Kaunti ya Siaya huenda ikawa kitovu kikuu katika sekta ya nishati nchini Kenya kufuatia mashauriano ya ngazi ya juu kati ya uongozi

wa kaunti hiyo na mashirika ya kitaifa ya nishati kuhusu mpango wa ujenzi wa kinu cha kuzalisha umeme wa nyuklia chenye thamani ya Sh500 bilioni. Gavana wa Siaya James Orenge aliandaa mkutano na ujumbe

kutoka Nuclear Power and Energy Agency (NuPEA) na Kenya Electricity Generating Company kujadili ramani ya utekezaji wa mpango wa nishati ya nyuklia nchini Kenya. Ujumbe huo ulijumuisha

Mwenyekiti wa NuPEA Lawrence Gumbe, Afisa Mkuu Mtendaji Justus Wabuyabo, na Mkurugenzi Mtendaji wa KenGen Peter Njenga. Maafisa hao waliufahamisha uongozi wa kaunti kuhusu maendeleo yaliyopatikana kuelekea mradi huo uliopendekezwa, ambao unatarajiwa kubadilisha kwa kiasi kikubwa sekta ya nishati nchini. Kwa mujibu wa mashirika hayo, mradi huo umepangwa kuanza rasmi ujenzi tarehe 1 Machi 2027, hatua itakayokuwa muhimu katika juhudi za Kenya kupanua vyanzo vya nishati kwa kuingiza umeme wa kiwango kikubwa usio na hewa ukaa. Gavana Orenge aliukaribisha mpango huo akisema kuwa utakuwa kichocheo muhimu cha ukuaji wa uchumi kwa Kaunti ya Siaya na nchi kwa ujumla. “Nishati ya nyuklia ni muhimu katika kutimiza maono ya Kenya ya kujitosheleza kwa nishati,” alisema Orenge wakati wa mkutano huo. Aliongeza kuwa mradi huo utaleta manufaa mengi kwa wakazi wa eneo hilo, yakiwemo nafasi za ajira, maendeleo ya miundombinu na upatikanaji wa umeme wa kuaminika. “Kaunti itanufaika moja kwa moja na kwa njia isiyo ya moja kwa moja kupitia ajira na maendeleo ya miundombinu. Wakazi wa Siaya hawatapokea tu ajira katika kituo cha kuzalisha umeme bali pia watapata umeme wa bei nafuu na safi. Wawekezaji pia watavutiwa kuwekeza Siaya kutokana na upatikanaji wa

umeme wa uhakika,” alisema. Mradi huo unatarajiwa kuwa na athari kubwa katika ajira na maendeleo ya uchumi katika eneo hilo. Wakati wa awamu ya ujenzi, inakadiriwa kuwa takribani ajira 10,000 zitaanzishwa, huku awamu ya uendeshaji ikitarajiwa kutoa takribani nafasi 1,200 za ajira za kudumu. Katika awamu ya kwanza, kituo hicho cha umeme wa nyuklia kinatarajiwa kuzalisha megawati 2,000 (MW) za umeme, jambo litakalosaiaidua kuimarisha mtandao wa taifa wa umeme, kupunguza kukatika kwa umeme mara kwa mara na kusaidia ukuaji wa viwanda. Mwenyekiti wa NuPEA Prof. Gumbe alisema kuwa mpango mpana wa nishati ya nyuklia una uwezo wa kuzalisha hadi megawati 6,000 kwa muda mrefu. Alieleza kuwa utekezaji wa mradi huo utafanywa kwa awamu ili kuhakikisha kuwa mtandao wa taifa wa umeme unaweza kuingiza umeme huo wa ziada kwa ufanisi huku ukizingatia viwango vya juu vya usalama na uendeshaji. Wakati huo huo, serikali ya kaunti kwa kushirikiana na NuPEA na KenGen inapanga kuanzisha mpango mpana wa kuwashirikisha wadau unao- lenga kuwaelimisha wakazi kuhusu nishati ya nyuklia. Mpango huo utalenga kuongeza uelewa kuhusu teknolojia ya nyuklia, kushughulikia masuala ya usalama na kuhakikisha kuwa jamii ya eneo hilo inashirikishwa kikamilifu katika maendeleo ya mradi huo.

KRA kupeleka kamera zinazovaliwa JKIA kuimarisha usalama na uwazi mipakani

Mamlaka ya Mapato ya Kenya Kenya Revenue Authority imeanzisha matumizi ya kamera zinazovaliwa mwilini kwa maafisa wa forodha na utekelezaji sheria katika Jomo Kenyatta International Airport ili kuimarisha usalama wa mipaka, kuongeza uwajibikaji na kukuza uwazi katika shughuli za forodha. Akizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi huo, Kamishna Mkuu wa KRA Humphrey Wattanga alisema hatua hiyo ni hatua muhimu katika kisasa cha usimamizi wa forodha na matumizi ya teknolojia katika kupambana na biashara haramu. Wattanga alibainisha kuwa mamlaka hiyo ina jukumu muhimu katika kulinda mipaka ya Kenya huku ikiwezesha usafirishaji wa bidhaa na watu kwa urahisi kupitia vituo vya kuingia nchini. "Kupitia ufuatiliaji endelevu na operesheni zinazoongozwa na ujasusi, KRA imepunguza biashara haramu ikiwemo usafirishaji wa bidhaa zilizopigwa marufuku, bidhaa bandia na zisizo na viwango, pamoja na dawa za kulevya," alisema. Aliongeza kuwa biashara haramu hunyima serikali mapato muhimu, hudhoofisha viwanda vya ndani na kuhatarisha afya

na usalama wa wananchi. Ili kukabiliana na changamoto hizo, Kamishna Mkuu alieleza kuwa KRA imeimarisha ushirikiano na mashirika mengine ya serikali pamoja na kuwekeza katika teknolojia ili kuboresha usalama wa mipaka. "Usimamizi wa forodha leo

unafanyika katika mazingira changamano ambapo tunapaswa kuwezesha biashara, kulinda mapato na pia kulinda jamii kwa wakati mmoja. Takwimu, ujasusi na teknolojia za kisasa ni muhimu katika kufanikisha majukumu haya," alisisitiza. Wattanga pia alifafanua kuwa

mazingira ya mipaka ya Kenya yanahitaji mbinu tofauti za uendeshaji, akibainisha kuwa baadhi ya vituo vya kuingia nchini vinahitaji uangalizi mkali kutokana na hatari za kiusalama, huku vingine vikihitaji ufanisi ili kushughulikia kiwango kikubwa cha biashara halali. "Mbinu yetu inaendelea kubadilika kulingana na mazingira husika ili kuhakikisha usalama na pia kuwezesha biashara kufanyika kwa urahisi," alisema. Aidha, Kamishna Mkuu alisisitiza kuwa mageuzi ya kidijitali ni nguzo muhimu ya ajenda ya kisasa ya forodha ya mamlaka hiyo, ikijumuisha matumizi ya teknolojia kama vifaa vya ukaguzi visivyoingilia moja kwa moja, mifumo jumuishi ya usimamizi wa forodha na uchambuzi wa hatari unaotegemea data. Kwa mujibu wa Wattanga, kuanzishwa kwa kamera zinazovaliwa mwilini kunaongeza chombo muhimu cha kuimarisha taaluma, uwazi na uadilifu wa shughuli za utekelezaji. "Vifaa hivi vitarekodi mawasiliano kati ya maafisa na umma, hivyo kuimarisha uwajibikaji huku vikilinda wafanyakazi na wananchi," alisema. Aliongeza kuwa kamera hizo zitakuwa muhimu hasa katika maeneo yenye shinikizo

kubwa kama viwanja vya ndege, bandari na mipaka ya nchi kavu, ambapo zitasaidia kuzuia mienendo isiyofaa na kulinda usalama wa maafisa. Pia zitasaidia kuongeza ufahamu wa hali halisi kupitia picha za moja kwa moja, na kusaidia maamuzi sahihi wakati wa ukaguzi na operesheni za utekelezaji sheria. Wattanga alisema kuwa rekodi za kamera hizo pia zitatoa ushahidi wa kuaminika na salama kwa matumizi katika michakato ya kiutawala na utatuzi wa migogoro. Kamera hizo zitatumika katika doria na ufuatiliaji katika mipaka ya nchi kavu, bahari na anga, pamoja na wakati wa ukaguzi wa ndege, meli na magari. Aidha, zitatumika wakati wa uhakiki wa mizigo katika vituo vya One Stop Border Posts, maghala ya mizigo ya mpito, Container Freight Stations, Inland Container Depots, maeneo ya mizigo ya viwanja vya ndege, ukaguzi wa mizigo ya abiria, operesheni za pamoja za utekelezaji, pamoja na ufuatiliaji wa maeneo yanayosimamiwa na forodha kama maghala yaliyofungwa na Export Processing Zones. Kwa upande mwingine, Wattanga alisisitiza kuwa matumizi ya vifaa hivyo yataimarisha ulinzi wa mapato ya serikali na kuwezesha ufuatiliaji wa moja kwa moja.

