

Zaidi ya taasisi 900 za umma kote nchini zimehamia mfumo wa Ununuzi wa Kielektroniki wa Serikali (e-GP), hatua inayochukuliwa kama mabadiliko makubwa katika mageuzi ya sekta ya ununuzi wa umma yenye thamani ya mabilioni ya fedha. Mfumo huo wa kidijitali, uliotekezwa kwa kipindi cha miaka mitatu iliyopita, unazitaka taasisi za umma kupakia mipango ya lazima ya ununuzi, jambo linaloimarisha uwazi, ushindani na uwajibikaji katika matumizi ya fedha za umma. Akizungumza mjini Naivasha, Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA), Patrick Wanjuki, alisema ongezeko hilo la matumizi ya mfumo ni “mabadiliko makubwa kutoka kwa

taratibu za mikono zisizo wazi ambazo kwa muda mrefu zimekumba ununuzi wa umma.” “Idadi ya taasisi za umma zilizohamia mfumo wa ununuzi wa kielektroniki imefikia 900 katika kipindi cha miaka mitatu iliyopita, licha ya upinzani kutoka kwa baadhi ya makundi, ikiwemo Baraza la Magavaa,” alisema Wanjuki. Alisema utawala huo umejitolea kutoa huduma za afya jumuishi, bora na zinazopatikana kwa wote, akiongeza kuwa serikali inalenga nguzo nne za UHC: ufadhili wa afya, usalama wa upatikanaji wa

Akizungumza katika Hospitali ya Kaunti Ndogo ya Gilgil kama sehemu ya maandalizi ya ujenzi wa hospitali ya kisasa ya Kiwango cha 5 ya huduma zote, mshauri huyo alisema Serikali imepiga hatua kubwa katika sekta ya afya, na ina azma kubwa zaidi ya kufikia Huduma ya Afya kwa Wote (UHC) kwa Wakenya wote na kukabiliana na vitisho vya afya vya kimataifa. Dkt. Aruasa alibainisha kuwa haiwezekani kufikia Vision 2030 au Malengo ya Maen-

deleo ya Milenia (MDGs) bila uwekezaji madhubuti zaidi katika mifumo na huduma za afya. Akiashiria kuwa afya na maendeleo ya kijamii na kiuchumi ni pande mbili za sarafu moja, Dkt. Aruasa alisema kuwa usawa ni kigezo na pia matokeo katika kufanikisha mafanikio katika maeneo hayo mawili. Aliahidi kuwa serikali imejitolea kuweka afya kama kipaumbele katika mkakati wa uokoaji wa uchumi na Vision 2030. Afisa huyo aliongeza kuwa kutambua kwa serikali ya Kenya Kwanza kwamba huduma bora za afya si fursa ya matajiri pekee bali ni haki ya kila mtu ni mabadiliko makubwa ya mwelekeo wa sera nchini. Kenya imeonyesha uongozi kwa kuifanyia mageuzi National Hospital Insurance Fund na kuibadili kuwa Social Health Authority, hatua inayoashiria dhamira ya dhati ya kufikia huduma ya afya kwa wote, aliongeza. Dkt. Aruasa pia alisema kuwa serikali imeongeza juhudi za kuboresha viwango vya huduma katika vituo vya afya vya umma kupitia uzinduzi wa mpango wa Kenya Quality Model for Health Plus (KQMH+), mfumo mpya unaolenga kuimarisha usalama, heshima na uthabiti katika huduma za afya ya msingi kote nchini.

Akizungumza wakati wa hafla rasmi ya uwekaji wa jiwe la msingi na uzinduzi wa mradi wa umeme wa hatua ya mwisho (last-mile connectivity) katika Soko la Athiru Gaiti, pamoja na vijiji vya Kalamene Mun-

yakiri na Ugoti katika Igembe Kusini, Waziri wa Nishati, Opiyo Wandayi, alisema mpango huo un-aakisi dhamira ya serikali ya kufikia upatikanaji wa umeme kwa wote, hususan kwa jamii ambazo bado hazijahudumiwa ipasavyo. Waziri huyo alibainisha kuwa mradi huo unaendana na ajenda ya Rais William Ruto ya maendeleo jumuisi na yenye mageuzi ya kijamii na kiuchumi. Aliongeza kuwa kituo cha kupoza na kus-

ambaza umeme (sub-station) cha Sh1.2b kinachojengwa Maua kitaimarisha zaidi usambazaji na upatikanaji wa umeme katika eneo hilo. "Miradi hii inalenga kutoa umeme safi, nafuu na wa kuaminika kwa vijiji husika, na upatikanaji bora wa umeme utaongeza fursa za biashara na kuboresha mazingira ya kujifunzia kwa wanafunzi," alisema Wandayi. Aidha, Rural Electrification and Renewable

Energy Corporation (REC) imetenga Shilingi milioni 304 kuunganisha kaya 4,004 katika Kaunti Ndogo ya Igembe Kusini, huku Shilingi milioni 25.5 zikitengwa mahsusi kwa maeneo ya Kalamene na Munyakiri. Mradi wa maeneo hayo unatarajiwa kukamilika ndani ya miezi miwili na nusu ijayo na utanufaisha familia 382. Aliwahakikishia wakazi kuwa transfoma zilizokuwa zimeondolewa zitarejeshwa.

