa kutualika na natumai mtatuita tena ili kuendeleza kazi hiyo njema,” Bw Antony alisema.

Mkurugenzi wa kikundi cha Destiny Bw Duncan Murithi Marete alisema maarifa muhimu kutoka NCA yaliwafungua macho na kuanzia sasa watayatumia kufaidika.

“Tunafuraha kwamba leo tumejua mahitaji ya usajili na bila shaka tutatekeleza jukumu letu katika kuhakikisha kuwa tumesajiliwa kikamilifu,” alisema Bw Marete na kuongeza kuwa watawasilisha taarifa hizo kwa wanakikundi ili wachukue hatua.

Vijana hao ni sehemu ya watu 375 huko Gitimbine ambao walipitia mafunzo ya vitendo kuhusu ukarabati wa barabara kwa mwaka wa pili ambapo kilomita nane za barabara zilikarabatiwa. Lengo kuu la CORE huko Meru ni kuinua hadhi ya vijana wa Meru kupitia uundaji wa nafasi za kazi na pia kukuza ujuzi wa kujitegemea.

## Serikali yawekeza Sh1B katika sodo kwa wasichana

Akizungumza wakati wa kuadhimisha Siku ya Kimataifa ya Usafi wa Hedhi 2024 katika Kituo Maalumi cha Mafunzo cha Mathare jijini Nairobi, Katibu wa Jinsia, Anne Wang'ombe, alisema Serikali inajali ustawi wa mtoto wa kike na itaendelea kutetea sera zinazounga mkono usafi wa hedhi.

Bi Wangombe ambaye alikuwa akiwagawia watoto Seti za Dignity Kits alisisitiza umuhimu wa kuzingatia viwango vya usafi hasa wakati wa hedhi.

Katibu alisema Siku ya Kimataifa ya Hedhi ilitengwa ili kupigana na unyanyapaa na miiko inayohusishwa na hedhi.

“Nipo hapa kuwahimiza nyote kutembea kwa ujasi hata wakati wa hedhi kwa sababu si laana wala mwiko. Ndio maana tunawapa vifaa hivi vya hadhi na pakiti nane za sodo za usafi baadaye ili kusaidia kurejesha heshima ya siku za hedhi kwa wasichana wote,” alisema Katibu.

Dignity Kit kwa wasichana ilikuwa na pakiti 10 za karatasi shashi, pakiti ya sodo za usafi, jozi ya chupi za wasichana, mafuta ya kujipaka, sabuni ya kufua, sabuni ya kuogea, kifurushi cha Oral Rehydration Solution (ORS), na vidonge vya zinc.

Mtoto wa kiume pia hakuachwa nyuma kwani wote walipokea Dignity Kits sawa na wasichana lakini ikiwa na jozi mbili za chupi za wavulana, bila sodo usafi.

Jumla ya shule sita ziliwakilishwa, huku wasichana zaidi ya 600 wakipokea vifurushi hivyo.

Shule hizi zilikuwa za Msingi za Kiboro, Ndururuno Daima na Salama, shule ya sekondari ya St Teresa's Junior, na shule mwenyeji, Mathare Special Training Centre.

## Kenya yaadhimisha Siku ya Usafi wa Hedhi kwa kuangazia upya afya ya wanawake

Wizara ya Afya imesitiza dhamira yake ya kuboresha afya ya hedhi na usafi kote nchini huku ulimwengu ukiadhimisha Siku ya Usafi wa Hedhi wiki iliyopita.

Bi Mary Muthoni Muriuki, Katibu wa Idara ya Kitaifa ya Afya ya Umma na Viwango vya Kitaaluma, alisema kuwa mada ya mwaka huu inalenga kuhakikisha kwamba kila mwanamke na msichana anapata rasilimali zinazohitajika na usaidizi wa kudhibiti hedhi kwa njia ya heshima na salama.

Bi Muriuki alibainisha kuwa tangu mwaka wa 2014, Kenya imeadhimisha Siku ya Usafi wa Hedhi ili kuangazia umuhimu wa desturi zinazofaa za kupata hedhi na kufanya nchi taifa linalofaa kwa hedhi.

