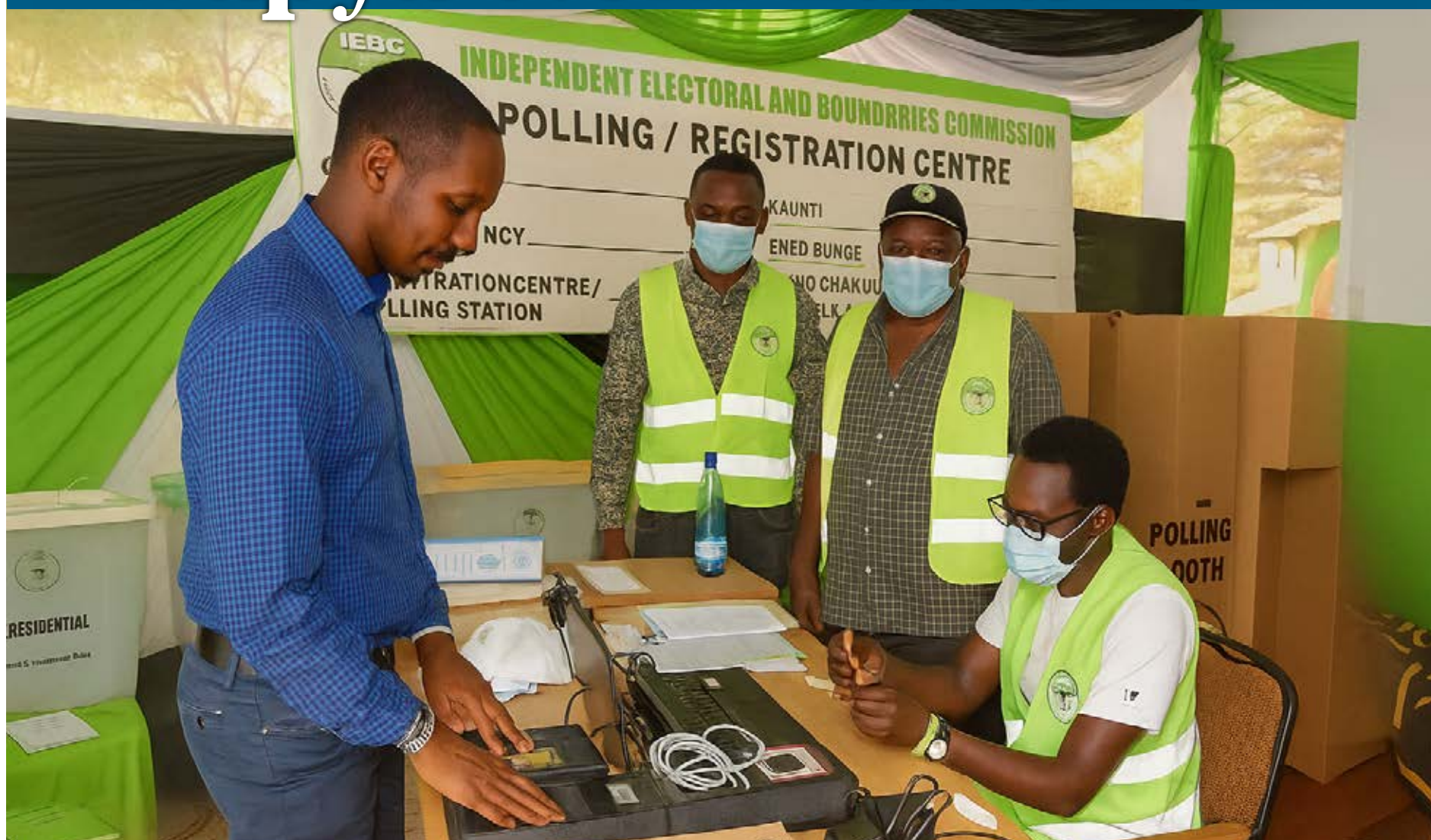

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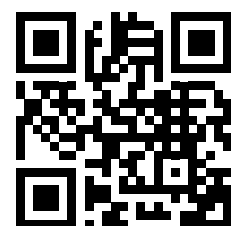


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IEBC yalenga wapiga kura wapya 6.8m kabla 2027

Tume Huru ya Uchaguzi na Mipaka (IEBC) inatarajiwa kuanzisha zoezi la Usajili Endelevu Ulioboreshwa wa Wapiga Kura (ECVR) mara baada ya chaguzi ndogo zijazo, kwa lengo la kusajili angalau wapiga kura wapya milioni 6.8 kabla ya Uchaguzi Mkuu wa mwaka 2027. Mpango wa ECVR utafuata zoezi la sasa la Usajili Endelevu wa Wapiga Kura, ambalo sasa liko katika wiki yake ya tatu na limefanikiwa tu kusajili wapiga kura 90,020 dhidi ya lengo la milioni 6.8. Mwenyekiti wa IEBC, Erastus Ethekeon, alisema kuwa ingawa kumekuwa na maendeleo, idadi ya waliojiandikisha bado iko chini ya matarajio licha ya hamasa kubwa miongoni mwa vijana wanaotaka kutumia haki zao za kidemokrasia. Akizungumza mjini Mombasa katika kongamano la uhamasishaji wa vijana lililoandaliwa na shirika la Amnesty International, Ethekeon alifichua kuwa jiji hilo la Pwani limeweza kusajili wapiga kura wapya 3,976 pekee. Aliongeza kuwa Tume inalenga kuongeza wapiga kura 183,000 zaidi katika maeneo yote sita ya Mombasa, ili kufikisha jumla ya wapiga kura 825,000 kufikia mwaka 2027. Tume inalenga kuongeza idadi ya wapiga kura waliosajiliwa katika

kila eneo bunge kama ifuata-vyo: Changamwe kutoka 93,561 mwaka 2022 hadi 120,241; Jomvu kutoka 75,085 hadi 96,495; Kisauni kutoka 135,276 hadi 173,851; Nyali kutoka 124,235 hadi 160,000; Likoni kutoka 94,764 hadi 121,786; na Mvita kutoka 118,974 hadi 152,900. Mwenyekiti alitaja kuwa idadi ndogo ya usajili kote nchini inatokana na upatikanaji mdogo wa huduma, kwani zoezi hilo kwa sasa linafanyika tu katika ofisi za tume za maeneo bunge, hivyo kuwazuia vijana wengi wanaoishi mbali kufika kusajiliwa.

“Lakini ili kutatua tatizo hilo, mara tu tutakapokamilisha chaguzi ndogo tarehe 27 mwezi huu, tutazindua zoezi la usajili wa wapiga kura kwa wingi, tunaloliita mara nyingine Usajili Ulioboreshwa wa Wapiga Kura. Mara tu tutakapolizindua, tutasogeza vituo vya usajili karibu na vitongoji,” alisema Ethekeon. Alibainisha kuwa hatua hiyo itarahisisha upatikanaji wa huduma na kuwahamasisha vijana wengi zaidi kujisajili. Aliongeza kuwa, ili kuimarisha juhudi hizo, IEBC itashirikiana na Idara ya Usajili wa Taifa ili kuharakisha

utoaji wa vitambulisho vya taifa kwa raia wanaostahili. Sambamba na ECVR, IEBC itazindua kampeni kabambe ya elimu ya wapiga kura na kuhimiza mashirika ya kiraia, vyombo vya