NHC kujenga kumbi za mihadhara za kisasa za Sh90M Masinde Muliro

- Identify and delineate the extent of the aquifer Systems and the Catchment that recharges them,
- Identify, map and estimate the infiltration potential of recharge zones.
- Identify, quantify and assess the quality of water from the potential water sources available for the implementation of MAR in Eldoret Aquifer System.

Mfumo wa NZF unachanganya hatua za lazima za kupunguza uzalishaji na upangaji wa bei ya kaboni kwa usafiri wa majini wa kimataifa, na kuashiria kanuni ya kwanza ya kimataifa ya hali ya hewa iliyoungwa kuelekeza sekta hiyo kufikia uzalishaji wa sifuri ifikapo takribani mwaka 2050. Ingawa mfumo huu ni wa mageuzi kwa usafiri wa majini duniani, athari zake kwa Afrika

ni kubwa zaidi ikizingatiwa kuwa usafiri wa baharini ndio mhimili wa biashara ya bara hili na ni muhimu kwa juhudi zake za viwanda, usalama wa nishati na ujumuishaji wa kikanda. Kenya inaongeza kasi ya juhudi za kutengeneza chanjo ndani ya nchi huku maafisa wa serikali na wanasayansi wakionya kuwa kuongezeka kwa usugu wa vimelea dhidi ya dawa (AMR), maambukizi kwa watoto wachanga, na magonjwa yanayopatikana hospitalini vinaweka tishio kubwa kwa afya ya umma na uendeleu wa mfumo wa afya. Msukumo huo mpya ulitangazwa na Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa Sekretarieti ya Utekelezaji wa Kenya Vision 2030 Delivery Secretariat, Kenneth Mwige, aliyesitiza kuwa Kenya lazima ipunguze kwa haraka utegemezi wake wa chanjo zina-zoagizwa kutoka nje na kuimarisha kinga ya magonjwa ili kulinda usalama wa afya wa taifa. Akizungumza katika Mkutano wa 16 wa Kisayansi na Afya (KASH) wa Kenya Medical Research Institute (KEMRI) uliofanyika Nairobi, Mwige alisema janga la COVID-19 lilifichua udhaifu wa Afrika kutokana na kukatika kwa minyororo ya usambazaji wa chanjo duniani. “COVID-19 ilituonyesha kuwa kutegemea kikamilifu wasambazaji wa nje kwa chanjo ni hatari ya kimkakati. Usalama wa afya lazima ujumuishe uwezo wa kuzalisha chanjo ndani ya nchi,” alisema. Alibainisha kuwa chanjo ni miongoni mwa nyenzo za gharama nafuu zaidi katika afya ya umma, zikisaidia kuokoa mamilioni ya maisha duniani na kupunguza kwa kiasi kikubwa gharama za muda mrefu za huduma za afya. Muhimu zaidi, Mwige alifichua kuwa Kenya inapanga kuongeza uzalishaji wa chanjo ndani ya nchi kupitia Kenya Biovax Institute, mpango wa ushirikiano kati ya sekta ya umma na binafsi unaolenga kuhama kutoka kufungasha na kusambaza chanjo hadi utengenezaji kamili. “Tuna uwezo wa kisayansi, taasisi za utafiti na vipaji vya kitaaluma vya kutatua changamoto nyingi za

afya. Tunachohitaji ni uratibu thabiti kati ya serikali, vyuo vikuu, sekta ya viwanda na utafiti,” alishauri. Mwige aliongeza kuwa chanjo zimeokoa takribani maisha milioni 150 duniani katika kipindi cha miaka 50 iliyopita, yakiwemo zaidi ya watoto milioni 110, akisisitiza kuwa kinga ni nafuu zaidi kuliko matibabu. “Iwapo tutachanja watoto mapema, tunazuia magonjwa baadaye, tunapunguza kulazwa hospitalini na kuokoa mabilioni ya fedha za afya,” alisisitiza. Mbali na usalama wa chanjo, Mwige alieleza wasiwasi kuhusu udhaifu wa kimfumo katika vituo vya afya vya umma nchini, ikiwa ni pamoja na msongamano wa wagonjwa, ukosefu wa usafi wa kutosha na mapungufu katika kuzuia na kudhibiti maambukizi. “Haikubaliki mwaka 2026 wagonjwa kushirikiki vitanda au kupata huduma katika wodi zilizojaa na zisizo na hewa ya kutosha. Kaunti lazima zipe kipaumbele mazingira safi, salama na yenye heshima kwa wagonjwa,” alielekeza. Aidha, alionya kuwa ukame na uhaba wa maji katika maeneo kame na nusu kame unaweza kuongeza kuenea kwa magonjwa ya kuambukiza, huku jamii zikilazimika kutumia vyanzo visivyo salama vya maji. “Watu wanapokosa maji safi, wanalazimika kutumia maji machafu, hali inayoongeza hatari

