kwa ushirikiano na sekta ya kibinafsi, imeanzisha uundaji wa simu za kisasa za bei nafuu za Kenya ndani ya nchi. Hii ina maana kwamba hatutahitaji kugiza simu kutoka nchi kama China au Korea," alisema.

Simu za chapa ya Neon, za bei ya Sh7,499 kila moja, zinapatikana katika matawi yote ya Safaricom au maduka ya Jamii Telecom nchini kote. "Simu hizi zinakuja na vipengele vyote muhimu, vinavyoruhusu watumiaji kupata huduma za serikali kwa urahisi kutoka mahali popote. Hakutakuwa tena na haja ya kuzuru afisi za serikali ana kwa ana," Owalo aliongeza.

Waziri alihakikisha kuwa kwa mabadiliko ya kidijitali, Wakenya watafaidika na huduma bora za serikali bila kuhitaji kufika binafsi katika afisi za serikali.

"Itakuwa utanga-

mano wa moja kwa moja kati yako kama Mkenya, simu yako na serikali. Hutahitaji kumjua mtu yeyote katika ofisi ya serikali ili kupata huduma hizi. Utaweza kutuma maombi ya kitambulisho au pasipoti," alieleza.

Ili kuendeleza ajenda ya mabadiliko ya kidijitali, Owalo alisema kuwa serikali imeshirikiana na Kampuni ya Kenya Power (KPC) kupanua uunganishaji wa nyaya, kuhakikisha upatikanaji wa mtandao unaotege-mewa na endelevu kote nchini.

Tangu Januari 2023, serikali imeweka takriban kilomita 11,000 za nyaya

za intaneti, kwa lengo la kufikia kilomita 100,000 ifikapo 2026.

"Tunahama kutoka kwa mbinu ya kitamaduni ya kutandaza nyaya za chini ya ardhi, ambayo inakabiliwa na uharibifu. Badala yake, tutatumia laini za usambazaji za KPC," Owalo alisema, akiongeza kuwa KPC tayari imeshirikiana wanakandarasi 300, kote nchini kuanza mradi huo.

"Tutapanua muunganisho wa nyaya kwa transfoma zote 74,000 zilizo-pindi nyaya zikiunganishwa kwa transfoma hizi, tunaweza kutoa ufikaji wa mtandao kwa taasisi zilizo karibu na mae-neo ya umma kama vile masoko," Waziri alieleza.

Zaidi ya hayo, Owalo alithibitisha kuwa mradi wa kuunganisha umeme unendelea ili kuhakikisha usambazaji wa umeme wa kutosha kusaidia miundombinu ya kidijitali.

The National Police Service Commission is established under Article 246 of the Constitution with the mandate to recruit and appoint persons to hold or act in offices in the Service; to confirm appointments within the National Police Service; to determine promotions and transfers within the National Police Service, to exercise disciplinary control over and remove persons holding and acting in offices within the Service and to perform any other functions prescribed by National legislation. Further, Article 249(1) mandates the Commission to protect sovereignty of the people; secure the observance by all State organs of democratic values and principles and promote Constitutionalism.

The Commission has finalized the preparation of its 2023-2027 Strategic Plan which has strategically positioned itself to confront the challenges facing the human resource management in the NPS especially on issues regarding the Commission mandate on recruitment, appointments, promotions, transfers and disciplinary control. Consequently, during this strategic plan period, the Commission has carefully identified strategic issues and key result areas for implementation. The Commission has made a strategic choice to pursue the following nine strategic issues grown from five strategic issues of the past strategic plan. These are: Recruitment and Appointments; Promotions and Transfers; Disciplinary Control and Removal; Appeal Hearings and Review; Welfare and Healthcare; Sovereignty, Constitutionalism, Democratic Values and Principles; Decentralization of Commission's Services; Reengineer Commission Business Processes and Audit and Compliance.

Katibu alibainisha kuwa matokeo ya afya yameboreshwa kwa kiasi kikubwa tangu kuzinduliwa kwa mpango wa CHP. Aliongeza kuwa usajili wa familia unaoendelea utaiwezesha wizara kubainisha kwa

usahihi idadi na maeneo ya familia, hivyo kuwezesha kuwahudumia vyema wananchi.

“Tumewataka kuhamasisha wananchi katika kujiandikisha ili wanufaike na huduma

“Tumewapitisha kwenye mafunzo na kuwaweka sawa lakini tutaendelea kuwawezesha kwa ujuzi na maarifa muhimu ili kuhakikisha wanatekeleza jukumu lao kama watoaji wetu wa huduma ya msingi,”

alisema.

Kufikia sasa, alisema CHPs wametembelea Wakenya milioni 3.9 wanaougua kisukari na kuwaelekeza 60,000 kati yao kwenye vituo vya afya.

Zaidi ya hayo, Wakenya milioni 3.8 wamehudumiwa na CHPs kwa shinikizo la damu huku baadhi ya visa 180,000 vikipelekwa vituo vya afya.

Wahudumu wa afya ya jamii, aliongeza, pia wametembelea watoto 180,000 ambao wamepimwa magonjwa ya kawaida yanayoathiri watoto na hatua sahihi zimechukuliwa kuwapeleka kwenye vituo vya huduma za afya.

Katibu alisema taarifa hiyo inapatikana kwa kubofya kitufe kufuatia kuanzishwa kwa afya ya kidijitali, huku rekodi zilizonaswa na vifaa vya CHP zikipelekwa ofisini kwake katika Afya House.

Waziri Bi Soipan Tuya alitoa tangazo hili huko Doldol, Kaunti Ndogo ya Laikipia Kaskazini, wakati wa kuadhimisha Siku ya Kuenea kwa Jangwa Duniani, ambayo huanzishwa kila mwaka Juni 17.

Alisisitiza kwamba mimea vamizi huleta changamoto kubwa kwa mfumo wa ikolojia, na Serikali ina nia ya kuwaondoa. "Tayari kuna mkakati uliowekwa, na

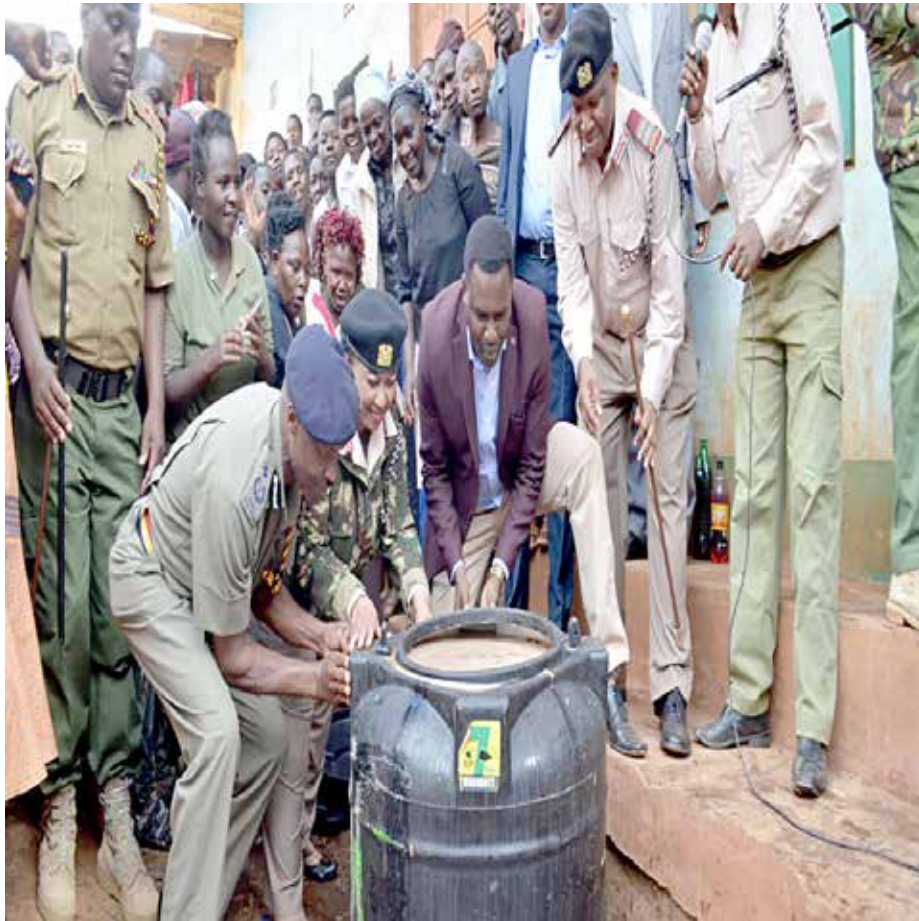

# Mke wa Rais Rachael Ruto ahimiza mageuzi katika elimu ili kunufaisha watoto wa Kenya

Mke wa Rais, Rachael Ruto, amesisitiza haja ya dharura ya mageuzi ya elimu nchini.