habari na wanamitandao kushiriki katika kuhamasisha vijana. “Tunawahitaji mtoke na kutusaidia kuwafikia vijana wengi iwezekanavyo ili tuongeze idadi ya waliojiandikisha, lakini pia kuhakikisha uchaguzi wa haki na wa kuaminika ambao sote tunautamani,” alisema. Aidha, aliwataka Wakenya kusaidia kujenga tena imani kwa tume mpya ya IEBC, akihakikishia kuwa tume imeweka mifumo madhubuti ya kuzuia udanganyifu wa uchaguzi. “Tunazo hatua za uwajibikaji. Tunao waangalizi. Tuna mfumo wa kiteknolojia wa utambuzi wa wapiga kura. Na bila shaka, mfumo wa utangazaji wa matokeo, ambao ni thabiti sana,” alisisitiza. Ethekeon pia aliwaonya wanasiasa na vyombo vya habari dhidi ya kusambaza madai yasiyothibitishwa ambayo yanaweza kuwakatisha tamaa wapiga kura. Aliyakumbusha vyombo vya habari kuangazia masuala yanayowahusu wananchi badala ya miujadala ya kisiasa inayogawa jamii. “Vijana, wanablogu, tunapaswa kusimulia hadithi yetu. Tusiruhusu wanasiasa waamue mazungumzo, kwa sababu tukifanya hivyo, tutapoteza imani katika kila kitu,” aliongeza. Akitathmini Uchaguzi Mkuu wa 2022 na ule wa 2017, Ethekeon alibainisha kushuka kwa

idadi ya wapiga kura kutoka asilimia 78.9 hadi 64, jambo alilohusisha na kutojitokeza kwa vijana kupiga kura. “Hiyo ni hali ya kutojali ambayo haifai kwa nchi yetu, kwa sababu kama watu milioni mbili hawajitokezi, basi kuna tazitizo. Tunapaswa kuwaelimisha wananchi kuhusu umuhimu wa kushiriki katika michakato ya kidemokrasia kama raia wenye uwajibikaji,” alisema. Afisa Mtendaji Mkuu wa IEBC, Marjan Hussein, pia alieleza wasiwasi wake kuhusu idadi ndogo ya wanaojisajili, akisema kuwa vijana wanaotaka mabadiliko wanapaswa kuyadhihirisha kwa vitendo kupitia kura. “Vijana wana uwezo wa kuleta mabadiliko ya kweli katika nchi hii, na ili kufanya hivyo, lazima sauti zenu zisikike. Njia pekee sauti zenu zina-weza kusikika ni kupitia kura, si kwa kupigana,” alisema. Mkurugenzi Mtendaji wa Vocal Africa, Hussein Khalid, aliahidi kushirikiana na IEBC katika kuhamasisha vijana, ambao wanatarajiwa kuunda takriban asilimia 56 ya wapiga kura watakaostahili. “Vijana peke yao wanaweza kumpa mtu ushindi, na wanaweza kuamua mwelekeo wa nchi hata kama kila mtu mwingine atapiga kura. Lakini iwapo vijana watajitokeza kwa wingi, wao ndio watakuwa maamuzi,” alisema Khalid.

Serikali yaonya watumishi wanaodai pesa kutoa huduma

Katibu wa Uhamiaji na Huduma za Raia, Dkt. Belio Kipsang, ametoa onyo kali kwa watumishi wa umma wanaodai malipo ya fedha taslimu kwa huduma za serikali, akisema Kenya sasa imehamia kikamilifu kwenye mfumo wa malipo usiotumia fedha taslimu. Dkt. Kipsang alisema kukamatwa na kushtakiwa kunawasubiri wale watakaopatikana wakihusishwa na madai ya malipo ya fedha taslimu, akitaja tabia hiyo kuwa ni ya udanganyifu. Aliongeza kuwa watumishi wote wa umma wanajua kuwa Hazina ya Kitaifa tayari imeungani-sha ukusanyaji wa ada zote za serikali kupitia kuanzishwa kwa nambari moja ya Pay Bill. Katibu huyo Mkuu alibainisha kuwa mfumo huo unawawezesha Wakenya kufanya malipo kutoka kwenye pochi zao za kidijitali kupitia tovuti rasmi ya serikali ya eCitizen. Akihutubia Maafisa wa Utawala wa Serikali Kuu (NGAOs) katika Chuo Kikuu cha Maasai Mara, Kaunti ya Narok, wakati wa mkutano wa kupanga mikakati ya kuongeza matumizi ya huduma za serikali, Dkt.

Kipsang alieleza kuwa kwa kuwa jukwaa la malipo ya kidijitali limeunganishwa na mifumo yote ya malipo ya kielektroniki nchini, ikiwemo huduma za pesa kwa simu, basi malipo ya fedha taslimu hayakubaliki tena. “Yeyote anayejidai kutoza au kulipa huduma yoyote ya serikali kwa fedha taslimu anajihusisha na kitendo cha ulaghai. Mojawapo ya sababu tulizohamisha huduma zetu kuwa za kidijitali ni kuzuia athari nyingi, hasa kutokuwasilishwa kwa fedha zinazok-

usanywa na wale wanaopaswa kufanya hivyo,” alisema. Dkt. Kipsang alisisitiza kuwa: “Malipo yote ya huduma za serikali lazima yafanywe kupitia eCitizen.go.ke. Nambari rasmi ya Pay Bill ya Serikali ya Kenya ni 222222. Watumishi wa umma wanaoomba malipo ya fedha taslimu wanavunja sheria.” Aliwahimiza watumishi wa umma waliopewa jukumu la kutoa huduma kwa wananchi kudumisha uadilifu, uwazi na taaluma, akionya kuwa afisa

yeyote atakayepatikana akihusishwa na vitendo vinavyoharibu taswira ya serikali kwa kudai fedha taslimu kwa huduma atachukuliwa hatua kali mara moja. “Enzi za kuwahamisha maafisa wa serikali wanaojihusisha na vitendo vya ufisadi zimepita. Wale watakaopatikana na hatia watafutwa kazi na kushtakiwa mahakamani. Tulikubali mfumo huu usiotumia fedha taslimu kama njia ya kuziba mianya inayoruhusu ufisadi kustawi serikalini,” alitangaza Katibu Mkuu. Dkt. Kipsang alibainisha kuwa mabadiliko ya kwenda kwenye mfumo usiotumia fedha taslimu yanakusudia kudhibiti wizi, kurahisisha ukusanyaji wa mapato, kuongeza ufanisi na uwazi, na kupunguza ufisadi unaohusiana na ushughulikaji wa fedha taslimu. “Kwa kutumia eCitizen, tumeonyesha kuwa huduma za serikali zinaweza kutolewa kwa ufanisi, kwa uwazi na kwa haki. Jukwaa la eCitizen limekua kwa kasi na kuwa lango kuu kwa Wakenya wanaotafuta huduma mbalimbali za serikali, ikiwemo pasipoti, leseni za udereva, na ulipaji wa kodi,” aliongeza. Katibu alitaja kuwa zaidi ya huduma 22,000 zimeingizwa kwenye mfumo huo, na mabilioni ya shilingi yanapitia humo, jambo linaloufanya kuwa moja ya majukwaa ya kidijitali yenye shughuli nyingi zaidi nchini. Alifafanua kuwa fedha zote zinazokusanywa kupitia eCitizen hupelekwa moja kwa moja katika Benki Kuu ya Kenya.

TSC yawafunza tena walimu 52,000 kwa ajili ya Shule Pevu

Tume ya Huduma za Walimu (TSC) imewafunza zaidi ya walimu wakuu wa shule za upili 52,000 kote nchini, ili kujiandaa kwa utekelezaji wa Elimu Inayotegemea Umahiri (CBE) katika shule za upili za juu. Naibu Mkurugenzi Mwandamizi wa Maendeleo ya Kitaaluma ya Walimu katika Tume hiyo, Bw. Andrew Mwathi, alisema idadi hiyo inajumuisha walimu walioko katika shule za sekondari za kawaida, taasisi za Elimu Maalum (SNE), na vituo vya mafunzo ya ufundi, ambao wanatarajiwa kufundisha Kidato cha 10 hadi 12 kuanzia Januari 2026. Bw. Mwathi alibainisha kuwa TSC inashirikiana kikamilifu na Kituo cha Hisabati, Sayansi na Teknolojia cha Afrika (CEMASTE) kuendesha mafunzo ya kitaifa ya walimu wa STEM (Sayansi, Teknolojia, Uhandisi na Hisabati) kama msingi wa CBE. Aliongeza kuwa mpango wa kuwajengea walimu uwezo umejikita katika kuwaandaa na kuwaelekeza walimu kulingana na njia mpya za masomo zilizotolewa chini ya Mtaala wa Elimu Inayotegemea Umahiri (CBC). Naibu Mkurugenzi huyo alieleza kuwa washiriki 52,452 wamegawanywa katika maeneo makuu matatu ya masomo: Sayansi, Teknolojia, Uhandisi na Hisabati (STEM), ambayo inajumuisha sayansi safi, sayansi tumizi na masomo ya ufundi; Sayansi za Kijamii, zikiwemo lugha, masomo ya binadamu, na biashara; Sanaa na Sayansi ya Michezo, inayojumuisha muziki, sanaa za kuona na one-sho, na elimu ya viungo. Akizungumza katika Kituo

