Viwanda vya chai hivi karibuni vitaruhusiwa kuuza bidhaa zao moja kwa moja kwa masoko ya kimataifa bila haja ya watu wa kati, amesema Waziri wa Kilimo na Maendeleo ya Mifugo, Mutahi Kagwe. Kulingana na Waziri, mkakati huu ni sehemu ya mfululizo wa hatua zinazotekelezwa na wizara yake ili kuimarisha uimara wa sekta ya chai ya nchi ambayo inakadiliwa kuwa na

thamani ya mabilioni ya shilingi. Alisema mageuzi haya pia yanakusudia kuimarisha minyororo ya thamani ya chai na kufanya sekta ya chai ya ndani kuwa ya ushindani kimataifa. "Nashukuru kusema kwamba, kupitia mageuzi yanayongozwa na wizara yangu, hivi karibuni tutaruhusu viwanda vya chai kuuza chai zao moja kwa moja kwa masoko ya kimataifa bila watu wa kati. Mkakati huu utasaidia juhudi za soko za Serikali ya Kenya na kuleta ongezeko

la mapato kwa wakulima wa chai," alisema Kagwe. Aliongeza kuwa wizara imeongeza juhudi za kuingia katika masoko ya kimataifa yanayochipuka kwa bidhaa hii ya kibiashara. Alifunua kwamba mipango inafanyika kutuma ujumbe wa ngazi ya juu—utakaohusisha Bodi ya Chai ya Kenya (TBK), Shirika la Maendeleo ya Chai la Kenya (KTDA), na Umoja wa Biashara ya Chai wa Afrika Mashariki

NPSC kuhamishia mchakato wa kuajiri polisi mtandaoni

ENDELEA KUTOKA UK 1

Tangu uhuru, mchakato wa uajiri wa polisi umekuwa ukifanyika kwa njia ya ana kwa ana, ambapo maelfu ya vijana wenye nguvu na ari wamekuwa wakijitokeza—mara nyingi wakiambatana na familia zao—kujaribu bahati yao. Hata hivyo, Leley alibainisha kuwa mchakato huo umekumbwa na visa vya ufiisadi na ukiukaji wa taratibu. “Si siri kuwa mbinu hii ya zamani imekuwa kikwazo kwa Wakenya wengi, hasa walioko maeneo ya mashambani, kupata nafasi sawa za kuhudumu. Zaidi ya hayo, inaweka hatari uaminifu wa umma kwa mojawapo ya taasisi muhimu zaidi nchini,” alisema. Leley alieleza kuwa Tume inapanga kuzindua Mfumo wa Uajiri wa Polisi (PRS), jukwaa la kidijitali lililo salama linalotarajiwa kubadilisha namna maafisa wapa wanaavyoingizwa katika Huduma ya Polisi ya Kitaifa (NPS). “PRS ni zaidi ya mfumo; ni suluhisho. Kupitia ukaguzi wa data kwa wakati halisi, uchujaji wa waombaji ki-otomatiki, na upangaji wa alama kidijitali, PRS huondoa hisia binafsi na ubaguzi



wa kibinadamu unaoweza kuathiri mchakato wa uajiri. “Inawawezesha waombaji kuwasilisha maombi yao mtandaoni, kufuatilia maelelezo yao na kupokea taarifa kwa wakati—all wakiwa nyumbani kwao,” aliongeza. Alieleza kuwa katika kila kipindi cha uajiri, serikali hutumia mamilioni ya fedha kuchapisha fomu, kusafirisha nyaraka na kulipa posho za uhakiki wa mikono. Kupitia njia ya kidijitali, gharama hizi zitapunguzwa kwa kiasi kikubwa. Leley aliongeza kuwa mfumo huo pia utasaidia kurahisisha tathmini za kiafya, na kuziweka kuwa thabiti na nafuu zaidi. Alisisitiza kuwa asili ya kidijitali ya mfumo huo itaon-

geza uwajibikaji na uwazi katika mchakato wa uajiri. “Mfumo huu utaondoa mawasiliano ya ana kwa ana yanayoweza kufungua mlango kwa vitendo vya ufiisadi. Kuyabadilisha na upatikanaji wa majukumu kwa usalama na rekodi za ukaguzi kwa wakati halisi ni hatua kubwa ya uwazi,” alisema. Hatua hii inaunga mkono Ajenda ya Mabadiliko ya Kiuchumi Kutoka Ngazi ya Chini Juu (BETA), hasa chini ya nguzo ya Barabara Kuu ya Kidijitali na Uchumi wa Ubunifu. Pia inaendana na mapendekezo ya Jopo la Maraga kuhusu kuboresha huduma ya polisi,” Leley alisema.