Akizungumza wakati wa sherehe za kuadhimi-sha Siku ya Mtoto wa Kiafrika katika Shule ya Msingi ya Mwatate, Kaunti ya Taita Taveta, Bi Ruto alisisitiza nguvu ya mageuzi ya elimu na haja ya kukumbatia mageuzi ya elimu kwa manufaa ya watoto wa Kenya.

Akihutubia washiriki, wakiwemo maafisa wa serikali, wazazi, watoto na washikadau wengine, Mke wa Rais aliangazia hatua kubwa za Kenya katika kuimarisha elimu, kama vile kuajiri walimu 30,000 wa ziada mwaka wa 2023, na kuashiria ongezeko kubwa la asilimia 272 kutoka 11,000 walioajiriwa awali.

Alibainisha kuwa uajiri huu ulifanya jumla ya walimu walioajiriwa hivi karibuni kufikia 41,000, thibitisho la dhamira ya serikali katika kuimarisha ubora wa elimu.

"Kenya imepiga hatua kubwa katika kuendeleza haki na ustawi wa watoto, hasa katika kuhakikisha kwamba watoto wetu wanapata elimu. Lazima tuipongeze serikali yetu kwa hatua kubwa tuliyo-piga katika kufikia kaulim-biu ya maadhimisho ya



mwaka huu," alisema.

Mke wa Rais pia alisherehekea kujumuishwa kwa watoto milioni 1.8 wa shule ya msingi katika mpango wa lishe shuleni, ambao alisema umeongeza kiwango cha mpito kutoka shule ya msingi hadi sekondari kutoka asilimia 84.5 mwaka 2022 hadi asilimia 91 mwaka 2023. Alibainisha kuwa mipango hii ni hatua muhimu katika kuhakikisha kwamba kila mtoto nchini Kenya anapata elimu bora.

Sambamba na hayo, alisema Serikali imeongeza upatikanaji wa kompyuta katika taasisi za elimu nchini chini ya mpango wa vituo vya Jitume Digital unaotekelezwa na Wizara ya Habari, Mawasiliano na Uchumi wa Kidijitali, kupitia Taa-

sisi ya Konza Technopolis.

Alisema kuwa vituo vya Jitume Digital 83 vimezinduliwa, ya hivi punde ikiwa katika Shule ya Upili ya Wasichana ya Butere katika Kaunti ya Kakamega.

Zaidi ya hayo, Mke wa Rais alisema kuwa serikali iliajiri wakufunzi wa ziada 1,300 wa Elimu ya Kiufundi (TVETs) mwaka 2023, ikiwa ni ongezeko la asilimia 22 kutoka wakufunzi 5833 wa awali mwaka 2022.

Kando na hilo, TVET tangu wakati huo zimetengewa nyongeza ya Sh21 bilioni kwa ufadhili wa elimu ya juu, huku Wizara ya Elimu ikipokea nyongeza ya Sh28 bilioni katika mgao wa bajeti mwaka wa kifedha wa 2024-2025.

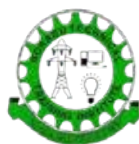

# Privatisation Authority unveils 2024-2028 strategy amid state corporation transition

As the Privatisation Authority launches its 2024-2028 Strategic Plan and unveils its new brand identity this week to transition from a commission to a state corporation under the Privatisation Act 2023, Managing Director Dr. Joseph Kosgey takes readers through the concept of shedding non-strategic and loss-making state agencies in an interview with MyGov writer Mutiso Mbithi, whose excerpts appear below:

**Q: What does Privatisation mean in layman's language?**

A: Privatisation basically means a transaction that results in transfer, other than to a public entity, of the assets and or liabilities of a public entity including the shares in a public entity through an open and transparent process.

**Q: What is the mandate of the Privatisation Authority?**

A: The Privatisation Authority is created under Section 8 of the Privatisation Act 2023 and it is mandated among others to advise the Government on all aspects of Privatisation of public entities, facilitate the implementa-

tion of government policies on privatization and implement the privatisation programme;

**Q: What is a Privatisation Programme?**

A: A Privatisation Programme is a list of public entities approved for privatisation by the Cabinet, ratified by the National Assembly and published in the Kenya Gazette. It shall be valid for a period not exceeding five years from the date of gazette-ment.

**Q: What are the benefits of privatisation?**

A: The concept of privatisation helps to push the participation of the private sector in the economy by shifting the production and delivery of products and services from the public sector to the private sector, the improvement of infrastructure and the delivery of public services by the involvement of private capital and expertise, reduction of the demand for government resources, improving the efficiency of the Kenyan economy by making it more responsive to market forces, improvement of the regulation of the economy by reducing conflicts between the public

sector's regulatory and commercial functions.

**Q: What is the process of formulating the privatisation programme?**

A: The Cabinet Secretary (CS) for the National Treasury shall formulate the programme through the process of proposing public entities to be included in the Privatisation Programme. The CS shall make appropriate consultation with persons likely to be affected by privatisation of the public entity among them; members of the public prior to submission of the proposed privatisation programme to the Cabinet for approval. Upon approval by Cabinet, the CS shall submit the approved privatisation programme to the National Assembly for ratification and once ratified, the Privatisation Programme shall be published in the Kenya Gazette.

**Q: Are Members of Parliament involved during the formulation of the privatisation programme?**

A: Yes. They are involved. Upon approval of the privatisation programme by the Cabinet, the Cabinet Secretary shall submit the approved Privatisation programme to the Na-



tional Assembly for ratification before gazette-ment and implementation of the programme.

**Q: Who implements the Privatisation Programme?**

A: The Privatisation Programme will be implemented by the Privatisation Authority, in accordance with the Privatisation Act, 2023.

**Q: How is the Privatisation Programme implemented?**

A: The Privatisation Programme is implemented through an assessment of the public entity; which is conducted to determine among others the financial, operational, legal position and to recommend the most preferred method of privatisation of the entity. A privatisation proposal is developed which is submitted to the Cabinet for approval through the CS for the National Treasury. After approval of the privatisation

proposal, the Authority shall implement the privatisation of the public entity as per the method of privatisation approved by Cabinet subject to the reserve price (determined through conducting a business valuation of the public entity)

**Q: Where do the proceeds of privatisation go?**

A: The privatisation proceeds are taken to the consolidated fund.

**Q: Who can participate in privatisation?**

A: Any person, whether Kenyan or non-Kenyan is eligible to participate in a privatisation, however the Cabinet Secretary for the National Treasury may limit participation in privatisation to Kenyans only.

**Q: Which privatisation methods are used when privatising government entities?**

A: They include; initial

public offer of shares, sale of shares by public tender, sale resulting from the exercise of pre-emptive rights, or such other method determined by the Cabinet.