cha Rasilimali za Kilimo (ARC) cha Chuo Kikuu cha Egerton wakati wa warsha ambapo wakufunzi 102 wa kaunti walipokea mafunzo ya maandalizi kwa ajili ya uhamisho wa wanafunzi wa Shule za Upili za Chini (JSS) kwenda Shule za Upili za Juu kuanzia mwaka ujao, Bw. Mwathi alisema zoezi la kuwanoa walimu ni sehemu muhimu ya kuhakikisha kuwa walimu wamepata ujuzi na maarifa ya kutosha kutekeleza mtaala wa CBC kwa ufanisi katika shule za upili za juu. Jumla ya wakufunzi 290 wa kaunti walipokea mafunzo hayo kupitia mpango wenye kaulimbiu "Kuimarisha Uwezo wa Wakuu wa Idara za STEM Kusimamia Mpito wa Elimu Inayotegemea Umahiri." Mafunzo hayo yalifanyika katika vituo vitatu nchini: Chuo Kikuu cha Egerton (Nakuru), makao makuu ya CEMASTE (Nairobi), na Hoteli ya Golf (Kakamega). Mafunzo yalitolewa na wakufunzi kutoka CEMASTE, Tume ya Huduma za Walimu (TSC), Baraza la Mitihani la Kitaifa (KNEC), Taasisi ya Elimu Maalum ya Kenya (KISE), na wakufunzi wa kaunti. Wakufunzi wa kaunti wanapewa mafunzo haya ili waweze kufikisha maarifa hayo kwa Wakuu wa Idara (HoDs) katika shule zao. Bw. Mwathi alieleza kuwa HoDs wako katika nafasi ya kimmkakati ya kuwezesha utekelezaji wa mtaala kwa ma-

fanikio, hivyo kuna haja ya kuwapa uwezo wa kusimamia mabadiliko hayo ipasavyo. Alisema kuwa wakufunzi wa kaunti waliopokea mafunzo hayo watakuwa msaada muhimu na watachukua nafasi ya wakuu wa shule watakaostaafu kabla ya mabadiliko mapya kuanza kutekelezwa. "TSC itaendelea kujenga uwezo wa walimu wote ili kuhakikisha mpito unafanikiwa," aliongeza. Mafunzo ya wakufunzi wa kaunti yaliongozwa na Wizara ya Elimu na kufanikishwa na CEMASTE. Naibu Mkurugenzi huyo alibainisha kuwa CBC tayari ime-tekelezwa katika ngazi ya elimu ya awali, msingi na sekondari ya chini, huku mafunzo ya walimu wa shule za upili yakikamilisha awamu ya mwisho ya utekelezaji wake, wakati kundi la kwanza la wanafunzi wa CBC litakapohamia sekondari ya juu Januari 2026. Aliongeza kuwa, kwa kuzingatia Dira ya Kenya 2030 inayolenga kutoa elimu, mafunzo na utafiti wenye ushindani wa kimataifa kwa ajili ya maendeleo ya taifa na ustawi wa mtu binafsi, TSC, CEMASTE na washirika wake wanaendelea kuboresha ubora wa elimu ya STEM nchini. "Lengo ni kuboresha ubora wa ufundishaji wa hisabati na sayansi kwa kuongeza ujuzi wa kimataala kwa walimu, jambo litakalowasaidia wanafunzi wa Kenya kupata na kukuza umahiri muhimu kama vile mawasiliano na ushirikiano, fikra makini na utatuzi wa matatizo, ubunifu na mawazo, uraia, ujasiri binafsi, ujuzi wa kidijitali na uwezo wa kujifunza," alifafanua. Bw. Mwathi aliongeza kuwa kipengele cha kipekee cha STEM ni mchango wake katika kuboresha maisha ya Wakenya binafsi

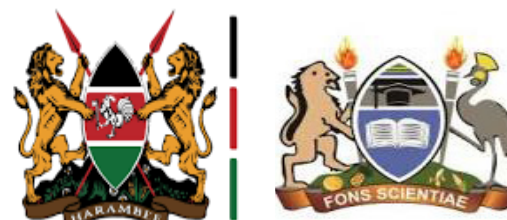

ukubwa wa mashamba katika Kaunti ya Nyeri na maeneo jirani hauongezeki. Alieleza kuwa KEMIS itawaunganisha taasisi zote za kielimu—kuanzia shule za chekechea na msingi hadi shule za upili za awali na za juu, TVET, na vyuo vikuu—na kuruhusu kufuatilia kwa wakati halisi safari za kielimu za wanafunzi. “Kila mwanafunzi atakuwa na kitambulisho cha kidijitali cha kipekee, kitakachotwezesha kufuatilia historia yake ya elimu kwa kubofya kitufe kimoja, kuanzia shule ya kwanza aliyohudhuria hadi chuo kikuu,” alisema Prof. Bitok. Katibu Mkuu aliongeza kuwa mfumo

huo utaunganisha mashirika yote muhimu ya elimu, ikiwemo Baraza la Miti-hani la Kitaifa (KNEC), Taasisi ya Maendeleo ya Mtaala (KICD), na vyuo vikuu, akikainisha kuwa hatua hii inalingana kuongeza ufanisi, uwajibikaji, na upan-gaji unaotegemea data katika sekta ya elimu. Itawaleta pamoja wataalamu wakuu kutoka pande mbalim-bali za dunia kushiriki utafiti, mawazo na ubunifu utakaosukuma ukuaji wa kiteknolojia Kenya,” alisema Bitok. Kulingana na Katibu Mkuu, mkutano huo hautaongeza tu hadhi ya Kenya katika sekta ya teknolojia duniani, bali pia utae-ndeleza ukuaji wa uchumi kupitia ubu-nifu, ushirikiano na kubadilishana ujuzi. Hekta 103,000 zalengwa katika kampeni ya kurejesha Mlima Elgon

Serikali imezindua mpango wa kitaifa wa kuratibu urejeshaji wa mfumo wa ikolojia wa Mlima Elgon, mlima muhimu unaotoa maji kwa jamii zinazopatikana katika Kaunti za Bungoma na Trans Nzoia. Waziri wa Mazingira, Mabadiliko ya Tabianchi, na Misitu, Dkt. Deborah Barasa, alitangaza kuwa serikali inalenga kurekebisha zaidi ya hekta 103,000 za misitu na mashamba yaliyoharibika katika miongo miwili iliyayo. Dkt. Barasa alibainisha kuwa jitihada za urejeshaji zinalingana na Amri ya Rais ya kupanda miti bilioni 15 ifikapo 2032, pamoja na Mpango wa Kitaifa wa Hatua za Mabadiliko ya Tabianchi na Ajenda ya Mageuzi ya Uchumi Kutoka Chini (BETA). “Mlima Elgon umeathirika na ukataji miti usio na mpangilio na matumizi duni ya ardhi, yakipelekea kupotea kwa bioanuwai na kupungua kwa mtiririko wa maji. Lazima tushirikiane kuruhusu Mlima Elgon kuinuka tena—kijani, chenye nguvu, na chenye uhai,” alisisitiza Waziri. Alibainisha kuwa Mlima Elgon ulipewa hadhi ya Hifadhi ya Biosphere ya Mipaka ya Mataifa mnamo 2023 na Baraza la UNESCO la Mtu na Biosphere (MAB), moja kati ya hifadhi mbili pekee barani Afrika zi-

nazoshirikiana kati ya Kenya na Uganda. Aidha, Dkt. Barasa alionya kuwa kuendelea kwa uharibifu kunaweza kutishia utambulisho huu wa kimataifa pamoja na maisha ya mamilioni yanayoiategemea. Alifichua kuwa Wizarara imeniteua Katibu Mkuu (PS) wa Madini, Bw. Harry Kimtai, kuwa Mlinzi na Kiongozi wa Jitihada za Urejeshaji wa Mlima Elgon, ili kuratibu juhudi za kitaifa na za mitaa. “Kama raia wa eneo hili, PS Kimtai anaelewa changamoto za mazingira na kijamii zinazokabili jamii za mlima na yupo katika nafasi nzuri ya kuhamasisha wadau kuelekea suluhisho endelevu,” alibainisha Dkt. Barasa. Aidha, aliwataka washirika wa maendeleo, serikali za kaunti, na sekta binafsi kushirikiana na Wizarara kuhakikisha matokeo endelevu. “Mlima Elgon ni chanzo