Juhudi ni pamoja na kutoa taarifa sahihi kuhusu hedhi, kuhakikisha upatikanaji wa bidhaa za hedhi kwa bei nafuu, kukuza vifaa vya usafi wa mazingira, na kutekeleza mbinu endelevu za kudhibiti taka. “Mbinu ya Kenya ya juhudi mara tatu kuhusu usimamizi wa hedhi ni pamoja na

kuvunja ukimya, kuendeleza mijadala ya wazi kuhusu hedhi ili kuondoa unyanyapaa, na kuwaelimisha wasichana na wanawake kuhusu mchakato huu wa asili wa kibayolojia,” Bi Muriuki alisema. Alisema jitihada nyingine ni pamoja na usimamizi wa usafi na usalama kwa kuhakikisha upatikanaji wa maji, vifaa vya kuosha, maeneo ya faragha kwa ajili ya usimamizi wa hedhi, udhibiti wa maumivu nyumbani na katika maeneo ya

umma, na huduma za afya kwa ujumla.

Bi Muriuki aliongeza kuwa pia wanatetea matumizi salama na utupaji kupitia mbinu bora kwa mazingira kwa matumizi tena, ukusanyaji na utupaji wa taka za hedhi. Kulingana na Katibu, Kenya ilizindua Sera yake ya MHM mnamo Mei 28, 2020, wakati wa janga la Covid-19. Ingawa hatua kubwa zimepigwa, ikiwa ni pamoja na kuunganishwa kwa MHM katika shughuli

na miradi mbalimbali ya serikali, msaada endelevu na uboreshaji unahitajika. “Utafiti uliofanywa na Wizara ya Afya mwaka wa 2016 unaangazia changamoto zinazowakabili wasichana na wanawake wa Kenya kuhusu afya ya hedhi na usafi. Matokeo muhimu ni pamoja na kutumia sodo zinazoweza kutupwa kati ya asilimia 46 ya waliohojiwa, huku asilimia 54 ya wasichana wa Kenya wakikabiliwa na changamoto za kupata bidhaa za usimamizi wa usafi wa hedhi (MHM),” Bi Muriuki alisema.

Alisema kukosekana kwa upatikanaji wa bidhaa za MHM kunahusishwa na tabia hatari ya ngono, na baadhi ya watu kutumia njia zisizo salama au kushiriki ngono kupata pesa. Katibu aliongeza kuwa hali duni ya WASH shuleni huzidisha changamoto na kufanya wasichana kutohudhuria masomo.

“Licha ya jitihada hizi, ikiwa ni pamoja na utoaji wa sodo shuleni, zaidi ya nusu ya wasichana na wanawake wa Kenya walio katika hedhi (asilimia 65) bado wanakosa upatikanaji endelevu wa bidhaa salama za hedhi,” katibu alieleza.

# Bahati traders to reap from integrated market

Traders in Bahati Sub-County in Nakuru are set to benefit from a multi-million integrated modern market to be constructed at Kabatini Trading Center.

Speaking during the handing over of the site, Governor Susan Kihika announced that the project is a partnership between the national government and the County Government of Nakuru. She said it will be completed in five months.

The tendering process was completed in March. According to Ms. Kihika, the project will include social halls, prefabricated stalls, market area segmentation, cold room facilities, offices, an ATM lobby, baby daycare services (creche), and primary processing facilities for value addition.

The governor said the project will also include supporting infrastructure such as sewer systems, high-mast flood lights, raised water tanks, banking institutions, a food court, and modern washrooms compliant with the needs of persons living with disabilities.

Ms. Kihika assured the traders that they will have a conducive working environment to carry out their businesses once the project is completed.

She was accompanied by Deputy Governor Mr. David Kones, Bahati Member of Parliament Ms. Irene Njoki, the Baringo County Women Representative Ms. Florence Jematia, her

Nyeri counterpart Ms. Rahab Mukami, and area Member of County Assembly Ms. Leah Nganga. The two-storey market will be constructed on half an acre of space, with at least 200 traders expected to have cold storage facilities.

"The market will also have water towers, cabros, an ablution block, and market offices," Ms. Kihika said. She added that the objective of the market is to act as a feeder for the market hub in Bahati, Subukia, Nakuru Town East and Nakuru Town West Sub-Counties.