Anne Amulele, mtafiti wa baada ya udaktari katika Mpango wa Utafiti wa KEMRI-Wellcome Trust wa Kilifi, aliwasilisha matokeo ya ufuatiliaji wa muda mrefu wa maambukizi kwa watoto wachanga katika hospitali za Kenya. Utafiti wake ulionyesha kuwa bakteria wa *Klebsiella pneumoniae*, ambaye ana usugu mkubwa dhidi ya dawa, ni chanzo kikuu cha maambukizi makubwa miongoni mwa watoto wachanga, hasa wanaozaliwa kabla ya wakati au wenye uzito mdogo. “Watoto hawa wako katika hatari kubwa, na bakteria wengi wanaokutana nao wana usugu dhidi ya antibiotiki zinazopatikana kwa urahisi, hali inayowacha madaktari na chaguo chache za matibabu,” alieleza kwa masikitiko. Aliripoti kuwa baadhi ya vitengo vya watoto wachanga hurekodi maambukizi makubwa kati ya 30 hadi 40 kila mwaka, huku kiwango cha vifo kikizidi asilimia 20 katika visa vikali. Hospitali kadhaa zimekupokwa na milipuko ya muda mrefu iliyoathiri makumi ya watoto wachanga. Kwa mujibu wa Dkt. Amulele, maambukizi huenea zaidi kutokana na msongamano wa wodi, uwezo mdogo wa uchunguzi wa maabara na miundombinu duni ya kuzuia maambukizi.

Gavana wa Kaunti ya Tana River, Meja (Rtd) Dhadho Godhana, amewakabidhi wawekezaji wa Kanada ekari 500 za ardhi kwa ajili ya maendeleo ya mradi wa Sh39 bilioni wa mji wa kisasa wa kikaboni katika Areri, Abakiki Village, Madogo area, Jimbo la Bangale. Mradi wa Areri Organic City, unaoendeshwa na Conkrite Capital, utaunganisha nyumba za kikaboni, vituo vya mafunzo ya ufundi, kilimo endelevu, na nishati mbadala. Mji huu wa kisasa wa kikaboni unasherehekewa kama mfano wa mustakabali endelevu wa miji Afrika, ukiundwa ili kuhifadhi nishati, kuu-tunza rasilimali, na kuboresha ubora wa maisha mijini. Conkrite Capital wameuita Tana River "Garden of Eden of Africa" kutokana na bioanuwai tajiri ya eneo hilo, huku mradi ukiwekwa kama kielelezo cha maendeleo endelevu ya miji barani Afrika. Mpango huu unalenga kuunganisha maendeleo ya miji na uhifadhi wa mazingira, kupunguza alama za kaboni na kukuza mtindo wa maisha wenye afya, kijani na unaojitegemea. Alisema serikali ya kaunti inawakaribisha wawekezaji wa ndani na wa kigeni kwa lengo la kuunda ajira na kukuza ukuaji wa uchumi. "Tunahitaji wawekezaji kufungua maendeleo, kuunda ajira, kuboresha miundombinu na kuendelea ukuaji jumuiishi," alisema. Aliongeza kuwa, "tunatuonyesha Tana River kama eneo la kipaumbele la uwekezaji na kitovu chenye fursa kwa wawekezaji wa ndani na kimataifa." Dhadho alikaribisha uwekezaji huu wa mabilioni ya shilingi kama ule ambao utafungua Tana River, ambao alisema umekuwa hazina iliyofichwa kwa muda mrefu. Katibu asukuma sera linganifu za wigo kuongeza muunganisho maeneo ya vijijini

Katibu wa Utangazaji na Mawasiliano, Stephen Isaboke, ameitaka serikali kufanikisha mageuzi ya usawa wa wigo ili kupunguza pengo la kidijitali na kufikia jamii za mbali. Isaboke alisema hayo baada ya kukutana na ujumbe kutoka GSMA Global Spectrum ofisini kwake, kabla ya warsha ya ngazi ya juu kuhusu upangaji wa leseni za wigo na teknolojia za satelaiti. Ziara hiyo ya heshima ililenga ushindani wa kidijitali wa Kenya, mageuzi ya bei ya spectrum, uhabiti wa satelaiti, changamoto za nishati katika sekta ya mawasiliano, na mikakati ya kufunga pengo la 60% la matumizi ya intaneti ya simu nchini, licha ya kufikia karibu kila kona ya nchi kwa mtandao wa 4G. Ujumbe huo uliokuwa ukiongozwa na Luciana Camargos, Kiongozi wa Spectrum katika GSMA Global, uliuhusisha pia Caroline Mbugua, Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa Sera na Mawasiliano; Luiz Felipe Zoghbi, Mkurugenzi wa Usimamizi wa Spectrum; na Linus Melly, Meneja Mkuu wa Sera kwa Afrika Kusini mwa Jangwa la Sahara. Kwa sasa, Kenya inafikia karibu 98% ya wakazi walio na mtandao wa 4G, jambo linalowekeka miongoni mwa watendaji bora wa kidijitali barani Afrika

