Serikali imetangaza mpango wa kubadilisha kikamilifu michakato yote ya ununuzi wa umma kutoka kwa mfumo wa kawaida hadi jukwaa la kielektroniki kufikia tarehe 1 Julai 2025, katika juhudi za kuzuia ufiisadi na kuongeza uwazi katika usimamizi wa rasilimali za umma. Akizungumza wakati wa ibada ya shukrani katika Shule ya Upili ya Wasichana ya Kipsigis katika Kaunti ya Kericho, Mkuu wa Utumishi wa Umma, Felix Koskei, alisema kuwa taasisi zote za serikali zitahitajika kutumia mfumo wa ununuzi wa kielektroniki. Mfumo huu umesaniifiwa kutoa mwonekano wa kina na ufuatiliaji wa

hatua zote za manunuzi. Koskei alisisitiza kuwa jukwaa hilo la kidijitali litaruhusu ufuatiliaji wa wakati halisi wa hatua kuu za manunuzi, ikiwemo uwasilishaji wa maombi, utoaji wa barua za zabuni, na michakato ya malipo. Serikali inakuza matumizi ya gesi ya petroli iliyoyeyushwa (LPG) katika taasisi za elimu. Akizungumza katika Shule ya Upili ya Wasichana Isiolo, Waziri wa Nguvu na Petroli, Opiyo Wandayi, alizindua kiwanda cha LPG katika taasisi hiyo. Alisema shule hiyo ni mojawapo

ya miradi 20 ya majaribio kote nchini, ambayo baadaye itapanuliwa hadi taasisi nyingine za serikali. Bw. Wandayi alibainisha kuwa mshiriki wa kwanza wa mradi huu alikuwa Shule ya Upili ya Jamhuri jijini Nairobi, iliyozinduliwa na Rais Dkt. William Ruto. Alieleza kuwa mpango huo utaenea kwa taasisi nyingine mara tu shule

20 za majaribio zitakaporidhika na matumizi ya LPG kama chanzo chao kikuu cha nishati. "Kuweka gesi katika taasisi kutaboresha ufanisi wa upishi, kuboresha afya na usafi wa wafanyakazi wa jikoni, na kuhifadhi mazingira kwa kupunguza matumizi ya kuni na makaa ya mawe," alisema Waziri. Aliongeza kuwa wizara

yake imetumia Sh1.3 billioni mwaka huu wa fedha kusambaza umeme vijijini na kwa kaya katika Kaunti ya Isiolo pekee. Bw. Wandayi alibainisha kuwa upatikanaji wa umeme utawezesha wakazi kuanzisha viwanda vidogo vya 'Jua Kali', hivyo kuhamasisha uku-

umma inaweza kufuatiliwa katika kila hatua ya matumizi. Aliongeza kuwa mfumo mpya utawezesha mashirika ya serikali kuchunguza kumbukumbu za kifedha kwa ufanisi zaidi, kubaini dosari na kuchukua hatua za haraka kurekebisha. Koskei pia alilalamikia mienendo mibaya ya awali ya ununuzi, akieleza kuwa mara nyingi imekuwa ikitumiwa vibaya na watu wachache wanaotumia nyadhifa zao kugeuza fedha kwa manufaa binafsi. Aliwahakikishia wananchi kwamba serikali inabaki thabiti katika dhamira yake ya kulinda rasilimali za umma na kuhakikisha fedha za walipa kodi zinatumika kwa madhumuni yaliyokusudiwa pekee. "Tumeweza kuondoa mengi ya maovu yaliyokuwa yakizunguka katika mifumo ya ununuzi, ambapo watu wachache walikuwa wakitumia mianya kufikia fedha ambazo hawakustahili," alithibitisha. Mkuu wa Utumishi wa Umma pia alitoa wito kwa watumishi wa umma na taasisi kuzikubali mageuzi haya, akibainisha kwamba mpito huu wa kidijitali si tu agizo la sera, bali pia ni wajibu wa



kimaadili wa kurejesha uadilifu katika utoaji wa huduma za umma. Miongoni mwa wageni mashuhuri waliokuwepo kwenye hafla hiyo walikuwa Gavana wa