**Q: Is there an appeal mechanism for parties aggrieved by the determination of the Authority or implementation of the privatisation programme?**

A: Yes. Section 46 of the Privatisation Act, 2023 provides the mechanism for appeal. Any person aggrieved by the determination of the

Authority or the implementation of the privatisation programme can lodge an appeal to the Privatisation Review Board.

**Q: Kindly list some of the other benefits which accrue from privatization.**

A: Privatisation minimizes conflicts with the private sector, generates additional revenue for the Government, helps the exchequer to save

money spend on non-strategic public entities, presents Kenyans with new opportunities for investment and creates a vibrant private sector which aligns the Bottom Up Economic Transformation Agenda (BETA). Suffice to say that

proceeds from privatization are spent on funding BETA Projects, creates new jobs for Kenyans, generates new taxes after dormant entities are revived by the private sector which leads to creation of opportunities for the vulnerable in society.

Wizara ya Afya imeongeza vituo vya kuhughulikia Ukimwi ili kupeleka huduma karibu na wananchi na kuhakikisha zinapatikana rahisi na Watu Wanaoishi na Virusi Vya Ukimwi.

Waziri wa Afya, Bi Susan Nakhumicha, alisema kuwa kwa sasa kuna maeneo 8,851 ya kupima Ukimwi na maeneo 3,752 ya matibabu, na zaidi ya 2,000 kati ya maeneo yamewekwa kuhudumu kidijitali.

Hizi ni pamoja na vifaa vinavyotolewa na mashirika ya umma, ya kibinafsi na ya kidini kote nchini. Bi Nakhumicha alidokeza kuwa zaidi ya asilimia 90 ya Watu Wanaoishi na Ukimwi wanapata huduma katika vituo vya afya vya Ngazi ya Pili hadi Nne.

Hasa, asilimia 21 wanapata huduma katika vituo vya Ngazi ya Pili, asilimia 27 katika vituo vya Ngazi ya Tatu, na asilimia 45 katika vituo vya Ngazi ya Nne.

“Leo hii, Kenya ina wastani wa watu milioni

1.4 wanaoishi na Ukimwi, ikimaanisha maambukizi ya kitaifa ya asilimia 3.7. Hadi kufikia mwishoni mwa Desemba 2023, watu 1,336,234 wanaoishi na Ukim walikuwa wakipokea matibabu,” alisema Nakhumicha.

Waziri huyo, ambaye

alikuwa akizungumza wakati wa ufunguzi rasmi wa Mkutano wa Ushirikiano wa Utoaji Huduma za Ukimwi mjini Mombasa alisema katika kipindi cha miaka kumi iliyopita, kumekuwa na kupungua kwa kasi kwa maambukizi mapya ya Ukimwi,

vifo vinavyotokana na Ukimwi, na maambukizi kutoka kwa mama kwa mtoto kwa silimia 78, asilimia 68, na asilimia 65 mtawalia.

Kwa mfano, Nakhumicha alibainisha, Kaunti ya Siaya ambayo hapo awali ilikuwa na idadi

Akizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi wa Mpango Mkakati wa Shirika la Kitaifa la Kudhibiti Pombe na Dawa za Kulevya (NACADA), Katibu wa Wizara ya Masuala ya Ndani na Utawala wa Kitaifa, Dkt Raymond Omollo alisisitiza kuwa matumizi mabaya ya pombe na dawa za kulevya ni tishio kubwa kwa usalama wa Kenya.

Omollo alisema kuwa mpango mkakati wa NACADA unalenga kuimarisha utifu na utekelezaji wa sheria, kanuni na viwango vya udhibiti wa pombe na dawa za kulevya kutoka 2023 hadi 2027.

"Mpango mkakati wa NACADA 2023-2027 una hatua madhubuti na za makusudi sio tu kuongeza mafanikio yaliyopatikana katika kupambana na unywaji pombe na dawa za kulevya bali pia kuendeleza kasi," katibu alisema.

Dkt Omollo aliongeza kuwa kuendesha gari mtu akiwa mlevi, ambako kume kuwa chanzo kikuu cha vifo na majeraha mabaya katika barabara za Kenya, kulifanya Wizara kuimarisha vita dhidi ya unywaji pombe na matumizi ya dawa za kulevya kwa kutangaza kuwa ni tishio kwa usalama wa taifa mnamo Machi 6, 2024,



kuashiria kuimarisha kwa kiasi kikubwa vita dhidi ya maovu haya.

Katika hotuba yake iliyosomwa kwa niaba yake na Katibu Tawala wa Taifa, Bi Beverly Opwora, Dkt Omollo alibainisha kuwa Wizara kwa kushirikiana na NACADA, imefanikiwa kufanya misako 61,769 na kukamata lita 342,880 za Chang'aa na lita 2, 553,108 za Kangara. Pia walikamata lita 70,743 za pombe ghushi na

kufunga maduka 15, 533 ya pombe kali na vituo 381 vya shisha.

Aidha, timu hiyo pia ilinasa kilo 6,047 za bangi na jumla ya watu 29, 886 kukamatwa.

"Maeneo ambayo yameathiriwa na maovu haya ni Bonde la Ufa, Nyanza, Kati na Nairobi," katibu alisema.

Kama ilivyoonyeshwa na NACADA, pombe sasa ndiyo dawa inayotumiwa vibaya zaidi na jamii nchini, inayoothiri zaidi vijana na taasisi za masomo.

Kulingana na data kutoka NACADA, Dkt Omollo alibainisha kuwa wastani wa umri wa kuanzishwa kwa matumizi ya pombe nchini Kenya ni miaka 16 huku kairibu asilimia 40 ya watumiaji

wa pombe wakiwa vijana, mmoja katika kila

Wakenya saba wenye umri wa kati ya miaka 25 hadi 30 ambao jumla yao ni 1,137,288 kwa sasa wanakunywa pombe kupita kiasi huku zaidi ya nusu yao wakiwa waraibu - ambao ni 596, 336.

"Mpango huo utasaidia nchi kuepuka tabia mabaya ya pombe na dawa za kulevya lakini pia kuweka mazingira mazuri kwa p miradi ya serikali kustawi," Dkt Omollo alisema. Alihimiza hama sisho kwa wazazi, uundaji wa miongozo inayolenga taasisi za masomo na kushirikiana na serikali za kaunti na washikadau wengine kuhusu maswala ya urekebishaji na usaidizi kwa waathiriwa wa ulevi na dawa za kulevya.

# Serikali kujenga vituo vya ICT katika Wadi zote ili kuboresha ujuzi wa kidijitali miongoni mwa vijana

Waziri wa Habari, Mawasiliano na Uchumi wa Kidijitali Eliud Owalo amewataka Wabunge kuharakisha ujenzi wa vituo vya ICT katika maeneo bunge yao ili kuimarisha ujuzi wa kidijitali miongoni mwa vijana.

Owalo alisema kuwa mpango huu utasaidia mpango wa serikali wa kuanzisha vituo vya ICT katika wadi zote 1,450 kote nchini.

Akizungumza katika Swahilipot katika Kaunti Ndogo ya Mvita, ambapo alizindua kituo cha 205 cha kidijitali, Owalo alisema kuwa Mpango Mkuu wa Dijitali ni nguzo muhimu ya mpango wa maendeleo wa utawala wa Kenya Kwanza, jinsi ilivyoainishwa katika Ajenda ya Mabadiliko ya Kiuchumi kuanzia mashinani.

“Nimepewa jukumu, kama Waziri wa Habari, Mawasiliano, na Uchumi wa Dijitali, kuhakikisha kwamba tunaanzisha vituo vya ICT kote nchini ili kuwapa wavulana na wasichana wetu ujuzi wa kidijitali,” Owalo alisema, akibainisha kuwa kituo cha Swahilipot kinawiana na lengo la serikali la ku-

wapa vijana uwezo wa kidijitali.

