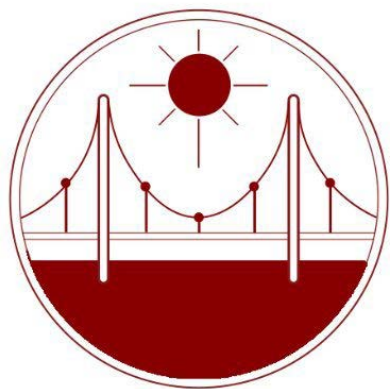

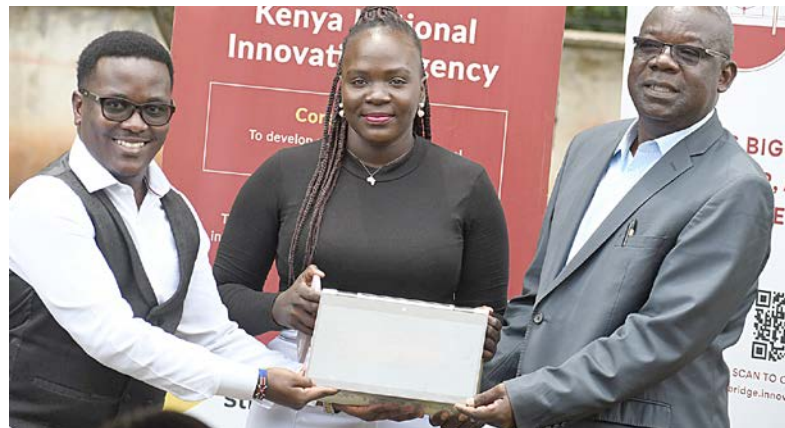
Afisa Mkuu wa KeNIA Dkt. Tonny Omwansa, alisema katika hotuba iliyosomwa kwa niaba yake na Bw George Masil kwamba uunganishaji kupitia nafasi za uwekezaji, ushirikiano na ujenzi wa uwezo utaharakisha mchakato wa vijana kufanyia biashara talanta zao.

“Jukwaa la KIB linalenga kujaza pengo la ujuzi miongoni mwa wavumbuzi kupitia ujenzi wa uwezo ambao utatolewa na vituo, vyo viku na wadau wengine,” alisema Omwansa.

Wakati huo huo, alisisitiza kuwa KIB itamaliza pengo la ujumuishi kwa kuhakikisha kwamba wavumbuzi kote nchini watapata fedha, ushirikiano na wateja wa ubunifu wao.

“Tulianzisha jukwaa hili kutatua shida za watu ambao hawana washirika wanaoweza kupata soko la dijitali kuungana na washirika kadhaa kama vile serikali za kaunti,” alisema Omwansa.

Vile vile, alifichua mpango wa Shirika hilo wa kuboresha vi-

tuo vyote 260 vya kuwezesha vijana (YECs) kote nchini kuwa Vituo vya Ubunifu. Shirika hilo, kwa ushirikiano na wadau wengine litaanzisha mipango na shughuli za kujenga uwezo katika vituo hivyo ili kuvutia vijana.

“KeNIA kwa ushirikiano na Wizara ya Masuala ya Vijana, Sanaa na Michezo inataka kuhakikisha wavumbuzi kutoka maeneo yote nchini wanafahamika kupitia jukwaa hili,” alikiongeza. Mchakato huo ulian-

zishwa mwaka wa 2020 na katika hatua za mwanzo, ulivutia washiriki kutoka kaunti 20.

Shirika hilo limejitolea kupanua matumizi ya KIB kote nchini na ni kwa muktadha huu ambapo timu ilifanya uzinduzi Nakuru kwa eneo la

Rift Valley na Kisumu kwa maeneo ya Ziwa na Magharibi.

Watakuwa wakielekeza Mom-basa kwa uzinduzi wa eneo la Pwani na kumalizia Nairobi wiki zijazo.

Kiwango cha jumula cha uafikiaji kilikuwa asilimia 41.7, kikiwa kimeimarika kwa asilimia 1.7 kutoka mwaka wa kifedha uliotangulia, kumaanisha kwamba utumishi wa umma umeendelea kuimarika katika kunyoo-sha maadili na kanuni katika utoaji wa huduma.

