Serikali kutathmini muundo mpya wa ufadhili kwa vyuo kuuboresha

Jopo Kazi la Rais kuhusu Mageuzi ya Elimu PWPER, lilipata kuwa vigezo vya awali vilivyotumiwa na serikali kutoa fedha kwa vyuo vya elimu ya juu, vilivitumbukiza vyuo vikuu na taasisi za mafunzo ya kiufundi kwenye madeni makubwa.

Wizara ya Elimu imeanza kufanya tathmini ya Mfumo Mpya wa Ufadhili (NFM), unaotumika sasa kutoa fedha kwa wanafunzi wa vyuo vikuu na vyuo vya mafunzo ya ufundi, miaka miwili baada ya kuzinduliwa.

Mtindo huo ulizinduliwa Mei mwaka jana kufuatia mapendekezo kutoka kwa ripoti ya Jopo kazi la Rais kuhusu Mageuzi ya Elimu (PWPER).

Kulingana na matokeo ya PWPER, kigezo cha awali kilichotumiwa na serikali kupatia fedha taasisi za elimu ya juu, kilivitumbukiza vyuo vi-

Serikali inategemea akiba kubwa ya madini Turkana kwa ajili ya kuinua uchumi wa nchi. Bw. Stanley Loter, Mkurugenzi wa Kaunti ya Rasilimali Madini, asema mwonekano wa awali wa eneo hili unaficha fursa kubwa za kiuchumi ambazo ardhi hiyo inasitiri. "Mwonekano wa ardhi hii ni wa kudanganya. Hii ni hazina bikira ambayo ina ufunguo wa mabadiliko yetu ya kiuchumi na ustawi," asema Bw. Loter. Turkana ni nyumbani kwa akiba kubwa ya madini adimu na ya thamani zaidi nchini Kenya. Kuna madini ya thamani, ya ujenzi, na ya kimkakati,

ambayo yanaunda safu iliyosheheni rasilimali katika eneo lililotengwa ambalo linapata mamia ya mamilioni katika mapato yanayowezekana. Waziri wa Madini, Uchumi Baharini na Masuala ya Uvuvi, Salim Mvurya anasema madini katika Kaunti ya Turkana yanaweza kusababisha ukuaji ambao haujawahi kushuhudiwa katika eneo hilo unaongwa mkono na mazingira wezeshi kukuza unyonyaji endelevu. Akiwa anaongoza wajumbe wenye mamlaka ya juu kuelekea Turkana, Mvurya alisema wakazi watafaidika pakubwa na madini hayo wakati serikali hizo mbili zitashirik-

Katibu alisema hatua ya kutathmini upya mfumo huu inatokana na nia ya kubaini na kutatua vikwazo vinavyotokana na utekelezaji wake. “Tumejitolea kukabiliana na vikwazo hivi na kuhakikisha kwamba kila mwanafunzi anapata fursa ya kuendelea na elimu ya juu bila vikwazo vya kifedha,” alisema.

Alisema mfumo huo umeundwa ili kuonisha ufadhili na mahitaji ya mwanafunzi binafsi badala ya taasisi.

“Mbinu hii inalenga kuhughulikia vyema hali mbalimbali za kiuchumi za wanafunzi wetu na kuhakikisha kwamba msaada wa kifedha unapatikana kwa wale wanaohitaji zaidi”, aliongeza Katibu.

Dkt Inyangala pia alitaja mfumo huo kama hatua ya mageuzi kuelekea mfumo wa ufadhili wa elimu ulio sawa na bora zaidi nchini.

Alisema NFM ilianzisha mabadiliko kadhaa muhimu ikiwa ni pamoja na kutenganisha uwekaji na ufadhili. “Kutengewa nafasi na

Huduma ya Vyuo Vikuu vya Kenya sasa kutatokana na sifa na chaguo. Mwanafunzi hutuma ombi kivyake kwa usaidizi wa kifedha, ikijumuisha ufadhili wa masomo na mikopo ya serikali “ilieleza Katibu.

