penalties. People are losing lives, and disciplinary action alone is insufficient," he added.

Ogamba spoke after visiting Hillside Academy in Enderasha, where a tragedy claimed the lives of 21 pupils and left several others injured.

The CS said ongoing investigations by the Directorate of Criminal Investigations will establish whether the school complied with the ministry's recommended safety regulations.

He also stated that

the Education Ministry would conduct an internal self-audit to identify any policy gaps.

The CS's remarks come a day after Deputy President Rigathi Gachagua urged County and Sub-County Directors of Education to continuously inspect all public and private schools to safeguard the security of learners.

The DP called on Kenyans to remain patient as investigators continue to probe the incident, adding that the findings will guide the government's next course of action.

"The issue of safety in schools remains a highly emotive matter. It is a wake-up call for education officers, whose responsibility is to ensure the safety of children in these institutions through regular inspections," said Deputy President Gachagua.

"Once the report is finalized, it will inform our next steps," he added.

Speaking during a stakeholder validation webinar on the regulations, Amb. Muchiri explained that Parliament empowered the Public Service Commission to develop affirmative action regulations.

He further clarified that Section 48 of the Public Service Commission Act, 2017, mandates the Commission to establish regulations promoting inclusiveness for gender, Kenya's diverse communities, persons with disabilities, and the youth.

"The Commission has therefore developed these regulations to promote a public service culture that supports and values diversity and the inclusion of special interest groups. These regulations aim to attract, retain, and advance persons from special interest groups in public service, accelerate the representation of these groups as mandated by the Constitution, eliminate unfair discrimination, and promote equal opportunity and fair treatment in public ser-

vice employment," Amb. Muchiri elaborated.

He reassured stakeholders that the regulations would not compromise merit and fair competition in favor of inclusion, emphasizing that affirmative action does not involve appointing unqualified individuals but aims to balance merit with inclusion.

"The appointed individual must meet the minimum requirements for the job. For instance, one cannot be appointed as a doctor or an architect on affirmative action grounds unless they are already qualified for those

positions," Amb. Muchiri insisted. He added that discretion would only be applied in terms of interview scores.

Amb. Muchiri also clarified that communities already overrepresented in government organizations would not face dismissals under these regulations.

"The draft regulations merely require institutions to review their diversity and inclusion status and halt appointments from overrepresented communities. This will create opportunities for underrepresented or unrepresented groups,"

he explained.

While acknowledging the progress made toward ensuring diversity, inclusion, and promoting the principle of equality and non-discrimination in public service, Amb. Muchiri emphasized that more work remains.

"Some of you may know that until 1989, women in public service were employed on contract terms, while men served on permanent and pensionable terms. Today, both men and women enjoy equal employment terms, whether permanent or contract-based," he noted.

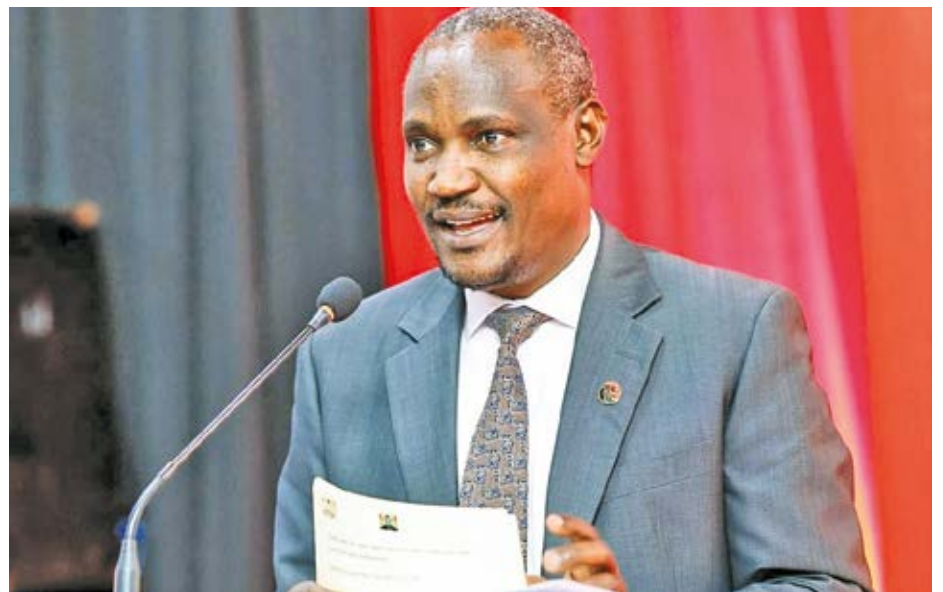

PRESIDENT RUTO'S BETA ACHIEVEMENTS AFTER TWO YEARS IN OFFICE



When the Kenya Kwanza Government took office in 2022, President Ruto pledged transformative leadership through the Bottom-Up Economic Transformation Agenda (BETA). This agenda focuses on five key areas: Agriculture, Health, Housing, MSME Economy, and the Digital Superhighway and Creative Economy. The Plan's vision is to improve the lives of economically marginalized Kenyans and address long-standing economic exclusion. The following is a summary of the government's achievements in these five areas.

AGRICULTURE

Recognizing that food constitutes 54% of household expenditures in Kenya, the Government prioritized reducing the cost of living through agricultural reforms. The focus shifted from subsidizing consumption to subsidizing production and enhancing agricultural productivity.

STRATEGIES

- Reduction in the cost of farm inputs
- Increasing farmers' incomes
- Creating more agricultural sector jobs
- Improving agricultural productivity and value addition

ACHIEVEMENTS

Fertilizer Subsidy Program

The Fertilizer Subsidy Program involved digital registration of all farmers and subsequently making low cost fertilizer available to them to enhance food production, thereby reducing food costs to the consumer and also creating job opportunities in the agricultural sector.

Improvement of Key Agricultural Value Chains

Tea

- **Removal of VAT:** The Government has removed VAT on tea purchased from local factories for value addition.
- **SME Support:** The Government has supported MSMEs by providing equipment for specialty tea production. These efforts have increased smallholder farmer earnings by 11.8%, from KSH 59.02 shillings in 2022 to KSH 66 shillings in 2024.

Edible Oils

The Government has distributed 556 metric tonnes of sunflower seeds to 34 counties, with further investment in seed multiplication and coconut cultivation. This has resulted in an 8.3% increase in the acreage under sunflower farming, from 60,000 acres in 2022 to 64,980 acres in 2024.