Matokeo yanaonyesha kuwa ingawa utumishi wa umma unatoa huduma kwa raia katika maeneo mengi, kuna haja ya kuzingatiwa kikamilifu maadili na kanuni za kitaifa

za utawala katika Ibara 10; na maadili na kanuni za utumishi wa umma katika Ibara 232.

Mnamo Desemba 31 2022, PSC iliwasilisha ripoti kwa Rais na Bunge inavyohitajika kisheria.

Vile vile, Tume ilitoa ripoti ya utafiti huo kupitia semina kwa njia ya video kwa wakuu wa wafanyakazi wa taasisi zilizotathminiwa katika sekta sita za utoaji wa huduma.

Sekta hizo ni pamoja na Tume za Kikatiba na Afisi Huru (CCIOs), Wizara na Idara za Serikali (MDAs), Vyuo Vikuu vya Umma, Mashirika ya Serikali na Mashirika mengine ya serikali yaliyo na kiwango fulani cha uhuru, Tume za Kisheria na Mamlaka na Taasisi za Kiufundi na Mafunzo Anuai (TVETs).

Katika semina hizo, Mwenyekiti wa Tume ya Utumishi wa Umma, Balozi Anthony Muchiri alihimiza taasisi hizo kuhakikisha zimefuata maadili na kanuni za utumishi wa umma inavyoeleza Katiba.

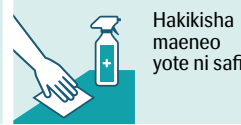
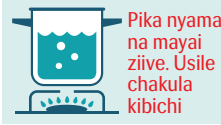

# Afueni kwa wakazi wa Maralal huku Bwawa la Yamo likikamilika

NA ERICK KYALO(KNA)

Familia 64,000 katika mji wa Maralal kaunti ya Samburu na vitongoji vyake hivi karibuni watapata maji safi na salama huku bwawa la Yamo lilikamilika.

Awamu ya kwanza ya Bwawa la Yamo, lililo na uwezo wa kuhifadhi lita 12 milioni za maji imekamilika na bwawa hilo linaweza kujaa katika misimu miwili ya mvua ya kawaida inayonyesha katika kaunti hiyo kila mwaka.

Mradi huo, unaotekelezwa na Shirika la Maendeleo ya Maji la Kaskazini kwa gharama ya Sh1.4 bilioni unatarajiwa kuhudumia maji huo kwa wakati huu hadi mwaka wa 2038 ambapo wataalamu wanasema vyanzo vipya vya maji vitatambuliwa.

Akizungumza wakati wa ziara katika mradi huo, Katibu wa Maji na Unyunyuzaji Dkt Kiprono Rono alisema bwawa hilo linaweza kutoa lita 6 milioni kwa siku am-

bayo yanakidhi mahitaji ya wakazi wa mji wa Maralal.

“Kazi ya ujenzi wa awamu ya kwanza ya bwawa imekamilika na awamu ya pili itahusu ujenzi wa kiwanda cha kuwekea maji dawa kitakachohitaji Sh1.5 bilioni ambazo serikali itatenga kati baajeti ijayo ili mradi huu uweze kukamilika,” alisema Kiprono.

“Pamoja na serikali ya kaunti, pia tutatambua miradi mingine ya maji katika kaunti na kupatia kipaumbele ili itengewe pesa katika bajeti miaka ijayo,” akiongeza.

Katibu huyo alihakikishia nchi kwamba serikali imeweka mipango ya kuhifadhi maji kwa kujenga mabwawa makubwa 100,

kujenga mabwawa madogo na kuchimba visima nchini.

“Kutoka kwa idara ya utabiri wa hewa, kuna ishara kwamba mvua hii haitanyesha kwa muda mrefu, na kama serikali, tumeweka hatua za kuhakikisha tumehifadhi maji kwa matumizi hasa msimu wa kiangazi,” alisema katibu.

Gavana wa Samburu Jonathan Leleliit kwa upande wake alisema changamoto kuu ya kupata maji safi ya kunywa ni kupata chanzo cha maji safi ambayo inaweza kupelekwa kwa mifereji kwa wakazi.

“Tunashukuru serikali kwa kuchagua kufanyia maadhimisho ya siku ya maji ulimwenguni hapa. Kumekuwa na changamoto za maji katika kaunti hii na tunatarajia kwamba siku hii italetika siku njema zijazo kwa watu wa Samburu kupata maji safi,” alisema Leleliit.