Kupitia makubaliano hayo, chuo hicho kitaunganisha matrekta ya ubora wa juu yaliyobuniwa mahsusi kulingana na mahitaji ya uendeshaji, aina ya ardhi, na kazi za mashamba au miradi husika. Matrekta haya maalum yanatofautiana na matrekta ya kawaida ya matumizi ya jumla, ambayo hubuniwa kwa matumizi mbalimbali. Mkataba huo ulisainiwa na Makamu wa Chansela wa Chuo Kikuu cha Egerton, Profesa Isaac Kibwage; Jaclyn Schess na Mike Christensen kutoka kampuni ya IROC Tractors yenye makao Idaho, Marekani; na Bill Bough Miller pamoja na Emmanuel Juma, Meneja wa Nchi wa Agypro Kenya. Mwenyekiti wa Baraza la Chuo Kikuu, Profesa James Sang, alisema kuwa kwa kuunganisha matrekta ya IROC hapa nchini, taasisi hiyo inalenga kuwapatia wakulima

wa Kenya vifaa vya kilimo vya kiwango cha kimataifa. Profesa Sang aliongeza kuwa mpango huo utapunguza utegemezi wa kazi za mikono, kuboresha mbinu za kilimo, kuongeza mavuno, na kuleta manufaa ya kudumu kwa uchumi wa eneo hilo. Alisisitiza kuwa mradi huo, unaongozwa na Kitivo cha Uhandisi na Teknolojia, unaonyesha nguvu ya ushirikiano katika kuendelea ubunifu na maendeleo endelevu. Aidha, alibainisha kuwa ushirikiano huo unatarajiwa kuchechea viwanda, kusaidia katika uundaji wa nafasi za ajira — hasa katika sekta ya utengenezaji wa mashine za kilimo — kukuza ujuzi wa kiufundi na kimitambo, kuhamasisha ongezeko la thamani, na kundeza matumizi ya mashine katika kilimo cha Kenya. “Kwa kuunganisha matrekta ya IROC hapa nchini, hatuiboresha tu matumizi ya mashine za kilimo, bali pia tunaimarisha nafasi ya Kenya kama kitovu cha uzalishaji wa mashine za kilimo katika ukanda huu,” aliongeza mwenyekiti huyo. Profesa Sang alizungumza wakati alipoongoza wajumbe wa Baraza la Chuo kutembelea na kukagua maendeleo ya uunganishaji wa trekta ya mfano (prototype) inayotengenezwa na wanafunzi wa uhandisi na wahadhiri wao katika Kitivo cha Uhandisi na Teknolojia. Wataalamu walionyesha sehemu mbalimbali za trekta hiyo, ikiwemo fremu (chassis), injini, mfumo wa haidroliki, na jukwaa la mwendeshaji, wakiibainisha kuwa muundo wake

wa modular na upatikanaji wa baadhi ya vipuri kutoka hapa nchini utapunguza gharama za uzalishaji na kufanya matengenezo kuwa rahisi zaidi. “Treta ya mfano kwa sasa inaendeshwa na injini yenye nguvu ya farasi 22, huku wahandisi na wanafunzi wakiipima kulingana na hali tofauti za ardhi nchini Kenya,” alifafanua Prof. Sang. Mwenyekiti huyo alibaini kuwa jamii za wakulima barani Afrika zenye trekta moja tu hupanda mazao yao hadi mara 40 kwa kasi zaidi, hivyo kupunguza gharama za upandaji kwa takriban theluthi moja na hatimaye kuongeza uzalishaji mara tatu. Hata hivyo, alisema kuwa kwa mashamba mengi barani Afrika ambayo ni madogo — yenye wastani wa hekta 1.3 — kununua au kukodisha

matrekta makubwa ya kibiashara siyo jambo la kiuchumi wala la vitendo. Alieleza kuwa trekta hiyo mpya imeundwa ikiwa na sehemu mbili za kuunganisha vifaa vya kilimo, moja mbele na nyingine nyuma, ili kumwezesha dereva kufanya kazi mbili kwa wakati mmoja bila kusimama kubadilisha vifaa. Hii inawaruhusu wakulima kufanya shughuli kama kulima, kupanda, na kuandaa udongo kwa pamoja, hivyo kupunguza muda na nguvu zinazotumika kubadilisha zana. Profesa Sang, akiwa ameandamana na Makamu wa Chansela Profesa Isaac Kibwage na wajumbe wanane wa baraza hilo, alisema kuwa katika sekta ya kilimo, mashamba madogo yatapata manufaa makubwa kwa kutumia trekta hiyo katika kazi kama kulima, kupanda, na kusafirisha bidhaa kutoka eneo moja hadi jingine. Alieleza kuwa muundo wa trekta hiyo ni mdogo, jambo linalorahisisha uendeshaji wake katika maeneo yenye nafasi ndogo, na kwa kuwa si nzito

sana, haitaharibu udongo. Sang aliongeza kuwa trekta hiyo imeundwa kuhakikisha wakulima wanapanda mazao yao kwa wakati, hatua inayoweza kuongeza mavuno kwa kati ya asilimia 12 hadi 69. Wakati wa maonyesho hayo, Baraza la Chuo Kikuu lilisisitiza sharti kuu: licha ya kuunganishwa hapa nchini, gharama ya trekta lazima izingatie viwango vya kimataifa na iwe nafuu ili iweze kufikiwa na wakulima wa Kenya. Makamu wa Chansela, Profesa Kibwage, alisisitiza umuhimu wa ushirikiano huo katika kukuza ubunifu na kutoa suluhisho la vitendo kwa changamoto za uboreshaji wa kilimo. Alisema kuwa ushirikiano huo unapaswa kuhitimishwa kwa kuanzishwa kwa kitengo cha kuunganisha matrekta katika Chuo Kikuu cha Egerton, kitakachowezesha uuzaji wa vipuri na matrekta kamili kwa wakulima wa ndani.

Hatua hii ya kinkakati inalenga kuboresha uwezo wa kukabiliana na dharura kando ya Barabara Kuu ya Mombasa-Nairobi, ambayo ni njia muhimu ya usafiri yenye msongamano mkubwa na ajali za mara kwa mara. hatari zaidi nchini Kenya. “Nawapongeza St. John Ambulance kwa mpango huu wa kuokoa maisha ambao utasaidia waathiriwa wa ajali kando ya barabara hii yenye shughuli nyingi,” alisema Waziri wa Utumishi wa Umma, Geoffrey Ruku, ambaye aliongoza uzinduzi huo mjini Emali. “Ninaweza kufichua hapa kuwa serikali kuu ina mipango ya kujenga Hospitali mpya ya Dharura (Trauma Hospital) mjini Emali ili kuboresha huduma za afya za dharura kando ya njia hii,” aliongeza Ruku. Katika maeneo ya Naivasha, mapinduzi tulivu yanaendelea kuchukua nafasi — manyoya baada ya manyoya. Wanasayansi wa Shirika la Utafiti wa Kilimo na Mifugo Nchini Kenya (KALRO) wamezindua kizazi kipya cha kuku wa kienyeji ambao si tu wanakua haraka na kutaga mayai mengi, bali pia wameundwa mahsusi kustahimili mazingira ya vijijini nchini Kenya. Lengo kuu ni kuibadilisha Kenya kuwa “Jamhuri ya Kuku,” ambako kila kaya inaweza kustawi kwa kutumia lishe bora na ya bei nafuu inayotokana na ufugaji wa kuku. Kwa miongo kadhaa, kuku wa kienyeji amekuwa zaidi ya chakula — amekuwa ishara ya

