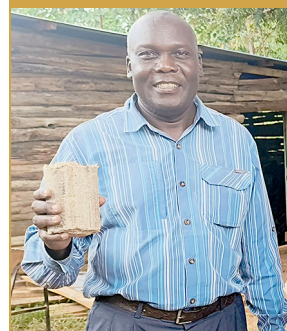

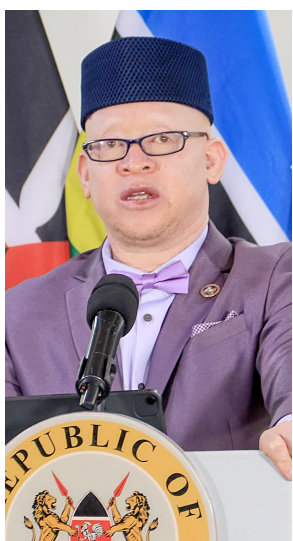

Sh500 milioni ni sehemu ya Sh4.4 bilioni ambazo serikali inatarajiwa kutumia kuwafidia wakazi wa Eneo Bunge la Kinango katika Kaunti ya Kwale, huku Hazina ikiwa tayari imelipa Sh1.6 bilioni kwa Priority Area One.

Ujenzi wa bwawa hilo ulikwama mnamo Julai baada ya kutatizwa na madai ya fidia na kurejesha riziki kutoka kwa jamii ya eneo la Kinango.

Umwagiliaji PS Eng. Ephantus Kimotho

alisema kuwa Sh500 milioni zilitolewa ili kufidia kundi la kwanza la wakazi, isipokuwa wacheache ambao hawakuwa na nyaraka zinazofaa. Viongozi wa eneo hilo wameahidi kusaidia katika kutatua mzozo huo.

Kimotho pia alitangaza kuwa Hazina na Wizara ya Maji, Usafi wa Mazingira na Umwagiliaji itatoa Sh500 milioni nyingine kwa Tume ya Kitaifa ya Ardhi ili kutoa tuzo kwa maeneo ya Mwavumbo na Bofu.

Mpango huo wa fidia unaokadiriwa kugharimu Sh2.8 bilioni, umeandaliwa kwa ushirikiano na viongozi wa eneo hilo ili kuhakikisha kuwa walioathirika wanalipwa fidia ipasavyo.

Kwa mujibu wa Msemaji huyo wa Serikali, orodha ya mishahara pia inaonesha kuwa watumishi 43,976 wenye umri wa miaka 55 na kuendelea wanatarajiwa kustaafu kazi kati ya mwaka 2024 na 2029, huku 7,662 wakitarajiwa kustaafu katika mwaka huu wa fedha pekee.

Dk Mwaura aliongeza kuwa kwa sasa mafisa 39,441 wanatumikia serikali kwa masharti ya kimkataba, huku kandarasi zao zikikamilika kwa tarehe mbalimbali kulingana na muda wao wa utumishi. "Hii inaunda nafasi za kazi 46,838 kwa vijana wetu wasio na kazi kuhudumu serikalini kwa masharti ya kudumu au ya kimkataba baada ya kustaafu na kumalizika kwa kandarasi za sasa," Dk. Mwaura alisisitiza.

Pia aliangazia ukumbusho wa Siku ya Kimataifa ya Vijana mwaka

huu, kusherehekea uchangamfu, ubunifu, na ujasiri wa vijana wa Kenya chini ya mada 'Kutoka Mibofyo hadi Maendeleo: Njia za Kijiditali za Vijana kwa Maendeleo Endelevu.' kuleta mabadiliko ya maana na kukuza maendeleo endelevu, sio tu nchini Kenya bali ulimwenguni kote.

Dk Mwaura alibainisha kuwa maadhimisho hayo yamekuja wakati nchi ikiwa imetekeleza hatua kadhaa za kuhakikisha uwezesaji wa vijana unakuwa wa ki-maendeleo kwa kuzingatia Mpango wa BETA, chini ya Serikali Mpya ya Msingi (BBG), ambayo inalenga kuleta maendeleo ya taifa shirikishi zaidi. ajenda. Msemaji wa Serikali alisisitiza zaidi kuwa Mpango huo umepata maendeleo makubwa ndani ya nguzo yake ya tano, Barabara kuu ya Dijiti na Uchumi wa Ubunifu, ikijumuisha uwekaji wa huduma za kidigitali za serikali 17,668.