PROPOSED INTRODUCTION OF PERMIT PROCESSING FEE ON THE NATIONAL ELECTRONIC SINGLE WINDOW SYSTEM (NESWS)

The Communications Authority of Kenya (CA) is the regulatory agency for the ICT sector in Kenya with responsibilities in telecommunications, e-commerce, cyber security, broadcasting and postal/courier services. The CA is also responsible for managing numbering and frequency spectrum resources, administering the Universal Service Fund (USF) as well as safeguarding the interests of consumers of ICT services.

The Authority plays an important role in the importation of ICT equipment into the country, by evaluating import permit applications submitted through the KenTrade National Electronic Single Window System (NESWS). The evaluation process consists of three stages: checking, verification, and inspection, to ensure that all ICT equipment imported into the country complies with applicable technical and regulatory requirements.

The Authority hereby notifies all stakeholders – including members of the public, importers, exporters, customs clearing agents, licensees, and other participants in the ICT sector – of its intention to introduce a **Permit Processing Fee** for permits processed through the KenTrade National Electronic Single Window System (NESWS).

Kaunti zaidhinisha mfumo mpya wa kupima utendakazi

Serikali za kaunti zote 47 nchini zimeidhinisha Mfumo Mpya wa Jumuiishi wa Usimamizi wa Utendaji (Integrated Performance Management Framework - IPMF), hatua inayofungua njia kwa mfumo wa pamoja wa kufuatilia matokeo na kuboresha utoaji wa huduma katika serikali za ugatuzi. Mfumo huo ulithibitishwa wakati wa warsha ya kitaifa iliyoifanyika Naivasha, na unatarajiwa kumimarisha uwajibikaji, ufanisi na utawala unaozingatia wananchi. Akifungua warsha hiyo, Mkurugenzi wa Mipango ya Uchumi katika Kitengo cha Usimamizi wa Utendaji wa Utumishi wa Umma Public Service Performance Management Unit (PSPMU), Robert Ngei, alisisitiza umuhimu wa mchango wa wadau katika kuunda mfumo huo. "Tumejumuiisha maoni kutoka kwa Serikali ya Kitaifa na pia Council of Governors katika mfumo huu uliothibitishwa," alisema. "Kwa kuwashirikisha kaunti katika zoezi hili la uthibitishaji, tunahakikisha kuwa mfumo huu si hati ya kitaifa pekee, bali ni mwakilishi halisi wa sauti na vipaumbele vya kaunti zote 47." Alibainisha kuwa mfumo huo haujaletwa kwa kaunti kama agizo kutoka juu, bali umeundwa kwa ushirikiano na serikali za kaunti ili kuakisi hali halisi za maeneo yao huku ukiendana na viwango bora vya kimataifa. Ngei alisisitiza kuwa

kaunti zinapaswa kukumbatia zana za kidi-jitali na matumizi ya data pamoja na ufuatiliaji wa wakati halisi ili kupima utendaji na kushughulikia mapungufu katika utoaji wa huduma kwa haraka. "Kwa kupokea mbinu bora za kimataifa, kaunti zitakuwa zinaunganisha mifumo itakayowaweze-sha sio tu kupima matokeo bali pia kutabiri changamoto na kuchukua hatua mapema," aliongeza. Mfumo wa IPMF unajengwa juu ya msingi uliowekwa na Mfumo wa Usimamizi wa Utendaji wa Kaunti wa mwaka 2017, uliotambulisha kaunti kwa usimamizi uliopangwa wa utendaji. Hata hivyo, mfumo mpya ni mpana zaidi na unajumuisha zana mbalimbali zilizothibitika kama Mikataba ya Utendaji (Performance Contracting), Tathmini za Utendaji wa Wafanyakazi, Bajeti Zinazotege-mea Programu, Mifumo Jumuiishi ya Ufuatiliaji na Tathmini, Mipango ya Matokeo ya Haraka (Rapid Results Initiatives) na Mikataba ya Utoaji Huduma kwa Wananchi.

Kwa pamoja, zana hizi zinaunda mkusanyiko mpana wa mbinu zitakazosaidia kaunti kuongeza ufanisi, kumimarisha uwajibikaji na kuboresha huduma kwa wananchi katika maisha yao ya kila siku. Kwa msingi wake, IPMF ni mojawapo ya matokeo muhimu ya Second Kenya Devolution Support Programme (KDSP II). Tofauti na miaka ya mwanzo ya ugatuzi ambayo ililenga zaidi kuanzisha ofisi na mifumo ya utawala, KDSP II inalenga matokeo yanayoonekana na yanayopimika kwa wananchi. "Chini ya KDSP II, mkazo umehamia kutoka kuanzisha mifumo ya ofisi pekee hadi kufikia matokeo yanayoweza kupimika na ambayo wananchi wanaweza kuyahisi," Ngei alieleza. Mfumo huo pia unaunganishwa moja kwa moja na motisha za kifedha. Kupitia KDSP II, Kipimo cha Utoaji Fedha Kili-chounganishwa na Utendaji (Disbursement Linked Indicator 6) kinazingatia kuimarisha uwajibikaji wa matokeo kupitia IPMF.

Simotwo alibainisha kuwa takribani wanafunzi 125 wa Darasa 9 kutoka shule hiyo walinafaika na mpango huo, ambao uliwapa fursa ya kupata uzoefu katika masomo ya sayansi. Alisema wanafunzi walipata nafasi ya kutumia vifaa vya maabara na kutangamana na vifaa vya kisayansi katika taaluma mbalimbali za sayansi, hatua iliyosaidia kuimarisha uelewa wao wa masomo hayo.

Jinsi kandanda inavyowabadilisha akina nyanya kuwa mabingwa wa kupinga ukeketaji

NA ANTHONY MELLY (KNA)

Soka haijanga tu kufunga mabao kaunti ya West Pokot—una-pambana pia na ukeketaji (FGM).

Katika eneo lililokuwa limeelezwa kwa ndoa za utotoni na ukatili wa kijinsia, wake wa zamani wanapuza majukumu ya jadi na kubadilisha sare za kawaida kwa viatu na jezi za mpira wa miguu. Mashindano haya hayahusu tu michezo; ni protesti yenye nguvu kupitia michezo dhidi ya desturi hatari kama FGM. Ingawa desturi hii bado inatumiwa katika baadhi ya jamii kudhibiti maisha ya wanawake, wachezaji hawa wanaonyesha kwamba waathiriwa wakubwa wa jamii

wanaweza pia kuwa wazalendo wa haki za binadamu.

Ili kukabiliana na changamoto hii, Idara ya Gender, Vijana na Michezo ya Kaunti ya West Pokot mwaka jana ilianzisha mashindano ya mpira wa miguu kwa wanawake wenye umri wa miaka 50 na kuendelea, maarufu kama “grannies” (wake wa zamani). Mpango huu unatumia michezo kama jukwaa la ubunifu kuelimisha jamii na kupinga desturi hatari rishi za kitamaduni, ikiwemo FGM, mimba za utotoni, ndoa za mapema, na ukatili wa kijinsia. Wakulima wapokea miche iliyoboreshwa ya kahawa

Wakulima wa kahawa wa Kirinyaga wamepata msaada mkubwa wiki hii baada ya Baragwi Cooperative Society kusambaza miche 30,000 bora ili kuongeza uzalishaji katika kaunti nzima. Mpango huu ni sehemu ya mpango wa kitaifa wa kuhuisha kilimo cha kahawa, unaotekelezwa kupitia New Kenya Planters Cooperative Union (New KPCU) ili kuimarisha sekta na kuongeza uzalishaji wa wakulima. Wakati wa zoezi la usambazaji, Felix Murithi Mwai, Mwenyekiti wa Kamati ya Kitaifa ya Ushirika wa Kahawa, alibainisha kwamba mpango huu—uliotangazwa na Wizara ya Ushirika CS Wycliffe Oparanya—unakusudia kuongeza uzalishaji wa kahawa kitaifa kwa kutoa miche bora moja kwa moja kupitia mashirika ya ushirika. Mwai alisema miche hiyo ime-wasili kwa wakati muhimu, huku wakulima eneo hilo waki-jitahidi kupanua mashamba ya kahawa na kuongeza uzalishaji. “Baragwi ni mojawapo ya mashirika ya ushirika ya kahawa kinara nchini kwa uzalishaji. Mkulima wa kahawa kutoka Gichugu, Mugoh wa Gikombe, alisema mpango wa usambazaji wa miche utasaidia wakulima kuongeza uzalishaji huku uki-waokoa gharama za kuanzisha mashamba mapya ya kahawa. Imani za miongo kadhaa kuhusu mwanzilishi wa Egerton zahojiwa