Waziri huyo pia alisema kuwa wizara hiyo imesh-

irikiana na wabunge kuwezesha usambazaji wa

vituo vya kidijitali katika kila wadi kote nchini.

Wabunge hao, Owalo alibainisha, tangu wakati huo wamerekebisha Sheria ya Hazina ya Maendeleo ya Kitaifa ya Serikal na sasa wanaweza kutumia asilimia tatu ya mgao wao wa kila mwaka wa NG-CDF kujenga vituo vya kidijitali.

“Jukumu letu sasa kama serikali ya kitaifa ni kunganisha mtandao, kuwapa kompyuta na kutoa mafunzo bila malipo. Baadaye, tutaunganisha vijana wetu na mataifa mbalimbali ili kupata ajira,” alisema.

Waziri huyo aliwahimiza vijana kuchukua vidokezo kutoka kwa wenzao, ambao tayari wanapata mapato kupitia kazi za mtandaoni, na hivyo kuwa huru kifedha.

Alisema lengo kubwa la serikali ni kuwawezesha vijana kupata ajira kutokana na kupungua kwa nafasi za kazi.

“Unaweza kuwa hapa na kufanya kazi kwa kampuni ya teknolojia huko Amerika, Ujerumani, India, Uingereza, Singapore au kwingineko. Vijana wanaofanya kazi mtandaoni wanalipwa

kwa dola,” alisisitiza Owalo.

Kuendelea mbele, Waziri alisema, huduma zote za serikali zitapatikana mtandaoni. “Tulipochukua hatamu za uongozi, tulikuwa na huduma 350 kwenye jukwaa la e-citizen. Leo, tuna 17,020 kwenye e-citizen,” alisema.

Aidha alisema serikali ina nia ya dhati ya kuhakikisha wananchi wanapata huduma wakiwa katika makazi au ofisi zao, bila kulazimika kutembelea ofisi za serikali.

“Vikwazo vyote ambavyo baadhi ya maafisa walikuwa wameweka kati ya huduma za serikali na wananchi ikiwa ni pamoja na kuomba rushwa sasa vitakuwa ni vya zamani kuendelea mbele mbele. Huduma za serikali zitakuwa kati yako, simu yako na serikali yenyewe bila mtu wa kati,” alisema Waziri.

Owalo aliendelea kusisitiza dhamira ya serikali ya kuhakikisha kuwa kuna intaneti nchini kote, na kuongeza kuwa, “Tumekuwa tukichimba mitaro ya kuweka nyaya za intaneti na sasa tumebadilisha mpango huo.

## Shirika la Anga la Kenya laendeleza ustawi wa kitaifa kupitia teknolojia

Shirika la Anga la Kenya (KSA) linaboresha matumizi ya teknolojia za anga na matumizi yake katika kusaidia maendeleo ya kitaifa ya kijamii na kiuchumi na kushughulikia changamoto za jamii.

Wakati wa Maonyesho na Kongamano la Toleo la 2 lenye mada ‘Teknolojia za anga kwa Manufaa ya Kijamii’, KSA iliahidi kukuza, kuratibu, na kudhibiti shughuli zinazohusiana na anga nchini.

Kongamano hilo la siku tatu lililenga kurahisisha mada tata ya sayansi na teknolojia ya anga na kufanya kuwa kueleweka na raia wa Kenya.

Akizungumza katika hafla hiyo, Waziri wa Ulinzi, Adan Duale, alibainisha kuwa teknolojia ya anga na matumizi yake inasaidia sekta muhimu za uzalishaji wa uchumi wa taifa, zikiwemo mawasiliano, uchumi wa kidijitali, kilimo na utoshelevu wa chakula, miongoni mwa nyingine.

Duale aliongeza kuwa teknolojia ya anga inawawezesha wanamaz-

ingira na kuwezesha kukabiliana na vitisho vya kisasa vya usalama kwa umma ikiwa ni pamoja na mabadiliko ya hali ya hewa, majanga ya asili, njaa na ukame miongoni mwa mengine.

“Kulingana na ripoti ya uchunguzi, uchumi wa anga za juu duniani ulifikia dola bilioni 630 mwaka 2023 na unatarajiwa kufikia dola trilion 8 mwaka 2035,” alifichua.

Waziri huyo alisema kuwa uchumi wa anga unatarajiwa kuwa mkubwa, kwa kuwa utaleta thamani kwa viwanda na suluhu kwa wananchi na

dunia nzima ambayo inakumbwa na changamoto.

Kulingana na Duale, itajumuisha sehemu kubwa ya uchumi wa dunia ifikapo mwaka 2035 huku ukuaji ukitarajiwa kuendeshwa na teknolojia ya anga.

Alikiri kuwa serikali inauchukulia kwa uzito mkubwa mpango wa anga ya juu wa taifa kwani inaendelea kuwezesha rasimilali zote muhimu ili kupata faida za uwekezaji zikiwemo za kiuchumi, kiteknolojia na kijiografia.

“Kenya imejenga uwezo wa kibinadamu na kiufundi na uwezo wa kitaifa katika sayansi ya anga, uhandisi wa mfumo wa anga, uchunguzi wa ardhi kupitia ushirikiano na washirika wa kimataifa,” Waziri alisisitiza.

Zaidi ya hayo, Duale alisema kuwa ushirikiano huu umewezesha ubadilishanaji wa mafunzo kuhusu mbinu bora na ubunifu wa kujenga uwezo, akisema kuwa nchi imeunda sera ya anga na mpango wankisheria ambao itatumia kuhifadhi data kuhusu anga.

## Mipango mipya yawekwa kudhibiti itikadi kali Kenya

Kituo cha Kitaifa cha Kukabiliana na Ugaidi (NCTC) kinalenga kutumia mbinu ya kijamii ili kuzuia itikadi kali nchini, kama sehemu ya mkakati mpya unaolenga kukabiliana na ugaidi na shughuli zinazohusiana nao.

Mkurugenzi wa NCTC Dkt Rosalind Nyawira alisisitiza hilo wakati wa kufunga warsha ya siku mbili ya kuchunguza upya Mkakati wa Taifa wa Kukabiliana na Misimamo mikali katika hoteli moja mjini Nanyuki.

Alisema kuwa mabadiliko hayo yalichochea na kutofaulu kwa mkakati wa awali uliopitishwa mwaka 2016. Kwa kuzingatia mabadiliko ya mienendo ya shughuli za ugaidi, kuna haja ya kubadilisha mbinu na kuunda mpya.

“Kuna haja ya kuchunguza upya mikakati iliyoandaliwa mwaka wa 2016; miaka minane ni muda mrefu. Kutokana na mabadiliko ya misimamo mikali, ni lazima tutoe mawazo mapya ikiwa tunataka kushinda magaidi,” alisema Dkt Nyawira.

Alieleza kwamba mzozo kati ya Israel na Palestina uliongeza vitisho vya ugaidi kwa Kenya na hivyo kuna haja ya idara za usalama kuimarisha umakini.

“Itikadi kali ulimwengu umebadilika kuwa wa mitandaoni ambapo unakuta mabadiliko makubwa, uajiri na mafunzo mara nyingi hufanywa mtandaoni, kwa hivyo kuna haja pia kama nchi kudhibiti matumizi ya teknolojia,” Mkurugenzi wa NCTC alisema.

Alibainisha kuwa chini ya mkakati mpya unaobuniwa, kutakuwa na mabadiliko kutoka

kwa mbinu zinazozingatia nguzo hadi kwa vikundi vya kazi katika Jukwaa la Ushirikiano wa Kaunti (CEFs) ambazo zitakuwa vyombo vya msingi vya utekelezaji katika vita dhidi ya ugaidi.