na kuimarisha sifa yake kama kitovu cha ubunifu kikanda. Hata hivyo, wadau walikiri kuwa upatikanaji wa mtandao pekee hauhakikishi matumizi. “Kenya imejenga msingi imara wa kidijitali. Hatua yetu inayofuata ni upatikanaji na ujumuishaji,” alisema Katibu Isaboke. “Wajibu wetu kama serikali ni kuhakikisha kila uamuzi wa kisheria – iwe kuhusu wigo, upangaji wa leseni, au teknolojia mpya – unashughulikia mahitaji ya taifa moja kwa moja. Swali la kila wakati ni: ni pengo gani tunalofunga?” aliongeza. Licha ya upatikanaji mpana, Kenya inakabiliwa na pengo la matumizi la 60%, ikimaanisha mamilioni ya watu wako ndani ya wigo wa mtandao lakini hawatumii huduma za intaneti ya simu. Bila hatua maalum, tafiti zinaonyesha inaweza kuchukua miongo kuufunga pengo hili. Camargos alisisitiza fursa kubwa inayohusiana na mifumo ya spectrum yenye bei inayoweza kutabirika na nafuu. “Ikiwa Kenya itatekeleza mbinu bora za kimataifa katika upangaji wa bei ya spectrum, ramani wazi za maendeleo, na upya wa leseni kwa ufanisi, nchi inaweza kuongeza hadi Sh662 bilioni katika Pato la Taifa (GDP) kufikia 2028. Athari kwa ajira na mapato ya kodi ni kubwa,” alisema. Ripoti ya GSMA Digitalisation

Report kuhusu Kenya inaonyesha mageuzi hayo yanaweza pia kuongeza mapato ya kodi kwa takriban Sh150 bilioni huku yaki-chochea upatikanaji wa kidijitali, ubunifu, na uwekezaji wa sekta binafsi. Ujumbe huo ulihimiza majadiliano yanayotegemea ushahidi ili kuhakikisha sera zina-

zoeleweka kwa muda mrefu na kuimarisha imani ya wawekezaji. Majadiliano pia yalijikita kwenye uunganishaji wa satelaiti unaoibuka na huduma za direct-to-device (D2D), ambazo zinakamilisha mitandao ya ardhini duniani kote. PS Isaboke alikaribisha ubu-

nifu lakini akatilia shaka athari zisizokusudiwa sokoni. “Ubunifu unakaribishwa. Teknolojia ya satelaiti inaweza kutusaidia kufikia maeneo ya mbali. Lakini lazima iende sambamba, si kuharibu miundombinu ya simu inayotumikia mamilioni ya Wakenya,” alisema. Alisisitiza kuwa wingi wa watoa huduma wavya wanaojitambulisha kama suluhisho la uunganishaji vijijini lazima waonyeshe mipango wazi ya upanuzi, ahadi zinazopimika, na kuendana na malengo ya huduma za kitaifa. Mbugua alibaini kuwa Kenya ina fursa ya kuunda viwango vya uhabiti barani Afrika. “Kote Afrika, uhabiti wa satelaiti bado haujalilingana. Kenya inaweza kuongeza kwa kuunda mfumo wa usawa unaohakikisha mshikamano kati ya watoa huduma wa simu na satelaiti huku ikihakikisha ushindani wa haki na uhakika wa uwekezaji wa muda mrefu,” alisema. Kikao hicho pia kilijadili changamoto za gharama katika sekta, ikiwa ni pamoja na bei ya spectrum na ongezeko la gharama za nishati zinazohusiana na upanuzi wa huduma za kidijitali na mahitaji ya data. PS Isaboke alionyesha kuwa hatua yoyote ya msaada ili-yopangwa itategemea utendaji na itahusiana na ahadi zinazopimika za upanuzi. “Kama kutakuwa na unyumbulifu au msaada uliopangwa, lazima ulingane na ratiba wazi, viashiria vya upatikanaji, na uwajibikaji. Upanuzi lazima upimwe na uwe sambamba na malengo ya maendeleo ya taifa,” alisema. Meneja Mkuu wa Sera, Linus Melly, alikaribisha mwamko wa ushirikiano wa majadiliano. “Kile tunachoonza Kenya ni mazunguzo ya kujenga. Lengo si kupunguza uhabiti, bali mfumo unaoeweza kutabirika na unaoeleweka unaoeweza watoa huduma kuwekeza kwa uendelevu huku ukilinda maslahi ya watumiaji,” alisema.

wiki, unajaribiwa kwanza kabla ya kusambazwa katika vituo vingine vya ECDE kaunti nzima. "Tunaanzisha mpango huu wa uji wenye virutubisho hapa Legetet kama jaribio, na nia ya kuupanua hadi shule zote za ECDE kaunti nzima," alisema. "Mafanikio ya mpango wa maziwa wa shule yanaonyesha kuwa kuwekeza katika lishe ya watoto kunatoa matokeo halisi," alisema Gavana, akiongeza, "Kuongezeka kwa idadi ya wanafunzi wanaohudhuria na usajili mkubwa ni ushahidi kwamba wazazi wanaamini dhamira yetu kwa ustawi wa watoto wao." "Kama taifa tumetambua wazi kwamba mustakabali wa uchumi wetu hautapimwa kwa idadi ya shahada tulizotoa, bali kwa idadi ya mikononye ujuzi, akili za ubunifu na wataalamu waliyoandaliwa kwa ajili

ya viwanda, biashara na ulimwengu wa kazi," alisema. Kiongozi wa Huduma za Umma alisema kuwa msukumo wa mpangilio upya unachochewa na mahitaji ya soko la ajira duniani, akibainisha kwamba makadirio ya ajira ya kimataifa yametabiri upungufu wa zaidi ya wafanyakazi milioni 85 wenye ujuzi ifikapo mwaka 2030, jambo linalosisitiza uhitaji wa haraka wa taasisi za TVET kujipanga upya. Alisema kuwa kama jibu, serikali imeanzisha mageuzi makubwa katika sekta ya TVET ikiwa ni pamoja na kuanzisha modeli ya mafunzo ya mchanganyiko, kutekeleza utambuzi wa ujifunzaji uliotangulia, kufanya ramani ya ujuzi kwa njia ya kidijitali na kuwekeza katika vifaa na miundombinu ya kisasa katika taasisi zote. "Hizi si marekebishi ya kiutawala; ni mabadiliko ya kimundo yaliyopewa lengo la kufanya Kenya kuwa mchezaji makini