Mbunge wa Samburu Magharibi Naisula Lesuuda alifichua kuwa chini ya asilimia tano ya wakazi wa kaunti ya Samburu wana maji safi na salama na kwamba mengi yanapaswa kufanywa kumimarisha hali.

Lesuuda aliomba wizara ya maji kutumia muundo wa kuunganisha stima kuhakikisha kila boma limeunganishwa maji.

# Homa Bay, NGO zatia mkataba kujenga chuo cha michezo

Homa Bay hivi karibuni itakuwa mwenyeji wa soka baada ya Serikali ya Kaunti kutia saini na Shirika lisilo la kiserikali (NGO) Acakoro Football Academy kuanzisha chuo cha kukuza michezo eneo hilo.

Ushirikiano huu utafanikisha ujenzi wa chuo cha kisasa cha michezo na taasisi katika wadi ya Kanyamwa-Kosewe, kaunti ndogo ya Ndihiwa itakayonufaisha watoto wenye umri wa chini ya miaka 14. Chuo hicho cha kwanza kitajengwa katika ardhi ya ekari 20 iliyotolewa na serikali ya kaunti na kufadhiliwa na shirika hilo lisilo la kiserikali kwa gharama ya dola za Amerika 3.5 milioni.

Akizungumza baada ya kutia saini Mkataba wa Maelewano (MOU) na Meneja Mkuu wa Acakoro Bw. Lucas Mott, Gavana Gladys Wanga alisema kwamba mkataba huo unaeleza ushirikiano wa muda mrefu wa kukuza

vipawa vya eneo hilo. “Mradi huu utafungua Homa Bay kwa nafasi za kuandaa hafla kubwa za michezo. Tuko na furaha miongoni mwa kaunti 47, Acakoro, kwa usaidizi wa watu wa Austria imechagua Homa Bay kuanzisha chuo hiki,” alisema Wanga.

Acakoro iliyoanzishwa 2013 kupitia ushirikiano wa Kenyan na Austria, Acakoro imekuwa chuo kikuu cha soka Kenya kinachotoa elimu bora pamoja na shughuli za michezo.

Kitakapoanzishwa, chuo hicho, kitatoa mafunzo ya michezo na elimu kwa watoto hadi Chuo Kikuu.

“Ushirikiano huu ni wa kipekee kwa kuwa Acakoro haitajenga chuo pekee lakini pia taasisi ya masomo kusaidia watoto kusoma na pia kushiriki michezo,” alisema Wanga. Katika kituo cha mafunzo, chuo hicho kitakuwa na viwanja viwili vya soka katika awamu yake ya kwanza.

The exercise is aimed at ensuring the integrity of the taxpayers' register with a view to enhance service delivery to all taxpayers.

All registered taxpayers are urged to update/correct their registration details as appropriate, on iTax, including their name, phone number, physical address, email address, physical location of businesses, residency status, directorships or partnerships held e.t.c.

Taxpayers are guided to log onto itax.kra.go.ke to access their profile and follow these simple steps to update the registration details as appropriate -

1. Under the registration menu, select the option “Amend PIN details”;
2. Set the “Mode of Amendment” to Online and click the next button;
3. Check the box marked “PIN” and then select the sections you would like to update; and
4. Update the details as appropriate, attach supporting documentation where necessary and submit.

# Public participation is key to enhancing service delivery – PS

Devolution Principal Secretary Ms Teresia Mbaika has expressed the State Department's commitment to a people-driven and deliberately inclusive participatory process where citizen participation is at the core of policy and strategy development, selection and implementation of projects and programs.

Speaking during a Familiarization Retreat for Agencies and Departments under the purview of the National

Assembly Departmental Committee on Regional Development in Naivasha, Ms Mbaika noted that the meaningful participation of the people in decision making processes at both levels of government has gone a long way in enhancing service delivery to the citizens in the country.

The PS noted that Kenya's "Constitutional dispensation places sacred premium to public participation, consultation and cooperation", add-

ing that "the Devolved System of Government is anchored on this principle of consultation, cooperation and co-ordination".

Ms Mbaika reiterated that the State Department has been in the forefront in providing the necessary policy and administrative environment for Devolution to flourish in the country.

She also emphasized that devolution is working for Kenyans despite serious challenges that have been ex-

perienced and documented "including attempts at clawing back to centralization and re-centralizing at county headquarters.