Leather

Initiatives undertaken by the Government to revitalize the leather industry include;

- Operationalizing the Kariokor Common Manufacturing Facility.
- Completing the Central Effluent Treatment Plants at Kenanie Industrial Leather Park, and providing training and tools to flayers.
- Livestock insurance coverage has expanded by 65.5% from 304,211 in 2022 to 503,469 in 2024.

These, among other initiatives, have led to a 30% increase in the utilization of processing capacity for skins, from 40% in 2022 to 70% in 2024.

Dairy

The Government has raised the guaranteed minimum price for milk from KSH37 in 2022 to KSH 50 per liter in 2024 (New KCC), representing a 35% increase. As a result, milk production has grown by 13%, from 4.6 billion liters in 2022 to 5.2 billion liters in 2024.

Rice

Paddy rice production has grown by 19%, rising from 192,299 metric tonnes in 2023 to 229,064 metric tonnes in 2024. This increase has also

The subsidy program has lowered flour shelf costs by an average of KSH 39.5, with the price of a 2kg packet of maize flour falling from an average of Ksh. 169.9 in 2022 to KSH 130.38 in 2024, representing a 23.3% reduction. The average wholesale price of maize per bag also dropped from KSH 4,729 to KSH 3,980, representing a 15.8% reduction.

resulted in a 19% boost in milled rice production, which climbed from 124,994 metric tonnes to 148,892 metric tonnes during the same period.

These targeted interventions in key agricultural value chains have notably increased productivity, reduced costs, and boosted farmers' earnings.

MSME ECONOMY



The MSME sector employs about 85% of Kenya's workforce, hence the focus the Kenya Kwanza Government has placed on supporting and enhancing the sector's ability to contribute towards the economic transformation of Kenya through the Bottom-Up Economic Transformation Agenda (BETA). It aspires to transform the MSME economy to absorb the youth joining the workforce every year and grow the operational surplus for workers.

STRATEGIES

To achieve this goal, the government committed to ending criminalization of work, provide access to finance, and enhance infrastructure and capacity building. The above was to be achieved by refurbishment and equipping of common user facilities to promote value chains and rollout of the Hustler Fund among other measures.

ACHIEVEMENTS

Refurbishment and Equipping of CIDCs That Provide Spaces for MSMEs

21 County Industrial Development Centers (CIDCs) set up and refurbished between 2022 and 2024.

These include;

- Leather Value Chains in Suneka, Isiolo South, Malindi, Runyenjes, and Banisa.
- Textile Value Chains in Mwea, Kitale, Olkaleu, and Embakasi North.
- Construction and Building Value Chains Machakos Town, Kajiado Central, Ilasit, Iten and Aldai-Kabujoji
- Dairy Value Chains in Kangema, Othaya and Londiani.
- Edible Oils Value Chains in Funyula, Marimati, Kianyaga and Chonyi.

Construction of County Aggregation Industrial Parks (CAIPS)

In 2022, the Government commenced and is in the process of constructing 19 County Aggregation Industrial Parks countrywide.

Financial Inclusion

- **Launch of Hustler Fund:** In 2022, the Government launched the Hustler Fund to provide affordable credit to Kenyans, especially those at the lower end of the economic pyramid in Kenya.
- **Individual Loans:** 21.87 million individuals have benefitted from the fund which has disbursed KSH 54.9 billion in addition to helping individual borrowers to save KSH 3.1 billion.
- **Loans to MSMEs and Groups:** 673,340 groups have so far subscribed and benefited from the fund which has disbursed KSH 185.8 million.

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AFFORDABLE HOUSING



Article 43(b) of the constitution of Kenya 2010 accords every Kenyan the right to “accessible and adequate housing”. The Government committed to construction of 200,000 affordable housing units annually and in the process, creating quality jobs for the youth.

STRATEGIES

- Increase the supply of new affordable houses to 200,000 per year especially for those at the lower end of the economic pyramid.
- Grow mortgages from 30,000 to 1,000,000 through mortgage refinancing.
- Provide high quality construction production to be achieved by strengthening Jua Kali industry’s capacity.
- Give developers tax and other incentives to build more affordable houses

ACHIEVEMENTS

The government provided the following incentives for Affordable Housing Developers:

- Reduced Railway Development Levy from 2% in 2022 to 1.5% in 2024.
- A 15% drop in corporate tax from 30% in 2022 to 15% in 2024 for those developers who construct 100 affordable houses per year.
- A 1.5% drop in Import Declaration Fees (IDC) from 3.5% in 2022 to 2% in 2024.

UNIVERSAL HEALTH COVERAGE

The right to health is a fundamental human right guaranteed in the Constitution of Kenya 2010. Article 43 (1) (a) of the Constitution provides that ‘Every person has the right to the highest attainable standard of health, which includes the right to health care services, including reproductive health care’.

In fulfilment of this constitutional mandate; the Kenya Kwanza Government aspires to provide 100% Universal Healthcare for essential health services, thereby guaranteeing quality and affordable healthcare to all Kenyans.

STRATEGIES

Waziri wa Vyama vya Ushirika na Maendeleo ya MSME Wycliffe Oparanya alifichua kwamba kwa sasa Wakenya milioni 15 wameajiriwa katika sekta ya MSME, na serikali inapanga kuongeza idadi hii hadi milioni 20 katika miaka mitatu ijayo. “Serikali inaajiri watumishi wa umma wapatao milioni moja, na makampuni makubwa nchini yanaweza kuajiri watu milioni mbili pekee. Dau letu bora zaidi la uundaji wa nafasi za ajira ni katika Mashirika ya Umma na MME, ambapo Wakenya milioni 15 wameajiriwa kwa sasa. Rais aliniagiza kuhakikisha kuwa Wakenya milioni tano zaidi wanaajiriwa kupitia sekta hii katika miaka mitatu ijayo,” Oparanya alisema. Waziri huyo, akizungumza huko Bondo alipokuwa akikabidhi hundi ya Uwezo Fund ya Sh32 milioni kwa vikundi katika Kaunti ya Siaya, alisema kuwa fedha za serikali kama vile Uwezo, Women Enterprise, Youth, na Hustler Funds zinalenga kubuni nafasi za kazi katika sekta ya MSME,