katika uchumi wa ujuzi wa dunia. Kwa miaka mingi, elimu ya ufundi na mafunzo ya kazi ilionekana kama njia mbadala, lakini leo, ipo katikati kabisa ya ajenda ya maendeleo ya taifa letu. Taasisi za TVET lazima zipite zaidi ya

karatasi na mawasilisho na ziingie vitendo katika warsha, maabara, viwanda na jamii," alisema. Maonyesho ya siku tatu yalifanyika chini ya kaulimbiu: "Utafiti na Ubunifu Kama Kichocho cha Ujuzi, Ajira na Maendeleo Ende-

levu", yakileta pamoja wadau, watafiti, viongozi wa viwanda na watunga sera, washirika wa maendeleo na wakufunzi. Maonyesho hayo yalifanyika wakati taifa likipanga upya nafasi ya ujuzi wa kiufundi na kazi katika uundaji wa ajira. Gavana wa Nyeri County, Mutahi Kahiga, alisifu mkutano huo kama mabadiliko makubwa katika ukuzaji wa ujuzi. Alisema serikali yake imechukua hatua makusudi ikiwa ni pamoja na programu za lengo maalum na za haki, kuhakikisha vijana wanapata elimu inayohitajika, mafunzo ya vitendo, na fursa zinazowahakikishia maisha yenye heshima. Kuhusu mafunzo ya ufundi, gavana alisema kuwa serikali yake imechukua hatua za makusudi za kuboresha ubora na umuhimu wa mafunzo yanayotolewa katika vyuo 28 vya vijana vya polytechnic kwa kueneza zana na vifaa vya kisasa.

Kituo cha samaki kinafadhiliwa na serikali Siaya tayari kwa shughuli

Shughuli katika kiwanda cha kupokea samaki na kuhifadhi kwa baridi cha Luanda K'Otieno chenye thamani ya Sh140 milioni, kinafadhiliwa na serikali katika Kaunti ya Siaya, zinatarijiwa hatimaye kuanza mwezi huu. Kiwanda hicho cha mamilioni ya shilingi cha uchakataji wa samaki na uzalishaji wa barafu kilizinduliwa na aliyekuwa Waziri wa Uvuvi na Uchumi wa Bluu, Najib Balala, mnamo Novemba 2024 kabla ya kukabidhiwa kwa mwekezaji, Vemric Enterprise, mapema mwaka 2025. Afisa Mkuu wa Uendeshaji wa Vemric Enterprise, Kenedy Komba, alieleza maandishi wa habari baada ya mkutano wa wadau—ikiwemo wana-jamii wa ufukwe wa Luanda K'Otieno—kuwa kuchelewa huko kulitokana na urasimu wa kiutawala na changamoto za kimuundo zilizohitaji kushughulikiwa kabla ya shughuli kuanza. Kuchelewa huko kulitatuliwa tu baada ya serikali ya Kaunti ya Siaya kuipa kampuni idhini ya mwisho, kufuatia mwaka mmoja uliogubikwa na vikwazo na masuala ya uzingatiaji wa kanuni za kisheria. Komba aliongeza kuwa mwekezaji alilazimika kuwekeza fedha zaidi kuboresha kiwanda hicho ili kufikia viwango vya kimataifa, hatua iliyowezesha kupata ithibati ya kusafirisha samaki katika masoko ya nje kama vile Umoja wa Ulaya. Alifichua kuwa taratibu za kiserikali za kupata vyeti vya uzingatiaji na leseni kutoka Shirika la Viwango la Kenya (KEBS) zilichangia ucheleweshaji huo. Afisa huyo pia alisema mashine ya kutengeneza barafu katika



kiwanda hicho ilikuwa ikiharibika mara kwa mara, jambo lililomgharimu mwekezaji zaidi ya dola 2,000 kila ilipoharibika. Aidha, kukatika kwa umeme mara kwa mara katika eneo hilo kulimlazimu mwekezaji kutumia zaidi ya dola 70 kwa siku kwa jenereta ya dizeli, hali ambayo haikuwa ya kiuchumi. Komba alisema baada ya mkutano na wadau wa sekta ya uvuvi na wanajamii, walikubaliana na wavuvi kuuza samaki wao kwa kampuni hiyo kwa bei nafuu na isiyomuumiza mwekezaji kwa kupandisha bei kupita kiasi. “Mojawapo ya changamoto tulizokutana nazo tulipoanza ni bei ya samaki. Kulikuwa na dhana kuwa wawekezaji wana fedha nyingi, hivyo kilo moja ya samaki inayouzwa kwa Sh550 Nairobi, kwetu ilikuwa ikiuzwa kati ya Sh700 hadi Sh800 hapa,” alisema Komba.