"Salio lingine la Sh1.3 milioni litatolewa katika mwaka wa 2025/2026," aliongeza.

PS alisema mradi huo una upekee kidogo kwani kutakuwa na sehemu ya kujikimu ambapo serikali itarejesha maisha ya watu walioathirika na mradi mahali walipokuwa kabla ya kuhamishwa.

Aidha, Serikali ilijadiliana na Benki ya Dunia ambayo ndiyo wafadhili wa mradi huo na kuku-baliana kutenga Sh1.9 bilioni pamoja na Sh500 milioni kwenda kwenye miradi ya jamii kwa kuhirikisha wazee husika, alisema.

Aliongeza kuwa kwa salio la Sh1.4 bilioni, tayari Wizara imemshirika mshauri ambaye ameanza kazi na ndani ya miezi mitatu atakuja na mpango wa kina kueleza jinsi sehemu husika zitakavyonufaika.

Kwa bahati mbaya, Katibu alisema shule tatu katika eneo hilo pia

"Mradi wa bwawa la Mwache uko katika Kaunti ya Kwale, lakini kaunti jirani za Mom-basa na Kilifi pia zitunufaika. Kuna mradi unaoitwa Kwale Urban ambao utazalisha lita za ujazo 9,000 katika kaunti na ekari nyingine 1,000 za unyunyiziaji maji mashambani," akasema.

Kaunti ya Mom-

basa itapata lita za ujazo 186,000 za maji kwa siku, na matokeo yake haitahitaji tena maji kutoka Kilifi.

Kimotho aliwahakikishia wenyaji kuwa kila mmoja wao ambaye ameathiriwa atalipwa fidia ipasavyo kama wakili na mpimaji wamefanya kazi katika mradi huo kwa miaka mitatu na uamuzi wa ardhi na masuala ya urithi yameshughuliwa.

Mbunge wa Kinango Bw.Gonzo Rai alisema

wakazi wa Kinango wameacha kazi wakidai kulipwa fidia lakini akaongeza kuwa mara baada ya kulifikisha suala hilo Bungeni, Tume na Wizara ya Hazina walikubaliana kutatua changamoto hiyo kwa wakati.

Rai alisema tatizo pekee linalorudisha nyuma ujenzi wa bwawa hilo ni mgogoro kati ya mkandarasi na wafanyakazi wanaodai kulipwa mishahara wa Julai, wakati mradi huo ume-sitishwa.

COMMENCEMENT OF TESTING AND FLUSHING OF THE KIGORO TO GIGIRI BULK TREATED WATER PIPELINE

Athi Water Works Development Agency (AWWDA) would like to inform members of the public living along/near the newly constructed Kigoro to Gigiri Bulk Treated Water Pipeline of the commencement of scheduled testing and flushing/washout of the pipeline from **Monday 26th - 9th September 2024.**

This exercise is critical to ensure the safe and efficient operation of the pipeline, which is part of the Northern Collector Tunnel Bulk Water System. During this period, residents may observe the following safety precautions:

- Please avoid any contact with the discharged water as it will contain chlorine used for sterilization.
- Refrain from accessing restricted areas around the pipeline during the testing period.
- Any unauthorized personnel should stay away from the testing areas to ensure their safety.

We kindly request the cooperation and understanding of the public during this period.

Background: The Kigoro to Gigiri pipeline is a vital component of the Northern Collector Tunnel Bulk Water System, designed to supply 140 million liters of clean water daily to Nairobi and communities along the pipeline route in Muranga and Kiambu counties. This pipeline, stretching 55 kilometers, will convey treated water from the Kigoro Water Treatment Plant to the Gigiri Pump Station and Reservoirs.