ukarimu, urithi, na bidii. Leo, anageuka kuwa nguzo ya mageuzi ya kilimo. Zaidi ya asilimia 60 ya kaya za vijijini hutege-mea ufugaji wa kuku kwa chakula na kipato, jambo linalofanya mafanikio ya KALRO kuwa ya wakati muafaka zaidi. Licha ya ongezeko la mahitaji, sekta ya ufugaji kuku nchini Kenya imekuwa ikis-uasua. Nchi huzalisha takriban kilo milioni 110 za nyama ya kuku na mayai milioni 7.2 kwa mwaka — kiwango cha chini sana ikilinganishwa na mahitaji ya kitaifa ya kilo milioni 648 za nyama na mayai bilioni 9.72. Mkenya wa kawaida hula wastani wa kilo 1.7 za nyama ya kuku kwa mwaka, ikilinganishwa na mapendekezo ya Shirika la Chakula na Kilimo Duniani (FAO) ya kilo 12.

Wafanyabiashara katika soko la Malaba wana sababu ya kutabasamu baada ya Rais William Ruto kuzindua ujenzi wa soko la kisasa lenye thamani ya shilingi milioni 350 katika eneo hilo. Kiongozi wa Taifa aliweka jiwe la msingi, ishara kwamba ujenzi utaanza mara moja katika eneo la ekari 1.2 katika mji wa mpakani. Soko la Kati la Kimkakati la Malaba litakuwa na miundombinu ya kisasa ikiwemo vyumba vya kuhifadha bidhaa, vyumba vya baridi kwa mazao mabichi, na vyumba vya kunyonyesha akina mama. Miradi hii inaonyesha dhamira ya serikali kubadilisha uchumi wa maeneo kupitia maendeleo jumuishi na ukuaji wa miundombinu. Aidha, miradi hii ni ushahidi wa kujitolea kwa serikali kuboresha mazingira ya biashara na kupanua sekta ya biashara ndogo na za kati (SME) kuwa kitovu cha viwanda kitakachoweza kuchukua nguvu kazi ya maelfu ya Wakenya wasio na ajira

Serikali yatenga Sh29 milioni kwa waathiriwa wa mafuriko

Mamlaka ya Udhhibiti wa Nishati na Petroli (EPRA) imeanzisha mashauriano ya kitaifa ya umma kuhusu pendekezo lililotolewa na Kampuni ya Mabomba ya Petroli ya Kenya (KPC) la kupitia upya viwango vya ushuru wa usafirishaji wa mafuta kupitia bomba na uhifadhi wa sekondari kwa kipindi cha udhibiti cha 2025-2028. Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa EPRA, Daniel Kiptoo, alisema kuwa zoezi hilo lina lengo la kuendeleza uwazi na ushirikishwaji katika kuamua viwango vipya vya ushuru, kwa mujibu wa Sheria ya Nishati ya mwaka 2019 na Katiba ya Kenya ya mwaka 2010. “Ajenda yetu ni kujadili viwango vya Ushuru wa Usafirishaji kupitia Bomba na Uhifadhi wa Sekondari kama vilivyopendekezwa na Kampuni ya Mabomba ya Petroli ya Kenya. Mapitio haya yanauia kuonyesha mabadiliko katika mazingira ya uendeshaji huku yakihakikisha uwiano kati ya urejeshaji wa gharama kwa Miundombinu Muhimu na upatikanaji wa bidhaa za petroli kwa bei nafuu kwa watumiaji,” alisema Kiptoo, katika hotuba iliyosomwa kwa niaba yake na Mkuu wa Idara ya Bei na Ushuru wa EPRA, Waweru Karanja, wakati wa wadau uliofanyika Nairobi. Alifichua kuwa EPRA imepokea ombi kutoka KPC likitaka idhini ya ongezeko la asilimia 2.4 kutoka ushuru wa sasa wa Sh5.44 kwa kila mita ya ujazo kwa kila kilomita, uliopitishwa Septemba 2022 kwa kipindi kinachoishia Juni 2025. Pendekezo jipya, alisema, litahusu kipindi kijacho cha miaka mitatu kuanzia Julai 2025 hadi Juni 2028. Kiptoo alisisitiza kuwa mashauriano na wadau ni hitaji la kisheria na kikatiba lililobuniwa kuhakikisha sauti zote zinasikika kabla ya kufanya mabadiliko yoyote ya ushuru. “Mchakato huu unaonyesha dhamira yetu ya pamoja ya uwazi, uwajibikaji na ushiriki katika kufanya maamuzi ya kiregulatary,” aliongeza. Mkurugenzi huyo KPC alifichua kuwa KPC inaendesha mtandao wa bomba wenye urefu wa kilomita 1,342, unaosafirisha bidhaa za petroli kutoka Mom-basa kupitia Nairobi

hadhi Nakuru, Eldoret na Kisumu, na kuhudumia kampuni za uzazi wa mafuta chini ya viwango vya ushuru vina vyodhibitiwa na EPRA. Alibainisha kuwa ushuru wa sasa umeongezwa zaidi ya kipindi chake cha awali ili kuruhusu kukamilika kwa mchakato wa mapitio hayo. Lengo kuu la EPRA, alieleza, ni kuhakikisha urejeshaji wa gharama za uwekezaji na uendeshaji wa miundombinu huku ikilinda maslahi ya watumiaji. Huku dunia ikiadhimisha Siku ya Kimataifa ya kumaliza Utawala wa Kiimla na Uhalifu dhidi ya Waandishi wa Habari, Baraza la Vyombo vya Habari Kenya (MCK) linaitaka ulinzi thabiti zaidi kwa waandishi wa habari dhidi ya ukatili unaofanywa kwa kutumia Teknolojia ya Akili Bandia (AI) unaolenga kijinsia, huku likionyesha wasiwasi mkubwa juu ya hatari zinazongezeka zinazowakumba waandishi wa habari wanawake, mtandaoni na nje ya mtandao. Baraza hilo lilionya kwamba unyanyasaji mtandaoni na ukatili unaotumiwa kwa AI dhidi ya waandishi wa habari wanawake mara nyingi hau-

chukuliwi hatua, jambo linalosababisha madhara halisi duniani, na lilisisitiza haja ya haraka ya kuunda nafasi salama za kidijitali kwa wahabari. Mkurugenzi Mtendaji wa MCK, Bw. David Omwoyo, alithibitisha dhamira thabiti ya Baraza ya kuendeleza uhuru wa vyombo vya habari na kulinda waandishi wa habari katika majukwaa yote. Akizungumza Nakuru wakati wa maadhimisho yenye kaulimbiu "Chat GBV: Kuongeza Uelewa juu ya Ukatili unaofanywa kwa AI unaolenga Kijinsia dhidi ya Waandishi wa Habari Wanawake," Bw. Omwoyo alisema unyanyasaji unaotokana na teknolojia unasababisha wanawake na wasichana katika vyombo vya habari kujizua wenyewe kutoandika au kuripoti baadhi ya taarifa,

hivyo kunyamaza sauti zao na kudhoofisha demokrasia. Alitaka kuwaleta gereza na kuwashtaki wale wote wanahusishwa na mashambulizi ya hivi karibuni dhidi ya waandishi wa habari, huku akisisitiza ushirikiano kati ya serikali na vyombo vya habari badala ya konfronti. "Tunahitaji msingi wa pamoja kati ya serikali na vyombo vya habari, si kuashiria hatia. Vyote vinahitaji kila kimoja kwa manufaa ya taifa," alisema. Bw. Omwoyo alisisitiza kwamba Mamlaka Huru ya Ukaguzi wa Polisi (IPOA) ipewe mamlaka ya