“Tumekutana na wavuvi na kukubaliana kuwa ili kampuni iweze kufanya kazi, bei lazima ziwe halisi na endelevu,” aliongeza. Afisa huyo alisema wamefani-kiwa kutatua changamoto kuu zilizokuwa zikizuiwa kuanza kwa shughuli, lakini bado wanaendelea kushirikiana na Shirika la Umeme la Kenya (Kenya Power) kutafuta suluhisho la kudumu kwa tatizo la kukatika kwa umeme, ambalo bado linaathiri shughuli zao. Alisema kampuni hiyo inaende-

lea kushikilia makubaliano yake na serikali ya Kaunti ya Siaya ya kuajiri angalau asilimia 50 ya wafanyakazi kutoka eneo hilo, aki-fichua kuwa hadi sasa asilimia 60 ya wafanyakazi wao wametoka eneo hilo katika nyadhifa mbalimbali kama vibarua, walenzi, wachujaji na wakataji samaki. Kiwanda hicho kina uwezo wa kuchakata tani 15 za samaki kwa siku, huku kampuni ikijishughulisha na kuongeza thamani na kuunganisha masoko. Mradi wa Usimamizi wa Ufukwe wa Kaunti Ndogo ya Rarieda, George Otuoma, alithibitisha kuwa mkutano wa wadau ulikubaliana kuwa jamii iunge mkono kuanza kwa shughuli za kampuni hiyo kwa kuuza samaki kwa bei nafuu na kuhakikisha upatikanaji wa samaki kutoka fukwe nyingine ndani ya kaunti kwa usambazaji wa kutosha na endelevu wa malighafi.

Kenya kuimarisha sekta ya afya kwa utafiti wa ndani, chanjo

Serikali inaongeza juhudi zote za kujenga mfumo wa afya imara na unaojitegemea, unaotegemea utafiti wa ndani, utengenezaji wa chanjo na suluhu za afya za kidijitali, Waziri wa Afya Aden Duale ametangaza. Akizungumza katika Kongamano la Kisayansi na Afya la KEMRI (KASH) jijini Nairobi, Duale alisisitiza kuwa afya ni nguzo muhimu ya ajenda ya kiuchumi ya serikali ya kutoka chini kwenda juu (bottom-up), huku Huduma ya Afya kwa Wote (UHC) ikiwa kiini chake. “Afya ni nguzo kuu ya ajenda ya kiuchumi ya utawala wetu ya bottom-up. Mtazamo wetu uko wazi: tunataka mfumo wa afya unaopatikana kwa wote, nafuu, wenye ufanisi na unaotegemea rasilimali za ndani, huku tukilinda familia dhidi ya gharama kubwa za matibabu,” alithibitisha Waziri huyo. Alibainisha nguzo nne zinazounga mkono mkakati wa Kenya wa UHC, zikiwemo ufadhili endelevu wa afya, nguvu kazi imara ya washudumu wa afya, huduma za kijamii zinazotolewa ngazi ya jamii, na mfumo wa afya wa kidijitali. Kwa upande mwingine, Duale alisema serikali imetumia teknolojia kufuatilia ujazo wa vitanda vya hospitali katika vituo vya umma, binafsi na vya kidini kupitia programu ya Bed Access Room, hatua iliyopunguza kwa kiasi kikubwa matukio ya wagonjwa kulala sakafuni hospitalini. “Mfumo huu wa afya wa kidijitali unahakikisha hospitali zinaendeshwa kwa ufanisi. Kwa mfano, Hospitali ya Kenyatta yenye uwezo wa vitanda 1,800 sasa inaweza kufuatiliwa kwa wakati halisi, na hivyo kuepuka kupokea wagonjwa kupita uwezo wake kama ilivyokuwa kabla ya kuanzishwa kwa mfumo wa kidijitali,” alieleza. Waziri huyo alisisitiza dhamira ya serikali ya kuimarisha uwezo wa kisayansi, utafiti na viwanda kusaidia utafiti, ubunifu na utengenezaji wa chanjo hapa nchini. Alifichua kuwa Taasisi ya Utafiti wa Tiba ya Kenya (KEMRI) imeinuliwa hadhi na kuwa taasisi ya kimkakati ya kitaifa. “Sio tu kuhusu sayansi. Ni kuhusu usalama wa afya, ushindani wa kiuchumi, ukuaji wa viwanda na uundaji wa ajira,” alisema. Aidha, serikali imeanzisha Idara ya Sayansi, Utafiti na Ubunifu, kutekeleza Mpango Mkuu wa Sayansi, Utafiti na Ubunifu wa miaka 10 (2026-2036)

Operesheni ya mashirika ya usalama yanasa bunduki, mifugo

Operesheni ya kiusalama inayohusisha taasisi mbalimbali katika Kaunti ya Isiolo imepiga hatua kubwa katika kukabiliana na shughuli za kihalifu kufuatia kuanza kwa ufuatiliaji wa kina ulioanzishwa na serikali siku tano zilizopita. Kamishna wa Kaunti ya Isiolo, David Kiprop, alisema operesheni hiyo inayoshirikisha vyombo mbalimbali vya usalama imefanikiwa kunasa silaha haramu, risasi, dawa za kulevya na mifugo iliyoibwa, kama sehemu ya juhudi za kurejesha usalama kote kauntini. “Ni wakati muafaka kwa kila mmoja kushirikiana, wakiwemo viongozi wote na wananchi, ili kuhakikisha amani na utulivu wa kudumu katika jamii