Alisema mfumo huo pia unaiwezesha serikali kutoa fedha kwa njia ya ufadhili wa masomo na mikopo kwa wanafunzi kwa kutegemea wawongozo wa kupima uwezo wa kila mmoja.

“Mfumo huo pia hutoa vigezo halisi vya ufadhili kulingana na gharama ya programu za Chuo Kikuu,” aliongeza Katibu.

Vilevile, Dkt Inyangala alisema fomula hizo mpya zinarahisishia vyuo vikuu kunufaika na njia mbalimbali za ufadhili, ikiwa ni pamoja na ufadhili wa wanafunzi, ruzuku ya utafiti, ruzuku ya miundombinu ya mitaji pamoja na huduma za ushauri.

Kuhusu uainishaji wa waombaji, katibu alisema kuwa NFM inaweka wanafunzi katika makundi matano kulingana na viwango vya mapato ya familia.

iana kuunda ufanisi katika utoaji wa leseni na utekelezaji ili kuondoa utendakazi haramu katika eneo hilo.

Waziri huyo alian-damana na Makatibu Wakuu Elijah Mwangi, Madini; ms Besty Njagi, Blue Economy na Geoffrey Kaituko wa Masuala ya Bahari. “Tunafanya kazi na kaunti kutumia uwezo wa uchimbaji madini. Kwa kuwa na Kamati ya Uchimbaji Madini iliyopo, tunaweza kutoa leseni na kufuatilia utendakazi ili wawekezaji walipe mrabaha kwa ajili ya usambazaji kwa wakazi,” aeleza. Ikimiliki ardhi yenye ukubwa wa kilomita za mraba 68,000, Kaunti ya Turkana ndiyo eneo la pili kwa ugatuzi baada ya Marsabit. Ingawa tamaduni mahiri ya wenyeji inayojulikana kwa dansi za kuvutia, mavazi ya kitamaduni ya kuvutia na ziwa la jangwani limekuwa isihara za watu wa Turkana kustahimili kiburi

na utambulisho, muujiza wa kweli wenye ahadi ya mabadiliko ya kiuchumi uko chini ya eneo kame. Mkoa umethibitisha kuwepo kwa madini yenye thamani ya juu zaidi ya 21. Wao ni ujenzi; asbesto, silika, jasi kwa mawe ya thamani; marijani, yakuti na garnet na za kinkakati kama kromiti na koltani. Pia kuna vipengele vya mionzi ikiwa ni pamoja na samarskite na pitchblende ambayo iko

chini ya darasa la urani. Bw Joseph Ekiru, mwenyekiti wa wachimbaji madini wa Kaunti ya Turkana, anasema visa vya madini vimeripotiwa kote katika kaunti hiyo. Anaongeza kuwa manufaa kutokana na unyonyaji kamili yatafunika sekta nyingine, na kufanya uchimbaji madini kuwa sababu kuu inayoendesha uchumi wa Turkana. “Hili jitu la madini linazinduka. Madini yatakuwa kibadilishaji

kikubwa cha ukujaji na maendeleo ya kaunti hii,” akasema. Data ya madini inaonyesha usambazaji mkubwa unaoenea kote Turkana. Maeneo kama Nadapal na Lokitang yana mabaki ya dhahabu huku ripoti zikionyesha mkanda mkuu wa dhahabu unaoipitia Kainuk hadi Kusini huko Nakwamoru, Maruputh na Loima. Sapphire za bluu ziko Kaeris na Malpus huku garneti nyekundu na kijani ziko Kaputirr.

Mpango wa Kitaifa wa Chanjo (NVIP) unasambaza upya chanjo za kawaida zinazopatikana kote nchini ili kuhakikisha watoto wanaozihitaji hawakosi chanjo katika kipindi hiki muhimu.