kuchangia lengo la jumla la watu milioni 20 walioajiriwa katika sekta hii. Oparanya alihimiza vikundi vya wafanyabiashara ambavyo vimefaidika na ufadhili wa serikali kuunda vyama vya ushirika ili wanufaike na mikopo mikubwa ya upanuzi kutoka kwa Majengo ya Viwanda ya Kenya (KIE). “Maswali mengi yameulizwa kuhusu vikundi ambavyo vimefikia kikomo cha Uwezo Fund cha Sh500,000. Ninataka kuwahimiza kuunda kampuni ambazo zinaweza kukopa kati ya shilingi milioni moja na ishirini kutoka KIE,” Oparanya alieleza. Waziri huyo aliongeza kuwa mashirika ya biashara ambayo yanafanikiwa kulipa mikopo ya KIE na yanahitaji fedha zaidi kwa ajili ya upanuzi yanaweza kupata mikopo ya juu ya hadi Sh500 milioni kutoka kwa Ushirikiano wa Maendeleo ya Kenya (KDC) chini ya wizara ya biashara. “Sitaki kuona watu wakizembea wakisema hawana kazi bado kuna fedha nyingi za serikali ambazo zinaweza kutumika kuchechea maendeleo ya kiuchumi na kuunda fursa za kujikimu kimaisha. “Mfaidika wa fedha za serikali hubuni nafasi za ajira anapoajiri watu ku-

saidia katika biashara na pia wafanyikazi wa nyumbani kutunza nyumba zao wanapokuwa kazini,” Waziri alisema. Oparanya katika maelezo hayo aliwahimiza wabunge ambao bado hawajaunda kamati za Uwezo Fund kufanya hivyo mara moja kwa manufaa ya wapiga kura wao akisema takriban majimbo 15 bado hawajaunda kamati hizo kufanya hivyo kwa maendeleo zaidi katika maeneo yao. Katibu wa Vyama vya Ushirika Bi Susan Mang’eni, ambaye aliandamana na Bw Oparanya, kwa upande wake alihimiza urejeshaji wa pesa za serikali kwa wakati na vikundi vya wafanyabiashara ili kuboresha alama za mkopo za wanachama. Mang’eni alisema kwa sasa serikali inafanya usajili wa vikundi vyote vya wafanyabiashara katika mfumo wa kidijitali ambapo itawezekana kufuatilia utendaji na viwango vya mikopo vya kila mwanaachama mmoja. “Najua kuwa baadhi ya wanakikundi wanarejesha mikopo, kuna wengine wanarudisha nyuma. Kulingana na Leonard Bor, Mwanachama wa Kamati Tendaji ya Kaunti (CECM) kwa Kilimo, Mifugo, na Uvuvi, ni asilimia moja tu ya wakulima wa viazi nchini Kenya wanaotumia mbegu rasmi. Wengi hutumia mbegu zilizosindikwa kutoka mashambani mwao na sekta isiyorasmi, hivyo kusababisha tija ndogo. Kitengo kilichogatuliwa kinashirikiana na Shirika la Utafiti wa Mifugo ya Kilimo Kenya (KALRO), Huduma ya Ukaguzi wa Afya ya Mimea ya Kenya (KEPHIS), Bayer East Africa, OCP Africa, na Koppert kuhimiza wakulima wadogo na wakubwa kutumia teknolojia ya

aeroponics kwa ajili ya uzalishaji msingi. mbegu za viazi zilizoidhinishwa umedumaa kwa uzalishaji wa tani saba kwa hekta, ikilinganishwa na uwezo wa tani 40. Kuwekeza katika uzalishaji wa mbegu zilizoidhinishwa kunatoa fursa na faida kubwa. Mbegu zilizothibitishwa hazina mnyauko wa bakteria, mguu mweusi, nematode na magonjwa mengine. Ingawa teknolojia hii ni mpya nchini Kenya, inazidi kupata umaarufu kutokana na visa vidogo vya magonjwa ya viazi,” Bw. Bor alisema. Aeroponics inakuza mimea katika hewa au ukungu bila kutumia udongo, wakati hidroponics ni njia ya kukua mimea bila udongo lakini kwa kutumia miyeyusho ya madini ya madini katika kutengeneza maji. Hapo awali ilipitishwa na KALRO kutoka Peru, teknolojia ni uboreshaji wa njia ya kawaida ya uzalishaji mizizi ya viazi ku-

toka kwa udongo. Huko Peru, ilianzishwa na Kituo cha Viazi cha Kimataifa. Mizizi hukuzwa katika miyeyusho ya kemikali ya kimiminika yenye virutubisho vya ziada vinavyoongeza upinzani dhidi ya magonjwa. Virutubisho vya ziada ni pamoja na nitratu za potasiamu, kalsiamu, na madini ya fosforasi. Teknolojia ina sanduku la

meshed lililogawanywa kuwa mbili. Sehemu hizo zina mashimo ambayo mizizi hukua. Mizizi kwenye kizigeu cha kisanduku cha chini hutoa mtandao mpana wa mizizi. Sanduku la chini lina dawa ya ukungu iliyo-pitwa na wakati ambayo hutoa virutubisho kioevu kila baada ya dakika tano. Sanduku limefungwa kwa plastiki nyeusi ili kuunda

giza lakini hutiwa hewa ili kuhakikisha mizizi inachukua oksijeni na dioksidi kaboni inayohitaji kukua. Uingizaji hewa husababisha uzalishaji zaidi wa mizizi. CECM ilidokeza kuwa serikali ya kaunti inashirikiana na mashirika ya serikali, taasisi za utafiti na wawekezaji wa kibinafsi katika ukuzaji wa aina za mbegu za viazi na mafunzo ya ‘kushikamana’ kwa wazalishaji wa mbegu. “Tunalenga kuongeza ushirikiano na wajasiriamali wa mbegu wajao katika sekta binafsi. Ili kuleta ujenzi wa uwezo tunatarajia kuandaa vipindi vya mafunzo kwa wakuzaji wa mbegu za viazi. “Mafunzo haya yataandaliwa kwa ajili ya wataalamu wa kilimo cha umma na binafsi wanaofanya kazi katika ukuzaji wa mbegu za viazi, uzalishaji na usambazaji. Tatalenga wafanyikazi wa kampuni za mbegu, taasisi za elimu na utafiti, wakulima wa viazi binafsi na

vikundi na maafisa wa ugani wa kilimo,” Bw Bor alisema. Alizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi wa kitengo cha kuzidisha mbegu za viazi kwa teknolojia ya aeroponic katika Kaunti Ndogo ya Njoro. Mpango huo unafadhiliwa kwa pamoja na Shirika la Farm to Market Alliance (FTMA), Chama cha Wakulima wa Nafaka (CGA) na Seed Delight Farm. Bw Bor alidokeza kuwa Serikali ya Kaunti ya Nakuru inashirikiana na KEPHIS, Baraza la Kitaifa la Viazi Kenya (NPCK) na Chuo Kikuu cha Egerton kufungua uwezo wa zaidi ya Sh15 bilioni wa kilimo cha viazi katika kitengo kilichogatuliwa. “Serikali ya kaunti inashirikiana na KEPHIS na wazalishaji wa mbegu walioidhinishwa ili kuhakikisha kuwa wakulima wanapata teknolojia za bei nafuu na za kisasa zinazohakikisha uzalishaji wa mazao ya juu na upanzi unaostahimili magonjwa,” akabainisha.