zetu,” alihimiza Bw. Kiprop. Kulingana na ripoti ya hivi karibuni ya usalama, kikosi hicho kilipata silaha saba, zikiwemo bunduki ya M16, AK-47 kadhaa na bunduki ya G3, pamoja na risasi 105 na magazini kadhaa. Bw. Kiprop aliongeza kuwa katika operesheni inayoendelea dhidi ya biashara ya dawa za kulevya, maafisa walinasagruu tano za dawa kali za kulevya katika eneo la Kambi Juu na kung'oa shamba la bangi katika Kambi Garba. Polisi walisema dawa hizo zinazoaminika kuwa sehemu ya mtandao unaochochea uraibu wa vijana na shughuli za kihalifu katika eneo hilo. Aidha, Kamishna wa Kaunti alisema maafisa wa usalama walifanikiwa kurejesha mbuzi na kondoo 107 wanaoam-

inika kuwa waliibwa wakati wa mashambulizi ya awali katika maeneo ya mpakani kati ya Isiolo na kaunti jirani. Kuhusiana na hilo, washukiwa wanne wamekamatwa kwa kumiliki silaha haramu, huku wengine watatu waki-zuiliwa kuhusiana na makosa ya dawa za kulevya. Kamanda wa Polisi wa Kaunti ya Isiolo, Isaac Sang, aliwapongeza wakazi kwa ushirikiano wao na kwa kutoa taarifa muhimu

zilizochangia mafanikio ya operesheni hiyo. “Napenda kuwashukuru wote waliotoa taarifa za kijasusi. Ushirikiano wa jamii ni muhimu katika kushinda vita dhidi ya uhalifu,” alisema. Mamlaka zilisisitiza dhamira yao ya kuhakikisha amani ya kudumu na hali ya kawaida vinarejea Isiolo, zikibainisha kuwa juhudi za pamoja kati ya vyombo vya usalama, viongozi wa jamii na umma kwa ujumla ni muhimu katika kufanikisha lengo hilo.

Serikali yatuma vikosi kulinda wanyamapori kiangazi kikizidi

Serikali imeagiza kamati inayohusisha mashirika mbalimbali kufanya tafiti za haraka za kieneo na kubaini maeneo hatari (hot-spots) ili kuongoza hatua za dharura zinazolenga kupunguza madhara ya ukame unaoendelea kuongezeka kwa wanyamapori nchini Kenya. Mpango huu unalenga kupunguza na kuzuia vifo vya wanyamapori, hasa katika Eneo Kavu na Nusu-Kavu (ASALs), ambapo malisho na maji bado ni nadra. Taasisi ya Utafiti na Mafunzo ya Wanyamapori (WRTI) na Huduma ya Wanyamapori Kenya (KWS) tayari wameshaanza operesheni za uwanjani kuhakikisha rasilimali zinatolewa kwa ufanisi, hususan kwa spishi zilizo hatarini zaidi. Taarifa ya Baraza la Mawaziri ilitoa onyo juu ya hali mbaya katika kaunti nne—Wajir, Mander, Kwale, na Kilifi—ukiashiria hatari ya ukame kuenea katika kaunti nyingine 13. Taarifa hiyo ilibainisha athari kwa mifugo na ongezeko la migongano kati ya binadamu na wanyamapori, hasa karibu na mbuga na hifadhi za wanyamapori. Serikali tayari imetoa Sh 4.1 bilioni kusaidia zaidi ya Wakenya milioni 3.3 waliokabiliwa na uhaba mkali wa chakula kutokana na mvua zilizoshindikana

za Oktoba–Desemba 2025, jambo linaloonyesha uzito wa hali hiyo. Kulingana na Mkurugenzi wa WRTI, Dkt. Patrick Omondi, zoezi hili linalenga kutoa hatua za muda mfupi, ikiwemo usambazaji wa maji na virutubisho muhimu kwa wanyama walioathirika, ili kuzuia vifo kadiri ukame unavyoongezeka katika wiki zijazo. “Utafiti wa kieneo katika mbuga na hifadhi za wanyamapori utaelekeza hatua za haraka zinazohitajika kuzuia vifo vya wanyama, kama ilivyotokea wakati wa ukame wa mwaka 2022,” alisema Dkt. Omondi.

Matokeo ya tafiti hizi yanatarajiwa kusaidia mikakati ya muda mrefu ya kukabiliana na ukame na mafuriko, yakijengwa juu ya Sensa ya Taifa ya Wanyamapori ya 2024–2025, iliyobaini ongezeko la idadi ya spishi muhimu. Msaada wa haraka ni muhimu hasa kwa spishi hatarishi, kama vile farasi wa pori wa Grevy (Grevy’s zebras) katika Samburu, ambao waliathirika sana wakati wa msimu wa ukame wa 2022. Dkt. Omondi alitoa maelezo haya wakati wa ufunguzi wa Kituo cha Utafiti wa Mito na Majidali mbadala (Alternative Wetland and In-

land Water Research) huko Naivasha, kufuatia kufungwa kwa kituo kilichotangulia kutokana na kuongezeka kwa maji ya Ziwa Naivasha. Omondi.