Waziri wa Habari, Mawasiliano na Uchumi wa Kidijitali (CS) William Kabogo amethibitisha dhamira ya serikali katika kutekeleza nguzo ya barabara kuu ya kidijitali, kama ilivyoielezwa katika Mabadiliko ya Kiuchumi ya Bottom-up, kuhakikisha muunganisho wa intaneti usiokatika kote nchini ifikapo mwaka 2028. Akizungumza wakati wa sherehe za kuhitimu kwa wanafunzi 250 na uzinduzi rasmi wa Kituo cha ICT cha Jimbo la Mvita kwenye Uwanja wa Ronald Ngala, Bw Kabogo alisema kuwa zaidi ya huduma 22,000 tayari zimeunganishwa katika jukwaa la e-Citizen. Waziri alimpongeza Mbunge wa Mvita Mohamed Machele kwa kuongoza miradi ya mabadiliko na kuwaomba viongozi wengine waache kelele za kisiasa na wakaze nguvu kwenye majukumu yao ya maendeleo. Kituo cha ICT cha Mvita kimefungwa na kompyuta 50 za kisasa na tayari kimeanza kubadilisha maisha. Wanafunzi wamepata ujuzi wa usomaji wa kidijitali,

ujuzi laini, akili ya hisia, elimu ya kifedha, masomo ya adabu, na ujasiriamali katika maandalizi ya soko la kazi la kidijitali linalokua kwa kasi duniani. Kabogo alifuatana na Katibu Wakuu Waheshimiwa Mha. John Tanui (Idara ya ICT) na Stephen Isaboke (Idara ya Utangazaji na Mawasiliano). Ili kupanua upatikanaji wa ujuzi wa kidijitali, Waziri aliagiza Katibu wa ICT na Konza Technopolis watoe kompyuta 50 zaidi katika kituo hicho, kuhakikisha vijana wengi wanapata faida kutoka kwa mpango huu unaobadilisha maisha. “Kulisha vipaji bora. Kituo hiki kinapaswa kuwa kituo cha vipaji na ubunifu ili watu waweze kujipatia riziki kupitia kazi za mtandaoni,” alisema waziri, akitaka kuwepo kwa fursa sawa kwa wasichana na wavulana. Aliongeza kuwa marekebisho ya hivi karibuni katika Sheria ya Mfuko wa Maendeleo ya Serikali za Mitaa (NG-CDF) ni muhimu katika mafanikio ya ajenda ya kidijitali. Kwa mujibu wa masharti mapya, asilimia tatu ya NG-CDF inaweza kutolewa kwa ajili ya kuanzisha vituo vya kidijitali, huku Wizara

Gharama kubwa za usindikaji chai katika viwanda vinavyoshirikiana na KTDA zimeelezwa kama mo-

jawapo ya changamoto zinazosababisha kipato kupungua kwa wakulima wadogo wa chai. Hii imesababisha kutafutwa kwa njia mbalimbali za kupunguza gharama za uzalishaji

na hivyo kuongeza mapato ya wakulima kutoka kwa chai yao. KTDA imeingia mkataba na Shirika la Maendeleo ya Viwanda la Umoja wa Mataifa (UNIDO) kuchunguza na

kufanya utafiti juu ya matumizi ya gesi zinazotokana na biomass (gasification) kama nishati ya kuendesha michakato ya usindikaji chai katika viwanda vyote vina-vyoshirikiana na KTDA. Hii ilifichuliwa wakati wa ziara ya timu ya UNIDO katika Kiwanda cha Chai cha Kiru kilichopo Kaunti Ndogo ya Mathioya kwa mazungumzo na Bodi ya Wakurugenzi wa KTDA. Ilibainika kwamba usindikaji wa chai kwa kutumia kuni umekuwa ghali na pia umechangia uharibifu wa mazingira kutokana na kukatwa kwa miti kwa wingi. Mwenyekiti wa KTDA Holdings, Chege Kirundi, aliipongeza makubaliano na UNIDO, akisema kuwa njia mpya za kuhifadhi mazingira na kutumia vyanzo mbadala vya nishati zitaundwa kusaidia usindikaji wa chai wenye gharama nafuu. Kirundi alisema matumizi ya gasification – inayotokana na biomass iliyotengenezwa kutokana na taka za chai – kuendesha viwanda vya chai ni njia sahihi kwa sababu itapunguza utegemezi mkubwa wa kuni kama mafuta ya usindikaji chai.

