- The Government of Kenya has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the Kenya Secondary Education Equity and Quality Improvement Program (SEEQIP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services. The Program has three result areas; (i) Expand equitable access to quality Secondary Education (ii) Improve teaching quality in Junior School, and (iii) Strengthen Systems for Equitable Service Delivery in Secondary Education
- The consulting services ("the Services") include Independent Verification of Results in Sampled Target Schools, Teacher Training Colleges and Educational Assessment Resource Centres (EARCS) with improved Infrastructure, School Based Teacher Support Services, Provision of Textbooks, School Grants and Meals, Beneficiaries of Scholarship and Mentorship Program, Reduced Percentage of Out of School Children in the Targeted Counties, Strengthened Systems through Institutionalization of Key Initiated Reforms in Basic Education and Transition to clean Cooking Energy. This will involve verification of the DLIs as per the annexes 1 and 2 in the Terms of reference as contained in the Preliminary verification protocol in Project Appraisal Document (PAD).

The task requires a Consulting firm or a joint venture of firms to undertake the assignment as per the scope of work as will be needed and as per the timelines specified in the T.O.R over a four-year period from 2026 to 2029.

- The Ministry of Education now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services.

#### The shortlisting criteria are:

- Tax Compliant registered agency/firm or Joint venture
- Minimum of five years of experience in conducting similar assignments or conducting national-level educational surveys. This includes proven expertise in data analysis, documentation of findings and preparation of reports.
- Demonstrate evidence of successful implementation of atleast three (3) similar assignments either alone or partnering with relevant national or international organizations i.e Contracts and recommendations from past clients.
- Evidence of availability of appropriate mixed skills to carry out the verification exercise which includes; Education specialists, Social Development specialists, Economists, Statistician, M&E, ICT Specialists, Procurement and Logistics etc

#### Key Experts will not be evaluated at the shortlisting stage.

- The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to Section III, paragraphs, 3.14, 3.16, and 3.17 of the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" July 2016 Procurement Regulations revised September 2025, 7th edition, setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.
- Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications, but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.
- A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost Based Selection method (QCBS) method set out in the Procurement Regulations.
