Reminder on the Requirement to Comply with **Electronic Tax Invoicing**

Further to our Public Notices dated 17th November, 2023 and 27th December, 2023, Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA) wishes to remind the public as follows:

- 1. effective 1st September, 2023, all persons carrying on business, including those not registered for VAT, are required to electronically generate and transmit their invoices to KRA via the electronic Tax Invoice Management System (eTIMS).
- 2. effective 1st January, 2024, business expenditure not supported by an eTIMS generated tax invoice is not deductible for tax purposes.

To facilitate compliance with eTIMS requirements. KRA has availed various solutions including simplified solutions dubbed "eTIMS Lite" for non-VAT registered taxpayers.

KRA reaffirms its commitment to continue supporting and facilitating all businesses to comply with the requirements of the Tax Procedures Act, 2015 including submission to the Commissioner electronic documents related to taxpavers transactional data.