Tawasifu mpya ya Egerton University, iliyoandikwa na Profesa Emilia Ilieva na Profesa Reuben Matheka, inapingana na imani iliyokithiri kwamba taasisi hii ilianzishwa na mkulima wa kikoloni Lord Maurice Egerton wa Tatton. Kitabu hicho, *Thus Until: A History of Egerton University (1939-2019)*—ambacho ni maelezo ya kurasa 600 yanayorakamba historia ya chuo kikuu hicho kwa miaka 80 kutoka shule ya kilimo ya kikoloni hadi kuwa taasisi ya juu ya kilimo—kiliuzushwa rasmi katika Njoro Main Campus mwezi Februari 2026 sambamba na sherehe za maadhimisho ya miaka 86 ya chuo kikuu. Kwa zaidi ya miongo minane, kumbukumbu rasmi na rekodi za kihistoria zimeendelea kudai kwamba Egerton University, taasisi ya zamani zaidi ya elimu ya juu nchini Kenya, ilianzishwa kama Shule ya Kilimo mwaka 1939 na Lord Egerton, raia wa Uingereza aliyehamia Kenya mwaka 1919 na kutoa ekari 740 za ardhi kwa ajili ya kuanzisha shule hiyo. Madhumuni ya awali ya shule hiyo ilikuwa kuandaa vijana weupe wa Ulaya kwa taaluma za kilimo. Kufikia mwaka 1955, jina lilibadilika kuwa Egerton Agricultural College. Walikuwa wakitoa

kozi ya cheti cha mwaka mmoja na kozi ya diploma ya miaka miwili katika kilimo. Mnamo 1958, Lord Egerton alitoa ekari nyingine 1,100 za ardhi ili kupanua taasisi hiyo. Waandishi wa *Thus Until: A History of Egerton University (1939-2019)*, kitabu kinachorakamba hatua muhimu ambazo chuo kikuu kimezipata tangu kuundwa kwake pale kilipoanzishwa na kuendeshwa awali kama kitovu cha mata-rajio ya wakoloni wenye uwezo wa kiuchumi katika kilimo, sasa wanasema kwamba taasisi hii ilikuwa ni mpango wa serikali ya kikoloni uliozinduliwa kwa lengo la kuimarisha kilimo cha wakoloni. Kichwa cha kitabu “*Thus Until*” ni tafsiri ya moja kwa moja ya methali ya chuo kikuu, *Sic Donec*, ambayo pia ilitumika kama methali ya familia ya Egerton wa Tatton. Kitabu hicho kinatazama methali hiyo hadi kwa Baron wa kwanza, Sir Thomas Egerton, aliyeshi kati ya mwaka 1540-1617. Kitabu kinaripoti kwamba alikuwa “mwakilishi mashuhuri zaidi” wa familia hiyo na alithaminiwa sana na familia ya kifalme. Inaripoti kwamba aliteuliwa kuwa Baron na King James I ambaye alikalia kiti cha enzi Machi 24, 1603. Baada ya kuwa “Baron, Egerton wa Ellesmere,” Thomas aliingiza usemi huu kama methali ya familia. Mwaka 1610, alichaguliwa kuwa Chancellor of Oxford University. Waandishi wanaashiria kwamba mchango muhimu wa



Lord Egerton katika kuanzisha shule hiyo ulikuwa ardhi. Hata hivyo, wazo hilo haliikuwa lake, bali la serikali ya kikoloni, ambayo, ikihamasishwa na shauku yake, iliamua kuipa shule hiyo jina lake. Kitabu kinaripoti kwamba uamuzi wa kumnukuu Lord Egerton katika jina la shule uliunda mtazamo kwamba yeye alikuwa si tu mtoaji msaada bali pia mwanzilishi wa shule hiyo, na kuongeza kwamba mtazamo huo ulikuwa wa makosa na uliendelea kudumu kwa muda mrefu. Kwa miaka mingi, wanafunzi wabaya wa Egerton University, pamoja na wengine wengi, waliambiwa wakati wa mafunzo yao kwamba Lord Egerton alianzisha shule hiyo peke yake na kuchukua wanafunzi watatu tu katika kundi la kwanza. Lakini kitabu kinatupilia mbali hadithi hiyo. Kwanza, kinafafanua kwamba shule hiyo “iliuzushwa rasmi Mei 9, 1941,” na “wavulana ishirini na wawili waliingizwa katika kundi la kwanza, ikifuatiwa na wagombea wengine waliopata alama nzuri mwaka 1942.” Waandishi wote ni maprofesa katika chuo hicho, huku Profesa Emilia Ilieva akihudumu

Egerton VC Prof Isaac Kibwage (kulia), Profesa Emilia Ilieva (kushoto) na Profesa Reuben Makau Matheka (kwa sehemu iliyofichwa) wakionyesha tamthilia ya wafu mpya wa Chuo Kikuu cha Egerton iliyoinduliwa hivi majuzi.

kama Profesa wa Fasihi, na Profesa Reuben Makau Matheka akihudumu kama Profesa wa Historia katika taasisi hiyo hiyo. Sura za mwanzo za kitabu kili-chochapishwa na East African Educational Publishers katika Nairobi zinajadili familia ya Egerton na kipindi cha “Happy Valley,” huku sura za baadaye zikichunguza mabadiliko ya uongozi, majaribio ya mitaala, na athari za sera za kitaifa za elimu. Kitabu kina sura 13 zenye maudhui makubwa. Kinaandika safari ya shule hiyo kutoka kuwa shule ya kilimo kwa “weupe tu” mwaka 1939 hadi kuwa chuo chenye rangi nyingi katika miaka ya 1960, na hatimaye kupandishwa hadhi kuwa chuo kikuu cha umma kikamilifu mwaka 1987. Hadithi hii inaweka Egerton University ndani ya muktadha mpana wa siasa za kimataifa na

kitaifa, ikieleza jinsi ilivyobadilika kutoka kuwa chombo cha fikra za kikoloni hadi kuwa mchezaji mkuu katika uhuru wa Kenya na maendeleo ya taifa.

Ingawa kundi la kwanza la wanafunzi liliingizwa mwaka 1941, mwaka 1939 unanagaliwa kama kipindi cha kuanzishwa kwa shule hiyo kwani ndio mwaka serikali ya kikoloni ilipofanya uamuzi wa mwisho wa kuanzisha shule hiyo. Mwaka huo, kitabu kinasema, “serikali ya kikoloni ilikuwa karibu kuchukua hatua muhimu katika maendeleo ya elimu ya Wazungu nchini Kenya, ikiruhusu kubadilika na utofauti wake.” Hatua hii ilifikishwa kufuatia majadiliano na mapendekezo ya awali kuhusu hitaji la kuanzisha shule ya kilimo ambayo, miongoni mwa mambo mengine, “ingeimarisha kilimo cha wakoloni.” Wazo la kuanzisha “shule ya kilimo kwa ujumla,” lilielezwa katika mkutano wa Mei 1939 na Mkurugenzi wa Elimu pamoja na Wakuu wa Shule za Msingi za Wazungu katika Nairobi, Nakuru, na Kitale, kitabu kinasema.

Kwa miongo kadhaa, mashua za mbao zimekuwa zikibeba maisha ya wavuvi wa jadi wa Ziwa Victoria—lakini kwa gharama fulani. Zikiwa hatarini kuoza, kutokuwa thabiti, na kushambuliwa na dhoruba, mashua hizi zimekuwa hatari iliyofichika kwa muda mrefu. Sasa, Kenya Shipyards Limited inabadilisha hali hiyo kwa mashua za Glass Reinforced Polymer (GRP), mbadala wa kisasa, salama, na wa kudumu zaidi unaoahidi kubadilisha tasnia ya uvuvi katika eneo hilo. Juhudi hii inaashiria mabadiliko makubwa katika sekta ya baharini ya eneo hilo. “Mashua za GRP hazimaanishi tu kuwa tunapata meli mpya kwenye

maji yetu. Zinawakilisha maendeleo na kuashiria zama mpya ambapo ubunifu unakutana na utamaduni,” alisema Major General Said Mohammed Farah wakati wa uzinduzi. Uamuzi huu ulitokana na hofu za usalama zilizotolewa na Kaunti ya Kisumu. “Mashua za mbao ambazo wavuvi walikuwa wakitumia hazikuwa imara kimuundo, zikisababisha ajali za maji na vifo,” alisema Captain Mungai. Ziwa Victoria imekuwa iki-kumbwa na vifo kwa muda mrefu. Makadirio ya awali yalionyesha vifo vya mwaka kwa mwaka kati ya 3,000 hadi 5,000, kutokana hasa na kuzama na mashua zisizo thabiti. Ingawa hatua za uingilaji kati zimepunguza idadi hiyo hadi takriban 1,000 kwa mwaka,

hatarini zinazotokana na mashua za mbao zilizozeeka bado ni kubwa. Mashua za GRP za KSL zimeundwa kukabiliana na hatari

hizi. Zimetengenezwa kwa fiberglass iliyokamilishwa kwa resin ya kiwango cha baharini na kumalizika na gel coat ya ulinzi,

zikiwa haziingii maji, haziozi, na zina uimara wa kimuundo. Mfumo wa kuhimili kuzama umejumuishwa kuhakikisha kuwa hata zikiharibika, mashua bado zinaweza kubaki juu ya maji. Kila mashua pia inakuja na vestu za kuokoa maisha, fura, na vifaa vingine vya kuokoa maisha. “Kwa muda mrefu sana, wavuvi wetu wamekabiliana na Ziwa Victoria katika mashua za mbao zinazohitaji matengenezo mara kwa mara na zisizozingatia viwango vya kisasa vya usalama,” alisema Farah. “Mashua za GRP ni thabiti zaidi, zinaishi kwa muda mrefu, na zinahitaji matengenezo kidogo sana.” Zaidi ya usalama, juhudi za GRP zinaendana na vipaumbele vya kimataifa vya mazingira.