Serikali kubuni mamlaka mpya ya udhibiti wa sekta ya Reli kubisha wawekezaji wa kibinafsi

Serikali ina mpango wa kuanzisha Mamlaka ya Udhibiti wa Reli na kuimarisha Taasisi ya Mafunzo ya Reli kwa ajili ya maandalizi ya kuingia kwa taasisi binafsi katika sekta ya reli, endapo Muswada wa Sheria ya Reli 2024 unaopendekezwa utakuwa sheria. Mswada huo ambao kwa sasa unashirikishwa na umma kote nchini, unapendekeza kukomesha ukiritimba unaoshikiliwa na shirika la reli la Kenya kwa kuruhusu wahuusika wa sekta ya kibinafsi kushiriki katika sekta ndogo ya reli. Bw. Jonathan Kilelo, mhandisi anayesimamia usalama wa reli katika Shirika la Reli la Kenya, alisema kuwa mamlaka hiyo mpya itawajibika kudhibiti reli na treni kwa kutoa leseni za uendeshaji kwa watu binafsi na mashirika yaliyohitimu. “Hii inamaanisha kuwa kampuni za kibinafsi zitaruhusiwa kununua treni zao wenyewe na kupata leseni kutoka kwa Mamlaka ya Udhibiti wa Reli iliyopendekezwa katika mswada huu. Mamlaka pia itawajibika kutekeleza viwango vina vyohitajika katika kuendesha huduma za reli nchini,” akasema. Eng Kilelo, ambaye alikuwa akizungumza katika Ukumbi wa Nidhamia mjini Malindi wakati wa kikao cha ushiriki wa umma kuhusu Mswada wa washikadau kutoka Kaunti za Kilifi, Lamu na Tana River, alisema kampuni zilizopewa leseni zitakuwa na ufikiaji wazi wa miundombinu ya reli iliyopo na pia kuruhusiwa. kujenga njia zao za reli.

“Tunataka njia zetu za reli ziwe za kisasa kama katika nchi nyingine, zinazotumia treni za umeme na za chini kwa chini kusafirisha watu na mizigo,” – Bw. Randu

“Ndani ya ratiba za kazi, watapewa muda ambapo reli zao zitaweza kutumia njia za reli. Kampuni za kibinafsi pia zitaruhusiwa kujenga reli zao wenyewe kutoka vituo vya reli vilivyo hadi maeneo yao ya biashara ili kuruhusu bidhaa zao kufika mwisho wa mwisho ndani ya viwanda vyao au vituo vya madini,” alisema. Hata hivyo, mabadiliko hayo yaliyopendekezwa yangesaidia uwekezaji wa sekta ya umma uliopo katika sekta ndogo ya reli, huku makampuni binafsi yakitarajiwa kulipia matumizi ya njia zilizopo. Kwa upande mwingine Bw.Kilelo ambaye pembeni yake ni Mwanasheria kutoka Wizara ya Barabara na Uchukuzi Bi Brenda Mwango alisema kuimarishwa kwa Taasisi ya Mafunzo ya Reli kutawezesha sekta ndogo ya reli kupata rasilimali watu wenye ujuzi wa kuendesha mradi huo wa huduma za reli kwa washiriki wapya katika sekta ndogo. “Muswada pia unapendekeza kuimarishwa kwa Taasisi ya Mafunzo ya Reli ili ujuzi unaohitajika kusaidia sekta hiyo uweze kuende-

lezwa ili kuhakikisha kwamba taasisi za sekta binafsi zinapokuja kuendesha huduma za reli, ziweze kupata wafanyakazi ambao wana ujuzi unaotakiwa.” alisema. Ujuzi uliopatikana katika taasisi hiyo ni pamoja na kazi za uhandisi wa mitambo, matengenezo ya miundombinu, ujuzi wa ishara na mawasiliano, usimamizi wa mizigo na usafirishaji, ukataji wa tiketi za treni na huduma za huduma kwa wateja pamoja na huduma za upishi na ukarimu. Naibu Kamishna wa Kaunti ya Wajir Mashariki, George Onyango alitoa shukrani kwa jumuiya ya wenyeji, kwa kutambua jukumu muhimu ambalo wazee, wanawake, na vijana wamecheza katika kulinda amani. “Amani tunayofurahia Wajir sio tu kwa sababu ya vikosi vya usalama lakini kwa kiasi kikubwa kutokana na ushiriki wa jamii,” Onyango alisema. Kamishna aliangazia ukaribu wa Wajir na Somalia na changamoto zinazoendelea katika nchi jirani, akisisitiza kuwa uthabiti wa mji huo unategemea pakubwa ushiriki wa wakazi wake. “Wakazi wanahusika kikamilifu katika kuhakikisha usalama,” alisema, akitoa wito kwa jamii kuendelea kusaidia vyombo vya usalama vya ndani. Alionya kuwa mamlaka haitawavumilia wanaojihusisha na biashara ya dawa za kulevya, akisisitiza wajibu wa pamoja wa kulinda mustakabali wa mji huo. Naibu Kamishna wa Kaunti aliihakikishia jamii kujitolea kwa vikosi vya usalama kudumisha amani, huku akihimiza kuendelea kwa ushirikiano kwa Wajir iliyo salama na yenye ustawi zaidi. Msafara wa maonyesho ya barabarani ni sehemu ya juhudi pana za kuimarisha ushirikiano, kujenga uaminifu, na kukuza usalama na usalama katika mikoa ya mpakani. Kupitia kuongezeka kwa ushiriki wa jamii, mpango huo unalenga kushughulikia changamoto za utawala wa mpaka huku ukihimiza amani, utulivu na ustawi kwa watu walioathirika.