Bila uwajibikaji, hakuwezi kuwa na uhuru. Bila vyombo vya habari huru, hakuwezi kuwa na demokrasia

kuchunguza na kushtaki kwa uhuru ukiukaji wa sheria na maadili unaofanywa na waandishi wa habari, huku Bunge likiandaa sheria madhubuti za usalama ili kuhalalisha unyanyasaji wa waandishi wa habari. Alibainisha kuwa kuongezeka kwa unyanyasaji mtandaoni unaolenga waandishi wa habari wanawake unaendelea bila kuchukuliwa hatua, mara nyingi ukisababisha madhara ya kimwili. "Nafasi za kidijitali lazima ziwe salama kwa wale wanaokusanya na kuripoti habari. Wakati waandishi wa habari wanyamazishwa, sote tunapoteza sauti yetu. Tuniwani pamoja kulinda uhuru wa vyombo vya habari, tusiweke haki, na kuhakikisha wale wanaosema ukweli kwa wanasiasa wanaweza kufanya hivyo bila hofu," alisema. Akitaja kupungua kwa cheo cha Kenya katika Orodha ya Uhuru wa Vyombo vya Habari Duniani, kutoka nafasi ya 69 mwaka 2022 hadi 117 mwaka 2025, Bw. Omwoyo alionya kwamba nchi inaweza kujiunga na orodha ya mataifa ambapo vyombo vya habari vinadhibitiwa au kunyamazishwa ikiwa marekebisha ya dharura hayatakelezwa. Alitangaza mpango wa kuanzisha mashtaka binafsi dhidi ya wahalifu wa ukatili dhidi ya waandishi wa habari kama sehemu ya juhudi kubwa za kuimarisha uwajibikaji na kupambana na utamaduni wa kutokukabiliwa na matokeo. "Bila uwajibikaji, hakuwezi kuwa na uhuru. Bila vyombo vya habari huru, hakuwezi kuwa na demokrasia," alitangaza. "MCK, kwa ushirikiano na Shirikisho la Waandishi wa Habari Kenya (KUI), Ofisi ya Wakili Mkuu (ODPP), Mahakama, na Wakala wa Ulinzi

wa Mashahidi (WPA), inafanya kazi kuhakikisha haki inatendeka na kuongeza usalama wa waandishi wa habari." Bw. Omwoyo alifichua kwamba MCK inaendelea kufuatilia na kurekodi kesi zote za vitisho na mashambulizi dhidi ya wahabari, ikihakikisha hatua za kisheria na mbinu bora za ulinzi kupitia ushirikiano na vyombo vya utekelezaji wa sheria na vyombo vya kisheria. Mkurugenzi Msaidizi wa Katiba Institute, Bi. Christine Kuria, alisisitiza kwamba Katiba ya 2010 inahakikisha uhuru wa vyombo vya habari chini ya Kifungu cha 34, huku Kifungu cha 33 kinakulinda uhuru wa maoni na Kifungu cha 35 kihakikisha haki ya raia kupata taarifa. Pamoja, alisema, masharti haya yanaweka vyombo vya habari kuwa haki ya kikatiba, si kipaumbele.

Alibainisha kwamba kwa wale walioathirika na kuripotiwa kwa vyombo vya habari, kuna njia halali za kupata haki. "Sheria ya Baraza la Vyombo vya Habari (2013) ilianzisha Tume ya Malalamiko ya Vyombo vya Habari, yenye mamlaka ya kutatua migogoro bila unyanyasaji. Sheria ya Kudhuru Sifa (Cap 36) inaruhusu fidia za kiraia kwa madhara ya hadhi, na Sheria ya Upatikanaji wa Taarifa (2016) inahimiza uwazi. Kenya tayari ina zana za kisheria kushughulikia malalamiko kwa njia halali. Kutishia na kutumia nguvu kinyume cha sheria waziwazi," alisema. Bi. Kuria pia alikumbusha kwamba Kenya, kama mkataba wa Kifungu cha 19 cha Mkataba wa Kimataifa wa Haki za Kiraia na Kisiasa (ICCPR) na Katiba ya Afrika ya Haki za Binadamu na Watu, ina wajibu wa kulinda uhuru wa vyombo vya habari.

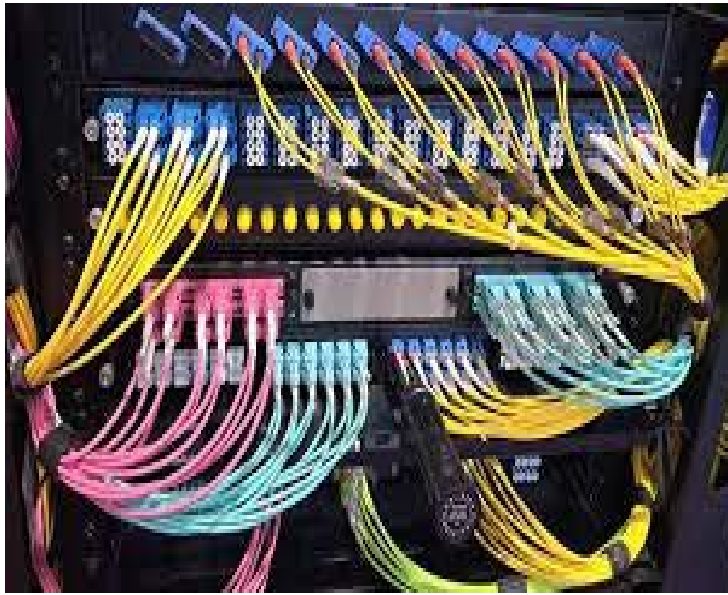

Roll-out of Automated Payment Plan for Tax Liabilities

The Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA) wishes to inform taxpayers and the general public that, as part of its ongoing commitment to enhance convenience and promote compliance, it is introducing a new **Automated Payment Plan (APP)** mechanism. This system-driven solution enables eligible taxpayers to settle outstanding tax liabilities, including principal tax, penalties and interest, through structured instalments.

To qualify for the APP, taxpayers must meet the following conditions:

1. Possess a valid KRA PIN and be fully compliant with iTax registration and profile updates.
2. Have a confirmed tax liability in the KRA system that is not subject to active litigation or appeal.
3. Demonstrate genuine inability or impracticality to settle the full liability in a single payment.
4. Submit a proposed instalment schedule via iTax or other designated KRA portals, subject to system validation.
5. Ensure the instalment period does not exceed **six months**.

Failure to adhere to the agreed payment schedule may lead to termination of the plan and trigger enforcement actions. These may include revocation of the Tax Compliance Certificate and other legal recovery measures.

Kampuni ya China kuzindua kiwanda cha mbolea ya kijani kibichi cha Sh100B

NA ERASTUS GICHOHI (KNA)

Kampuni moja ya Ki-china itaanza shughuli zake kuanzia mwaka ujao katika kiwanda chake cha Sh100 bilioni kilichoko Olkaria, Naivasha, kitakachozali-sha mbolea ya green ammonia kikamilifu kwa kutumia nishati ya geothermal hapa nchini. Uwekezaji mkubwa wa Kaishan Limited unatarajiwa kuzalisha mifuko 9.6 milioni ya mbolea ya kilo 50 kila mwaka, hatua itakayosaidia kupunguza gharama ya dola bilioni za Kenya zinazotumika kuagiza mbolea kutoka nje. Kwa muktadha, Kenya ilia-giza tani 600 za mbolea zenye thamani ya Sh80 bilioni mnamo 2023, huku Sh60 bilioni tayari zikitumika kuagiza tani 443 kufikia mwisho wa Julai mwaka huu pekee. Juhudi za serikali za kuvutia wawekezaji katika sekta ya mbolea zinalenga kulinda wakulima kutokana na mabadiliko makubwa ya bei za kimataifa na upungufu wa usambazaji huku zikihifadhi akiba ya dola ya taifa. Kupitia ushirikiano wa pamoja na KenGen, kampuni hiyo

itatumia asilimia 100 ya nguvu ya geothermal ya 165 MW kuendelea shughuli zake, kuunda ajira zaidi ya 1,000, na kutoa faida ya Sh1.67 bilioni kila mwaka. Akizungumza wakati wa hafla ya kuanza ujenzi Naivasha, Rais William Ruto alisema kwamba mara kiwanda kitakapokuwa kimeanza kufanya kazi, kitazalisha tani 480 za mbolea, kusaidia kupunguza gharama za uagizaji na kuhakikisha wakulima wanapata bidhaa zenye lishe kwa wakati. “Nchi ilitumia Sh80B kuagiza tani 600 za mbolea mwaka 2023 na hadi sasa imetumia Sh40B mwaka huu kuagiza tani 443, na kiwanda hiki kitabadilisha mwenendo huu na kuokoa akiba ya dola ya taifa,” alisema Rais Ruto. Rais Ruto aliongeza kuwa mbolea zinazozalishwa hapa nchini zitaunga mkono ukuaji wa sekta ya kilimo kwa kupunguza gharama za pembejeo na kuimarisha malengo ya taifa ya usalama wa chakula. Alisema kiwanda hiki pia ni sehemu ya mpango wa serikali wa kuongeza ardhi ya umwagiliaji kote nchini, akibainisha kuwa ardhi inayopatikana kwa kilimo cha mvua imeisha.

