Alisema kuwa Baraza lita-hakikisha mashujaa wanaheshimiwa, na urithi wao unahifadhiwa ili kuhamisha vitendo vya ushujaa kwa manufaa ya wananchi.

“Kuhifadhi michango muhimu ya mashujaa wa kitaifa kutasaidia kukuza sauti za mashujaa wa taifa, kuinua ufahamu wa umma na hivyo basi kutia fahari na vitendo sawa vya kujitolea, uzalendo na ujasiri miongoni mwa Wakenya,” Angwenyi alisema.

Akizungumzia upunguzaji wa bajeti, Mwenyekiti wa Baraza alitaka serikali kuharakisha uanzishaji wa Hazina ya Taifa ya Mashujaa ambayo itasaidia familia za mashujaa waliofariki dunia.

“Na moja ya mambo ambayo tumeyafanya Mheshimiwa Spika, ni kwamba kulikuwa na eneo kubwa la uchimbaji madini huko Dabel, Marsabit, ambalo sasa limefungwa kwa sababu ya uchimbaji haramu na katika kipindi cha takribani wiki mbili zilizopita, maafisa wetu walikuwa Migori, Siaya na Narok, na waliweza kufunga shughuli zote haramu za uchimbaji madini katika kaunti hizo,” Waziri Mvurya alisema.



Aidha, waziri alisema wizara yake imependekeza kufukuzwa kwa baadhi ya wageni waliokuwa wakijishughulisha na uchimbaji madini bila kuwa na stakabadhi zinazohitajika.

Maseneta hao walimpongeza Waziri Mvurya kwa kuelewa kwa kina mamlaka ya wizara yake. Kiongozi wa Wengi katika Seneti Aaron Cheruiyot na Maseneta Dan Maanzo (Makueni), Boni Khalwale (Kakamega) na Richard Onyonka (Kisii) waliuliza maswali yanayohusiana na

uchimbaji haramu wa madini.

Seneta wa Pokot Magharibi Julius Murgor aliuliza kuhusu hatua zilizowekwa kulinda wenyeji dhidi ya maeneo yaliyochimbwa ambayo Waziri alisema wizara yake imeunda mfumo wa udhibiti wa madini na usalama ili kushughulikia maswala ya mazingira na hatari zingine.

Wizara ya Afya imepokea dozi 450,000 za dawa za kupanga uzazi aina ya Medroxy-Progestosterone-Acetate (DMPA) za thamani ya Sh56.4 milioni kutoka kwa washirika wake wa maendeleo.

Waziri wa Afya Bi Susan Nakhumicha alisema hatua hii muhimu inasitiza kujitolea kwa pamoja kushughulikia hitaji lisilotimizwa la huduma za upangaji wa uzazi na kuboresha matokeo ya afya kwa wanawake na familia kote nchini Kenya.

Katika hotuba iliyosomwa kwa niaba yake na Kaimu Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa Afya, Dkt Patrick Amoth, wakati wa kupokea msaada wa dawa za kupanga uzazi kutoka FCDO-USAID katika Kituo cha Kitaifa cha Kusambaza dawa na vifaa vya afya cha KEMSA huko Embakasi, Bi Nakhumicha alisema kuwa hafla hiyo ni ushuhuda wa dhamira isiyoyumba ya washikadau

wote katika kuendelea usalama wa bidhaa za afya ya uzazi na kuharakisha kuafikiwa kwa malengo ya upangaji uzazi nchini Kenya.

“Ningependa kutoa shukrani zangu kwa FCDO, UNFPA, na washirika wengine wote ambao kwa ukarimu wameunga mkono mpango huu muhimu. Ushirikiano na kujitolea kwenu katika kuboresha afya na ustawi wa wanawake na familia za Kenya ni wa kupongezwa sana. “Zaidi ya idadi, athari za juhudi zetu ni kubwa. Kwa kuepusha mimba zisizotajijiwa, vifo vya uzazi, na utoaji mimba usio salama, sio tu kwamba tunalinda afya na ustawi wa raia wetu bali pia tunakuza maendeleo ya kijamii na kiuchumi na ustawi,” waziri alisema.

Akizungumza jijini Nairobi wakati wa Kongamano la Viongozi wa Vyombo vya Habari barani Afrika, Omwoyo alisema lengo la kongamano hilo ni kujadili biashara ya vyombo vya habari, maendeleo yake, na jukumu lake katika kuunda mustakabali wa Afrika.

“Kongamano hili sio tu

onyesho la umuhimu wa vyombo vya habari vya Kenya na Afrika na jukumu lake katika maendeleo; pia ni jambo la kushukuru kwamba kwa nguvu na ushirikiano mkubwa, tunaweza kupanga mustakabali mwema wa vyombo vya habari vya Afrika,” Omwoyo alisema.