Viwanda vya chai kuuza moja kwa moja kwenye masoko ya kimataifa

ENDELEA KUTOKA UK 1

(EATTA)—kwenda kwa masoko muhimu ya kimataifa katika Mashariki ya Mbali, Mashariki ya Kati, China, Urusi, na India ili kupromoti na kuuza chai ya Kenya kwa nguvu. Kagwe pia alitangaza ufunguzi wa dirisha la mnada wa chai ya jadi ndani ya Mfumo wa Uuzaji wa Chai Uliunganishwa (ITTS). Mnada huu utasimamiwa na EATTA kwa kushirikiana na mdhibiti wa sekta hiyo, Bodi ya Chai ya Kenya. Kufikia Julai 2024, kulikuwapo na takriban kilo milioni 100 za chai zisizozwa katika ghala la Shirika la Maendeleo ya Chai la Kenya huko Mombasa. Kulingana na Waziri, mnada huu, utakaofunguliwa mwezi Juni mwaka huu, utakuwa na manufaa katika kuuza kiasi kikubwa cha chai ya jadi isiyouzwa kwenda sokoni la kimataifa. “Mnada wa chai ya jadi utaweka msingi wa njia ya usambazaji inayotegemewa ambayo inatarajiwa kuongeza motisha mpya kwa mabadiliko endelevu ya bidhaa kutoka kwa chai ya kukatwa, kupasuliwa na kukunjwa (CTC teas) hadi chai ya jadi. Huu ni mpango mpya, na utakuwa na athari kubwa

katika bei ya chai nchini na nje ya nchi,” alisisitiza Waziri. Kagwe alisema haya akiwa katika Kiwanda cha Chai cha Gitugi kilichopo Othaya, Kaunti ya Nyeri, wakati wa uzinduzi wa maadhimisho ya Siku ya Kimataifa ya Chai. Sherehe za mwaka huu zinajikita katika mada ya “Uendelevu wa Sekta ya Chai – Kuanzalia Mbele” huku Waziri akisisitiza ahadi yake ya kuhakikisha wakulima wa chai wanapata msaada wa kutosha kutoka serikalini.

Serikali yaahidi kuunga mkono viwanda vya ndani kuunda ajira



Waziri Lee Kinyanjui na Gavana Ann Waiguru wazindua kiwanda kipya cha kusaga ngano Joy Millers Limited.

Serikali itasaidia viwanda vya ndani kupitia sera zinazofaa, amesema Waziri wa Uwekezaji, Biashara, na Viwanda (MITI), Lee Kinyanjui. Akizungumza katika mji wa Kutus, Kaunti ya Kirinyaga, wakati alipozindua mashine mpya ya kusaga ngano katika kampuni ya Joy Mill-

ers Limited, Waziri huyo aliongeza kwamba ushirikiano kati ya serikali ya kitaifa na za kaunti katika kujenga Mbuga za Uunganishaji wa Kaunti na Viwanda (CAIPs) na Maeneo ya Usindikaji wa Uuzaji (EPZs) kote nchini utaongeza idadi ya viwanda vya ndani. Alisifu Joy Millers kwa kuonyesha kwamba viwanda vya asili vinaweza kustawi. "Hakuna nchi ambayo imeendelea bila kuongeza thamani na viwanda; hiyo ndiyo

ufunguo. Kampuni hii inaejiri zaidi ya watu 2,000, na hii ni hadithi ya kupigiwa mfano kwa wajasiriamali, ikionyesha jinsi mtu anavyoweza kuanzia kuwa mtaalamu wa usafiri hadi kumiliki kampuni kubwa," alisema Kinyanjui. Waziri huyo pia aliwatahadharisha mabenki kupunguza viwango vya riba ili kusaidia uchumi ambapo kila mtu ana-faidika. Alifichua kuwa wizara yake iko katika mchakato wa kuandaa sera ya utaratibu