The PS, however, stated that the State Department is alive to such challenges and has put in place various mitigation measures adding that it shall continue to "provide policy leadership, facilitation and coordination through continuous and sustained stakeholder consultation, collaboration and cooperation".

# State to set up drought tolerant cashew nut in ASALs

Crops Development Principal Secretary Kello Harsama has directed the Kenya Agricultural and Livestock Organization (KALRO) to establish cashew nut nurseries in Arid and Semi-Arid Land (ASAL) counties for economic diversification.

Harsama launched four new varieties of cashew nuts that are drought and disease resistant, and only take one and half years to mature as opposed to the traditional varieties that take five years.

The new varieties expected to increase farmers' earnings due to their short maturity have been named Kkorosh75, Kkorosh81, Kkorosh82, and Kkorosh100.

The PS termed the development of the varieties “a big breakthrough in the agriculture sector” since farmers plant, harvest, and sell within a short duration.

The PS encouraged farmers and leaders from ASAL counties to grow cashew nuts as an alternative source of income.

“I have directed KALRO to start nurseries in other parts of Kenya where there is drought in Marsabit, Wajir, Isiolo, Samburu, Turkana, Elgeyo Marakwet, and Baringo. I will solicit funds for KALRO to set up nurseries in the ASAL counties so that people in those areas can start benefiting from cashew nuts because the market is available abroad and in Kenya,” Harsama said.

“It is a good opportunity for Kenyans who want to cultivate in arid areas. This crop does not require a lot of rain, and it is drought tolerant. People should take advantage and plant it in abundance to get profit,” he added.

Kama sehemu ya mpango wa Mkurugenzi Mkuu, wito spesheli unatolewa na WHO na wadau wengine kuhimiza nchi wanachama kuanzisha matibabu ya muda mfupi ya TB. Kifua Kikuu kisichotibika na dawa kinaendelea kuwa wasiwasi wa afya ya umma na watu wanaoathiriwa na TB, jamii na mifumo ya afya kote ulimwenguni. Mwaka wa 2021, kukiwa na karibu watu milioni moja waliouga TB isiyoponywa na dawa mbali mbali au TB isiyotibiwa na rifampicin (MDR/RR-TB), na ni mmoja kati ya watu watatu aliyepata matibabu.

### Familia 1,853 Makueni kupokea chakula cha msaada kutoka kwa serikali

Familia 1,853 kutoka wadi nne kaunti ya Makueni zitanu-faika na aina tofauti za chakula kilichotolewa na serikali ya kitaifa kupitia kamati ya kitaifa ya kushughulikia ukame (NSCODR).

Wanaonufaika wanatoka wadi za Kimakiu/Kalanzoni, Kilome Kasikeu kaunti ndogo ya Mukaa na Kee kaunti ndogo ya Makueni ambazo zimeathiriwa vibaya na ukame wa muda mrefu unaofanya mimea kufeli kwa misimu mitano.

Katibu wa Idara ya Serikali ya Ugatuzi Teresia Mbaika ambaye alizindua usambazaji wa chakula kwa familia zinazoathiriwa na njaa katika kaunti hiyo alisema kwamba "hii ni mwanzo wa juhudi za serikali ya kitaifa kukinga familia zinazoathiriwa na ukame kote nchini," alisema akiaga chakula cha msaada ambacho kitasambazwa Makueni katika makao makuu ya kaunti ndogo ya Mukaa. Alifichua kwamba watakuonufaika kutoka wadi za Kimakiu/Kalanzoni ni 500, na kila mmoja atapokea kilo 6 za unga, kilo nane za mchele, mafuta lita moja, kilo tatu za unga wa uji na kilo tatu za ndengu na inatarajiwa kitasaidia kwa wiki tatu zijazo.

Vile vile, Katibu alisema kwamba Jumua ya Sh Sh 800 milioni zimetumiwa kuhakikisha usambazaji wa chakula cha msaada katika kaunti tisa zinazoorodheshwa kuathiriwa vibaya zaidi na ukame nchini. Pesa hizi zinakusanywa chini ya kauli mbiu ya "Wakenya Tulindane" na wengi wametoa michango yao ikiwemo Safaricom, Family, Equity, Kenya Commercial Banks miongoni mwa zingine.