Utafiti wa miaka 15 waonyesha hatari kwa vito vya utalii Kenya

Serikali iko chini ya shinikizo la kuchukua hatua za dharura za uhifadhi wa Mto Mara kufuatia uzinduzi wa mradi wa kihistoria wa utafiti wa kisayansi wa miaka 15. Utafiti huo unaonyesha hatari muhimu zina-zokabili mfumo wa ikolojia wa mto kutokana na mabadiliko ya tabianchi, uchafuzi, na shughuli za binadamu zinazokaribia mto. Akizungumza katika Maonyesho ya Bonde la Mto Mara, Mchunguzi Mkuu wa Mradi Edward Njagi alisisitiza kuwa juhudi hiyo inatafsiri data ngumu za kisayansi kuwa taarifa rahisi kueleweka kwa watoa sera na jamii za eneo. “Kama hatua za dharura hazitachukuliwa, tuta-poteza mto huu,” Njagi alionya, akibainisha kwamba kuanguka kwa Mto Mara kungetwanga maisha ya jamii za eneo na sekta muhimu ya utalii nchini Kenya. Utafiti wa Mto Mara, uliochukua miaka 15, ulifuatilia mto kutoka vyanzo vyake katika Msitu wa Mau, kupitia mfumo maarufu wa Mara-Serengeti, hadi kwenye maeneo ya wetlands ya Mara nchini Tanzania, ambapo hatimaye unaingia kwenye Ziwa Victoria. Njagi alieleza kuwa, kihistoria, matokeo ya kisayansi huchapishwa katika majarida ya kiufundi kwa lugha ngumu ambayo ni vigumu kwa umma kuelewa. “Chapisho hili linafanya utafiti kuwa rahisi kueleweka na wanasayansi, mameneja, wanafunzi, na umma kwa ujumla. Linafuata safari ya mto kutoka chanzo hadi delta na linaonyesha umuhimu wa kila sehemu kwa ustawi wa binadamu na ikolojia,” alifafanua Njagi. Alionya kwamba Mto Mara unakabiliwa na shinikizo linaloongezeka kutokana na mchanganyiko wa mabadi-

liko ya tabianchi, matukio ya asili, na shughuli za binadamu kama kilimo na matumizi ya ardhi yasiyo na udhibiti. Mchunguzi Mkuu pia alieleza wasiwasi kuhusu kupungua kwa viwango vya maji, vina-vyotishia uhai wa wanyama pori na maisha ya binadamu. “Viwango vya mto vinaendelea kushuka kila mwaka. Ikiwa hatua za dharura hazitachukuliwa, matokeo yatakuwa makubwa. Utalii, wanyama pori, na jamii zinazotegemea mto wote wataathirika,” alisisitiza. Aidha, utafiti huo ulitathmini afya ya mfumo wa ikolojia wa mto kwa kuchunguza viumbe vya majini, ikiwa ni pamoja na samaki, ambao ni viashiria nyeti vya ubora wa maji. Katika muktadha huo, Njagi alibainisha kuwa uchafuzi kutoka kemikali za kilimo ni kielelezo kikuu cha kupungua kwa ubora wa maji, mara nyingine kusababisha vifo vikubwa vya samaki. “Mmoja wa sababu kuu zinazochangia kudorora kwa ubora

wa maji ni uchafuzi unaotokana na kilimo. Kemikali kutoka shamba huingizwa mtoni wakati wa mvua na huliwa na samaki, mara nyingine husababisha vifo vikubwa,” alibainisha. Kwa upande mwingine, Njagi alisisitiza kwamba matokeo hayo yataelekeza kampeni za uhamasishaji na kuhimiza wadau kutumia mbinu endelevu. Mchunguzi Mkuu pia alionya dhidi ya ujenzi wa mabwawa makubwa kando ya mto, ambayo alisema yanaweza kupunguza mtiririko wa maji kwa kiasi kikubwa na kutishia mfumo wa ikolojia. “Kwenye matukio madogo, mabwawa yanaweza kukubalika, lakini mabwawa makubwa yangepunguza kwa kiasi kikubwa mtiririko wa mto, na hivyo kuwa tishio kubwa kwa maisha ya mto,” alisema. Vilevile, wanasayansi wa kimataifa wanaohusika katika mradi huo pia walisisitiza umuhimu wa ikolojia wa Mto Mara. Mchunguzi Mkuu wa Mradi katika University of Florida,

Profesa Amanda Subalusky, alieleza mto huo kama mfumo wa kipekee unaunganisha misitu, wetlands, wanyama pori, na jamii za eneo nchini Kenya na Tanzania. “Mto Mara ni hazina. Ni mfumo wa ajabu unaunganisha Msitu wa Mau, Mara-Serengeti, na wetlands za Mara, ukihusisha watu na wanyama wanaoitegemea,” aliripoti. Aidha, Subalusky alibainisha kuwa mto unaunga mkono aina nyingi za viumbe chini ya maji, ambavyo mara nyingi hupuuza ikilinganishwa na wanyama maarufu wa ardhi wa eneo hilo. Pia aliongeza kuwa utafiti huo unatoa fursa ya kuelimisha jamii kuhusu umuhimu wa mifumo hii ya majini. Hata hivyo, mradi wa utafiti wa miaka 15 unatarajiwa kuongoza maamuzi ya sera za Kenya kuhusu uhifadhi wa mto, usimamizi wa bioanuwai, na utalii endelevu, ukithibitisha umuhimu wa kulinda rasilimali za asili kama msingi wa ustawi wa kiuchumi na kijamii.

Iombe Crater, hazina adimu ya ikolojia katika Kaunti ya Meru

Ijisitiri katika maeneo kavu ya Igembe North Sub-County, Iombe Crater imejipanga kati ya vilima—ni maajabu ya asili yanayovutia ambapo fumbo, utamaduni, na uzuri vinaungana. Kasoko hii inajulikana kwa maji yake yenye rangi nyingi na ladha ya alka-line, yanayong’aa kutokana na madini na chumvi za soda, yakitengeneza mandhari yanayokaribisha kama ya kichawi. Kwa vizazi, wafugaji wamekuwa wakikusanya chumvi ya soda kwa ajili ya chakula cha mifugo, huku familia za eneo hilo zikitumia kama mbadala wa asili wa chumvi ya meza. Chumvi hii ni ya thamani sana kwa kupika vyakula vigumu kama maharagwe na mahindi, kwani inavyorahisha upikaji, kupunguza muda wa kupika, na kuhifadhi kuni. Kinachofanya Iombe Crater kuwa cha kipekee ni maji yake yanayopatikana mwaka mzima, yanayoungwa mkono na chemchemi za ardhi, na kuifanya kuwa eneo la kipekee la ikolojia katika eneo hilo. Zaidi ya uzuri wake wa asili, crater hii ina umuhimu mkubwa wa kitamaduni na kiroho. Wazee wa jamii hutatua kanuni zinazoizua wanawake na wasichana walio na hedhi kuingia crater. Kukiuka kanuni hii huchukuliwa kuwa dhambi inayoweza kuhasirisha Mungu. Hadithi za wenyeji zinaeleza kwamba watu huinuliwa na kupigwa na nguvu zisizoonekana kama adhabu kwa kutoheshimu eneo hili takatifu. Mary Kaloki, 75, alieleza umuhimu wa mila hii. “Inachukuliwa kuwa dhambi kwa mwanamke aliye na hedhi kuingia crater. Wazee wetu walikuwa wanauona kitendo kama hiki kingeweza kumkasirisha Mungu na kuleta masikitiko kwa jamii,” alisema. Aliongeza kwamba kupuuza kanuni hii kunadhaniwa kusababisha usawa wa asili wa crater kuvurugika, mara nyingine kusababisha chumvi ya soda kutoweka kwa muda, na kuwala-zimisha watu na mifugo kukosa rasilimali hii ya thamani.

Aliongeza kwamba ushirikiano kati ya jamii za wafugaji, watoa sera, na sekta binafsi utakuwa muhimu katika kuunganisha wakulima wa mifugo na masoko ya kikanda pamoja na wanunuzi wakubwa.