Makasisi 300 wafunzwa kusaidia afya ya akili ya polisi

Zaidi ya maafisa 300 wa polisi wanaotumika kama wachungaji (chaplains) kutoka sehemu mbalimbali za nchi wamepata mafunzo maalumu, yaliyozinduliwa kwa lengo la kuwawezesha kuwa washauri, watoa mwongozo na wafuasi wa maafisa wa polisi wanaokabiliana na changamoto zinazongezeka za afya ya akili na matatizo ya kifamilia. hukutana na hali za kusumbua kama ajali za barabarani, matukio ya uhalifu wenye vurugu, na kudumu kwa muda mrefu katika maeneo yenye hatari au ya uhasama, jambo linaloweza kuathiri utendaji wao kitaaluma na maisha ya kifamilia.

“Maafisa hawa ni binadamu. Wanapitia changamoto ngumu wakati wa utekelezaji wa majukumu yao, na kama hawatasaidiwa ipasavyo, changamoto hizi zinaweza kuathiri uamuzi wao, mahusiano na utendaji wao kwa ujumla,” alisema.

Mfuko wa Taifa wa Watu Wenye Ulemavu Kenya (NFDK) umezindua nyumba ya kulala yenye vitanda 60 kwa wasichana katika Kituo cha Mafunzo na Urejeshaji wa Kazi cha Kericho Kilicho Nyagacho, Kaunti ya Kericho, hatua ambayo inatoa msukumo mkubwa katika mafunzo ya ufundi kwa watu wenye ulemavu katika eneo hilo. Mradi huo, uliojengwa kwa gharama ya Sh3.5 milioni na kufungwa samani kwa ziada ya Sh500,000, ulifadhiliwa na Mfuko wa Uaminifu wa NFDK kama sehemu ya mpango wake wa kimsingi wa kusaidia taasisi, unaolenga kuimarisha vituo vinavyowawezesha watu wenye ulemavu kupitia elimu na ujuzi. Akizungumza wakati wa hafla ya uzinduzi, Mwenyekiti wa NFDK, Profesa Francis Kibera, alisema kuwa kukamilika kwa nyumba hiyo ya kulala kunatambulika kama hatua muhimu katika kuboresha upatikanaji wa mafunzo na ustawi wa wanafunzi. “Haitoshi kuwa na jengo

tu. Bila samani zinazofaa, haliwezi kutimiza madhumuni yake. Tunafurahi kuwa mradi huu umefanikiwa kufanyika kupitia ushirikiano wa pamoja,” alisema Prof. Kibera. Profesa Kibera alibainisha kuwa Rais wa sasa ni mlezi wa Mfuko na ndiye anayeteua wadamini wake, hatua ambayo alisema imeimarisha ushirikiano na wasimamizi wa serikali ya kitaifa. “Mfuko unasaidia watu wenye ulemavu kwa ngazi ya mtu binafsi na taasisi. Kwenye ngazi ya mtu binafsi, wanufaika hupatiwa vifaa vya msaada kama vile kiti cha magurudumu na fimbo nyeupe, pamoja na zana za ufundi ikiwemo vifaa vya urembo wa nywele, mashine za kushona, na mashine za kuosha magari ili kuhimiza kujitegemea. Kwenye ngazi ya taasisi, Mfuko hutoa ruzuku ndogo hadi Sh300,000 kusaidia miradi midogo na ukarabati,” alisema Prof. Kibera. Alihimiza taasisi hizo kuomba ruzuku hizo, akibainisha kuwa kituo cha urejeshaji kinaweza kunufaika na msaada kama huo kuboresha miundombinu yake.

Serikali yaimarisha mabadiliko ya malezi ya watoto ya familia

Serikali imezidisha utekelezaji wa mpango wa kitaifa wa kuhamisha watoto kutoka kwa malezi ya taasisi kwenda kwa malezi ya kifamilia. Katibu Mkuu wa Idara ya Huduma za Watoto, Carren Ageng’o, alisema kuwa marekebishi haya yameunganishwa kwenye Sheria ya Watoto ya 2022, ambayo ilileta mabadiliko makubwa kwenye sheria za ulinzi wa mtoto na kuliweka rasmi marufuku malezi ya muda mrefu katika taasisi. Aliongeza kuwa mkakati wa miaka 10 wa mageuzi ya malezi (2022–2032) unaelezea njia ya hatua kwa hatua ya kurudisha watoto katika familia, ukizingatia kwanza utambulisho na kuunganishwa tena na familia. Maafisa wa watoto wanashirikiana na taasisi, viongozi wa jamii, na ndugu wa watoto

ili kutafuta wazazi wa asili au familia za karibu, kwa lengo la kuwarudisha watoto katika mazingira salama ya nyumbani. “Utafiti unaonyesha kuwa watoto wanaokulia katika taasisi hukumbana na changamoto za maendeleo, pengo la utambulisho na tatizo la kujiamini kwa sababu hawana muundo thabiti wa kifamilia,” alisema Katibu Mkuu. Idara ya Huduma za Watoto, aliongeza, ilikuwa ikipanga ramani ya watoto wote wanaoishi katika taasisi nchini kote ili kubaini kiwango cha mpangilio wa kuhamishwa. “Tayari tumemaliza zoezi hilo katika eneo la Bonde la Ufa ambapo tumebaini watoto 13,000 ambao kwa sasa wako katika malezi ya taasisi,” alisema. Katibu alisema serikali imepanga bajeti ya mpango huu na kubaini mahitaji yote ya kuhakikisha watoto wote warudishwa kwa mfumo wa kifamilia.