Afisa Mkuu Mtendaji alisema mkutano huo ulijiri wakati vyombo vya habari vya kidijitali barani Afrika vinapoanza kukita mizizi na unatoa nafasi kwa watalaamu wa vyombo vya habari katika bara kujadili njia za kubadilisha vyombo vya habari vya jadi kuwa vyombo vya habari vya kidijitali jambo ambalo linazidi kuwa la

lazima viweze kudumu.

“Mpito wa kidijitali hajaunda fursa zaidi kwa vyombo vya habari na waundaji wa maudhui, lakini pia umeturuhusu kupitia mpito ambapo kwanza kabisa, maudhui zaidi yanaundwa na pili habari na maudhui yanafikia hadhira zaidi,” Omwoyo alisema.

Alibainisha kuwa nyakati za zamani habari zilikuwa zikitafsiriwa kwa lugha za Kiafrika lakini hivi sasa teknolojia hiyo imeweza gazeti kusomwa kwa lugha moja na teknolojia kupitia Akili Unde (AI) inajua lugha ya matumizi ya watumiaji mbalimbali.

Aliwataka viongozi wa vyombo vya habari kutopigana na teknolojia badala yake washirikiane kupata matokeo bora badala ya kuwa na fikra ambapo wakati mwingine vyombo vya habari vinashindana kupita kiasi.

“Teknolojia imeonyesha kuwa ushirikiano utaleta matokeo bora, kupunguza gharama za uendeshaji na

Government to replace lost documents for flood victims-PS

The government has embarked on the process of replacing vital identification documents for Kenyans affected by floods.

State Department for Immigration and Citizens Services Principal Secretary Prof. Julius Bitok said the Department will visit each of the counties affected by the floods and replace birth certificates, identity cards and passports lost by the flood victims.

The PS who was speaking at the Meat Training Institute in Mavoko when he led a tree planting exercise said, "we have set up a centre in Nyayo House for emergency replacement of your documents".

He called upon Mavoko residents to keep on planting trees which will help curb the severity of the floods that have been caused by climate change.

At least 3,000 tree seedlings were planted towards the realisation on the government's

target of 15 billion trees by 2032.

"Everyone must come out to plant trees which will help in solving the effects of climate change," Prof Bitok said.

Athi River Deputy County Commissioner Patrick Mwangi on his part hailed Mavoko residents for their cooperation and support during the floods which helped in saving lives.

He encouraged them to plant trees not only in the institutions but also in their homes and work places.

Member of County Assembly Jeremiah Kaloi urged Mavoko residents to focus on taking care of trees after planting and creating a better environment.

The MCA decried the dire situation of the displaced flood victims in Athi River and called upon the government to intervene by giving them alternative land in Mavoko.

He also called upon the government to give Athi River flood victims Sh10, 000 stipend to help them rebuild their lives.

Government receives 15 firearms through village elders

Isiolo Sub-County Security and Intelligence Committee has received 15 rifles and 22 rounds of ammunition surrendered through the influence of community elders.

Deputy County Commissioner Mr. Patrick Musango confirmed that the voluntary surrender had been going on for the last four months in the area.

Musango said that Ngaremara elders and herders had volunteered nine firearms and 13 rounds of ammunition through their chiefs and area elders.

The DCC added that Leparua elders from Oldonyiro Ward surrendered two AK-47 rifles with seven rounds of ammunition to local security teams.

Two homemade rifles were recovered by secu-

city officers while on normal patrols at Kulamawe estate in Bulapesa Ward, Isiolo town.

The administrator said the arms' surrender shows that wananchi are working closely with local chiefs leading to the reduction of livestock theft while several stolen animals recovered.

He attributed the isolated cases of insecurity in the area to the presence of firearms in wrong hands and warned that the government would deal with the criminals.

He appealed to residents to continue surrendering illegal firearms to the authority adding those volunteering them will be pardoned.

Musango urged chiefs and their assistants and the 'nyumba kumi elders' to expose criminals in the villages by using SMS to senior security officers and forward the same texts to his office for ease of following up.

Mvurya calls for protection of water catchment areas against encroachment

The Cabinet Secretary for Mining, Blue Economy, and Maritime Affairs, Salim Mvurya, has called for the protection against encroachment of water catchment areas and riparian land in a bid to mitigate the effects that climate change has on the environment.

Speaking during the World Tree Planting Day event held at Lake Kenyatta in Lamu, Mvurya highlighted the need to curb the encroachment of riparian land, citing the effect the recent floods had on people downstream where at least 228 people lost their lives during the deluge.