Katibu wa Idara ya Serikali ya Huduma ya Matibabu, Harry Kimtai, alisema kwamba wanachukua hii kama hatua ya haraka ya kuziba pengo.

Aliongeza kuwa wanashirikiana kwa karibu na UNICEF ili kuhakikisha utoaji wa chanjo zilizoagizwa baada ya malipo ya mwisho. Kimtai alieleza kuwa Wizara inafuatilia matumizi ya chanjo katika viwango vyote kitaifa na kuwezesha ugawaji upya kati ya kaunti.

"Jumla ya Sh1.25 bilioni zimetengwa kwa ununuzi wa haraka wa chanjo za kawaida na kujaza chanjo za kuokoa maisha katika vituo vyetu vya afya," alieleza Kimtai.

Katibu alifanua kuwa licha ya changamoto za kiutaratibu kutokana na mvua kubwa zinazodelea kunyeshwa, Wizara na washirika wake wataharakisha usafirishaji wa chanjo zinazotarajiwa kuwasili wiki ya kwanza ya Juni 2024.

"Kujitolea kwetu kwa afya na ustawi wa Wakenya wote bado ni thabiti, na tunafanya kazi kwa bidii kushughulikia changamoto zozote katika mpango wetu wa chanjo," alihakikishia Kimtai.

Aliendelea: "Tuna ripoti za uhaba wa chanjo za kawaida katika vituo vya afya nchini.

"Kwa sasa, kuna uhaba wa chanjo muhimu, na zilizopo zinaweza kutumiwa chini ya

Ahadi yetu kuhusu afya na ustawi wa Wakenya wote inasalia kuwa thabiti - Katibu

miezi miwili kitaifa kwa chanjo za jadi kama vile Chanjo ya BCG, Chanjo ya Polio, na Chanjo ya Rubella ya kukinga Surua."

Kimtai aliongeza kuwa viwango vya chanjo nyingine nyingi za kawaida za utotoni, ikiwa ni pamoja na zinazotolewa kwa usaidizi na Gavi (chanjo ya Pneumococcal, Rotavirus, HPV, na Malaria), vimepungua na vitadumu kwa miezi mitatu hadi sita pekee.

Upungufu huu wa akiba, Kimtai alisema, unaweka watoto na watu wanaoishi katika mazingira hatari katika hatari ya magonjwa yanayokingwa kwa chanjo na yanaweza kuzuka.

"Kwa kutambua kwamba chanjo ni majawapo ya afya zenye ufanisi zaidi za afya ya umma, tumejitolea kuhakikisha ugavi thabiti wa chanjo," alisema katibu.

Alisisitiza kwamba Kenya imenufaika na mfumo thabiti wa chanjo kwa zaidi ya miaka 44,

na kama Wizara wamejitolea kuhakikisha vizazi vijavyo vinafurahia maisha yenye afya. "Taratibu za mpango wa kuharakisha upatikanaji" kwa usaidizi wa Gavi zinaanzishwa, ikiwa ni pamoja na kuchunguza ufadhili endelevu wa ununuzi wa

chanjo," alisema.

Katibu aliongeza kuwa wanashirikiana na Hazina ya Kitaifa ili kuhakikisha wameongezewa pesa zinatolewa kwa mpango wa chanjo.