Serikali ya Kitaifa inatarajiwa kutumia zaidi ya Sh1.2 bilioni katika ujenzi wa madarasa 1,243 ya Shule ya Sekondari za Msingi (JSS) katika kaunti nne za eneo la Magharibi.

Mkurugenzi wa Elimu wa Kanda (RDE) Jared Obiero alisema kaunti za Kakamega, Vihiga, Bungoma, na Busia zimetengewa jumla ya Sh1,243,000,000 kwa madarasa hayo, ambayo yatakuwa tayari kwa wanafunzi wa darasa la tisa mwaka ujao.

Akizungumza na Shirika la Habari la Kenya (KNA) ofisini mwake Kakamega, Obiero alibainisha kuwa ujenzi wa awamu ya kwanza tayari umeanza, huku awamu ya pili ikipangwa kuanza Oktoba mwaka huu.

RDE iliongeza kuwa Bodi ya Usimamizi ya Shule (BOM) na Kamati za Miundombinu ya Shule (SIC) zinasimamia ujenzi huo. Serikali tayari imehamisha fedha hizo kwenye akaunti za benki za shule husika. Kwa mu-

jibu wa miongozo ya Wizara ya Elimu, ujenzi lazima ukamilike ndani ya miezi mitatu tangu tarehe ya kusainiwa kwa mkataba.

Obiero alitaja kuwa Kaunti ya Kakamega ndiyo iliyopokea mgao mkubwa zaidi, huku madarasa 506 yamepangwa—81 chini ya awamu ya kwanza na 425 ya ziada chini ya awamu ya pili.

Alisema Vihiga imetengewa jumla ya vyumba vya madarasa 170, ambapo kwa sasa 55 vina-jengwa chini ya awamu ya kwanza, na madarasa mengine 115 yatajengwa chini ya awamu ya pili.

Kaunti za Bungoma na Busia zimepewa jumla ya madarasa 366 na 201 mtawalia.

“Chini ya awamu ya kwanza, Bungoma kwa sasa inajenga madarasa

129, huku 239 yanatarajiwa kujengwa chini ya awamu ya pili, wakati Busia madarasa 50 yanajengwa chini ya awamu ya pili na madarasa 151 yatajengwa katika awamu ya pili.

“Kazi za ujenzi wa awamu ya pili zinatarajiwa kuanza Oktoba mwaka huu, wakati ambapo kazi zinazoendelea za ujenzi wa awamu ya kwanza zitakuwa zimekamilika,” alisema.

“Nimezindua kazi za ujenzi katika shule kadhaa ikiwa ni pamoja na Shule ya Msingi ya Kakamega ambayo ina idadi kubwa ya madarasa 12 kulingana na uandikishaji,” akaongeza.

“Kila darasa linajengwa kwa gharama ya sare ya Sh1 milioni kote nchini,” aliongeza.

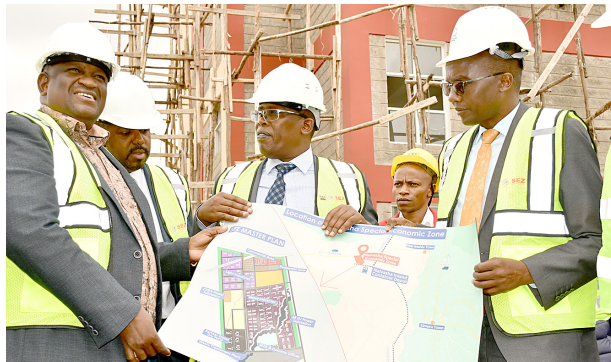
Mwekezaji wa tatu aingia Naivasha SEZ, kuunda nafasi nyingi za kazi

Ukanda Maalum wa Kiuchumi wa Naivasha (SEZ) umepata msukumo baada ya mwekezaji mpya kuhamia huko kuanzisha kampuni ya usindikaji wa viazi.

Kampuni ya Crystal Frozen and Chilled Foods Limited imejitolea kuwekeza Sh645 milioni ili kuanzisha kituo cha kuzalisha viazi vilivyopozwa au vilivyogandishwa (vikate) katika Naivasha SEZ.