Dkt. Solomon Munyua, mtaalamu wa Biashara ya Mifugo, alibainisha kwamba Afrika inaagiza bidhaa za mifugo zenye thamani ya takriban Dola za Marekani bilioni 10.2 kila mwaka, huku mauzo yake ya nje yakihesabu Dola bilioni 3.4 pekee, na kuunda pengo la kibiashara la takriban Dola bilioni 6.8. Dkt. Munyua alisema nchi za Afrika lazima zitatue udhaifu wa sera, kuboresha ujumuishaji wa data za masoko, na kufunga mapengo ya usimamizi ili kufungua thamani kamili ya uchumi wa mifugo. Alipendekeza mapitio ya mifumo ya kistruktura na sera pamoja na ahadi ya kisiasa na nia njema ili kuondoa viziuzi vikuu na kupanua biashara ya mifugo. “Serikali lazima zitatue gharama kubwa za uzalishaji na kuwekeza katika kuongeza thamani ikiwa bara linataka kufaidika kikamilifu na rasilimali zake za mifugo,” alisema. Dkt. Munyua pia alibainisha kwamba Afrika imechukua faida ya takriban asilimia 10 tu ya uwezo wake wa ngozi na makovu, huku nchi nyingi zikiendelea kuagiza bidhaa za ngozi zilizokamilika kutoka masoko kama China na India licha ya uwezekano mkubwa wa kuendelea viwanda vya ndani.

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Upper Tana Water Fund yadhimisha miaka 10 ya kulinda maji ya Kenya

Serikali ya Kenya imetoa swito wa kuongezwa kwa uwekezaji katika urejeshaji wa maeneo ya vyanzo vya maji na matumizi ya suluhisho zinazotegemea asili huku Upper Tana Water Fund ikiadhimisha miaka 10 tangu kuanzishwa kwake jijini Nairobi. Akizungumza wakati wa hafla ya kifungua kinywa na mahojiano yaliyohusishwa na programu ya Global Environment Facility (GEF6), Katibu Mkuu katika Wizara ya Mazingira na Mabadiliko ya Tabianchi, Festus Ng'eno, alisema mfuko huo ni moja ya mifano iliyofanikiwa zaidi ya ushirikiano kati ya sekta ya umma na binafsi nchini Kenya katika kulinda vyanzo muhimu vya maji. Dkt. Ng'eno alieleza kuwa mpango huo unaonyesha jinsi ushirikiano kati ya mashirika ya serikali, huduma za maji, jamii na sekta binafsi unavyoweza kuhakikisha upatikanaji wa maji ya kutosha na yenye ubora kwa muda mrefu kupitia uwekezaji katika urejeshaji wa maeneo ya juu ya mabonde ya maji. "Upper Tana Water Fund ni moja ya mifano thabiti zaidi ya ushirikiano wa umma na binafsi nchini Kenya unaolenga kurejesha mabonde ya maji na kuhakikisha upatikanaji endelevu wa maji," alisema. Kenya ilikua nchi ya kwanza barani Afrika kuanzisha mfuko wa maji mwaka 2015 kupitia Upper Tana Nairobi Water Fund Trust, mfano ambao tangu wakati huo umechochea kuanzishwa kwa mifuko 17 ya maji katika nchi 11 za Afrika. Mpango huo unawaleta pamoja taasisi za umma, kampuni binafsi

na washirika wa maendeleo kufadhili shughuli za uhifadhi katika maeneo ya juu ya vyanzo vya maji vinavyosambaza maji kwa Nairobi na maeneo ya jirani. Dkt. Ng'eno alisema mtindo huo unaonyesha jinsi watumiaji wa maji walioko maeneo ya chini ya mabonde ya maji – wakiwemo kampuni za huduma za maji, biashara na mashirika ya serikali – wanavyoweza kuwekeza katika mifumo ya ikolojia ya maeneo ya juu ili kulinda rasilimali za maji.

Kwa mujibu wa Katibu Mkuu huyo, mfuko huo unaendana kwa karibu na vipaumbele vya kitaifa vya Kenya kuhusu usalama wa maji, ustahimilivu wa tabianchi na ulinzi wa mazingira. Aliongeza kuwa mpango huo unaunga mkono ahadi za Kenya chini ya Climate Change Act, Mpango Mkuu wa Kitaifa wa Maji na Michango ya Kitaifa ya Kupunguza Athari za Tabianchi (NDCs). Mbinu hiyo inategemea suluhisho

zinazotegemea asili, ikiwemo urejeshaji wa misitu, ulinzi wa maeneo ya kandokando ya mito na kuboresha afya ya udongo ili kuimarisha ustahimilivu wa mabonde ya maji.

Kenya imepiga hatua muhimu katika elimu jumuishi kwa kuanza rasmi kutumia Unified English Braille (UEB), na hivyo kujiunga na mataifa mengine duniani yaliyokubali mfumo huo wa kimataifa. Uzinduzi huo uliandaliwa na Idara ya Serikali ya Elimu ya Msingi kwa ushirikiano na The Action Fund, na uliongozwa na Mkurugenzi Mkuu katika Wizara ya Elimu, Elyas Abdi, aliyemwakilisha Katibu Mkuu Julius Bitok. Dkt. Abdi alisema hatua hiyo ni tukio muhimu katika kuhakikisha wanafunzi wenye ulemavu wa kuona hawasahauliki katika mfumo wa elimu. Ili kusimamia mchakato huo, Katibu Mkuu ameteua Kikundi Kazi cha Kiufundi (TWG) chenye wanachama 20 kutoka idara mbalimbali za serikali na mashirika

ya serikali yanayojitegemea.

Dkt. Abdi aliwahimiza wadau wa elimu kushirikiana kwa karibu na TWG ili kufanikisha mabadiliko hayo kabla ya muda uliopangwa wa mwaka 2029. Akizungumza katika hafla hiyo, Mkurugenzi wa Elimu ya Mahitaji Maalum na kiongozi wa TWG, Fredrick Haga, alisema kuwa kupitishwa kwa UEB kutarahisisha matumizi ya breli kwa kuondoa changamoto ya kuwepo kwa mifumo mingi. "Kenya sasa inaungana na mataifa mengine duniani kukumbatia mfumo mmoja uliunganishwa unaoondoa tofauti na kurahisisha ujifunzaji," alisema. UEB iliundwa ili kushughulikia changamoto zilizokuwepo katika Standard English Braille (SEB), ambayo ilikuwa na kanuni ngumu na ukosefu wa uwiano katika masomo kama hisabati, sayansi na teknolojia.

Kwa kuoanisha misimbo ya breli, UEB hurahisisha kusomana kuanzika, hivyo kuwapa wanafunzi fursa ya kupata elimu bora bila vikwazo visivyo vya lazima. Mabadiliko hayo yanatarajiwa kuboresha matokeo ya wanafunzi

wenye ulemavu wa kuona, kwa kuifanya Kenya kuendana na viwango vya kimataifa. Pia yataongeza fursa za ushirikiano wa kielimu, ubadilishanaji wa vifaa vya kujifunzia, na ushiriki katika majukwaa ya kimataifa ya elimu. Wadau wa elimu walisema hatua hiyo inaonyesha dhamira ya Kenya ya kuendeleza elimu jumuishi chini ya kaulimbiu ya "hakuna mwanafunzi anayeachwa nyuma." Kupitia UEB, wanafunzi wasioona watafaidika na mfumo rahisi na unaoeleweka, unaosaidia maendeleo ya kusoma, kuhesabu na kupata mtaala wa kisasa. Kadri TWG inavyoanza kazi yake, wadau katika sekta ya elimu wanahimizwa kuunga mkono mafunzo, uundaji wa rasilimali na kampeni za uhamasishaji. Mabadiliko haya hayahusu tu kubadilisha mfumo wa breli, bali kufungua milango kwa maelfu ya wanafunzi ili waweze kufanikiwa kitaaluma na kijamii.