Ms Kihika said the national government in partnership with counties was committed to improving traders' business environment in the country.

"Majority of Kenyans are traders by nature and what they look for is the dignity of their hustles and the places they trade from, but most of them trade in filthy places, where there is no road, sewerage and other amenities, hence attracting people with low purchasing power," the Governor said.

The market is expected to bolster trade and transform the economy of the trading center along the busy Nakuru-Nyahururu highway.

The Sh200 million modern market is part of the government's Economic Stimulus Program (ESP).

Bahati MP Ms Njoki emphasized that the government's investment in market infrastructure will

ensure that traders at the grassroots operate in conducive environments and cut food losses.

"This will guarantee our farmers and traders more earnings to support more livelihoods in our county," the legislator added.

The MP urged the contractor to ensure construction materials are sourced locally and all jobs given to the locals.

The market will consist of a ground floor that will accommodate more than 200 modern stalls for traders and the first floor will include a boardroom.

The stalls will be divided into fresh produce and clothes and wares sections.

In addition, the modern market will include a lactation room for breastfeeding mothers, an ICT room fully connected to the internet and a revenue center.

The market will further have food courts for traders to sell meals to consumers in the area.

Deputy Governor Mr Kones noted that the project will help create em-

ployment in the area and urged the contractor to complete it on time, fur-

ther insisting that locals should be prioritized in the supply of building

materials and construction jobs.

Kampuni ya Serikali ya Kuchakata Pareto Kenya (PPCK) itafanyiwa marekebisho kwa gharama ya Sh450 milioni kupitia ufadhili wa Serikali wa Sh450 milioni.

Msemaji wa Serikali Isaac Mwaura pia alisema kuwa Serikali inalenga kuimarisha kilimo cha pareto kwa kuhakikisha kuwa angalau ekari 30,000 za ardhi zimewekwa chini ya zao hilo na wakulima 200,000 kukumbatia zao hilo nchini ifikapo 2027.

Kulingana na Mwaura, ingawa pareto iliipatia Kenya

Sh72 milioni mwaka jana, Kenya ina uwezo wa kupata Sh9 bilioni kutoka kwa zao hilo la biashara ikiwa sekta hiyo itafufuliwa.

Mikakati mingine Mwaura alisema ni pamoja na utoaji na usambazaji wa miche bora ya kutosha kwa wakulima na kuongeza uwezo wa kiwanda cha kusindika pareto.

Alidokeza kuwa serikali inawahimiza wawekezaji binafsi kujiunga na sekta hiyo akisema itaondoa ukiritimba ambao alisema ndiyo sababu kuu ya kuporomoka kwa sekta hiyo ndogo.

Dkt Mwaura alidokeza, kama sehemu ya mkakati wa kuwahamasisha wakulima zaidi kukumbatia zao hilo, PPCK sasa inatoa miche ya bure, na hii itaongeza ekari chini ya pareto. Alisema PPCK imeongeza uzalishaji wa nyenzo safi za upanzi kwa zaidi ya asilimia 90..

"PPCK inasaidia wakulima kikamilifu. Ekari moja inachukua takriban miche 22,000, ambayo inagharimu zaidi ya Sh60,000. PPCK imechukua mzigo huo kutoka kwa wakulima. Wizarara ya Kilimo pia imesambaza tani 15,000 za nyenzo bora za kupanda pareto," alifafanua.

### Bwawa la Sh.63.5 Milioni kumaliza shida ya maji Laikipia Kaskazini

Ni furaha tele kwa zaidi ya wakazi 30,000 wa Laikipia Kaskazini kufuatia uzinduzi wa Bwawa la Sh 63.5 milioni huko Doldol ambalo linatarajiwa kushughulikia shida za maji katika maeneo ya wafugaji. Bwawa hilo, linalofadhiliwa na Mamlaka ya Ustawishaji ya Ewaso Ng'iro Kaskazini (ENNDA), litatoa maji kwa jamii nne za Ilgvesi, Ilmokodo, Ilmumonyot, Indikiriri, na Kaunti ya Samburu.