Aliongeza kuwa uongozi katika sekta ya chai umekuwa ukitafta njia bora za kuongeza uzalishaji huku ukipunguza gharama kwa miaka mingi. “Kupitia ushirikiano na watafiti chini ya UNIDO, kuna mwanga mwishoni mwa giza. Kukata matawi ya chai na mimea mingine sham-bani kunaweza kuwa chanzo muhimu cha gesi ya kuendesha michakato ya usindikaji chai,” alisema Kirundi, ambaye pia ni Mwenyekiti wa Kiwanda cha Chai cha Kiru. Hivi sasa, viwanda hutumia kuni zilizotumika kama mafuta, zinazopatikana kutoka kwa wakulima wa chai na mashamba ya miti, baada ya kuacha kutumia mafuta ya furnace kuendesha boiler. Timu ya UNIDO, inayoongozwa na Bi. Darti Shah na Karen Taylor, alisema itashirikiana na wakurugenzi wa chai kupunguza gharama za uzalishaji kwa asilimia 10 kupitia mpango unaoitwa Accelerating Climate Innovation Technology. Kikosi hicho chenye wana-chama kutoka Indonesia, Canada, Nigeria, Uingereza, na Brazil, ilisema inalenga kutoa elimu kwa watu kuhusu matumizi ya nishati safi yenye gharama nafuu. Watafiti walisisitiza matumizi ya gesi katika viwanda, wakielezea kuwa biomass kutoka kwa kukata matawi ya chai na taka za shamba inaweza kubadilishwa kuwa nishati.

duliwa katika Kaunti ya Meru takriban mwezi mmoja uliopita na sasa imepanuliwa hadi Kaunti ya Turkana.

Akizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi katika Shule ya Nakwamekwi Comprehensive School katika Kaunti Ndogo ya Turkana ya Kati mnamo Jumatatu, Wa-

ziri wa Mazingira na Misitu Dkt. Deborah Barasa, akiwakilishwa na Mkurugenzi wa Misitu wa Mipango ya Kiuchumi Lawrence Muthamia, alisema huu ndio mtindo ufao zaidi wa kusaidia Kenya kufikia malengo yake ya kufunika miti.

Alisema dhamira ya mageuzi

haikuwa tu ya kimazingira bali pia ya vizazi, na imejikita katika Kampeni ya Kupanda Miti Bilioni 15 chini ya Ajenda ya Mabadiliko ya Kiuchumi ya Chini-Up (BETA). “Mpango huu, uliotekelezwa kupitia Mfumo wa Mabadiliko ya Kijiji cha Mfano, ni tamko la kijasiri kwamba hatua za hali ya hewa, elimu, na maisha ya ndani lazima zikue pamoja,” alisema Dk. Barasa.

Aliongeza: “Dhana ya Kijiji cha Mfano, iliyoinduliwa kwa mara ya kwanza Meru Mei 1 mwaka huu, sasa inabadilishwa hapa Turkana, ikileta pamoja wanafunzi, walimu, wazazi, taasisi za kidini, na viongozi wa jamii chini ya ajenda moja ya mabadiliko ya kijani.”

Kulingana na Dkt. Barasa, mfumo huo unahusisha upandaji miti wa kilimo mseto katika shule, ufundi wa aina nyingi, na sehemu za ibada; vitalu vya miti vinavyoendeshwa na jamii kwa ajili ya uendeleu na maisha; elimu ya matumizi bora ya ardhi kwa kuzingatia hali ya hewa na usimamizi wa miti; pamoja na ufuatiliaji unaoendeshwa na data wa juhudi za upandaji na viwango vya maisha.