Dkt. Ng'eno alibainisha kuwa ushahidi wa kisayansi unaonyesha kuwa kuwekeza katika miundombinu ya kijani kama misitu na udongo wenye afya mara nyingi kunaweza kuwa na gharama nafuu zaidi kuliko kutegemea tu miundombinu ya kawaida ya kijivu. Katika kipindi cha miaka kumi iliyopita, mpango huo umechangia kuboresha kwa ubora wa maji, kupunguza mchanga unaolingia kwenye mito na kuimarisha mtiririko wa maji wakati wa kiangazi, hatua ambazo zimewanufaisha mamilioni ya wakazi wa Nairobi na maeneo ya jirani wanaotegemea Bonde la Upper Tana kwa maji ya kunywa. Mpango huo pia umeunga mkono urejeshaji wa mifumo muhimu ya ikolojia ya "water towers" huku ukiimarisha maisha ya jamii za eneo hilo kupitia kilimo endelevu, upatikanaji wa maji na ajira za mazingira. Aidha, mfuko huo umehamasisha ufadhili na msaada wa kiufundi kutoka sekta mbalimbali, ikiwemo mashirika ya serikali na kampuni za huduma za maji kama Nairobi City Water and Sewerage Company. Washirika wa sekta binafsi wanaunga mkono mpango huo ni pamoja na East African Breweries Limited, Frigoken, Pentair, na Coca-Cola Africa Foundation, pamoja na washirika wa kimataifa kama Global Environment Facility na Embassy of Sweden in Kenya. Dkt. Ng'eno alisisitiza kuwa ushirikiano huo unaonyesha jinsi uwekezaji ulioratibiwa kati ya sekta ya umma na binafsi unavyoweza kulinda rasilimali za asili zinazochosha maendeleo ya kiuchumi. Akiangalia siku za usoni, aliwahimiza washirika wa maendeleo, mifuko ya tabianchi, taasisi za ufadhili wa ndani na sekta binafsi kuongeza uwekezaji katika mifuko ya maji huku shinikizo kwa vyanzo vya maji vya Kenya likiongezeka kutokana na ongezeko la idadi ya watu, mabadiliko ya matumizi ya ardhi na athari za tabianchi. "Mtindo wa mfuko wa maji unatoa faida kubwa kwa uwekezaji kupitia kupungua kwa gharama za kusafisha maji na ustahimilivu wa muda mrefu wa mifumo ya ikolojia," alisema. Aliongeza kuwa serikali imejitolea kuimarisha sera na kuunda mazingira wezeshi ya kupanua matumizi ya suluhisho zinazotegemea asili na ufadhili wa mabonde ya maji. Alibainisha pia kuwa mifuko ya maji inachangia utekelezaji wa ahadi za kimataifa za mazingira, ikiwemo malengo chini ya Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework yaliyojadiliwa wakati wa COP16 UN Biodiversity Conference, kwa kuunga mkono urejeshaji wa ardhi, uboreshaji wa udongo na ukarabati wa mabonde ya maji. Kenya ilionyesha malengo yake ya mabadiliko ya kidijitali katika Mobile World Congress 2026 mjini Barcelona, Hispania, ambapo viongozi wa kimataifa walikusanyika kuchunguza teknolojia zinazochipuka kama intelijensia bandia yenye uwajibikaji (agentic AI), suluhisho za miji smart, na miundombinu inayoungwa mkono na 6G. Ushiriki wa Kenya ulisisitiza juhudi za nchi hiyo za kueneza muunganisho wa nyuzi za nywele (fibre connectivity), kuanzisha vituo vya kidijitali, na kuharakisha mchakato wa kuhamia kwenye uchumi unaojengwa kwa maarifa. Kongresi hiyo, mojawapo ya majukwaa makubwa zaidi ya teknolojia duniani, iliwaleta pamoja watunga sera, viongozi wa sekta na wabunifu kujadili jinsi teknolojia za kizazi kijacho zinavyobadilisha uchumi na huduma za umma. Kamati ya Kenya ilishiriki katika majadiliano ya kimkakati, mikutano ya pande mbili, na maonyesho ya kiutendaji yenye lengo la kuimarisha ekosistimu ya kidijitali ya taifa. Moja ya mambo ya kuangaziwa ni ukaguzi wa Mfumo wa Mawasiliano wa Simu wa Reli wa Baadaye (FRMCS), jukwaa la kizazi kijacho lililoundwa kubadilisha mifumo ya reli ya zamani kwa uwezo unaotegemea 5G. Mfumo huu unaruhusu mawasiliano ya wakati halisi kati ya treni na vituo vya udhibiti, ukiongeza usalama, uaminifu na ufanisi wa operesheni. “Mifumo ya mawasiliano ya

kizazi kijacho itakuwa na jukumu muhimu katika kuboresha usalama wa usafirishaji, ufanisi wa operesheni na ujumuishaji wa kidijitali wa miundombinu ya usafirishaji,” alisema Katibu Mkuu wa Utangazaji na Mawasiliano, Stephen Isaboke, ambaye aliongoza kamati hiyo. Isaboke alisisitiza kuwa Kenya inajipanga kuchukua faida ya intelijensia bandia na muunganisho wa hali ya juu kuendeshwa mabadiliko ya kiuchumi na kuboresha sekta muhimu. Alibainisha kuwa utumiaji wa teknolojia hizo unaweza kuhar-

akisha utoaji wa huduma za kidijitali na kuchochea ukuaji unaoendeshwa na ubunifu. Ushiriki wa Kenya katika MWC 2026 ulikuwa umejikita katika mpango wa serikali wa Digital Superhighway, unaolenga kueneza muunganisho wa nyuzi za nywele, kutoa Wi-Fi ya umma, na kukuzwa huduma za umma zinazotegemea teknolojia. Mpango huu ni nguzo muhimu ya Vision 2030 na sehemu ya malengo ya Kenya kuwa kiongozi wa mkoa katika mabadiliko ya kidijitali. Akiwa pamoja na Isaboke walikuwa maafisa kutoka Mamlaka ya Mawasiliano Kenya, wakiwemo

Mwenyekiti wa Bodi Charles Karondo, na Adam Lane, Mkurugenzi Msaidizi wa Masuala ya Serikali katika Huawei Kenya, pamoja na washirika wengine wa teknolojia. Uwakilishi wao ulionyesha mtazamo wa ushirikiano wa Kenya, ukileta pamoja serikali, wadhhibi, na wachezaji wa sekta binafsi. Kamati hiyo ilitembelea maonyesho na kuhudhuria vipindi vya onyesho vinavyoonyesha teknolojia za mtandao zinazoendeshwa na AI, programu za miji smart, mifumo ya usafirishaji yenye akili, na muunganisho wa kizazi kijacho wa 6G.

Akizungumza katika sherehe ya kufunga mafunzo ya siku tano kuhusu Kushirikiana Taarifa na Kujenga Mitandao ya Uaminifu, Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa Mamlaka ya Mawasiliano Kenya (CAK), David Mugonyi, alisema

kuwa mpango huo umeweze-sha wataalamu wa usalama wa mitandao kupata ujuzi unaohitajika kulinda mfumo wa kidijitali wa taifa. Mugonyi alibainisha kuwa mafunzo hayo yaliwaleta pamoja wadau kutoka serikali na sekta binafsi ili kuchunguza njia za kuboresha ushirikiano katika kupambana na vitisho vinavyoongezeka vya mtandao. “Katika siku tano zilizopita, wadau kutoka serikali na sekta binafsi wamejifunza jinsi ya kushirikiana kwa ufanisi zaidi ili kulinda mfumo wa kidijitali wa Kenya,” aliripoti Mkurugenzi Mkuu. mtandao vimekuwa vizuri zaidi kiteknolojia, havina mipaka na vinaweza kuingilia kazi za taasisi, jambo linalofanya isiwezekane kwa taasisi moja pekee kushughulikia vitisho hivyo kwa kujitegemea. “Vitisho vya mtandao ni vizuri kiteknolojia, havina mipaka na vinaingilia kazi za taasisi, na kwa hiyo, hakuna taasisi moja inayoweza kuvitawala peke yake,” Mugonyi alisisitiza. Mkurugenzi Mkuu alifichua kuwa mafunzo hayo yali-pangwa kwa ushirikiano kati ya Mamlaka ya Mawasiliano Kenya (CAK) na Ofisi ya Mambo ya Nje, Jumuiya ya Madola na Maendeleo ya Uingereza (FCDO), kwa lengo la kuimarisha uwezo wa kubadilishana taarifa miongoni mwa wafanyakazi wa mstari wa mbele wa usalama wa mitandao.

Uchumi viumbe inaji-tokeza kama mhimili wenye nguvu wa maendeleo ya Kenya, ikiwa na uwezo wa kubadilisha usalama wa chakula, kuimarisha usalama na uhuru wa chakula, na kuendeleza sekta ya afya. Akizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi wa bodi ya ushauri ya Bio-Kenya, Prof. Shaukat Abdulrazak alisema kuwa sekta hii tayari ina mchango mkubwa katika mabadiliko ya uchumi wa nchi, ikichangia kati ya asilimia 20 hadi 26 ya Pato la Taifa la Kenya (GDP). Prof. Shaukat alisema kuwa ubunifu katika bioeconomy unaweza kuhakikisha Kenya inakuwa na chakula cha kutosha, kufungua upatikanaji wa vipimo, chanjo, na dawa kwa bei nafuu, na kuongeza uzalishaji katika sekta zinazotegemea bioteknolojia. “Jukumu la sayansi, utafiti na ubunifu katika ustawi wa taifa na uhuru haliwezi kupuu-zia. Sayansi haionekani tena kama shughuli ya kitaaluma pekee, bali kama rasilimali ya kitaifa yenye mkakati—inayopaswa kusaidia moja kwa moja maendeleo ya kijamii na kiuchumi ya nchi kupitia njia ya BETA kama ilivyoelezwa na Rais Dkt. William Ruto,” alisema Prof. Shaukat. Prof. Shaukat alisema kuwa serikali, kupitia Idara ya Serikali ya Sayansi, Utafiti na Ubunifu, inabaki imejazatiti kuunda mazingira yanayounga mkono utafiti na ubunifu kupitia sera zinazounga mkono, kuimarisha taasisi, na ushirikiano wa kimkakati. Alionyesha kuwa utawala huu unathamini ushirikiano na wadau wote, ikiwa ni pamoja na Alliance of Bio-iversity International na CIAT, Biovision Africa Trust, na washirika wengine katika kukuza sayansi na ubunifu kwa maendeleo endelevu. Prof. Shaukat aliahidi msaada kwa niaba ya Idara ya Serikali ya Sayansi, Utafiti na Ubunifu, na kuthibitisha msaada kamili kwa Bio-KE pamoja na jitihada za ushirikiano zilizowakilishwa wakati wa uzinduzi wa bodi. Alisisitiza kuwa Kenya lazima iendelee bioeconomy yake kupitia hatua za ushirikiano wa kimkakati, akiongeza kuwa mapitio ya maendeleo chini ya Bio-KE, marekebisho ya mtaala, na ushirikiano wa kimataifa lazima yaendane na Mkakati wa Taifa wa Bioeconomy. Alisema kuwa hili ni muhimu kwa kuwa bioeconomy haiwezi kukua peke yake; sera sahihi, elimu, utafiti na ubunifu vinapaswa kushirikiana kwa usawa. Mabadiliko na ukuaji tunayoyataka yatatokea tukiwa tunaishi kama mabadiliko yenyewe.