Kampuni ya Crystal Frozen and Chilled Foods Limited inalenga kushughulikia suala la muda mrefu la upotevu wa mazao ambalo limeathiri wakulima wa Nakuru na kaunti jirani ya Nyandarua. 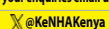

Dkt Misoi aliwataka wakazi kutumia kikamilifu vifaa vilivyowekwa na serikali, haswa zahanati 17 zinazofanya kazi kikamilifu ndani ya kaunti ndogo.

Pia aliwahimiza wanawake wajawazito kuepuka kujifungulia nyumbani na badala yake watembelee hospitali, ambapo wanaweza ku-

pata huduma zote muhimu na kupata huduma za kitaalamu kutoka kwa timu yenye wafanyakazi wa kutosha wa hospitali hiyo. Aidha, Dkt Misoi alitoa changamoto kwa wahudumu wa Hospitali ya Kaunti Ndogo ya Trans Mara Magharibi kujitahidi kufikia ubora katika kutoa huduma bora zaidi kwa wakazi wa Trans Mara.

Alimpongeza Gavana Patrick Ntutu kwa kuboreshwa kwa huduma za afya katika kaunti nzima tangu aingie madarakani. Kabla ya ufungaji wa kiwanda cha oksijeni, hospitali ililazi-

Peter Kilel, mhandisi wa matibabu, alieleza kwamba kiwanda hicho cha oksijeni kinaweza kutoa mitungi 60 kwa saa 24, ambayo ni sawa na silinda moja kila baada ya dakika 40.

Waziri wa Kilimo na Maendeleo ya Mifugo Dkt Andrew Karanja ameahidi kuanzisha mageuzi makubwa katika sekta ya chai ambayo inasaidia maisha ya wakulima 834,129 nchini ambayo katika siku za hivi majuzi imekuwa ikikabiliana na changamoto ya chai isiyozwa iliyohifadhiwa katika ghala za Mombasa.

Hisa ambazo hazijauzwa ambazo awali zilikuwa na kilo milioni 100 sasa zimepunguzwa hadi kilo milioni 70, huku kukiwa na juhudi kubwa za kuziondoa mwishoni mwa Septemba.

Karanja alisema baadhi ya mafanikio katika sekta ya chai yanaweza kuchangiwa na hali nzuri ya hewa na serikali kuingilia kati kupitia mpango wa ruzuku ya mbolea.

Hata hivyo, aliongeza kuwa unywaji wa chai kwa wakati unaathiriwa na mdororo wa kiuchumi unaokabili baadhi ya masoko makubwa na muhimu kama vile Pakistan, Misri na Sudan.



Waziri wa Kilimo Dkt Andrew Karanja akitoa maelezo kwa wanahabari baada ya mkutano wa mashauriano na washikadau wa chai mjini Mombasa.

Karanja alibainisha kuwa kutokana na mpango wa ruzuku ya mbolea, uzalishaji wa chai kwa kipindi cha nusu mwaka wa 2024 ulikuwa kilo milioni 321.09 kutoka kilo milioni 273.64 zilizorekodiwa katika kipindi kama hicho mwaka 2023.

Mwaka huu, Waziri alisema sekta hiyo inatarajia kuvuka uzalishaji wa juu kwa mwaka jana kwa asilimia nane, akiongeza, "Tutakuwa na moja ya uzalishaji wa juu zaidi katika chai. Hilo ni moja ya maswala ambayo yanaleta shida kidogo katika suala

la hisa ". "Inatarajia kuwa kufikia mwisho wa mwaka huu sekta ya chai italeti zaidi ya Sh2 bilioni," Dkt Karanja alisema wakati wa mkutano na wadau wa Chai katika afisi za Jumuiya ya Biashara ya Chai ya Afrika Mashariki (EATTA) mjini Mombasa.

Aidha alibainisha kuwa uchambuzi wa awali unaoonyesha kuwa katika Mwaka wa Fedha (FY) 2023/2024, wastani wa malipo kwa mkulima mdogo wa chai utaozeka hadi Sh66 kwa kilo moja ya majani mabichi kutoka Sh59.02 mwaka

wa 2022/2023 na Sh50.18. katika Mwaka wa Fedha wa 2021/2022.