wa umoja kupunguza idadi ya leseni zinazohitajika, pamoja na hatua ya serikali ya kuondoa ushuru kwa uagizaji wa vifaa na mashine za viwanda ili kuruhusu wawekezaji zaidi kuanzisha viwanda. "Ikiwa unaleta vifaa kwa ajili ya viwanda kama vile kusaga, hutalipa ushuru wowote. Pia tunayo fedha kutoka kwa Shirika la Maendeleo la Kenya kwa riba ya chini kama asilimia tisa," alisema. Kinyanjui pia aliwataka wakazi kula bidhaa za ndani ili kukuza ukuaji wa uwekezaji unaozalisha ajira. Joy Millers ni kampuni inayochakata unga wa mahindi na pia inashughulika na kusaga ngano ili kukidhi mahitaji ya soko ndani na nje ya Kenya. Gavana wa Kirinyaga, Anne Waiguru, alisema kuwa usakinishaji wa vifaa vipya vya Joy Millers vinavyoweza kusaga tani 600 za ngano kwa siku ni mafanikio makubwa katika mabadiliko ya Kirinyaga kuwa nguvu ya viwanda vya kilimo. Alisifu uwekezaji unaoendelea wa kampuni hiyo na kuthibitisha kujitolea kwa serikali yake kuhamasisha kuongeza thamani, kuunda ajira, na ustawi wa wakulima. "Ni heshima na faraja kuwa shahidi wa hatua nyingine katika safari yetu ya ukuaji. Vifaa hivi vipya si tu ishara ya upanuzi, bali pia ni sherehe ya mafanikio ya kudumu, ushirikiano wa ndani, na mustakabali wenye ujasiri tunaoujenga kwa watu wetu," alisema.

Waiguru alielezea kampuni hiyo kama mchezaji muhimu katika injini ya uchumi ya Kirinyaga na mshirika katika safari yake ya mageuzi. Alisisitiza athari za kijamii na kiuchumi za ukuaji wa kampuni hiyo, ikiwemo ajira ya zaidi ya vijana 1,500 moja kwa moja na maelefu ya wengine kwa njia zisizo za moja kwa moja. Alithibitisha kuwa kaunti ina miundombinu na rasilimali zinazohitajika kwa viwanda vya kilimo kustawi, akieleza kuwa kampuni hizo hutumika kama madaraja, kuunganisha mazao ya kilimo yaliyotajirika katika kaunti na soko la kimataifa linalotamani bidhaa za ubora na zilizoongezwa thamani na kwa wakati mmoja kuweka mfano mkubwa, ikionyesha kuwa biashara za nyumbani zinaweza kupanuka na kustawi Kirinyaga. "Kirinyaga inabaki kuwa uti wa mgongo wa sekta ya kilimo ya Kenya, na zaidi ya nusu ya ardhi yetu imetengwa kwa kilimo. Kama serikali ya kaunti, tumekuwa tukiwasaidia wakulima wetu kubadilisha na kupanua uzalishaji wao ili kuboresha maisha yao," alisema. Waiguru aliongeza kuwa utawala wake unakaribisha uwekezaji zaidi katika kaunti kupitia EPZ ya Sagana inayokuja na CAIPs ambazo zitakuwa na maeneo ya usindikaji wa uuzaji, viwanda, uwanja wa gofu, hoteli ya nyota nne na nyumba za bei nafuu miongoni mwa mengine.

Kenya na Ufalme wa Hashemite wa Jordan zimetia saini makubaliano ya kuimarisha ushirikiano katika sekta ya utalii. Waziri wa Utalii na Wanyamapori, Rebecca Miano, alisema makubaliano haya ni hatua muhimu katika uhusiano wa kibiashara kati ya mataifa mawili.

Alielezea kujitolea kwao katika kukuza utalii kama

njia ya kuhamasisha ufanisi wa kiuchumi, kuunda ajira, na kubadilishana tamaduni. “Tunaelewa umuhimu wa utalii si tu kama chanzo cha fedha za kigeni bali pia kama sekta inayounda ajira na kuwa na athari moja kwa moja kwa maisha ya watu, kulingana na ajenda ya BETA. Ni mojawapo ya sekta ambazo mara nyingi hutajwa kama matunda yanayovunwa kwa urahisi kwa sababu ya uwezo wake mkubwa,” alisema.