Sh248.2 milioni zilizosalia zitatengwa ujenzi wa Hospitali ya Level IV ya Kaunti Ndogo ya Kuresoi Kaskazini. Majumba yote mawili yaliyojitegemea huko Kure-

soi Kaskazini na Rongai yatakuwa na mabawa ya kisasa ya uzazi na watoto wachanga, maduka ya dawa, mashine za eksirei na maabara za hali ya juu. Pia wataweka vitengo vya wagonjwa wa nje, vitengo vya ajali na dharura, vituo vya kupiga picha na kumbi za sinema, aliongeza Bi Mungai. "Ninashukuru Kaunti ya Makueni kwa mbinu thabiti katika kuanzisha sera ya jinsia inayoleta usawa katika uongozi, kufanya maamuzi na ugawaji wa rasilimali. Hii inahakikisha kwamba wanaume na wanawake wanawezeshwa kuchangia maendeleo ya jamii," alisema. Bi Wang'ombe alisema

GBV inasalia kuwa suala lenye mizizi ambalo linatishia mfumo wa kijamii wa Kenya akisema juhudi za pamoja za kushughulikia maovu hayo kupitia kuanzishwa kwa kituo cha kupona ni muhimu. PS alibainisha kuwa ili manufaa ya juu zaidi kupatikana katika kituo cha uokoaji, ni muhimu kuwa na rasilimali, wafanyakazi na miundombinu inayohitajika ili kuwahudumia waathirika kwa ufanisi na uendeleu.

Zaidi ya hayo, Wang'ombe alisema kituo cha uokoaji lazima kimilikiwe na jamii ili kustawi na kukuza hisia ya uwajibikaji wa pamoja ili kuepusha kituo hicho kuwa mradi wa serikali. "Uendeshaji endelevu wa kituo hiki utategemea ufadhili wa uhakika na wa uhakika. Ninatoa wito kwa serikali ya kitaifa na kaunti, washirika wa maendeleo kuhakikisha kuwa kituo hiki kinasalia imara kifedha, kuruhusu utoaji wa huduma

za bure na nafuu kwa waathirika wanaotafuta usaidizi," akabainisha. Ikumbukwe kuwa Nairobi Women ndio wafadhili wa ujenzi wa kituo cha kupona huko Makueni. Waliohudhuria hafla hiyo ni pamoja na Kamishna wa Kaunti ya Makueni Henry Wafula, Mjumbe wa Kamati Tendaji ya Jinsia Eng. Peter Mumo miongoni mwa maafisa wengine wa serikali katika kaunti hiyo.

Mradi huo unatekelezwa na Wizara wa Mazingira, Mabadiliko ya Tabianchi, na Misitu, Shirika la Chakula na Kilimo, Shirika la Utafiti wa Kilimo na Mifugo la Kenya (KALRO), na serikali za kaunti za Trans Nzoia na Bungoma kama washirika wakuu. Mhifadhi Mkuu wa Huduma ya Misitu nchini Kenya Alex Lemarkoko, katika hotuba iliyosomwa kwa niaba yake na naibu wake Bi Charity Munyasya wakati wa mkutano wa mashauriano na Serikali ya Kaunti ya Trans Nzoia na uchunguzi wa mradi huo, alisema kuwa uhifadhi na urejeshaji wa Mlima Elgon. mfumo ikolojia ni eneo la kipaumbele ambalo linahitaji juhudi za pamoja. “Serikali za Kaunti ya Trans Nzoia na Bungoma ni washirika wakuu katika utekelezaji wa mradi huo na pia ni wanachama wa kamati ya usimamizi wa mradi, ambayo inaongozwa na Wizara ya Mazingira Mabadiliko ya Tabianchi na Misitu,” alisema. Akiuita mfumo wa Ekolojia wa Msitu wa Mlima Elgon kama mnara muhimu wa maji na eneo la bioanuwai muhimu kwa hatua ya hali ya hewa na maisha ya jamii zinazopakana na misitu, Lemarkoko aliongeza msitu wa asili un-

aovuka mpaka ambao ni makazi ya mimea na wanyama unapaswa kulindwa kwa bidii kwa ajili ya vizazi vijavyo. “Kwa kuwa mradi utazingatia ulinzi wa misitu, uhifadhi, urejeshaji na usimamizi wa hekta 7,000 za ardhi ya misitu iliyoharibiwa, jamii za jirani zitanufaika kwa kushirikika katika utekelezaji na kufanya maamuzi na kupata mikataba ya kuotesha miche na kurejesha maeneo yaliyoharibiwa,” alisema. alisema. Aliyekuwepo wakati wa mkutano huo ni Kamishna wa Kaunti ya Trans Nzoia Gideon Oyagi ambaye alikaribisha mpango huo wa ushirikiano akisema utasaidia pakubwa kufanikisha mpango wa kitaifa wa upandaji miti wa bilioni 15 kufikia 2032. “Kwa muda wa miaka mitano mradi huu utakuwapo, mpango wa kaunti wa upandaji miti milioni 11 wa kila mwaka utafikiwa na kwa kuongeza lengo la kitaifa la miti bilioni 15 kufikia 2032,” alisema. Gavana wa Trans Nzoia George Natembeya alikaribisha ushirikiano huo, akisisitiza juu ya haja ya kuhusisha vitengo vya kaunti kikamilifu katika utekelezaji wa kushindwa kwa mradi ambapo matokeo dhahiri yanaweza yasipatikane. “Kama kaunti, tunapatikana kwa urahisi kuunda ushirikiano ambao unaweza kusaidia watu wetu. Mradi huu ukitekelezwa vyema utasaidia sana katika kusaidia mkoa wetu na nchi kwa ujumla,” aliongeza. Hata hivyo, hebu tufikirie kuhusisha kikamilifu jamii za wenyeji katika mchakato wa upandikizaji,” alisema Natembeya.