"Tumegundua kuwa tunayo hisa ya zamani ambayo tunahitaji kusafisha na moja ya vikwazo, ambayo inafanyika ili kuhakikisha kuwa haijandolewa, ni bei ya hifadhi. Tunasimamisha bei hiyo ya akiba ya hisa ya zamani," Dkt. Karanja alitangaza.

Baadaye, kamati itaundwa kuangalia bei ya akiba ili kuhakikisha kwamba haibaki tuli na kuleta matatizo.

Wakati huo huo, ili kukabiliana na changamoto za ubora duni, wizara itakuja na hatua za kuwa na kiwango cha chini cha ubora. Waziri huyo alifichua kuwa nchi hiyo imeanza kuzalisha chai ya asili kwa ajili ya masoko maalumu kama vile Uchina.

"Tutaweka miundo kuhakikisha kuwa chai ya asili inauzwa kwa mnada. Tunaweza kuunda mnada mwingine wa pili wa kuuza chai yetu ya asili," CS alisema.

Karanja alisema baadhi ya vitendo visivyo vya kimaadili vya biashara na ulaghai katika biashara vimebainika, na hivyo basi serikali itaweka mikakati ya kukomesha utovu huo kwa kuwa unaathiri mapato ya wakulima.

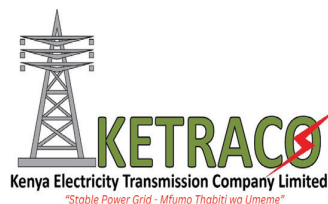

Section 18 of The Primary Health Care Act, 2023 mandates the County executive committee members to establish a Primary Healthcare Network (PCN) in their respective counties at the sub-county level. Each Primary Health Care network will consist of a Level 4 sub-county hospital serving as the hub, with KEPH Levels 3, 2, and 1 acting as spokes. Every Primary Health Care Network is designated to serve a specific population, as determined by the County Primary Health Care Advisory Committee, and each person within the population will be registered within a specific PCN. The primary goal of establishing these networks is to enable the delivery and access to primary healthcare services from the community level to healthcare facilities in a seamless, coordinated manner, thereby promoting efficiency and effectiveness in service delivery.

The Social Health Insurance Act of 2023 establishes a Primary Healthcare (PHC) Fund which is funded by the exchequer. The eligible beneficiaries of the fund are Social Health Authority (SHA) registered members. The PHC Fund shall procure primary healthcare services from the level 2 and 3 hospitals housed under the PCN at the sub-county level. These services include essential outpatient services, screening, inpatient and maternity services. The provider payment mechanism shall vary based on the benefit package approved by the SHA Board.

Msemaji wa Serikali Isaac Mwaura alisema sekta ndogo ya mifugo imepeleka zana za kisasa za udhibiti wa hatari za kilimo, kama vile mipango ya bima ya mazao na mifugo na zana za soko la bidhaa, ili kuhakikisha kuwa kilimo kinaleta faida na mapato katika sekta hiyo yanat-abirika.

“Katika kipindi cha miezi 23, vituo vimezalisha takribani dozi milioni moja za shahawa ya ng’ombe na majani 50,000 ya shahawa, wakati vibali 35 vya kugiza mbegu zilipitishwa, kuruhusu kuingizwa nchini kwa dozi 297,027 za shahawa na viinitete 416,” aliongeza. kwamba mpango huu ulikusudiwa kufanya kilimo kuwa na faida zaidi.

Akizungumza na vyombo vya habari wakati wa mkutano na waandishi wa habari wa kila wiki,



Mwaura pia alitaja kuwa zaidi ya lita 400,000 za nitrojeni kioevu zilizalishwa, na sire 950 zilifanyiwa tathmini, ambapo 638 zilidhinishwa na 312 zilikataliwa kwa kutofuata sheria.