Waziri alibaini kuwa katika mwaka wa 2024 na robo ya kwanza ya 2025, sekta hiyo imeonyesha mwelikeo mzuri wa ukuaji. “Sote tunahitaji kushirikiana ili kuhakikisha tunazidisha idadi ya watalii na mapato, na kuhakikisha kwamba jamii pia zinanufaika moja kwa moja,” aliongeza. Akichochea na mafanikio ya Jordan, Miano alisema kuwa kwa idadi ya watu milioni 11,

Jordan huvutia karibu watalii milioni sita kila mwaka—sambamba na uwiano wa 2:1 ambao Kenya inatamani kufuata. “Kwa idadi ya watu inayokaribia milioni 55, Kenya ilikaribisha wageni milioni 2.4, kulingana na takwimu za sasa. Lengo letu ni kuongeza idadi hii kuwa angalau watalii milioni tano kila mwaka ifikapo 2027,” alibaini. Waziri alieleza imani yake kwamba, MOU hii itatoa jukwaa la kujifunza kwa pamoja na ush-

Wandayi reaffirms commitment to boost private sector investment in LPG sector

The Government has reaffirmed its commitment to fostering a thriving and investor-friendly environment, where the private sector is encouraged and empowered to flourish. This strategic pledge, aimed at unlocking the full potential of private enterprise, is seen as a key catalyst for job creation, especially for the nation’s growing youth population. Speaking during his official visit to the Lake Gas site, the Cabinet Secretary for Energy and Petroleum, Opiyo Wandayi, noted that this is a national effort to accelerate the uptake of liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) as a cleaner, safer, and more affordable cooking fuel for households across the country. By enabling private players to scale innovation, distribution networks, and infrastructure, the government aims not only to reduce dependence on traditional fuels but also to stimulate job creation, LPG supply chains, and related industries. “We are here to conduct a site visit to assess this LPG facility’s preparedness for the arrival of the first vessel carrying LPG. We have stated and want to reiterate that as a government, we are committed to providing an enabling environment for the private sector to invest their money and create employment opportunities for our young people. I must commend the leadership of Lake

Gas for this wonderful initiative and for taking the time to invest in this facility, which, so far, I’m told, has cost about \$80 million. That’s not small money,” Wandayi said. The facility has already entered its second phase of development, which involves the construction of an additional 15,000 metric tons of LPG storage capacity. This comes on top of the existing 10,000 metric tons, bringing the total storage capacity to 25,000 metric tons upon completion. This significant expansion marks a major step toward strengthening the country’s energy infrastructure and will play a critical role in ensuring a stable, reliable supply of LPG to households and businesses nationwide. The CS noted that this will automatically translate to the reduction of the ultimate cost of the product to wananchi. “If we open this space to more people to bring in LPG and for more volumes to flow in, ultimately, the forces of demand and supply will set in, and the price will reach its level, where it should be. And that’s what we need,” he said. “We commend the management of Lake Gas, and we commit to continuing to support them in any way possible. I must also thank the County Government of Kilifi under the leadership of his excellency, Gideon Mung’aro, for also providing the necessary support for the private sector to establish businesses in this county,” he added.

Wandayi asisitiza kujitolea kuimarisha uwekezaji wa sekta binafsi katika LPG

Serikali imesisitiza tena kujitolea kwake kukuza mazingira yafaayo kwa uwekezaji, ambapo sekta binafsi inahimizwa na kuwezesha kustawi. Ahadi hii ya kimkakati, inayolenga kufungua uwezo kamili wa biashara za kibinafsi, inaeonekana kama kichocheo kikuu cha kuunda ajira, hasa kwa idadi inayokua ya vijana wa taifa. Akizungumza wakati wa ziara yake rasmi kwenye eneo la Lake Gas, Waziri wa Nishati na Petroli, Opiyo Wandayi, alieleza kuwa hii ni juhudi ya kitaifa ya kuharakisha utumiaji wa gesi ya petrol iliyoishinikizwa (LPG) kama nishati safi, salama, na inayoweza kumudu kwa matumizi ya kaya kote nchini. Kwa kuwawezesha wachezaji binafsi kuongeza ubunifu, mitandao ya usambazaji, na miundombinu, serikali inalenga si tu kupunguza utegemezi kwa nishati za jadi bali pia kucheza uundaji wa ajira, mnyororo wa usambazaji wa LPG, na sekta zinazohusiana. “Tuko hapa kufanya ziara ya eneo hili ili kutathmini maandalizi ya kituo hiki cha LPG kwa ajili ya kuwasili kwa meli ya kwanza inayobeba LPG. Tume tangaza na tunataka kurudia kusema kuwa kama serikali, tumejizatiti kutoa mazingira