Rais Ruto alisema serikali itashirikisha sekta binafsi kupata ufadhili zaidi ili kuongeza uwezo wa nishati wa taifa kutoka 2,300MW hadi 10,000MW katika miaka kumi ijayo. Aidha, alisema serikali ipo katika mchakato wa kujenga mabwawa 50 makubwa yatakayowashughulikia ekari 2.5 milioni chini ya umwagiliaji na kusaidia kuzalisha nguvu ya ziada ya 2,000MW. Aliipongeza KenGen kwa juhudi zake katika viwanda kwa kutoa nishati ya bei nafuu, thabiti, na safi kutoka visima vya geothermal ambavyo vitatumika kuendesha kiwanda cha mbolea.

Kwa upande wake, Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa Kaishan, Dr. Yan Tang, alisema mara kiwanda kitakapokamilika kitazalisha mifuko 9.6 milioni ya mbolea ya kilo 50 kila mwaka, kikitegemea 165MW ya nishati ya geothermal. Mwenyekiti huyo aliongeza kuwa kiwanda kitasaidia kunasa maelifu ya tani za dioksidi ya

kaboni na kuhakikisha hakuna hewa chafu inayotolewa, ku-saidia kufanikisha malengo ya Kenya ya kupambana na mabadiliko ya tabianchi. “Tunapanga kuanza baadhi ya shughuli kuanzia mwaka ujao na kutoa ajira zaidi ya 1,000 moja kwa moja na nyingine 500 katika mimea ya operesheni, huku wanufaika waki-patiwa mafunzo hapa nchini na China ili kuongeza uzalishaji bora,” alisema Dr. Tang. Waziri wa Nishati na Petroli, Opiyo Wandayi, alisema mradi huu ni mabadiliko makubwa yatakayosaidia kilimo endelevu kupitia nishati safi.

Jukwaa latetea viwango vikali kwa sekta ya ujenzi inayokua ya Kenya

NA KENNEDY MATHEKA (PCO)

Sekta ya ujenzi nchini Kenya imepitia mabadiliko makubwa katika miongo kumi iliyopita, yakichochea na miji inayokua haraka, uwekezaji mkubwa katika miundombinu, na programu za kielelezo za serikali kama Mpango wa Makazi Nafuu. Hata hivyo, kadri jengo linavyoinuka na barabara zinavyopanuka kote nchini, haja ya mifumo thabiti ya usalama na uhakikisho wa ubora imekuwa muhimu zaidi kuliko hapo awali. Akizungumza wakati wa Mkutano wa Uhamasishaji wa Upatikanaji wa Huduma ya Ukaguzi wa Taifa—tukio la kihistoria lililoandaliwa na Idara ya Jimbo ya Kazi za Umma kwa kushirikiana na Huduma ya Ukaguzi wa Kenya (KENAS)—Katibu Mkuu wa Kazi za Umma Joel Arumonyang alisisitiza kuwa ukaguzi katika ujenzi hauishii tu kwa kuthibitisha vifaa.

“Unahusisha maabara za majaribio, mashirika ya uthibitisho, na vyombo vya tathmini ya ulinganifu, kuhakikisha vinakidhi viwango vya kitaifa pamoja na vigezo vya kimataifa kama ISO. Mchakato huu unahakikishia ujuzi wa kiufundi, maadili mema, na ubora wa utendaji katika sekta nzima,” alisema Arumonyang. Kwa kuzingatia viwango hivi, PS alisema, ukaguzi husaidia kuzuia kushindwa kwa miundo, ucheleweshaji wa miradi, kupita bajeti, na migogoro ya kisheria; masuala ambayo kihistoria yamekuwa yakipunguza imani ya umma na, katika baadhi ya kesi, yamesababisha ajali za kuanguka kwa majengo. “Kukabiliana na changamoto hizi, Idara ya Jimbo inashirikiana kwa karibu na KENAS kuthibitisha vyombo vya tathmini ya ulinganifu na kuimarisha uthibitisho wa bidhaa za ujenzi. Ushirikiano huu unalenga kuongeza imani ya umma, kulinganisha mbinu za Kenya



na viwango vya kimataifa, na kuendeleza ubunifu,” alisema. Arumonyang alisisitiza kuwa ukaguzi sasa ni ishara muhimu ya kuaminika kwa wawekezaji na watoa fedha. “Miradi inayoungwa mkono na vyombo vilivyoidhinishwa ina uwezekano mkubwa wa kupata ufadhili na bima,” alibainisha. “Ukaguzi si tu taratibu, bali ni msingi wa taaluma, maadili mema, na

maendeleo ya kiteknolojia.” Alitangaza pia mipango ya kuzindua jukwaa la kidigitali la ukaguzi ili kurahisisha maombi, upya, na upatikanaji wa umma kwa vyombo vilivyoidhinishwa, kuongeza uwazi na ufanisi. Mkurugenzi Mtendaji wa KENAS, Dk. Walter Ongeti, alithibitisha umuhimu wa ukaguzi katika kuhakikisha uthabiti na uimara katika ujenzi. Dkt. Ongeti alirejelea She-

ria ya Huduma ya Ukaguzi ya 2019, inayotoa amri kwamba vyombo vyote vya tathmini ya ulinganifu lazima viidhinishwe ili kufanya kazi kisheria katika sekta ya ujenzi nchini Kenya. Dk. Ongeti alionyesha wasiwasi juu ya kiwango kidogo cha ukaguzi, akieleza kuwa ni matokeo ya mapengo katika mifumo ya uthibitisho na usawa wa kikanda. Kenya yalenga Uchina uuzaji wa nyama ukiongezeka hadi Sh18.7b

NA ERASTUS GICHOHI (KNA)

Uuzaji wa nyama wa Kenya kwenye masoko ya kimataifa unatarajiwa kuongezeka kwa kasi kubwa, uki-chochewa na ongezeko la mahitaji ya kimataifa, ukujitokeza kwa masoko mapya. Mashariki ya Kati imekuwa msaada muhimu kwa wazalishaji wa nyama wa ndani, huku nchi kama Umoja wa Falme za Ki-arabu, Saudi Arabia, Oman, Qatar, na Kuwait zikiongoza na kuingiza mabilioni ya shilingi katika sekta ya nyama ya Kenya. Jumla ya mauzo ya nyama ya Kenya yaliongezeka kutoka Sh11.5 bilioni mwaka 2022 hadi Sh19 bilioni mwaka 2023, na Sh18.7 bilioni mwaka 2024, ikionyesha wastani wa ongezeko la kila mwaka la asilimia 39. Kwa kuwa tayari Kenya ina nafasi imara katika eneo la Ghuba, sasa inalenga masoko makubwa ya Asia, ikiwemo China, Malaysia, na Indonesia, kuongeza zaidi mauzo yake ya nyama. Kulingana na Said Ali, mshauri wa Ofisi ya Umoja wa Afrika ya Mifugo (AU-IBAR), sekta ya mifugo nchini Kenya inachangia asilimia 12 ya Pato la Taifa (GDP) na inahesabu asilimia 40 ya jumla ya uzalishaji wa sekta ya kilimo.