Mkakati huo unalenga kuzipa kaunti uwezo wa kukabiliana na changamoto zao za kipekee ambazo zinaweza kutumiwa na watu wenye msimamo mkali. Warsha hiyo iliyoleta pamoja washiriki kutoka kaunti saba za Embu, Kirinyaga, Nyeri, Laikipia, Meru, Isiolo na Marsabit ilieleza kuwa mkakati huo mpya unalenga kuwa na washauri wa kiume wa kuwaongoza vijana na pia kuunda mitandao ya wanawake kuchukua hatua kama mifumo ya tahadhari ya mapema kwa kuwa akina mama wako katik hali nzuri kugundua mabadiliko katika tabia ya watoto.



# Serikali kugharimia vifaa vya kusikia, vya usaidizi katika mfumo mpya wa afya

Vifaa vya kusikia na vingine vya kusaidia vitajumuishwa katika mfumo mpya wa mafao huku serikali ikitaka kuendeleza mageuzi kutoka Mfuko wa Taifa wa Bima ya Afya (NHIF) hadi Mamlaka ya Afya ya Jamii (SHA). Waziri wa Afya Bi. Susan Nakhumicha alisema serikali itagharamia vifaa vya usaidizi vinavyohitajika na watu wenye ulemavu ili kuwawezesha kuendelea na maisha yao ya kila siku bila kulipia gharama za nje. “Vifaa vya kusaidia kama vile magongo na fremu za kutembea vitagharamiwa chini ya mpango wa Huduma ya Afya ya Msingi ya SHA,” Waziri alisema alipokuwa akiwahutubia wanahabari katika hoteli moja Nairobi. “Uzuri wa mpango huu mpya ni kwamba, hakuna Mkenya aliye na ulemavu atalazimika kulipia vifaa vya kusaidia. Hiki ni kifurushi kipya cha manufaa kilichobuniwa na kikosi cha wataalamu wa masuala ya kiuchumi baada ya kuchunguza kwa karibu huduma za afya ambazo Wakenya wamekuwa wakitafuta,” Waziri aliongeza. Alisema kuwa serikali itatoa vifaa vya kusaidia wagonjwa wenye ulemavu wa kudumu wa mwili au hisia na hali sugu zinazoendelea. Hata hivyo, alionya kuwa vifaa vya matibabu vitatolewa kwa watu wenye ulemavu wa kudumu pekee wanaotambuliwa na Baraza la Kitaifa la Watu Wenye Ulemavu (NCPD). Chini ya utaratibu huu, walengwa watapata kifaa kimoja cha usaidizi kwa kila kaya kwa

mwaka, isipokuwa kwa viatu vya matibabu, ambayo ina kikomo cha mbili kwa kaya kwa mwaka. “Vifaa vya usikivu ni vya watu wenye umri wa miaka 18 na chini na vitatolewa mara moja tu kwa maisha,” alisema, akiongeza kuwa vifaa vinahitajika kwa sababu ya kutokuwa na uwezo wa muda au kutokuwa na uwezo wakati vikiwekwa kwenye kifurushi cha upasuaji. Baada ya timu ya wataalamu kukadiria gharama za mafao, mchakato uliochukua mwaka mmoja na nusu, gharama mpya za vifaa vya usikivu zitakuwa Sh55,000 ikilinganishwa na ya sasa, ambayo ni kati ya Sh60,000 na Sh100,000 kutegemea kwenye duka. Jozi ya mikongojo itagharimu takriban Sh900, huku za kutegemea mguu kifundo zitauzwa Sh1,000, fremu za kutembea zitanunuliwa kwa Sh500 na viatu vya matibabu Sh1,000. Huku akielezea manufaa mengine mapya ambayo Wakenya wanapaswa kutarajia mara moja SHA itanza kufanya kazi Julai 1, Nakhumicha alisema wagonjwa walio na magonjwa sugu kama vile kisukari pia watapata marupurupu ya kujazwa tena kutoka kwa maduka ya dawa ya jamii yaliyorodheshwa. Nakhumicha alieleza kuwa wagonjwa ambao wanatakiwa kuwa na dawa kila wakati na maagizo wataweza kuzijaza kutoka kwa maduka maalum ya dawa chini ya kifuniko kipya. “Ikiwa una maagizo ya magonjwa sugu kwa mfano mgonjwa wa kisukari ambaye anatumia dawa zake kwa muda wote, badala ya ku-

rudi kwa mtaalamu, na una maagizo, unaweza kwenda kwenye duka la dawa la jamii ili yorodheshwa na kupokea kujaza,” CS. sema. Waziri huyo pia alidokeza kuwa kaya zitaweza kupata manufaa ya mwisho wa maisha ambayo yatakidhi huduma kama vile ada za kuhifadhi maiti.

**Tunaendelea vizuri sana na kifurushi cha manufaa kina mengi mazuri mapya**

“Hifadhi ya mwisho wa maisha inakusudiwa kuwasaidia Wakenya kupunguza mzigo wa kutuma pesa kwa wanafamilia wao,” alisema, akibainisha kuwa hii itapunguza pesa nyingi za kuchangisha mtandaoni ambazo Wakenya wanapaswa kubeba mara kwa mara. Waziri huyo alibainisha kuwa mojawapo ya manufaa mengine ambayo Wakenya watapata kuanzia Julai 1 ni pamoja na; Jalada la Ajali na Dharura. “Tunasema kwamba kwa mpango huu mpya, ikiwa wewe ni msamaria mwema na uko kwenye eneo la ajali, usiwe na wasiwasi, wasaidie majeruhi wawahi hospitali; serikali itagharamia kila kitu mradi mgonjwa amesajiliwa,” alisema. Madai ya Nakhumicha yaliungwa mkono na Katibu Mkuu wa Huduma za Matibabu, Harry Kimtai ambaye alisema NHIF ina mapungufu mengi katika upatikanaji wa huduma, ambayoyalilazimugeuzi. “Tuligundua kuwa hatuwezi kufika mbali na NHIF chini ya mpango wa

Serikali ya Kenya Kwanza ndiyo maana tulichukua zamu ya digrii 360 na kufanyia kazi kuleta mageuzi,” Kimtai alisema. Marekebisho hayo, Kimtai alisema, yaliwezesha kuanzishwa kwa miwada minne, ambayo sasa ni Sheria, ili kuiimarisha sekta ya afya. Sheria ya Afya ya Kidijitali ambayo inatoa fursa ya kuanzishwa kwa Wakala wa Afya wa Kidijitali ambao utaongoza utoaji wa huduma za afya za kidijitali na kuanzisha mfumo mpana wa taarifa za afya wa kidijitali (digital superhighway). Sheria ya Ufadhili wa Uboreshaji wa Kituo ambayo inaweka mfumo wa uhifadhi na matumizi ya rasilimali za afya kwenye chanzo. “Tunaendelea vizuri sana na kifurushi cha faida kina faida mpya zilizoongezwa. Hivi ndivyo Wakenya watapata,” akasema. “Hifadhi mpya, kwa mfano, pia inajumuishwa huduma za meno na macho miongoni mwa manufaa mengine mapya ambayo hayaku-

jumuishwa hapo awali katika NHIF,” aliongeza. Alisisitiza kuwa Afya ya Akili ni faida nyingine iliyoongezwa katika mpango huo mpya ambao haukushughulikiwa na NHIF akisema mpango huo mpya unaruhusu Wakenya kufanyiwa uchunguzi wa magonjwa ya akili. “Wakenya husubiri mtu awe mgonjwa, ndipo waende kuchunguzwa, na hatimaye kutibiwa. Lakini uchunguzi wa mpango huu utashughulikiwa,” alisema.