“The people who have been most affected by the floods are those who have been living very close to water catchment areas,” he stated, adding that the national and county governments need to work closely to curb encroachment of these riparian lands.

He said apart from the water catchment areas being gazetted, the national government has committed efforts and resources to plant 15 billion trees to enhance water retention, prevent soil erosion, and create micro-climates that support agricultural productivity.

“In addition to the immediate ecological advantages, the tree planting exercises seek to enhance the country’s capacity to mitigate the effects that climate change has brought upon different parts of Kenya,” Mvurya added.

His sentiments were echoed by Blue Economy and Fisheries Principal Secretary Betsy Njagi who stated that there needs a constant monitoring of the water catchment areas and riparian lands against encroachment.

Kukamilishwa kwa gati tatu za kwanza za kisasa za Meli hadi ufuoni na Mamlaka ya Bandari ya Kenya (KPA) kunaoleleka kuongeza ufanisi wa Bandari ya Lamu.

“Maendeleo haya ya kina yatachochea msururu wa shughuli za kiuchumi, na kuifanya Kenya kuwa kituo cha biashara ya kimataifa na vifaa, muhimu sana katika kukuza uhusiano wa kibishara na masoko ya Asia,” alisema Mbogo wakati wa mkutano wa kila mwaka wa Jamii ya Wanauchumi wa Kenya huko Mombasa.

Mwenyekiti wa LAPSSET

alibainisha kuwa Afrika ndilo bara lisilounganishwa zaidi duniani na uagizaji wa bidhaa za ndani kati ya nchi za Afrika ni takriban asilimia 17.

Bandari ya Lamu, Mbogo aliongeza, imeipa Kenya njia mbadala ya biashara kwani nchi inategemea Bandari ya Mombasa.

“Ukienda Mama Ngina Waterfront, utaona njia hiyo. Tuna njia nyembamba sana. Iwapo lolote lingetokea kwenye mkondo huo, basi tutalemaza sio uchumi wa nchi hii pekee bali Afrika Mashariki nzima,”

alisema.

Bandari ya Lamu ni bandari ya asili yenye rasimu ya mita 18 na mita 21 wakati wa mawimbi ya chini na mawimbi makubwa mtawalia.

“Tumejenga bandari kwa njia ambayo gati tatu zina mita 1,200 ambazo zina-weza kuruhusu meli kubwa katika bandari hiyo bila changamoto yoyote. Meli hizo hazivezi kuingia katika Bandari ya Mombasa,” alisema Mbogo.

Tangu kukamilika kwa gati la kwanza mwaka wa 2019, Bandari ya Lamu imekuwa ikitumika kwa kiwango cha chini, lakini bodi ya Mamlaka ya Maendeleo ya Ukanda wa LAPSSET ilifanikiwa kuwashawishi Waethiopia kutumia Bandari hiyo ambayo iko karibu ikilinganishwa na bandari za Djibouti na Tadjourah zote za Djibouti.

“Njia kutoka Lamu hadi Moyale ni ndefu, ni kilomita 1,300 lakini bado ni fupi kwa kilomita 300 ikilinganishwa na njia ya sasa ambayo Waethiopia wanatumia kuagiza bidhaa zao kutoka Djibouti ambayo ni kilomita 1,600,” Mbogo alisema.

Waziri, Bi Alice Wahome, ambaye alikuwa akizungumza katika Msitu wa Marmanet Kusini, Rwathia, Kaunti ya Laikipia, alisema kuwa wizara yake tayari imepata miche milioni 16 ya miti ya kupandwa katika kaunti za Nyeri na Laikipia, ambayo itasambazwa katika miezi michache ijayo.

“Miongoni mwa miche tuliyoinunua ni ile ya miti ya matunda, ambayo itapatwa wakulima ili kupanda katika mashamba yao ikiwa ni njia ya kujihakikishia utoshelevu wa chakula, huku ile ya kiasili iliyobaki ikipandwa katika maeneo ya misitu iliyoharibiwa kama huu,” Bi Wahome alisema, akiongeza kuwa moja kati ya kila miche mitano ya miti ambayo wizara yake iliazimia kupanda itakuwa miti ya matunda.

Waziri huyo pia alibainisha kuwa nchi inatazamiwa kuvuna kiasi kikubwa cha kaboni kutokana na juhudi endelevu za upanzi wa miti na uhifadhi zilizoanzishwa na Rais William Ruto.

KISIP 2 ni mradi wa serikali unaotekelezwa na Serikali ya Kenya (GOK) kupitia ufadhili wa Benki ya Dunia na AFD. Ni mradi muhimu wa kuwezesha Ruwaza ya 2030 unaozingatia ajenda ya Serikali ya kuwezesha wakazi katika mitaa ya mabanda.