“Kwa msaada wa kiufundi kutoka kwa Huduma ya Misitu ya Kenya (KFS), Taasisi ya Utafiti wa Misitu ya Kenya (KEFRI), na washirika wengine, mpango huu unakita mizizi katika zaidi ya taasisi 30 katika Kaunti ya Turkana,” alisema Dkt Barasa.

Kupitia uanzishwaji wa mashamba ya miti ya kilimo katika shule, makanisa, na mashamba ya jamii, tunarejesha maisha katika mandhari iliyoharibika,” alisema Bw Muthamia. Serikali imehamisha vifaru weusi 21 hadi Hifadhi ya Segera Rhino Conservancy katika Kaunti ya Laikipia, kama juhudi za kukuza uhifadhi, kupunguza msongamano, na kulinda spishi hii hatarini. Waziri wa Utalii na Wanyamapori, Rebecca Miano, aliongoza hafla ya uhamisho huo katika Ol Pejeta. Waziri alisema kwamba kuhamisha vifaru hao hadi katika Hifadhi ya Segera, yenye ukubwa wa takriban ekari 50,000, kutawapatia makaazi salama na yenye utajiri wa kiasili kwa ajili ya kuzaliana. “Uhamisho huu wa vifaru weusi 21 hadi Hifadhi ya Segera ni zaidi ya hatua ya uhifadhi. Ni uthibitisho wa ujasiri wa ahadi ya kudumu ya Kenya kulinda mustakabali wa moja ya spishi muhimu duniani ambazo ziko hatarini kupotea,” alisema Waziri. Miano alibainisha kwamba zoezi hili ni hatua muhimu kufikia kiwango cha ukuaji wa idadi ya vifaru kwa asilimia 5 kila mwaka. “Hifadhi ya sasa ya Segera yenye ukubwa wa kilomita za mraba 90 inapangwa kupanuliwa hadi ekari 250,000, jambo ambalo litawapatia vifaru makazi salama na yenye utajiri wa kiasili kwa ajili ya kuzaliana. Hii ni hatua muhimu kuelekea kufikia lengo letu la ukuaji wa asilimia 5 kwa mwaka,” alisema Waziri. Mchakato huu wa uhamisho wa kina unatarajiwa kuchukua siku

18, huku vifaru watatu wa kwanza wakiwa tayari wamehamishwa hadi Hifadhi ya Segera. Miano alieleza kwamba Kenya inahifadhi asilimia 80 ya idadi ya vifaru weusi wa mashariki, ambao idadi yao imeongezeka kutoka 384 mnamo mwaka wa 1989 hadi 1,059 mwaka jana. “Kenya inahifadhi asilimia 80 ya idadi ya vifaru weusi wa Afrika, na takwimu hizi ni ushahidi wazi wa miongo kadhaa ya juhudi za serikali, wanahifadhi na jamii, ingawa hivyo, maisha ya spishi hii bado yako hatarini,” aliongeza Waziri. wanyama kuliko uwezo wake wa kubeba, tunapunguza mapigano ya kieneo ambayo husababisha zaidi ya asilimia 30 ya vifo vya vifaru,” alisema Miano. Aidha, Waziri alieleza kuwa uhamisho huu ni hatua muhimu katika kufungua upeo mpya wa uhifadhi kaskazini mwa Kenya. “Tukio hili pia linaashiria mwanzo mpya kwa kaskazini mwa Kenya, eneo ambalo kwa muda mrefu limechukuliwa kama jangwa. patiwa dawa za kuwalevya kwa kutumia helikopta na timu ya madaktari wa mifugo kutoka Huduma ya Wanyamapori Kenya (KWS), zoezi lililofanywa kwa umakini mkubwa ndani ya dakika 15 baada ya kugunduliwa kwa mwonekano wa juu katika eneo la Ol Pejeta.