Alibainisha kuwa kwa NHIF hakuna usawa na ni ubaguzi maana malipo ya Mfuko yanafanyika kwa njia tofauti huku wale wenye kipato cha chini wakilipa asilimia kubwa ya mapato yao. “Mpango mpya hauna ubaguzi, tulichofanya ni kusawazisha malipo; wanaolipwa na wasi-olipwa, wote watachangia asilimia 2.75 ya mapato yao kupata huduma za matibabu,” alisema. Kimtai alieleza kwa waandishi wa habari kwa nini kuhama kutoka NHIF hadi SHA ni muhimu, akifafanua kuwa takwimu zote za gharama za bidhaa na huduma zinatokana na gharama zilizohesabiwa kwa uangalifu na timu. Hata hivyo, manufaa mapya yaliyorodheshwa yanaweza kusimamishwa mara tu mtu binafsi atakaporejelea malipo yake. Kaimu Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa Afya Dkt. Patrick Amoth alisisitiza dhamira ya serikali ya kufikia Huduma ya Afya kwa Wote (UHC) kupitia mageuzi yanayoendelea.

## NEMA yaanza msako dhidi ya uvamizi wa ardhi kando ya mito

Mamlaka ya Kitaifa ya Kusimamia Mazingira (NEMA) imeapa kukabiliana na wawekezaji wanaovamia ardhi ya kando ya mito kinyume cha sheria ili kurejesha maeneo hayo muhimu.

Mkurugenzi wa NEMA kanda ya Bonde la Ufa Njoki Mukiri alisema kuongezeka kwa vitisho vya mabadiliko ya tabianchi kumesababisha mafuriko na kuongezeka kwa kina cha maji ambayo yameathiri nyumba, hoteli na mashamba ya kilimo yaliyojengwa kwenye hifadhi za maji na kusababisha watu

kuyahama makazi yao na kusababisha hasara ya mamilioni ya fedha.

Sheria ya Usimamizi na Uratibu wa Mazingira [2015] inafafanua ardhi ya kando ya mito kama kiwango cha chini cha mita sita a hadi mita 30 kila upande wa ukingo wa mto kutoka alama ya juu zaidi, ambayo ni ardhi ya umma.

Akizungumza mjini Naivasha wakati wa kongamano la washikadau wa mazingira, Mukiri alisema kuwa kwa miaka mingi, wawekezaji wa kibinafsi wamenyakua na kuvamia hifadhi za mito, wakijenga miundo

kinyume cha sheria ambazo zinafafanua ardhi ya kando ya mito kama ya umma.

Pamoja na kupanda kwa viwango vya maji kutoka kwenye maziwa na vyanzo vya maji, Mukiri alibainisha kuwa shughuli za utalii zimepata pigo kwani miundo iliyojengwa kwenye ardhi hiyo inazama, na kusababisha hasara kubwa ya mali na mapato.

Aidha, Mkurugenzi huyo alisema kuongezeka kwa mafuriko yanayoletwa na mabadiliko ya tabianchi kumeathiri mashamba ya kilimo na kusababisha uharibifu wa mazao jambo

ambalo linatishia utoshelevu wa chakula na maisha.

Kwa upande mwingine, alisema uharibifu wa hifadhi za mito na mazingira yake kutokana na kuongezeka kwa shughuli za kibinadamu ume-sababisha kuongezeka kwa uchafuzi wa samaki na viumbe vingine vya baharini hali ambayo imevuruga uchumi wa eneo hilo. “NEMA itaongoza msako dhidi ya miundomsingi haramu na shughuli zingine za kibinadamu ambazo zinafanywa kwenye ardhi ya kingo ili kukabiliana na uharibifu uliosababishwa na kurejesha mifumo

ya ikolojia,” alisema.

Mkurugenzi huyo aliwatahadharisha wawekezaji dhidi ya kuvamia maeneo ya hifadhi badala yake washauriane na mamlaka husika ili kuepusha hasara katika siku zijazo na kuongezeka kwa serikali inataka kuongezeka urejeshwaji wa maeneo hayo nchini kote.

Alisema serikali imeanzisha mikakati mbalimbali ya kukabiliana na hali ya hewa inayolenga kukomesha uharibifu wa ardhi ikiwa ni pamoja na upandaji miti, urejeshaji wa ardhi na kuilinda dhidi ya uharibifu.



## Kenya yageuza mwelekeo kutoka misaada ya hadi kwa maendeleo endelevu kwa wakimbizi

Idara ya Uhamiaji na Huduma za Raia, kwa ushirikiano na Idara ya Wakimbizi, inapitia pendekezo la ushirikiano wa wakimbizi nchini Kenya.

Mpango huo wa kwanza unaiotwa Shirika Plan, unalenga kubadilisha kambi za wakimbizi za Kenya kuwa makazi ambayo kwa sasa yameteuliwa kuwa manispa, huku wakimbizi wakijumuishwa kama sehemu

ya mpango wa maendeleo wa jamii nzima.

Julius Bitok, Katibu wa Uhamiaji na Huduma kwa Raia, alisema kuwa serikali inachukua hatua kuhakikisha utekelezaji wa Mpango wa Shirika, kutoka mfumo wa kibinadamu kuwa wa maendeleo.

“Tunataka wakimbizi wajitegemee badala ya kutegemea tu usaidizi wa kibinadamu,” Bitok alisema, akisisitiza

kuwa mpango huo unalenga kuwaunganisha wakimbizi na jamii zinazowahifadhi ili kuisi kwa uelewano na kushirikiana vyema.

Aliendelea, “Tutapeleka rasimu ya Mpango wa Shirika kuthibitishwa na wadau ikiwa ni pamoja na kaunti na wabunge ili kupata maoni zaidi ya kumimarisha stakabadhi hii na baadaye kwenye Baraza la Mawaziri kudidhinishwa ifikapo Agosti mwaka huu.

Katibu alikuwa akizungumza jijini Nairobi wakati wa maadhimisho ya Siku ya Wakimbizi Duniani.

Alifichua kuwa rasimu ya Mpango wa Shirika tayari imepitishwa na kwamba mnamo Novemba 1 2024, wazo la kibunifu litazinduliwa. Bitok alikariri kuwa mpango huo wa kihistoria tayari umefanikisha kupitishwa kwa Sheria ya Wakimbizi, 2021 ambayo itahakikisha

mfumo wa kisheria na udhibiti kusaidia Mpango wa Shirika.

“Mpango wa Shirika ni mbinu ya awamu kwa kipindi cha mpito cha miaka minne na makadirio ya bajeti ya awamu ya kwanza ni dola milioni 943,” katibu ilisema. Alisema mpango huo unalenga kuhusisha wadau wote wakiwemo wabunge, magavana, wakimbizi na jamii zinazowahifadhi ili kuhakikisha usalama wa makazi hayo.

Waziri huyo aliongeza kuwa Awamu ya Kwanza ya Bwawa la Thwake inatarajiwa kukamilika ifikapo Desemba mwaka huu.

“Hii ni hatua kubwa kwa mradi huu, na ninataka kushukuru timu zote zilizohusika katika ujenzi. Ni hadithi ya mafanikio kwa sababu kila mmoja wetu alitekeleza jukumu muhimu,” Njeru alisema.

Walioandamana na Waziri walikuwa Julius Korir, Katibu wa Idara ya Maji na Usafi wa Mazingira; Mhandisi Samuel Alima, Katibu wa Maji; Henry Wafula, Kamishna wa Kaunti ya Makeni; Bi Regina Ndambuki, Mwenyekiti wa shirika la Maendeleo ya Maji la Tana; Mhandisi Tito Mwamati, Afisa Mkuu Mtendaji wa Shirika la Maendeleo ya Maji la Tanathi; pamoja na wawakilishi kutoka kwa mwakandarasi, mshauri, na Wizara.

Kulingana na wajenzi, zoezi hili linaashiria hatua muhimu kwa bwawa hilo, ambalo linajengwa kwenye makutano ya Mito ya



Thwake na Athi kwenye mpaka wa kaunti za Makeni na Kitui. Pia ilibainika kuwa kujazwa kwa mwisho kwa tuta kunaweka hatua ya shughuli mbalimbali za mkondo wa chini ambazo zitabadilisha usambazaji wa maji, uzalishaji wa umeme na kilimo

cha unyunyuzaji katika eneo la Ukambani.