Kamati ya Kitaifa ya kushughulikia Ukame (NSCODR) inasimamiwa na Afisa Mkuu Mtendaji wa Safaricom Peter Ndegwa na wanachama wake ni serikali na mashirika mengine. Katika maeneo haya mifugo imekufa ingawa idadi yake haikutajwa na watoto kupata utapia mlo na kuacha shule. Katika hafla hiyo, Katibu alisema serikali itakarabati visima katika maeneo yaliyoathiriwa ili kupata maji ya matumizi ya nyumbani na kunywesha wanyama. Wakati huo huo, Mbaika alisema kwamba serikali inachimbua mabwawa katika mbuga za kitaifa kuzuia wanyama kufa kwa kuwa wanachangia pakubwa katika ukuaji wa uchumi.

### Kaunti ya Taita Taveta yafufua mpango wa lishe chekechea

Wanafunzi 12,000 wa chekechea katika kaunti ya Taita Taveta watanufaika na mpango wa lishe shuleni baada ya serikali ya kaunti kuzindua mpango utakaowezesha watoto kubaki darasani huku uhaba wa chakula ukien- delea katika baadhi ya sehemu za nchi.

22 za unga wa uji na sukari kupeleka kwa shule 317 za chekechea.

Malori yaliyoagwa kutoka makao makuu ya kaunti Mwataate yalikuwa na tani kumi na sita za unga wa uji na tani sita za sukari kusaidia wanafunzi zaidi ya 12,000 wa ECDE. "Tunaaga shehena hizi kwa matumaini kwamba itaweka watoto wetu madarasani na kuwa afueni kwa wazazi nyumbani ambao wanang'ang'ana kulisha watoto wao," Gavana Mwandime alisema.

Upepo mkali, jua kali na anga kavu ndio hali ya hewa katika kaunti ya Taita Taveta kwa misimu sita na hali hiyo inaendelea. Kutokana na moja ya ukame mbaya nchini Kenya, wakazi wa kaunti hiyo wanaotegemea kilimo cha mvua, wameshuhudia kufeli kwa

mimea na kusababisha njaa. "Ingawa ukame na njaa zinakumba matabaka yote na watu wa kila umri, ni watoto na wanafunzi wa chekechea wanaotumia zaidi. Tumeshuhudia wengi wakikosa kuhudhuria masomo miongoni mwa wale wa chekechea na tunaamini mpango huu utawafanya warudi shuleni," alisema Gloria Monikombo, Waziri wa Elimu wa Kaunti hiyo.

Kulingana na takwimu za Mamlaka ya Taifa ya Kushughulikia Ukame mnamo Januari mwaka huu, watu zaidi ya 150,000 katika kaunti hiyo wanakabiliwa na njaa huku 17,000 miongoni mwa wakiwa watoto. Kulingana na mtaalamu wa lishe katika kaunti hiyo Pauline Mugo kumekuwa na ongezeko la visa vya utapia mlo huku zaidi ya asilimia 23 ya watoto walio na umri wa chini ya miaka mitano wakikumbwa na hatari ya kudumaa.

na watu faraghani kwa sababu lazima uwe na mka-

limani. "Sababu nyingine ni kwamba ni vigumu kupata huduma za serikali na katika maeneo mengine kama maduka makuu, benki na vituo vya afya kwa sababu nyingi ya taasisi hizi na mashirika hapa hazina wakalimani wa lugha ya ishara," alifichua. Airimu alisema kwamba kushirikiana na KNLS kumewanufaisha kwa sababu wanapata intaneti bila malipo kufanya utafiti, masomo ya kompyuta ambapo viziwi wanaweza kwenda kusoma. Mpangilio huo pia unawezesha wasomaji kutembelea maktaba na kupata fursa ya kufahamu kuhusu mpango huo. Ili kushukuru, walitoa mafunzo ya wiki moja bila malipo kwa wafan-

yakazi waKNLS ya lugha ya ishara Kenya. Alieleza kuwa mafunzo hayo ni ya kila mtu anayetaka hasa ya kimsingi, lakini kwa kiwango cha juu, wanapendelea walio na cheti cha mthani wa kidato cha nne. "Katika siku za hivi majuzi, tumeona kwamba watu wengi wa wale wanaopenda hasa ni wanawake vijana kwa jinsia na pia umri. Mafunzo hayo ni ya muda na zaidi yanatolewa moja kwa moja mara tatu kwa wiki huku kila somo likichukua masaa mawili kuanzia saa kumi hadi saa kumi na mbili au kutoka saa nne asubuhi hadi saa sita adhuhuri," alisema Wairimu.