Serikali imeweka kiwango cha pamoja cha ada za kila mwaka zinazolipwa na wanafunzi katika Vyuo vya Ufundi na Ustadi (TVET) nchini, kwa lengo la kuongeza upatikanaji wa programu zao. Waziri wa Elimu, Julius Migos Ogamba, alitangaza ada mpya ya kila mwaka ya Sh67,189 kwa programu za TVET kote nchini, akibainisha kuwa kiasi hicho kinajumuisha pia ada za tathmini. Baada ya mashauriano ya kina na wadau wa sekta ya TVET, serikali imeweka kiwango cha pamoja cha ada za TVET ili kuhimiza upatikanaji wa mafunzo haya,” alisema Ogamba. Ogamba alitangaza mabadiliko hayo wakati wa sherehe ya kuapishwa kwa wanafunzi wa kwanza wa Baringo National Polytechnic mjini Kabarnet, Kaunti ya Baringo, tangu taasisi hiyo kupandishwa hadhi kwa polytechnic ya kitaifa. Akihutubia wahitimu, wazazi, wafanyakazi na wageni, Waziri alieleza kuwa sherehe hiyo ni hatua ya kihistoria kwa taasisi hiyo na aliwapongeza kundi la kwanza la wahitimu. Alibainisha kuwa wahitimu walikuwa wakiisha masomo yao wakati wa mabadiliko ya haraka ya kiteknolojia na kiuchumi, na kuwaongoza wakumbatie mafunzo ya maisha yote na kutumia ujuzi wao kuunda fursa binafsi na kwa jamii zao. Ogamba alisema kuwa Elimu na Mafunzo ya Ufundi na Ustadi ina jukumu muhimu katika ajenda ya maendeleo ya Kenya, ikiwa ni pamoja na Vision 2030, Bottom-Up Economic Trans-

formation Agenda, na malengo ya uchumi wa viwanda nchini. Aliongeza kuwa serikali inatekeleza mageuzi yanayolenga kuimarisha sekta ya TVET ili kutoa wahitimu wenye ujuzi, unaoweza kuendana na mahitaji ya soko la ajira na ushindani. “Mmoja wa mageuzi muhimu ni kuimarisha Mafunzo na Elimu Kulingana na Uwezo (Competency-Based Education and Training - CBET). Njia hii inabadilisha mtazamo wetu kutoka kufundisha kwa nadharia nyingi kwenda kwenye mafunzo ya vitendo, tathmini ya vitendo na kuendana na mahitaji ya sekta.” Miongoni mwa mageuzi ni

utekelezaji endelevu wa CBET, unaolenga mafunzo ya vitendo na kuendana na mahitaji ya viwanda. “Chini ya CBET, wanafunzi wanapimwa kwa kile wanachoweza kufanya, sio tu kile wanachojua. Mageuzi haya yanashughulikia moja kwa moja tatizo la muda mrefu la kutokulingana kati ya ujuzi unaofundishwa katika taasisi na mahitaji ya soko la ajira,” ilieleza sehemu ya taarifa. Waziri alisema kuwa mbinu hii inabadilisha mafunzo kutoka kufundishwa kwa nadharia kwenda kwenye mafunzo ya vitendo na tathmini ya vitendo, ikiwapa wanafunzi ujuzi unaolingana na mahitaji ya soko la ajira.

Aliongeza kuwa serikali inahimiza ushirikiano imara kati ya taasisi za TVET na viwanda ili kuboresha mafunzo ya kazini na kuhakikisha mafunzo yanabaki muhimu. Ogamba alisema kuwa serikali pia inakuwaweka vifaa vya kisasa, miundombinu ya kidijitali, uboreshaji wa walimu na mapitio ya mtaala ili kuimarisha taasisi za mafunzo. Baringo National Polytechnic ni miongoni mwa taasisi 69 zitakazonufaika na awamu ya tatu ya vifaa vya uhandisi wa mitambo vilivyotolewa na AVIC International ya China. Taasisi hiyo pia inatarajiwa kupokea vifaa vya baridi

kutoka GIZ, pamoja na miundombinu na vifaa vya chakula na vinywaji kutoka Colleges and Institutes Canada. Waziri alisema kuwa serikali inafanya kazi ya kupanua upatikanaji wa ufadhili wa masomo, mikopo na ruzuku kupitia Higher Education Loans Board (HELB) kusaidia wanafunzi wengi zaidi. “Majadiliano yanaendelea na Hazina ya Taifa kushughulikia upungufu wa fedha katika utoaji wa mikopo,” aliahidi Waziri. Ogamba alizitaka taasisi za TVET kusasisha mtaala wao mara kwa mara ili kujumuisha ICT, ujuzi wa kidijitali, teknolojia za nishati mbadala.

Murang'a yasambaza mbegu za mahindi, mbolea kwa familia 140,000 kupitia mfumo wa kidijitali

Serikali ya Kaunti ya Murang'a imefani-kiwa kusambaza mbegu za mahindi zilizoidhinishwa pamoja na mbolea za kupanda kwa takriban kaya 140,000 kupitia mfumo wa kidijitali. Uboreshaji huu wa usambazaji wa mbegu na mbolea unalenga kuongeza ufanisi na uwajibikaji katika mpango wa kusaidia pembejeo za kilimo. Kupitia mpango huu, wakulima waliojiandikisha kote kaunti waliweza kupata kilo 2 za mbegu za mahindi zilizothibitishwa zinazofaa kwa mazingira yao, pamoja na kilo 10 za mbolea ya kupanda. Wakulima pia walipokea viondoa wadudu (pesticides) kusaidia

kudhibiti mdudu wa fall army-worm, ambao umekuwa tishio kubwa kwa uzalishaji wa mahindi katika miaka ya hivi karibuni. Afisa Mkuu wa Kilimo wa Kaunti, Dkt. Apollo Maina, alisema mfumo wa kidijitali umeboresha sana mchakato wa usambazaji ikilinganishwa na miaka iliyopita. Akizungumza na Shirika la Habari la Kenya (KNA), Maina alisema kuwa mfumo huo umeondoa machafuko yaliyoashiriwa awali wakati wakulima walilazimika kukusanyika kwa wingi kwenye vituo maalumu vya usambazaji. “Awali wakulima walikusanyika katika maeneo maalumu kukusanya mbegu na mbolea, jambo lililokuwa likisababisha foleni ndefu, machafuko na wakati mwingine fujo,” alisema.



Baadhi ya wakulima ambao wamenufaika na mbegu za mahindi zilizoidhinishwa na mbolea chini ya mpango wa kusambaza mbegu kaunti ya Murang'a.

Afisa Mkuu aliongeza: “Kwa mfumo wa kidijitali, wakulima sasa wanaweza kupata pembejeo zao kutoka kwa wauzaji waliokodishwa katika kaunti, jambo linalofanya mchakato kuwa wa mpangilio na wenye ufanisi zaidi.” Kulingana na mpangilio mpya,

serikali ya kaunti inaendesha usambazaji kwa kupata mbegu na mbolea kutoka maghala ya Bodi ya Taifa ya Nafaka na Mazao (NCPB) yaliyopo Maragua kabla ya kusambaza pembejeo hizo kwa wauzaji waliothibitishwa ambao kisha wanawagawia wakulima.

Maina alisema kuwa jukwaa la kidijitali linahakikisha kila mkulima aliyesajiliwa anapokea sehemu yake bila usumbufu au kurudiwa mara mbili. “Mfumo huu unakuza uwazi na uwajibikaji kwa sababu kila muamala unahifadhiwa kidijitali. Hii inahakikisha msaada unafika kwa walengwa sahihi huku kupunguza uwezekano wa matumizi mabaya au kuhamishwa kwa pembejeo,” alifafanua. Afisa Mkuu alibainisha kuwa mpango huu ni sehemu ya ajenda kubwa ya kidijitali inayotekelezwa na serikali ya kaunti ili kuboresha utoaji wa huduma katika sekta mbalimbali. Aliongeza kuwa kutumia teknolojia katika programu za kilimo si tu kunarahisisha mchakato, bali pia kunawawezesha mamlaka kuweka rekodi sahihi za walengwa na kufuatilia usambazaji wa pembejeo. Kilimo bado ni shughuli muhimu ya kiuchumi katika Kaunti ya Murang'a, huku maelfu ya kaya yakitegemea kilimo kwa chakula na kipato.