Hivi sasa, ujenzi na shughuli zinazohusiana na bwawa hilo unaendelea, na maendeleo kwa ujumla yanafikia asilimia 93.6 mbele kidogo ya asilimia 92.77 ilivyopangwa.

“Ili kutangaza dhana

mpya na kuinua kijamii na kiuchumi mamilioni ya wakazi katika eneo la Mashariki ya Chini, Wizara tayari imekamilisha miundo na za zabuni za vipengele muhimu vya chini,” alifichua Waziri.

Njeru alisema majadiliano yanaendelea na Benki ya Maendeleo ya Afrika (AfDB) ili kupata fedha kwa ajili ya kazi hizo.

“Hii ni kwa mujibu wa lengo la jumla la Serikali la kutimiza mpango wa muda mrefu wa maendeleo wa nchi katika maeneo ya maji, nishati na kilimo kama ilivyoainishwa chini ya Ajenda ya Mabadiliko ya Kiuchumi kuanzia mashinani,” waziri Njeru alisema.

Awamu ya kwanza ya

mradi inahusisha ujenzi wa bwawa la Concrete Face Rockfill (CFRD) lenye urefu wa mita 80.5 lenye uwezo wa kuhifadhi mita za ujazo milioni 688. Awamu ya pili itaangazia kuendelea miundombinu ya usambazaji wa maji, usafi wa mazingira na maji chafu, kusambaza mita za ujazo 150,000 za maji yaliyo-safishwa kila siku kwa takriban watu milioni 1.3 katika Kitui, Makeni, na Jiji la Konza Techno katika Kaunti ya Machakos.

Awamu ya tatu na ya nne itashuhudia uwekaji wa mfumo wa umeme wa maji wenye uwezo wa MW 20 na uendelezaji wa mradi wa unyunyuzaji katika hektari 40,000.

**KENYA ROADS BOARD**

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the Road Maintenance Levy Fund Act, the Cabinet Secretary for Roads and Transport, in consultation with the Cabinet Secretary, National Treasury is seeking to review the Road Maintenance Levy Fund (Imposition of Levy) Order, 2016.

The Ministry of Roads and Transport proposes an amendment to the Road Maintenance Levy Fund Act, 1993 by increasing the Road Maintenance Levy by **Kshs 7.00, from Kshs 18.00 to Kshs 25.00** per litre of petrol and diesel.

The value of Kenya's road network has been established as **Kshs 3,999 trillion**. This valuable asset requires investments to protect it from deterioration and loss of value. Based on the projected RMLF collections, the financing gap for road maintenance over the next 5 years is estimated at **Kshs 315 billion**.

The Road Maintenance Levy was last reviewed 8 years ago in July 2016, when the rate was increased to Kshs 18.00 per litre of petrol and diesel. It is proposed to increase the rate by Kshs 7.00 per litre of petrol and diesel for the following reasons:

- Increased cost of Road Maintenance - As a result of inflation and other macro-economic fundamentals, the cost of road maintenance has increased in the period by up to 50%.
- Expansion of the Road Network - In the last 10 years, the Government of Kenya, with the assistance of Development Partners has carried out significant development and rehabilitation of the road network in the country. The road network has therefore grown from 161,451 km of roads in 2016 to 239,122 km.
- Increase in Fuel Prices - As a result of increased import costs. Local fuel pump prices have doubled from the year 2016 to date, whereas the RMLF rate has remained constant. In comparison with fuel import prices, RMLF rate has effectively reduced from 64% to 16%.
- Lack of funding for maintenance of paved KeRRA roads - The 32% RMLF allocation to KeRRA is shared equally among the 290 constituencies for maintenance of constituency roads, leaving no funds to address the maintenance needs of paved KeRRA roads.

## Watafiti wa Egerton wazuia ugonjwa wa kuku kwa tiba asili ya mitishamba

NA ANNE MWALE(KNA)

Magonjwa ya ndege ni mojawapo ya changamoto kuu zinazokabili ufugaji wa kuku nchini Kenya. Iwe ni kuku, bata, bata bukini, au aina nyingine yoyote ya kuku, magonjwa yanaweza kuharibu makundi yote au kuzuia uzalishaji na ukuaji katika jamii.

Coccidiosis, kwa mfano, ni mojawapo ya magonjwa ya gharama kubwa zaidi ya kuku nchini Kenya, na kusababisha hasara ya zaidi ya asilimia 50 kwa wafugaji. Matumizi ya viuvavijasumu vya kuzuia magonjwa—dawa zinazotolewa kuzuia badala ya kutibu magonjwa—kumesababisha ukaidi wa dawa dhidi ya Coccidiosis.

Hata hivyo, watafiti katika Maabara ya Marejeleo ya Chakula Salama ya Chuo Kikuu cha Egerton (SAF-Lab) wametengeneza dawa ya mitishamba inayoitwa Aloe Secundiflora Herbal Extract (ASHE). Wanadai kuwa inazua vimelea vya Coccidiosis katika asilimia 80 ya kuku wa kufuga, na kusaidia kukabiliana na kuongezeka kwa ukaidi wa

dawa kwa kuku.

Kwa mujibu wa mwanasayansi mkuu Profesa Charles Muleke Inyangwa, dawa hiyo iliyotengenezwa kwa unga wa aloe vera, inawapa wafugaji wa kuku njia asili ya kuzuia Coccidiosis bila hatari ya kusababisha bakteria sugu kwa binadamu. "Asilimia 40 ya magonjwa ya kuku nchini Kenya yameonyesha ukaidi kwa dawa za kisasa. Huku zaidi ya asilimia 25 ya kuku nchini wakiathirika na Coccidiosis, dawa ya mitishamba ya ugonjwa huu

itaokoa mamilioni ya sekta ya kuku nchini," anasema Profesa Inyangwa.

Anaongeza, "Ufugaji wa kuku umekuwa ukikabiliana na janga kimya kimya vimelea vya ndani. Ascaris na vimelea vya coccidian huleta uharibifu kwa kuku wa kifuga, na kusababisha hasara kubwa ya kiuchumi kwa wafugaji. Utumiaji kiholela wa dawa za kuua viini na dawa za kuua minyoo umesababisha kuku wasiostahimili dawa, na kuwaacha wafugaji wakiwa na hamu ya kutafuta njia

mbadala salama na zinazofaa. Lengo letu ni kutengeneza dawa ya mitishamba ambayo ni nzuri na salama kwa matumizi."

Prof Inyangwa anasema kuwa dawa hiyo ambayo inaweza pia kutibu minyoo inapatiwa kuku kwa njia ya maji na amedokeza kuwa inaweza kupunguza viwango vya maambukizi ya Coccidiosis kwa asilimia 81.

Shirika la Chakula na Kilimo la Umoja wa Mataifa (FAO) linasema kuwa ukaidi dhidi ya vijidudu (AMR) katika wanyama unatishia maisha ya mamilioni ya wafugaji.

FAO inakadiria kuwa katika miaka kumi zaidi ya watu milioni 24 wataingia kwenye umaskini uliokithiri kutokana na AMR.

Prof Inyangwa anaeleza kuwa safari ya ASHE inanzia katika Kaunti ya Baringo, ambako Aloe Secundiflora huvunwa. Majani hukatwa kwa uangalifu ili kutoa jeli, ambayo hupitia mchakato mkali hadi kukaushwa

Matokeo yake ni unga mwembamba, ambao huwekwa kwenye vyombo vya gramu 30, tayari kwa matumizi.