bora kwa sekta binafsi kuwekeza pesa zao na kuunda fursa za ajira kwa vijana wetu. Lazima nipongeze uongozi wa Lake Gas kwa jitihada nzuri hii na kwa kuchukua muda kuwekeza katika kituo hiki, ambacho hadi sasa, niambiwa, kimegharimu takriban dola milioni 80. Hiyo si pesa ndogo,” alisema Wandayi. Kituo hicho tayari kimeingia katika hatua yake ya pili ya maendeleo, ambayo inahusisha ujenzi wa uwezo mwingine wa kuhifadhi LPG wa tani 15,000 za metriki. Hii inajumuisha tani 10,000 za metriki zilizopo, na

hivyo kufanya jumla ya uwezo wa uhifadhi kuwa tani 25,000 za metriki pindi itakapokamilika. Upanuzi huu mkubwa ni hatua muhimu kuelekea kuimarisha miundombinu ya nishati ya taifa na utacheza sehemu muhimu katika kuhakikisha upatikanaji thabiti na wa kuaminika wa LPG kwa kaya na biashara nchi nzima. Waziri alieleza kuwa hii itasababisha moja kwa moja kupungua kwa gharama ya mwisho ya bidhaa kwa wananchi. “Tukifungua nafasi hii kwa watu wengi zaidi kuleta LPG na

kwa mabadiliko zaidi ya kuingia, hatimaye, nguvu za mahitaji na usambazaji zitaingia, na bei itafikia kiwango chake, pale inapaswa kuwa. Na hiyo ndiyo tunahitaji,” alisema. “Tunapongeza uongozi wa Lake Gas, na tunajitolea kundelea kuwaunga mkono kwa njia yoyote ile inayowezekana. Lazima pia nishukuru Serikali ya Kaunti ya Kilifi chini ya uongozi wa Mheshimiwa Gideon Mung’aro, kwa pia kutoa msaada muhimu kwa sekta binafsi kuanzisha biashara katika kaunti hii,” aliongeza. Waziri pia alifichua kuwa meli ya kwanza itawasili katika wiki mbili, ambayo itakuwa ishara ya ufunguzi wa kituo hiki, akibainisha kuwa kila kitu kingine kitakuwa chasherehe na hicho kimeachwa kwa usimamizi kuamua. Katibu Mkuu wa Petrol, Mohamed Liban, alisisitiza umuhimu wa juhudi za pamoja kati ya wadau wa sekta hii kufikia maendeleo ya maana na endelevu katika kupanua upatikanaji wa LPG nchi nzima. “Kwa kuleta wadau wote pamoja, wa ndani na wa kimataifa, tunaweza kuimarisha juhudi zetu na kuendelea pamoja ili kuanzisha kituo cha watumiaji cha pamoja kinachoweza uwezo wa ndani,” alisema. Mung’aro aliongeza kusema kuwa kampuni kama Lake Gas zinapaswa kuzingatia mafunzo kwa vijana wa eneo hili ambapo ujuzi maalum wa kiufundi unahitajika. “Vijana wetu ni werevu na wana uwezo; wanaweza kufundishwa na kubadilika haraka na mahitaji ya sekta,” aliongeza. Meneja wa Usambazaji na Uendeshaji wa Lake Gas, Moris Mutiso, alisema kuwa wanajitolea kuleta nguvu kwa jamii ya eneo hilo. “Tayari tumekamilisha mikakati ya kuhakikisha kwamba angalau asilimia 70 ya wafanyakazi wanaofanya kazi katika kituo hiki watatoka Kaunti ya Kilifi,” alisisitiza. Alisema kuwa mradi huu unatarajiwa kuleta ajira za kudumu kati ya 50 hadi 60 ndani ya kituo hicho. Hata hivyo, mbali na fursa hizi za ajira za moja kwa moja, mradi huu utafungua uwezo mkubwa zaidi wa biashara.