Mwenyekiti wa Bwawa la Doldol Solomon Ole Pusi alifichua kuwa bwawa hilo, ambalo lilijengwa awali na wenyaji katika miaka ya 1950, lilikuwa na udongo, na kwa msaada mkubwa kutoka kwa serikali, uhaba wa maji utakuwa historia kwa watu, mifugo na wanayama wa porini.

"Tunafuraha kwa kazi inayofanyika hapa, upanuzi wa bwawa na uzoaji wa udongo, tunatumai kuwa changamoto za maji zitatatuliwa. Inasikitisha kwamba hata baada ya msimu wa mvua tunabaki

bila maji kwa mifugo yetu," alisema Ole Pusi, akiongeza kuwa wakati wa kiangazi, walilazimika kuhamia msitu wa Mlima Kenya kutafuta maji kwa mifugo wao. Mbunge wa eneo hilo Sarah Korere alipongeza mradi huo, akibainisha kuwa wafugaji wameathirwa pakubwa na ukame kwa miaka mingi na kupitia upatikanaji wa maji, kutakuwa na mabadiliko kwa jamii katika eneo bunge lake.

Kwa mujibu wa Mkurugenzi wa Huduma na Miundombinu wa ENNDA, Josiah Mulwa, bwawa hilo litajengwa ndani ya muda wa miezi sita na litawekwa mfumo wa jua kusukuma maji kwa lengo la kukuza nishati salama katika eneo la wafugaji.

"Hili ni eneo lenye uhaba wa maji. Wanawake, mifugo na watoto husafiri kwa umbali mrefu kutafuta maji, ambayo ni changamoto kubwa. Mradi huu ukimamilika, familia nyingi zitanufaika," alisema Mulwa.

### Mpango unaofadhiliwa na USAID kuwezesha mashirika katika kaunti 11

Jumla ya kaunti kumi na moja zitanufaika na mpango unaofadhiliwa na USAID ulioundwa ili kuwezesha mashirika ya mashinani kushiriki kikamilifu katika mipango ya maendeleo na michakato ya kutengeneza bajeti.

Mpango huo wenye thamani ya Sh3.5 bilioni kwa kaunti kumi na moja, utatekelezwa kupitia mbinu tatu zenye miradi mahususi inayolenga uwezeshaji wa mashirika ya mashinani, kuimarisha mfumo wa udhibiti kuhusu afya na umoja dhidi ya udanganyifu, ubadhirifu na Unyanyasaji.

Kaunti ya Turkana ni miongoni mwa kaunti zitakazonufaika na mpango huo. Nyingine zitakazonufaika ni Kisumu, Kisii, Homa Bay, Kiambu, Samburu, Makeni, Mombasa, Nakuru, Kakamega, Kilifi, na Isiolo. Akizungumza katika mkutano wa kuanzishwa kwa mpango huo mjini Turkana, Naibu Gavana Dkt John Erus alisisitiza umuhimu wa ushirikishwaji wa jamii akisema kuwa inasaidia kuwianisha malengo ya maendeleo na mahitaji ya wakazi.

Naibu Gavana alikaribisha mpango huo na kubaini-

isha kuwa uliambatana kikamilifu na masharti ya ushirikishwaji wa umma yaliyoainishwa katika Katiba ya Kenya 2010.

"Pamoja na mpango kama huu, ushiriki wa watu wa ngazi ya chini sio tu wa uhakika, lakini thamani yake inaboreshwa kwa kiasi kikubwa," Naibu Gavana Erus alisema.

Huko Turkana, mpango utafanya kazi na mashirika ya maendeleo ya mashinani (LDOs) ili kutambua vipaumbele na kuchangia matarajio ya maendeleo.

Vile vile, mpango huo utajengea uwezo LDOs ili kufuatilia ipasavyo utendakazi wa serikali ya kaunti na kuibua maswali wakati mwelekeo unapoenda kinyume unapokeuka kutoka na viwango vilivyowekwa.

Mpango huo ambao ulizinduliwa huko Naivasha mnamo Aprili 2024 unajiri wakati uongozi wa Kaunti unatumia mbinu ya maendeleo ya wadi ambapo wadi hunufaika kutokana na mgao wa bajeti ili kupanga miradi ya maendeleo zinazopaswa kupatia kipaumbele.