Akizungumza na wadau muhimu huko Naivasha, Ali alitaka upanuzi na uboreshaji wa mabonde ya wanyama, akibainisha kuwa ni mabonde saba tu kati ya 1,000 yaliyopo kwa sasa yanayokidhi viwango vya kimataifa vya uuzaji wa nyama nje. Ali pia alionya kuhusu tishio linaloongezeka kutokana na mabadiliko ya tabianchi, ikiwemo vipindi virefu vya ukame vinavyoendelea kuharibu jamii za wafugaji ambazo hutoa zaidi ya asilimia 70 ya nyama ya nchi. Ali alisema kuna haja ya kushughulikia uhaba wa chakula cha wanyama cha ubora, pamoja na kui-

marisha urithi wa mifugo ili kuongeza uzalishaji. Richard Kyuma, Mkurugenzi Mtendaji wa Huduma ya Maendeleo na Uendelezaji wa Mifugo ya Taifa, alisema utafiti wa kina uliofanywa hivi karibuni na mashirika husika ya serikali unaonyesha kuwa Kenya ina takriban mifugo 22 milioni ya ng'ombe na mbuzi na kondoo 58 milioni. Kyuma alisema serikali inaanzisha kanuni mpya zinazolenga kufungua uwezo kamili wa sekta kwa kuboresha uzalishaji, ubora wa nyama, na uthabiti wa masoko. Alibainisha kuwa mipango ipo ya kuunganisha wazal-

ishaji wa mifugo katika ushirika ili kurahisisha shughuli na kuhakikisha sekta yenye thamani ya mabilioni ya shilingi inatumika kikamilifu. Kyuma aliongeza kuwa ushirikiano kati ya wazalishaji wa nyama na waendeshaji wa mabonde ya kulisha mifugo kote nchini utakuwa muhimu katika kukuza ongezeko la thamani na kuvutia faida kubwa zaidi. "Hii itawaweka wakulima salama kutokana na hasara zisizotarajiwa zinazotokana na ukame unaojirudia," alisema, akibainisha kuwa uchumi wa Kenya ulipoteza zaidi ya Sh1 trilion wakati wa vipindi vya ukame vya 2008-2011.

Aina mpya ya viazi, inayoitwa CIP-Asiryq, imeendelezwa na wanasayansi kutoka Kituo cha Kimataifa cha Viazi (CIP) kwa kushirikiana na jamii za asili, na inastahimili ugonjwa ulioungamiza Ireland mwishoni mwa miaka ya 1840-late blight. Late blight ni ugonjwa hatari wa viazi unaosababishwa na ukungu wa maji unaosambaa haraka na kuendelea kuhar-

ibu mazao ya viazi duniani kote, ukisababisha hasara za hadi Dola za Kimarekani bilioni 10 kila mwaka. Nchini Kenya, viazi ni zao la chakula la pili kwa kiwango cha matumizi baada ya mahindi, na late blight imekuwa ikisababisha upotevu wa mazao kati ya

asilimia 30 hadi 70 kila mwaka, na katika baadhi ya matukio, hadi asilimia 100. Sasa, mabadiliko ya tabianchi yanasababisha ugonjwa huu kuenea zaidi na kutishia maisha ya wakulima wadogo wanaopanda moja ya vyakula muhimu zaidi duniani.

Baiskeli 500 zatolewa kuimarisha huduma ya afya ya msingi Kwale

Wizara ya Afya, kwa kuhirikiana na Amref Health Africa, World Bicycle Relief, na Buffalo Bicycles Kenya, imewapatia Watendaji wa Afya wa Jamii (CHPs) wa Kwale baiskeli 500. Mpango huu unalenga kuongeza uharakati na ufanisi katika utoaji wa huduma muhimu za afya kwa jamii. Akizungumza wakati wa tukio hilo, Katibu (PS) wa Afya ya Umma na Viwango vya Kitaaluma, Mary Muthoni, alisisitiza kuwa kuboresha usafirishaji ni muhimu katika kustawisha Huduma ya Afya ya Msingi (PHC), msingi muhimu wa Utoaji wa Huduma za Afya kwa Wote (UHC). PS Muthoni alibainisha kuwa kwa baiskeli mpya, CHPs wataweza kufikia kaya zaidi, kufanya ufuatiliaji kwa wakati, kusaidia juhudi za kuzuia magonjwa, na kutoa msaada haraka wakati wa kampeni za afya na milipuko ya magonjwa. Alisema baiskeli hizi zinawasaidia wafanyakazi wa

afya kukabiliana na ardhi ngumu na kufikia jamii zilizo mbali na huduma muhimu za afya. PS alisema kuwa watendaji wa afya wa jamii ni uti wa mgongo wa mfumo wa afya kwa sababu wao wako karibu zaidi na jamii, wakiishi na kufanya kazi miongoni mwa wananchi na kuwahudumia wale walioko karibu. "Mpango huu umebuniwa kupunguza changamoto za usafirishaji zinazowakabili watoa huduma zetu wa mbele katika ngazi ya chini," alisema. Mpango huu unathibitisha ahadi ya serikali ya kuwawezesha CHPs kwa zana, ujuzi, na msaada wa kiutendaji wanayohitaji kuhakikisha kila Mkenya, bila kujali eneo alilopo, anapata huduma za afya bora bila kero za kifedha. Aliwahimiza watoa huduma za afya ngazi ya chini kutunza vizuri baiskeli hizi na kuzitumia kwa uwajibikaji. "Baiskeli hizi zitarahisisha kazi yenu, hivyo tafadhali ziheshimieni na kuzitunza," alisema.

Mamlaka ya Usafiri wa Anga wa Kenya (KCAA) imepanga kuzindua mnara mpya wa kisasa wa Udhambi wa Trafiki ya Anga (ATC) katika Uwanja wa Ndege wa Kimataifa wa Kisumu, hatua kubwa katika kuboresha miundombinu ya anga na viwango vya usalama katika eneo la magharibi mwa Kenya. Mnara huo wenye ghorofa nane, ambao sasa umekamilika kwa asilimia 99, ni ishara ya kisasa na maendeleo ya kiteknolojia. Umpambwa kwa mfumo wa ufuatiliaji na mawasiliano ya ICT za kisasa, ulioundwa kufikia viwango vya kimataifa vya anga, ukiahidi ufanisi bora wa uendeshaji na uratibu salama wa ndege juu ya anga inayozidi kuwa na shughuli nyingi Kisumu. Mwenyekiti wa Bodi ya KCAA, Brown Ondego, na Mkurugenzi wa Huduma za Udhambi wa Anga, Anne Gitau, waliongoza ujumbe wa ngazi ya juu uliojumlisha uongozi wa KCAA, timu ya mradi, na wadau muhimu katika ziara ya ukaguzi wa

mwisho. Kenya kuanzisha mfumo wa kitaifa wa takwimu za elimu mwaka 2026. Wizara ya Elimu, kwa kuhirikiana na Wizara ya Habari, Mawasiliano na Uchumi wa Kidijitali (ICDE), imepanga kuzindua jukwaa kamili la kidijitali linalojulikana kama Mfumo wa Usimamizi wa Taarifa za Elimu Kenya (KEMIS) mnamo Januari 2026. Akizungumza na waandishi wa habari katika Kampasi ya Moi University Annex, Eldoret, baada ya kikao cha wadau kuzungumzia maandalizi ya Mkutano wa Kenya wa Programu na AI (Artificial Intelligence), Katibu Mkuu wa Elimu ya Msingi, Prof. Julius Bitok, alisema mfumo mpya utakuwa jukwaa kubwa zaidi lililounganishwa la takwimu za elimu nchini. Alieleza kuwa KEMIS itawaunganisha vyuo vyote kuanzia shule za chekechea na msingi hadi shule za sekondari za awali na juu, TVET, na vyuo vikuu, ikihusu ufuatiliaji wa moja kwa moja wa safari za kielimu za wanafunzi.