Serikali imeahidi kutoa mara moja Sh63 milioni zinazodaiwa na wakulima 5,000 wa Chama cha Ushirika cha Wakulima wa Barichu katika Kaunti Ndogo ya Mathira, Kaunti ya Nyeri. Waziri wa Ushirika Wycliffe Oparanya pia ameamuru kufutwa mara moja kwa usimamizi wa chama cha ushirika kinachokumbwa na matatizo na kuagiza Mkurugenzi wa Ushirika wa Kaunti Peter Theuri kuchukua jukumu kwa muda, akisubiri kuchaguliwa kwa maafisa wapya. Akihutubia wakulima kutoka kwa jumuiya kubwa ya wazalishaji kahawa katika Kiwanda cha Kahawa cha Karindundu, Oparanya aliahidi kufanya mkutano na wakulima hao ili kujadili hatua za kushughulikia madeni ya shirika hilo, ambayo jumla yake ni Sh300 milioni. “Rais Dkt. William Ruto ameagiza KPCU Mpya kutoa pesa na kulipa wakulima moja kwa moja kwenye akaunti zao tunapowasaka maafisa wafisadi ambao wamekutorosha pesa ulizochuma kwa bidii,” Oparanya alisema, akisindikizwa na wabunge wa eneo hilo Eric Wamumbi (Mathira.) na Duncan Mathenge (Mji wa Nyeri). “Wakati huo huo, tumeagiza uongozi wa muda kufanya uhakiki wa wakulima wanaostahili kulipwa ili kutuwezesha kushughulikia malipo yao hivi karibuni Septemba 18 mwaka huu,” alisema. Oparanya, vile vile aliahidi kujitolea kwa serikali katika kugeuzi ustawi wa jamii iliyokuwa ikitengeneza faida kwa kuwakamata wale waliohusika na kuporomoka kwake. Alisema Kurugenzi ya Makosa ya Jinai na Maofisa wa Maadili na Kupambana na Rushwa wameagizwa kuwafuata wale wote waliosababisha hasara ya mapato ya wakulima na kuhakikisha wanapata siku yao mahakamani. “Ili kuhakikisha haki inatendeka, Rais ameagiza Idara ya Uchunguzi wa Makosa ya Jinai na Tume ya Maadili na Kupambana na Rushwa kujitokeza na kuchunguza ubadhiriifu wa chama hiki cha ushirika na kuwafungulia mashtaka wale wanaopatikana na hatia ya kutumia vibaya rasilimali za jamii,” alisema. “Tunapaswa kuchunguza

uendeshaji wa vyama vya ushirika Nyeri jinsi benki na pesa za Saccos zinavyolindwa,” akaongeza. Betrice Wanja, mwana-chama wa jamii alisema kuwa ameamua kuzuilia kahawa yake hadi pesa anazodaiwa na jamii kulipwa kwenye akaunti yake. Mkulima huyo aliyefadhaika alisema alijutia uamuzi aliofanya wa kuwachagua maafisa wali- ofedheheshwa ofisini, hatua ambayo alidai ilichangia usimamizi mbaya wa viwanda vinne vya kahawa vinavyofanyiza Sosaiti. “Hatuna imani yoyote na maafisa kwani wameamua kufanya. Kwa sasa, tuna kahawa kwenye mashamba yetu ambayo hatuwezi kuleta hapa kwa vile hatujalipwa tulichopel- eka awali. Tunaomba msaada kutoka kwa Serikali kwani chama chetu cha ushirika kimeanguka kihalisi. Tunajilaumu kwa fujo hizi kwani sisi ndio tuliwachagua hawa watendaji wasio na tija ofisini, na tuko hapa tulipo kwa sababu ya chaguzi zetu zisizo sahihi. Lakini tunatafuta usaidizi ili kuweka mambo sawa,” alilalamika. Beth Wahito, ambaye anafanya kazi katika viwanda hivyo alisema matatizo yanayoikumba Jumuiya ni mbaya kiasi kwamba wasimamizi walikuwa bado hawajalipa ada zao za kila mwezi za mwishoni mwa mwaka jana. “Mbali na kuwa mkulima ninayeshirikiana na kiwanda hiki, mimi pia ni mfanyakazi hapa. Kwa bahati mbaya, hata baada ya kufanya kazi hapa kuanzia Novemba hadi Januari kwa uaminifu, Jumuiya bado haijalipwa hata senti moja. Kwa hivyo, naiomba Serikali iingilie kati na kulazimisha kuachilia mishahara yetu inayotumia kutuwezesha kutimiza majukumu yetu ya kifedha,” aliomba. Mwezi uliopita, wakulima wa kahawa kutoka chama cha ushirika walifanya maandamano katika mji wa Karatina, wakielezea kukerwa kwao na usimamizi mbaya wa mapato kutokana na mazao yao. Wakulima hao waliokasirika walikashifu malipo duni ya zao hilo pamoja na makato ya kiholela kutoka kwa mapato ya msimu uliopita. Walisema walihisi kukosa kubadilishwa na serikali ambayo iliahidi watapata bei ya chini ya uhakika ya Sh80 kwa kilo moja ya kahawa ya cherry.

Mpango wa World Vision ‘pata mbuzi’ wasaidia kupiga vita ukeketaji kuria

Shirika lisilo la kiserikali (NGO) limebuni mbinu ya kipekee ya kukabiliana na mila ya kitambo ya ukeketaji katika Kaunti ya Migori. Ukeketaji, ambao umeenea miongoni mwa Wakuria, kwa muda mrefu umewanyima wakazi haki zao za kijamii na kiuchumi. Hatua za hivi majuzi za Dira ya Dunia kushughulikia suala hili zimeonekana kuwa na mafanikio. World Vision ilianzisha programu iitwayo ‘Pata Mbuzi - Acha Ukeketaji,’ ambayo imewahimiza wakazi wengi wa eneo hilo kugeukia ufugaji wa mbuzi na kuachana na ukeketaji. “Mpango umeonyesha kwa ufanisi kizazi kipya kwa njia mbadala na kuwaondoa kutoka kwa mila mbaya ya FGM,” alisema Bw. Zadrack Yator, meneja wa nguzo katika World Vision. Aliongeza kuwa mpango huo pia umetoa fursa muhimu ya kungeza kipato kwa vijana. Mpango wa ufugaji wa mbuzi, alisema, unalenga kuhamisha usikivu wa Wakuria kutoka kwa mila mbaya kama vile FGM, ndoa za utotoni na mimba za utotoni. Yator alisisitiza kuwa ufugaji

wa mbuzi ni juhudi kamili ya kukabiliana na changamoto za umaskini na ukeketaji ndani ya jamii ya Wakuria. “Tuliamua kukuza ufugaji wa ng’ombe wa maziwa kwa kuchangia mbuzi kwa walengwa wetu kwa kuwahimiza kuzingatia uzalishaji wa maziwa na nyama ili kuboresha utulivu wao wa kiuchumi na kupunguza shinikizo la kujihusiisha na mila mbaya kama vile ukeketaji,” Yator alibainisha. Ni programu ya ‘ndoto kubwa’ ambayo inakuza ufugaji wa mbuzi wa maziwa huko Kuria, alidokeza alipokuwa akiweka mustakabali mzuri kwa wale ambao wamekumbatia mpango huo. Mashirika yasiyo ya kiserikali (NGOs), Kaunti ya Migori na serikali ya kitaifa, Bodi ya Kupambana na Ukeketaji na taasisi nyingine nyingi zinazokomea ukeketaji zimekuwa muhimu sana katika kuweka ramani mwafaka ya kukomesha ukeketaji katika eneo la Kuria, alisema. Uingiliaji kati wa mashirika haya kama vile matumizi ya sanaa, maigizo na muziki kupitisha jumbe za kupinga ukeketaji zinazokuza haki za elimu kwa mtoto wa kike kupitia vituo vya elimu salama, na utumiaji wa mifano ya kuigwa katika jamii ya Kuria kumepunguza uovu huo kwa kiasi kikubwa.