## KWA UFUPI

### MoH yaanzisha mitandao 160 ya afya ya msingi nchini

Jumla ya Mitandao 160 ya Huduma za Afya ya Msingi (PCNs) imeanzishwa kwa ufanisi kote nchini, huku mingine 41 ikiendelea, na hivyo kuashiria hatua kubwa ya kuwezesha utoaji wa huduma zinazomhusu mtu binafsi.

Bi Muthoni Muriuki, Katibu wa Afya ya Umma na Viwango vya Kitaalamu, alisema kuwa kwa sasa, asilimia 87 ya kaunti zina angalau PCN moja inayofanya kazi. Alibainisha kuwa PCN zinazofanya kazi zimeonyesha mafanikio makubwa katika kutoa huduma bora za afya ya msingi, ikiwa ni pamoja na kuongezeka kwa ufikiaji, uchunguzi wa magonjwa, uboreshaji wa rufaa kwa wagonjwa, na uratibu bora kati ya wafanyakazi wa afya. "Mafanikio ya PCN ni pamoja na kuongezeka kwa huduma na ufikiaji, kama vile Kaunti ya Garissa na Vihiga, ambapo ujumuishaji wa upangaji uzazi uliongezeka kutoka asilimia 66 mwaka wa 2019 hadi asilimia 87 mnamo 2022, Huku utoaji ukiongezeka kutoka asilimia 77 hadi 98 katika Kaunti ya Garissa,"

Muriuki alisema. Alisema kuwa katika Kaunti ya Pokot Magharibi, Kaunti Ndogo ya Kacheliba PCN imekuwa na ukumbi wa utendaji kazi na kuongeza wahudumu wa afya, na hivyo kuimarisha utoaji wa huduma. Katika Kaunti ya Lamu, rufaa kwa vituo vipya vilivy-oanzishwa imepunguza rufaa kwa Hospitali ya Rufaa ya Kaunti, na hivyo kurahisisha upatikanaji wa huduma za afya. Kulingana na Muriuki, juhudi za mafunzo na kujenga uwezo zimekuwa muhimu, huku Wakufunzi 248 wakifunzwa kusaidia kaunti katika kuanzisha PCN zao. Wakufunzi hao wana juukumu katika kusambaza mbinu bora na kuhakikisha utendakazi bora wa PCN. "Njia bunifu zinatumiwa, kama vile katika Kaunti ya Kisumu, ambapo utumiaji wa droni kwa usambazaji wa bidhaa umeboresha usambazaji wa vifaa vya matibabu kwa wakati unaofaa. Katika maeneo ya mbali ya Kwale, ambapo tathmini za uchunguzi wa uzazi zime-tekelezwa," alisema.

### Waziri aamuru utekelezaji mkali wa sheria za malisho

Mhifadhi Mkuu wa Misitu ameagizwa kuhakikisha utekelezaji madhubuti wa sheria na kanuni zilizowekwa kuhusu malisho na uvunaji wa nyasi katika misitu ya umma. Waziri wa Mazingira, Mabadiliko ya Tabianchi na Misitu Bi Soipan Tuya alieleza wasiwasi wake kuhusu ongezeko la visa vya malisho haramu katika misitu ya umma kote nchini. Alibainisha kuwa hali hii inadhoofisha juhudi za serikali kufikia lengo la kitaifa la kupanda miti bilioni 15. Ili kuhakikisha kuwa ni shughuli endelevu na shirikishi za usimamizi wa misitu kama vile malisho ya mifugo katika misitu iliyotangazwa kwenye gazeti la serikali, Tuya alisisitiza kuwa Wizara itashirikiana kikamilifu na jamii zinazopakana na misitu ambazo ni wanachama wa Vyama vya Jamii za Misitu (CFAs) zilizosajiliwa rasmi.

"Kuhusu masuala ya haki za mtumiaji wa misitu, Wizara itashirikiana na vyema vya Misitu vya Jamii zilizosajiliwa ipasavyo kupitia Mpango Shirikishi wa Usimamizi wa Misitu na Mikataba ya Usimamizi wa Misitu kama ilivyoainishwa

na sheria," Tuya alisema. Katika taarifa iliyotumwa kwenye vyomba vya habari, waziri alieleza kuwa Wizara yake, kwa kushirikiana na washirika, inatumia teknolojia ili kuimarisha ufuatiliaji wa misitu, kuharaka uwekaji mipaka, na kupanua programu ya ua ili kufikia misitu yote ya umma iliyotangazwa kwenye gazeti la serikali. Alisema serikali imejika katika kulinda uadilifu wa misitu nchini inapofanya kazi ya kuimarisha miti, na kuongeza kuwa kua-jiri na kupeleka askari wa misitu 2,700 hivi karibuni waliojumuisha kadeti 100 na walenzi wa misitu 468 kumepunguza kwa kiasi kikubwa uhalifu unaohusiana na misitu.

"Misitu ya umma ya Kenya ni muhimu kwa lengo la kuinua miti ya nchi yetu hadi asilimia 30 ifikapo 2032 kama inavyotarajiwa katika Mkakati wa Kitaifa wa Kurejesha Mazingira," Tuya alisema. Waziri huyo aliongeza kuwa mkakati huo ndio msingi wa mpango wa kitaifa wa upandaji miti bilioni 15 kitaifa.

Waziri wa Maendeleo ya Vyama vya Ushirika, Biashara Ndogo na za Kati (MSMEs) Simon Chelugui alisema kuwa Wizara iliandaa stakabadhi kwa Baraza la Mawaziri ambalo liliidhinishwa 6.7 bilioni kusaidia wakulima wa kahawa kulipa madeni wanayodaiwa.

"Uamuzi wa Baraza la Mawaziri ulijumuisha msaada mwingine kwa wakulima wa kahawa kama vile uboreshaji wa miche ya kahawa, ulipaji wa madeni ya zamani ya KPCU, na usaidizi kwa maeneo yanayochipuka ya kahawa na vifaa vya usindikaji ili kuongeza

ubora wa kahawa inayouzwa kutoka maeneo hayo," Chelugui alisema.

Akizungumza jijini Nairobi wakati wa mkutano wa mashauriano na wakopeshaji wa vyama vya ushirika vya kahawa, Chelugui alisisitiza kuwa sekta ndogo ya kahawa nchini Kenya ni muhimu kwa

uchumi wa nchi. Inatoa riziki kwa wakulima 800,000, inawanufaisha watu milioni tano wasio wa moja kwa moja, na inachangia kwa kiasi kikubwa mapato ya fedha za kigeni kutokana na mauzo ya nje. Alieleza kuwa serikali itaunda timu ya uthibitishaji wa mashirika mbalimbali ili kuchambua madeni yaliyowasilishwa kutoka kwa vyama vya ushirika na kuandaa ripoti kwa Hazina ya Taifa iweze kutoa fedha.

"Zoezi hilo linataka uaminifu na uwazi kwa viongozi wa vyama vya ushirika na wadeni wao wakati wa kuandaa madeni. Ni muhimu kutambua kwamba idhini ya Baraza la Mawaziri ilisisitiza kwamba uwongo wowote unaweza kusababisha kufunguliwa mashtaka kwa wale ambao watapatikana na

hatia," Chelugui alieleza.

Alisema wote wanaodai wanatakiwa kutoa taarifa ya kina ya mikopo iliyotolewa kwa vyama vya ushirika kwa Kamishna wa Maendeleo ya Ushirika.

Alisisitiza kuwa timu ya uthibitisho itaongozwa na vigezo ambavyo ni pamoja na mikopo husika ambayo lazima iwe imechakatwa kupitia vyama vya ushirika.

"Mahitaji mengine ni kwamba mkopo uwe umepangwa na kuidhinishwa na wanachama katika mkutano mkuu ulioitishwa kihalali, Kamishna wa Maendeleo ya Ushirika awe amedhinisha ukopaji, orodha ya wanachama wanaonufaika endapo fedha za awali zitatolewa kwa wanachama kama mikopo au pembejeo za shambani," alisema.