"Rasilimali za ndani zitahakikisha ufadhili endelevu wa chanjo, hasa

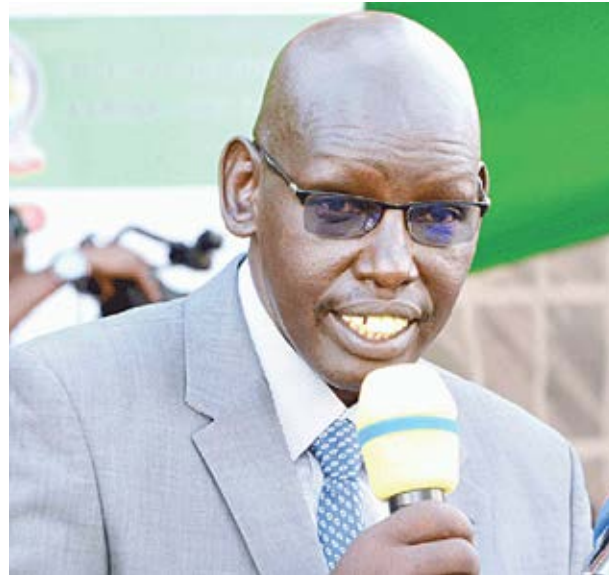

Pursuant to Regulation 21 of the Environmental Management and Coordination (Impact Assessment and Audit) Regulations, 2003, the National Environment Management Authority (NEMA) has received an Environmental Impact Assessment Study Report for the above proposed project.

The proponent Tanathi Water Works Development Agency intends to construct a dam which will involve gravity flow distribution of treated water. The design capacity of the proposed dam is 74167M³/day. The proposed dam will submerge the existing two rivers dam and therefore the current production (12000M³/day) of the existing two rivers dam will be lost. The selected dam type is Roller Compacted Concrete Dam(RCC)of structural height 39.3m high with an Overflow Ogee Spillway(126m) stepped spillway chute and a stilling basin. Other key features of the proposed dam include: Riverbed Elevation(2150masl), Storage Level(2173.55masl), Full Supply Level(NWL);2180.3Masl, maximum water level at floods (2182.80masl), Dam Crest Level (2184.3masl), Dead Storage 6.62Mm³, Live Storage 9.06Mm³, Total Dam Volume 15.686Mm³, Area Inundated at Full Supply Level 1.74Km². The raw water from the one river will be transmitted to the Namanga Water Works for treatment before distribution to consumers. The project will be located in Namanga town in Kajiado County.

The following are the anticipated impacts and proposed mitigation measures:

Stakeholders resolve to have informal sector workers register for pension schemes

Kenyans in the informal sector have been urged to join pension schemes and commence saving for retirement to secure a good future once they exit from their jobs.

According to statistics by the Retirement Benefits Authority (RBA), despite the total assets under management amounting to over Sh1.7 trillion as of December 2023, only 26 per cent of the labour force is actively saving for retirement.

Speaking during the official opening of a five-day Huduma clinic in Mombasa meant to educate residents on the critical importance of saving for retirement, RBA Chief Executive Officer (CEO) Charles Machira said the public needs to be informed that formal employment is not a prerequisite for pension scheme enrolment, and it is important to save and plan for retirement.

Machira also urged

stakeholders in the pension industry, including the media, to reverse the trend of poor saving for retirement by enlightening Kenyans on the importance of retirement savings and the various options available.

He noted that sensitization through the Huduma clinic plays a profound significance particularly when considering the alarming statistics indicating that approximately seven out of 10 Kenyans face the risk of falling into poverty upon retirement due to inadequate savings.

“The initiative targets informal sector workers, with the goal of enlightening them on the various avenues available for retirement savings.

“Additionally, for those already engaged in the sector, we continue to provide free retirement preparation training for scheme members nationwide,” he said.

He added that RBA is closely collaborating with other stakeholders, such as the individual pen-

sion plans represented, to raise awareness among all Kenyans regarding the importance of retirement savings.

He said instances of retirees encountering challenges in accessing their pension benefits have been noted over the years and promised to do a follow up and ensure every retiree gets their benefits 30 days after the day of retirement, as prescribed by the law.

Huduma Centre Chief Executive Officer Mugambi Njeru said Huduma Centres are ready to partner with RBA and bring services closer to the people, ensuring accessibility and inclusivity for all.

Mombasa Deputy County Commissioner Ronald Mwiwawi said the initiative will offer a prime opportunity for residents to learn how to start saving and secure their future.

Mwiwawi said the government is steadfast towards ensuring citizens do not retire into poverty and is promoting a culture of saving for retirement as a crucial step in achieving the goal.