Aisha* na Amina*, wote wakiwa na umri wa miaka 17 tu, wanastahili kuwa shuleni au kujenga ndoto zao. Badala yake, wanapitia changamoto za uzazi wa ujana huko Korogocho, mojawapo ya makazi ya mtaani yenye msongamano mkubwa zaidi Nairobi, ambapo ujauzito wa vijana mara nyingi hutimiza mwisho wa elimu rasmi na kuanza kwa matatizo ya kiuchumi. “Nataka kurudi shuleni, lakini pia nataka mtoto wangu apate maisha bora,” Aisha anasema, akimshika mtoto wake mchanga. “Mara nyingine mama yangu hana pesa, basi tunabaki njaa tu.” Amina, aliyekuwa na ujauzito akiwa na miaka 16, anasema kwa uchungu kama huo: “Wanasema tunaweza kurudi shuleni, lakini hawajituli kama tuna mtu wa kutunza watoto, chakula, au karatasi za usafi wa hedhi.” Hadithi zao ni za kawaida mno. Utafiti wa mwaka 2022 uliofanywa na African Population and Health Research Center (APHRC), kwa kushirikiana na Miss Koch Kenya na Idara ya Huduma za Watoto ya Kaunti ya Nairobi, unaoonyesha hali mbaya. Kati ya wasichana 594 walihojiwa, 76.7% waliripoti kuwa ujauzito wao haukuwa wa kusudi, na 91% walikuwa wametoroka shule wakati wa utafiti. Katika warsha ya vyombo vya habari iliyo-fanyika katikati ya Mei 2025, iliyoratibiwa na

Media for Environment, Science, Health and Agriculture (MESHA) na Solutions Journalism Network, Dkt. Anthony Ajayi wa APHRC alisisitiza kwamba ujauzito wa vijana si tu suala la kiafya—ni suala kubwa la kijamii na kiuchumi. “Wakati wasichana karibu wote walipata huduma za antenatal, ni takriban tatu tu kati ya kumi waliokamilisha ziara nane zinazopendekezwa,” alisema Dkt. Ajayi. “Aibu, hofu ya kudharauliwa, umasikini, na ukosefu wa taarifa ni vikwazo vya kawaida. Kwa kusikitisha, mmoja kati ya wanne wa wanawake vijana waliotoa ripoti ya unyanyasaji wa maneno au mwili na wauguzi wakati wa kujifungua. Wengine walizuiliwa hospitalini kwa sababu ya madeni ya bili.” Halingumu ya kiuchumi huongeza changamoto hizi. Ni asilimia 25 tu ya mama vijana wanaopata kazi zenye malipo—kazi nyingi zisizo rasmi kama kufua nguo au kusuka nywele. Takriban theluthi mbili wanakumbwa na changamoto za kuki-dhi mahitaji ya watoto wao, mara nyingi wakitegemea ndugu wa kusaidia katika utunzaji wa watoto. Changamoto za afya ya akili ni kubwa. Kulingana na utafiti wa APHRC, asilimia 40 ya wasichana wana dalili

za msongo wa mawazo mdogo, wakati zaidi ya asilimia 25 wanakumbwa na dalili za msongo wa mawazo wa kiwango cha kati hadi kikali, ikiwa ni pamoja na kujeruhi nafsi zao. Nusu yao waliripoti uzoefu wa vurugu, na asilimia 25 walikumbwa na vurugu za wanao-doa. Sababu kuu za ujauzito wa mapema ni pamoja na kufungwa kwa shule wakati wa majanga kama janga la COVID-19, migogoro ya familia, umasikini, unyanyasaji wa kingono, na ufahamu mdogo wa njia za kujikinga. Bett. Takwimu za Muhtasari wa Takwimu wa Kaunti ya Uasin Gishu za mwaka 2023 zinaonyesha kuwa watoto wapatao 40,000 wako katika shule za awali za umma takriban 674. Hata hivyo, wanafunzi wengi bado wanakabiliwa na njaa na utapiamlo, changamoto ambazo huathiri ukuaji wao, afya na mafanikio yao katika masomo. Mkutano huo uliwaleta pamoja wadau kutoka sekta za afya, elimu na kilimo kwa lengo la kutafuta suluhisho endelevu la lishe na ustawi wa watoto.