Juhudi zingine kama vile mzungumzo ya mtoto wa kike na Chama cha Wanawake wa Kwanza, kuanzishwa kwa ufadhili wa elimu, elimu ya uraia, kuwawezesha watu wa jamii kupata maisha mbadala na kuwezesha wazee wa Kuria kutuliza roho zao pia zimechangia kupunguzwa kwa ukeketaji. Hata hivyo, ili kuendelea kupambana na tabia hiyo mbaya, shughuli nyingi za kujipatia riziki zinahitaji kutangazwa ili kuhakikisha jamii inashiriki katika shughuli chanya na zenye tija, Yator alisema. Katika nia ya kuondoa tabia hii mbaya, World Vision, kwa mfano, imekuwa ikishirikiana na jamii ya Wakuria katika miradi endelevu ya kimaendelevu ili kugeuza mawazo ya jamii kutoka kwa ukeketaji. Shirika la World Vision kufikia sasa limetoa mbuzi 504 katika kaunti nzima. Mpango wa ndoto kubwa pia unakuza ufugaji wa mbuzi wa maziwa huko Kuria na utasaidia moja kwa moja ustawi wa watoto na maziwa ya jamii kwa kufichua chanya cha biashara za uzalishaji katika eneo la Kuria. “Lengo letu kupitia mpango huu ni kuboresha lishe ya watoto na kuinua kipato cha kaya kiuchumi. Tunajaribu kuchangia katika kukuza uchumi ambao kwa

muda mrefu umehusishwa na kuongezeka na kuongezeka kwa ukeketaji katika Jumuiya ya Wakuria,” Yator alieleza. Mjumbe wa Kamati Tendaji ya Kilimo na Mifugo kaunti ya Migori Bw Chacha Mosenda alisema kuwa kaunti hiyo imekuwa mstari wa mbele kukumbatia washikadau katika vita dhidi ya ukeketaji huko Kuria. Mosenda ambaye anatoka katika jamii ya Kuria anasema kuwa ubia wa ki-

chumi unaowezekana ndio mzizi pekee wa uhakika katika kukomesha ukeketaji. Afisa huyo alifichua kuwa wakeketaji wanaoshiriki katika ukeketaji wamekuwa wakifanya kitendo hiki kiovu kwa manufaa ya kiuchumi. Lakini kwa kuanzisha biashara zinazofaa za kiuchumi kama vile ufugaji mbuzi na World Vision, tishio linaweza kukoma milele, alisema. “Kama kaunti, tume-

kuwa tukishirikisha jamii kwa kutoa mbegu bure ili kukuza sekta ya kilimo na kuwezesha jamii zetu kupitia mipango ya uzalishaji,” alisema Mosenda. Afisa huyo wa kaunti anakiri kwamba mwelekeo wa jamii katika kutokomeza ukeketaji unatokana na mila mbaya ya kuwaoza wasichana katika umri wao wachanga baada ya kufanyiwa utaratibu huo, ili kupata utajiri kwa wazazi wao.

Moriasi alibainisha kuwa moja ya nyongeza kuu katika hazina ya Mfuko ni mkopo wa Go Green, ambao unalenga vijana wenye ubia katika uchumi wa kijani. “Bidhaa hii itasaidia vijana katika maeneo kama vile nishati mbadala, udhibiti wa taka, kilimo hai, upandaji miti, na mikopo ya kaboni, miongoni mwa mengine,” Moriasi alieleza. Aliongeza kuwa bidhaa hii ya mkopo inaendana kika-milifu na juhudi za serikali za kukabiliana na changamoto za mabadiliko ya tabianchi na mwelekeo wa kimataifa kuelekea maendeleo endelevu. Mkopo huo, alisema, unawaweka vijana wa Kenya katika mstari wa mbele katika mapinduzi wa uchumi wa kijani. Bidhaa nyingine mpya za mkopo zilizozinduliwa na Mfuko ni pamoja na mkopo wa V-talanta kwa tasnia ya ubunifu na VIBE kwa wale walio na ubia katika uchumi wa bluu.

“Kwa kutambua umuhimu wa fursa za kimataifa, Mfuko pia umezindua mkopo wa uhamiaji.” Moriasi alifanua, “Mbali na ujasiriamali, Mfuko pia unawezesha vijana kupata ajira nje ya nchi”. “Kama mhusika katika mfumo wa ikolojia wa uhamiaji wa wafanyikazi, tumeanzisha mkopo wa uhamiaji ambapo

vijana wanaweza kupata hadi Sh300,000 ili kufidia gharama za usafiri na nyaraka” Mkurugenzi Mtendaji alisema. Hii, alisema, itawawezesha vijana wa Kenya kufuata nafasi za kazi za kimataifa ambazo zinaweza kuwa hazipatikani kwa sababu ya shida za kifedha. Bidhaa hizi mpya zinajitunga na bidhaa zilizopo za

mkopo za Mfuko, ambazo ni pamoja na mikopo ya vikundi, mikopo ya kuanzisha biashara na upanuzi, fedha za mali na mikopo maalumu kwa sekta kama vile kilimo na fedha za biashara. Kwa pamoja, Mkurugenzi Mtendaji huyo alisema, wanaunda mfumo ikolojia wa kina wa kifedha ambao utawalea na kusaidia wajasiriamali wadogo

katika kila hatua ya safari yao ya ujasiriamali. Moriasi alisema, kwa wale wanaopenda kuomba mikopo hii, Mfuko wa Maendeleo ya Biashara ya Vijana umeanzisha utaratibu wa moja kwa moja wa maombi. Waombaji wanaotarajiwa wanapaswa kuanza kwa kutembelea makao makuu ya kaunti zao na kuuliza kuhusu Ofisi ya Hazina ya Vijana kutoka mahali ambapo wanaweza kupata fomu ya maombi ya mkopo, ambayo wanapaswa kujaza kabisa na kuambatanisha hati zote zinazohitajika. Baada ya kukamilika, fomu inapaswa kurejeshwa katika ofisi hiyo hiyo. Baada ya kuwasilisha, Afisa wa Mfuko wa Vijana atawaongoza waombaji katika hatua zote zinazofuata ikiwa ni pamoja na uhakiki, mafunzo na kueleza taratibu za ulipaji. Baada ya kuidhinishwa, fedha za mkopo zitawekwa moja kwa moja kwenye akaunti ya benki ya kikundi kinachotuma maombi au biashara binafsi.