Msemaji huyo aliongeza kuwa serikali imeshirikisha wahudumu wa mifugo 1,128 kutoa usaidizi wa kiufundi kwa wakulima katika ngazi ya kaunti.

Malisho ya mifugo pia yamepewa ruzuku kupitia msamaha wa ushuru na msamaha wa asilimia 16 ya malighafi ya VAT sambamba na usambazaji wa kilo 8,900 za mbegu kwa

ajili ya uzalishaji wa malisho.

Hii, alisema, imesababisha kuimarika kwa bei na upatikanaji wa vyakula vya mifugo na kuimarika kwa upatikanaji wa vyakula vya mifugo zaidi katika maeneo kavu ya ASAL.

“Uendelezaji wa Msururu wa Thamani ya Maziwa uliimarishwa kwa kuchora ramani ya maeneo 265 katika kaunti 34 kwa ajili ya kuweka vipozezi vya maziwa na utoaji wa mbuzi 200 wa maziwa kwa vituo vya kuzidisha. Huku uchoraji wa ramani ukiwa umekamilika, vipoza

maziwa 220 vimeratibiwa kusakinishwa ili kukabiliana na hasara ya baada ya kuvuna katika uzalishaji wa maziwa,” aliongeza.

Sekta ya mifugo pia imeshuhudia kuboreka kwa mnyororo wa thamani wa nyama, ambapo ujenzi wa sehemu mbili za malisho huko Kibiru (Meru) na Hadado (Wajir) ukiwa umekamilika kwa asilimia 80 na 20.

“Hii inakamilishwa na utoaji wa kondoo na mbuzi wa nyama kwa vituo vya kuzidisha na wafugaji wasomi katika maeneo ya mradi wa Kenya Livestock Commercialization Project (KELCOP) kwa ajili ya kuimarisha uzalishaji wa mifugo,” alisema.

Mradi wa KELCOP pia umewezesha kuchimba visima saba na kuviweka na nishati ya jua, pamoja na utoaji wa sufuria za maji katika Kaunti za Siaya na Samburu. Mradi huo pia ulishuhudia visima vilivyochimbwa katika Kaunti za Marsabit, Samburu, Baringo, Siaya na Elgeyo Marakwet.

Wakulima wa miwa wanufaika na ongezeko la bei hadi Sh5,000 kwa tani

Wakulima wa miwa wana sababu ya kutabasamu baada ya serikali kuidhinisha bei iliyorekibishwa ya miwa kwa tani, na kuongeza kutoka Sh4,950 hadi Sh5,000.

Bei hiyo mpya ilianza kutumika tarehe 22 Agosti na inaonyesha hali ya soko iliyopo, ikijumuisha kushuka kwa bei ya sukari, gharama za uzalishaji na mienendo ya biashara ya kimataifa.

Waziri wa Kilimo na Maendeleo ya Mifugo Dkt. Andrew Karanja alitangaza mabadiliko hayo katika taarifa yake kufuatia kikao cha kamati ya bei ya miwa, ambacho kina jukumu la kupanga na kuhakiki bei ya miwa. Kulingana na Waziri, bei hizo mpya zitaongeza zaidi mapato ya wakulima.

Kituo hicho, kitachounganishwa na vituo vya utafutaji na uokoaji huko Busia, Migori, Siaya na Homabay, pia kitafanya kazi na MRCC nyingine katika eneo hilo kwa ajili ya kupunguzwa kazi na shughuli za ziada. Akizungumza katika gati ya Kisumu alipotembelea eneo la mradi

huo, Joho, ambaye alianadamana na Katibu Mkuu wa Masuala ya Bahari (PS) Geoffrey Kaituko alisema serikali imejitolea kuharakisha mradi huo ili kuhakikisha usalama wa wavuvi na wasafiri katika ziwa hilo. PS alisema kituo hicho kitarabitibu shughuli za uokoaji ziwani kwa kushirikiana na Uganda na Tanzania huku serikali ikielekea kufua usafiri unaounganisha nchi hizo tatu kupitia ziwa hilo.