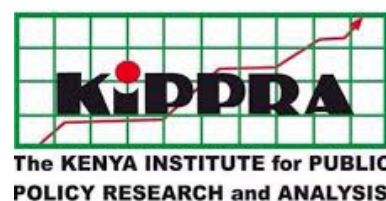

usimamizi wa taka, na unatumia nzi ambao kwa karnenyingi wamehusishwa na uchafu na kuonekana kama wadudu wa kero wanaosababisha magonjwa kwa binadamu. Kwa mujibu wa Nyange, matumizi ya funza wa nzi kutengeneza chakula cha mifugo ni ya gharama nafuu na yanampa mkulima nafasi ya kupata faida kubwa zaidi. Alieleza kuwa chakula kin-

Jiji la Kisumu linashuhudia ongezeko la kasi ya uwekezaji, miezi mitatu baada ya Mkutano wa Kimataifa wa Uwekezaji wa Nyanza 2025. Mkutano huo ulivutia zaidi wa wawekezaji hamsini kutoka ndani na nje ya nchi, ambao walihidi kuwekeza zaidi ya dola milioni 200 katika mkoa wa Nyanza. Wakati wa mkutano, serikali ya kitaifa ilijitolea kuwekeza katika miradi muhimu ya miundombinu inayolenga kufungua uwezo kamili wa kiuchumi wa Nyanza. KFS yazindua mfano wa bustani ya miche ya matunda Meru

■ Huduma ya Misitu ya Kenya (KFS) imezindua bustani ya miche ya miti ya matunda katika Shule ya Msingi ya Kiamwiri katika Kaunti ya Meru ili kukuza upandaji miti zaidi katika eneo hilo. Mradi huu, unaoongozwa na Mkurugenzi wa Misitu wa Mpango wa Uchumi Lawrence Muthamia, unalenga kuendeleza utekelezaji wa wazo la kijiji la mfano, ambalo linaatarajiwa kuharakisha kufikiwa kwa asilimia 30 ya kifuniko cha msitu ifikapo 2032. Alisema kuwa bustani hii ni mfano wa kuonyesha na kituo cha kujenga uwezo ambacho kitakuwa kitovu cha mafunzo na maonyesho katika kaunti zinazohirikiana, na lengo la kupanua mfano huo kitaifa. Muthamia alisema anafanya kazi kwa karibu na KFS katika Kaunti ya Meru, ambayo inatarajiwa kutoa usafiri na mwongozo wa kiufundi katika zoezi lote. “Mradi huu unaunga mkono ajenda kubwa

ya kilimo na upandaji miti ya Meru chini ya Ajenda ya Mabadiliko ya Uchumi ya Kugeuza (BETA) na Dira ya Kenya 2030 na unanza na shule 30 za kipaumbele. Imepangwa ili kuhamasisha jitihada za kijani katika taasisi za elimu, familia, ardhi za jamii, na maeneo ya umma,” alisema Muthamia. Aliongeza kuwa kijiji la mfano ni zaidi ya wazo, ni mkakati wa kimungu wa mapinduzi ya uchumi, kurejesha familia, na kubadilisha vijiji kuwa vituo vya ustawi na madhumuni. “Safari yetu kuelekea uhuru wa kiuchumi inaendelea, na nadhihirisha kwa uthabiti kuwa hii ni siri ya kazi ya Mungu katika wakati wetu,” alisema Muthamia. Wakati akizindua safari ya vijana 30 wa Kenya waliopata fursa za ajira katika Falme za Kiarabu katika Uwanja wa Ndege wa Kimataifa wa Jomo Kenyatta, Katibu Mkuu wa Wizara ya Kazi na Maendeleo ya Ujuzi, Bw. Shadrack Mwadime, alisema kuwa serikali imedhamiria kutoa msaada wa kifedha kwa Wakenya walioko katika hali ya umasikini na waliopata ajira nje ya nchi. Bw. Mwadime alieleza kuwa wazo la kutafuta