Timu ilizuru Bandari ya Mombasa ili kutathmini maendeleo ya Container Terminal II ambayo iliwekwa kuongeza uwezo kutoka TEU 1.65M hadi 2.1M ifikapo 2022 na imekamilika na inafanywa kazi kikamilifu. Meneja Mkuu wa Ustawi- ishaji Miundombinu katika Mamlaka ya Bandari ya Kenya (KPA) Mathews Amuti alisema kuwa

Kituo cha Pili cha Mafuta cha Kipevu, kituo cha kisiwa cha Kipevu kilichohamishwa karibu na Jeshi la Wanamaji la Kenya, kimekamilika na vyumba vitatu vimewekwa vifaa vya kushughulikia meli kubwa za mafuta ya petroli. hadi lita milioni 120,000,000. Mradi huo ulizinduliwa mnamo 2022. "Kituo cha Meli za Cruise pia kimeboreshwa kwa vifaa vya sasa vya 1 na 2 ili kushughulikia ukuaji unaotarajiwa katika sekta ya utalii. Kituo kinatumika," Amuti alisema. Akizungumza katika Bandari ya Mombasa, Mkuu wa Wafanyakazi

wa Ofisi ya Waziri Mkuu Joseph Busiega, alieleza jinsi tathmini hizo ni muhimu, akibainisha kuwa zinalenga kutatua changamoto au ucheleweshaji, kukuza uwajibikaji, uwazi, na matumizi bora ya rasilimali za umma katika maendeleo ya taifa. Baadaye walitembelea Kanda Maalum ya Kiuchumi ya Dongo Kundu (SEZ) kukagua kampuni ya LPG ya Taifa Gas, ambayo bado iko katika hatua za uanzishwaji na itakamilika Septemba mwakani. Sekretarieti ilifuatilia fidia kamili kwa watu walioathiriwa na mradi na ardhini sasa inapatikana kwa fursa za uwekezaji. Pamoja na SEZ, pia iliyo-tathminiwa ilikuwa Dongo Kundu Southern Bypass. Mkurugenzi wa Mamlaka ya Kitaifa ya Barabara za Kenya (KeNHA) Kanda ya Pwani Jared Makori alisema madhumuni ya mradi huo ni kutoa njia ya kupita kwa trafiki kutoka Bandari, SGR, na Pwani ya Kusini bila kuingia Kisiwa cha Mombasa. Barabara inakwenda Bandarini na ina njia za kutokea zinazopitia Port Reitz kuelekea uwanja wa ndege na Mombasa.

Kenya sasa yazindua mpango kukomesha uchafu wa kinyesi

Serikali imeongeza juhudi za kutokomeza kabisa uchafuzi wa mazingira kupitia haja kubwa nchini ifikapo mwisho wa 2025. Kulingana na takwimu, Wakenya milioni tano bado wanajisaidia ovyo, huku asilimia 85 wakii-shi katika kaunti kumi na tano. Hata hivyo, mikakati inaendelea kuwekwa kuhakikisha kwamba maeneo haya hayanakero la haja kubwa (ODF) kufikia mwisho wa 2025. Muungano wa Kenya Sanitation Alliance (KSA), ulioanzishwa 2021 kwa lengo la kutokomeza haja kubwa nchini Kenya ifikapo 2025 kupitia ushirikiano wa sera, ushirikishwaji wa jamii, na maendeleoyamiundombinu, inaongoza juhudi hizi. Kaunti kumi na tano zilizotambuliwa kuwa na viwango vya juu vya kujisaidia wazi ni Baringo, Garissa, Homabay, Isiolo, Kajiado, Kilifi, Kwale, Mandera, Marsabit, Narok, Samburu, Tana River, Turkana, Wajir, na Pokot Magharibi. Maafisa wakuu wa afya kutoka kaunti hizi kumi na

tano zenye mzigo mkubwa, wakiongozwa na Watawala wa Afya wa Kaunti (CECs), pamoja na maafisa kutoka Wizara ya Maji na Usafi wa Mazingira na washirika za maendeleo kama vile UNICEF, USAID, na AMREF, walikusanyika katika hoteli huko Malindi chini ya usimamizi wa KSA kujadili mikakati ya kutokomeza tabia hiyo. Bw. Daniel Kurao kutoka shirika la Amref Health Africa nchini Kenya alisema washirika wengi wameungana chini ya Muungano wa Kenya Sanitation Alliance ili kuondoa mzigo wa usafi katika kaunti 15 ambapo asilimia 85 ya asilimia kumi ya Wakenya wanaofanya maozoezi ya uchafu hutoka. "Tunakusanyika kwa sababu tunaona mzigo kwamba nchini Kenya, asilimia kumi ya wale wanaofanya uchafuzi wa wazi, ni idadi kubwa, takriban milioni tano ambapo asilimia 85 wako katika kaunti hizi 15," alisema, akibainisha ODF ni sababu kuu ya magonjwa ya kuhara. Kulingana na Idara, Hifa- dhi ya Viwanda ya Ngozi ni kituo cha viwanda vingi, kinacholenga kuhudumia viwanda tisa, wazalishaji ishirini wa bidhaa za ngozi katika Awamu ya Kwanza ya mradi, watengenezaji wa kemikali za ngozi na vifaa, muuzaji mmoja wa kemikali, na mtengen- ezaji mmoja wa tasnia ya ngozi. Wawekezaji hawa wanatarajiwa kuanzi- sha shughuli pindi hifadhi

hiyo itakapoanza kufanya kazi. Wawekezaji hao 32 wameonyesha kuvutiwa na hifadhi hiyo kupitia barua za nia na wataanza kuendeleza viwanda vyao baada ya Idara kutangaza na kuchapisha Vigezo vya Uajiri wa Wawekezaji. Idara pia imetoa mafunzo kwa wafugaji 1,166 katika machinjio 163, na kuwap- atia zana 1,195 za kuchuna vikiwemo visu na mafaili ya chuma ili kuboresha ubora wa ngozi na ngozi zinazouzwa nje ya nchi. na Taasisi ya Uzalishaji wa Chanjo za Mifugo ya Kenya (KEVEVAP) iliongezeka kutoka dozi milioni 30.1 mwaka wa 2022 hadi dozi milioni 35.2 mwaka wa 2023, na kuashiria ku- panda kwa 17%.