Aliongeza kuwa pamoja na hatua za kuimarisha usalama katika ziwa hilo, serikali inalenga kuongeza unyonyaji wa shughuli za uchumi wa bluu katika ziwa ili kutoa ajira kwa vijana na kukuza biashara kati ya kaunti na baina ya nchi. Kaituko alisema serikali itashirikiana na vyama vya ushirika vya wavuvi ili kuwajengea uwezo wavuvi kupata boti za nyuzinyuzi ambazo ni salama zaidi. Katibu alisema zaidi kwamba KPA imetoa ardhi kwa KMA kwa mradi huo na kununua ardhi ya ziada, ambayo, alibaini kuwa ingebadilisha usafiri na uendeshaji katika ziwa.

Wizara ya Afya inawataka Wakenya wanaopata homa, vipele vya ngozi, vidonda vya utando wa mapua, kuumwa na kichwa, maumivu ya misuli, maumivu ya mgongo, uchovu, uvimbe wa nodi za limfu, au ambao wana historia ya kusafiri kwenda nchi kuripoti visa vya Mpox au kuguswa na kisa kinachoshukiwa, kuripoti kwenye vituo vya afya kwa uchunguzi wa ugonjwa huu wa kuambukiza.

Akizungumza katika Maabara ya Kitaifa ya Afya ya Umma jijini Nairobi, Katibu wa Baraza la Mawaziri wa Afya Dkt. Deborah Mlongo Barasa alisema kuwa Mpox ina muda wa incubation kuanzia siku tano hadi kumi na nne, ingawa inaweza kutofautiana kutoka siku moja hadi 21 kutoka kwa maambukizi hadi kuonekana kwa dalili.

Aliwataka Wakenya kuwa waangalifu na kuripoti kesi zote zinazoshukiwa kwa wizara mara moja.

Dk. Barasa alibainisha kuwa dalili kwa kawaida hudumu kutoka wiki mbili hadi nne na kusisitiza kuwa magonjwa mengine, kama vile kipele na tetekuwanga, yanaweza kujitokeza sawa na Mpox.

Aliwashauri watu wanaoonyesha dalili za ugonjwa huo kutembelea kituo cha afya mara moja

kwa ajili ya tathmini na usimamizi sahihi. “Kwa ushirikiano na wizara nyingine, serikali za kaunti, na washirika, wizara imetekeleza hatua kadhaa za kuwalinda Wakenya kutokana na mkurupuko huu,” Dkt. Barasa aliongeza.

“Hasa, tumeanzisha Kituo cha Uendeshaji wa Dharura ya Afya ya Umma na Mfumo wa Usimamizi wa Matukio wa Mpox ambao unasimamia uratibu na juhudi za kukabiliana nchini. Vile vile, Timu za Kitaifa za Kukabiliana na Haraka zimetumwa kutoa usaidizi wa kiufundi kwa kaunti ambazo zimeripoti visa vinavyoshukiwa,” Dkt Barasa akabainisha. Waziri huyo alisema kaunti vile vile zimeanzisha mbinu za kukabiliana na dharura, huku Vituo 25 vya Uendeshaji wa Dharura Kaunti (EOC’s) vinavyofa-

nya kazi kwa sasa na vinautoa juhudi zilizoratibiwa.

Aliagiza kaunti zote kuanzisha Timu zao za Majibu ya Haraka (RRTs), muhimu katika uchunguzi wa kesi na ufuatiliaji wa anwani.

Waziri huyo alisema pia kwamba uchunguzi umeimarishwa kote nchini na maeneo ya kuingia. Aliongeza kuwa wasafiri 300,000 wamepimwa Mpox, na kuongeza kuwa bidii ya timu za ufuatiliaji za Wizara imehakikisha kuwa kesi moja na iliyo-thibitishwa iligunduliwa mapema na mawasiliano ya mgonjwa yalifuatiliwa na hakuna aliyepata ugonjwa huo.

Zaidi ya hayo, Waziri alisema, Wizara ya Afya imefuata na kupima kesi 29 zinazoshukiwa, ambazo zote zimethibitishwa kuwa si ugonjwa huo.