Serikali yasaka masoko mapya kukinga wakulima kutokana na athari za vita

NA WANGARI MWANGI NA SAMUEL MAINA (KNA)

Serikali inachunguza masoko mbadala ya bidhaa za kilimo ili kulinda wakulima na wauzaji wa nje kutokana na hasara za kiuchumi zinazoweza kutokea kutokana na mzozo kati ya Marekani na Israel na Iran. Waziri wa Kilimo na Maendeleo ya Mifugo, Mutahi Kagwe, alisema kuwa timu ya mashirika mengi, inayoongozwa na Wizara ya Mambo ya Nje, imekuwa ikipitia hali hiyo mara kwa mara ili kupunguza athari zinazoweza kusababishwa na vita vinavyoendelea. “Tumepanga hatua za kuhakikisha tunatazama masoko mengine. Kwa mfano, katika soko la nyama, mbuzi na kadhhalika, kuna masoko mbadala yaliyojitokeza kutokana na hali hii, hivyo tunaamini tutakuwa na uwezo wa kuhudumia masoko mengine na badilisha masoko ambayo kwa sasa yapo katika mzozo,” alisema Kagwe. Kauli zake zinatokana na kuongezeka kwa wasiwasi miongoni mwa wauzaji wa nje kuhusu uwezekano wa kupoteza biashara yenye thamani ya Shilingi 700 bilioni kati ya Kenya na Mashariki ya Kati. Baadhi ya mauzo makubwa ya Kenya kuelekea Mashariki ya Kati ni chai, kahawa, maua na nyama. Moja ya sekta zinazokabiliwa na hasara kubwa kutokana na mzozo huu ni biashara ya kuuza nyama na mifugo ya nje yenye thamani ya mamilioni, ambapo Kagwe alisema kuwa nchi inasafirisha bidhaa za nyama na mifugo zenye thamani ya takriban Shilingi 300 milioni kila wiki. Hata hivyo, Bodi ya Sekta ya Wauzaji wa Mifugo na Nyama

Kenya ilikadiria hasara kutokana na usumbufu huo kufikia Shilingi 1 bilioni kwa wiki. Katika mahojiano na televisheni, Afisa Mtendaji Mkuu wa bodi hiyo, Nicholas Ngahu, alisema kuwa ingawa Falme za Kiarabu, Saudi Arabia, Oman na Kuwait zilikuwa masoko muhimu ya bidhaa za mifugo ya Kenya, kufungwa kwa anga na kuongezeka kwa hatari za usalama Mashariki ya Kati kumeathiri vibaya mlolongo wa usambazaji. Alisema kuwa wachezaji wa sekta ambao walitarajia kupata

faida kutokana na ongezeko la mahitaji wakati wa msimu wa Ramadhani, wamekumbwa kuacha muda mfupi au kupunguza kasi ya shughuli katika mabwawa ya uchinjaji. Hata hivyo, Kagwe alihakikishia wauzaji wa nje kuwa serikali inaendelea kuchunguza njia mbadala za usafirishaji ili kuwakinga kutokana na ongezeko la gharama za usafirishaji. Alisema kuwa kutokana na vita kuathiri shughuli za usafirishaji kwenye Strait of Hormuz, serikali inachunguza njia mbadala za kupoleka

mizigo kwenda Bahari Nyekundu. “Hatuwezi kukaa tu tukiangalie matukio yanatokea karibu nasi, lazima tuchukue hatua kupunguza athari kwa wakulima wetu,” alisema. Kagwe, akizungumza Nyeri siku ya Jumatano, pia alihakikishia wakulima kuwa nchi ina angalau mbolea ya kutosha kusaidia uzalishaji wa chakula. Alisema Wizara ya Kilimo ilipendekesha Shilingi milioni 8 katika makadirio ya bajeti ya ziada ambayo yataelekezwa kwenye mpango wa ruzuku ya mbolea.

Serikali yaimarisha msaada kwa wafugaji kupitia mradi wa DRIVE

NA NDUTA NJORGE (PCO)

Serikali inaongeza juhudi za kulinda maisha ya wafugaji na kuimarisha ustahimilivu dhidi ya mabadiliko ya tabianchi kupitia uzinduzi wa Mradi wa De-risking, Inclusion and Value Enhancement of Pastoral Economies (DRIVE) ambao sasa unatekelezwa katika kaunti 21. Mradi huo unaofadhiliwa na Benki ya Dunia na kutekelezwa kwa ushirikiano na Idara ya Serikali ya Maendeleo ya Mifugo, Shirika la Maendeleo la Kenya (KDC), ZEP-RE, serikali za kaunti pamoja na wadau wa sekta binafsi, unabadilisha namna hatari za ukame zinavyosimamiwa katika maeneo kame na nusu kame (ASALs) nchini. Mifugo ndiyo nguzo kuu ya uchumi katika maeneo ya ASAL, ikiendeleza maisha ya mamilioni

ya kaya na kuchangia pakubwa katika uzalishaji wa kilimo kitaifa. Hata hivyo, ukame wa mara kwa mara unaochochewa na mabadiliko ya tabianchi umeendelea kudhoofisha uhai wa mifugo, kipato cha kaya na usalama wa chakula. Mradi wa DRIVE unashughulikia changamoto hizi moja kwa moja kwa kuanzisha bima ya mifugo inayotegemea fahirisi (index-based livestock insurance) – mfumo unaotumia takwimu za satelaiti kuhusu uoto na mvua ili kuanzisha malipo wakati hali ya malisho inaposhuka chini ya kiwango kilichokubaliwa. Mfumo huu bunifu wa bima unahakikisha wafugaji wanapata msaada wa kifedha kwa wakati kabla hasara hazijafikia kiwango kikubwa. Tofauti na bima za kawaida, malipo hutolewa kiotomatiki na kutumwa moja kwa moja katika akaunti za kidiji-



tali za wafugaji, kuwawezesha kununua malisho na chakula cha mifugo wakati wa ukame. Akizungumza katika mkutano wa hivi karibuni wa Kamati Elekezi ya Mradi wa DRIVE, Katibu Mkuu wa Idara ya Maendeleo ya Mifugo Jonathan Mueke alisema kuwa hadi sasa takriban kaya 294,796 za wafugaji – zinazowakilisha watu wapatao milioni 1.55 – zimenunua bima ya mifugo inayolinda wanyama milioni 3.06 wenye thamani ya takriban Shilingi bilioni 32. “Wanawake wanawakilisha

takriban asilimia 60 ya wanufaika, jambo linaloonyesha dhamira ya serikali ya kuhakikisha hatua za kuimarisha ustahimilivu zinazingatia usawa wa kijinsia,” alisema Mueke. Mradi huo pia umeongeza ujumuishaji wa kifedha katika maeneo ambayo hayakuwa na huduma za kutosha. Zaidi ya akaunti za kifedha za kidijitali 224,000 zimeanzishwa kupitia mfumo inayohusishwa na DRIVE, huku makusanyo ya ada za bima ya mifugo yakifikia Shilingi bilioni 3.5.

Wizara yazindua mkakati wa uhamiaji salama, wa utaratibu

Idara ya Uhamiaji na Huduma za Uraia imeandaa mpango wa kina wa kutekeleza Mkataba wa Kimataifa wa Uhamiaji Salama, Wenye Utaratibu na wa Kawaida (GCM) kwa lengo la kushughulikia changamoto za uhamiaji nchini Kenya na barani Afrika. Hati ya utekelezaji ya GCM ya mwaka 2023–2025, ambayo kwa sasa inapitiwa na kuthibitishwa na wadau mbalimbali, inatarajiwa kuwasilishwa katika Jukwaa la Mapitio ya Kimataifa ya Uhamiaji litakalofanyika Mei 2026 mjini New York. Katibu katika Idara ya Uhamiaji na Huduma za Uraia Belio Kipsang, akithibitisha upya kujitolea kwa serikali katika ajenda ya kimataifa ya GCM, alisema Kenya imekuwa na nafasi muhimu katika kuendeleza mkataba huo kwa kumimarisha na kuongoza masuala ya usimamizi wa uhamiaji. “Ahadi yetu si ya kinadharia tu, bali imejikita katika sera zetu za kitaifa na mifumo ya kisheria inayolinda haki za wahamiaji na kuhimiza ujumuishaji wao katika jamii,” alisema Belio. Mkataba wa Kimataifa wa Uhamiaji (GCM) uliithinishwa mwaka 2018 mjini Marrakech, Morocco, kufuatia kutambulwa kuwa uhamiaji ni jambo la kimataifa linalohitaji hatua za pamoja na uwajibikaji wa pamoja ili kuhakikisha uhamiaji salama, wenye utaratibu na wa kawaida kwa wote. Alisema kuwa uhamiaji si suala la sera pekee bali pia ni suala la maisha ya watu, utu na heshima kwa haki za binadamu, kwani huvuka mipaka na kuathiri maisha ya mamilioni ya watu. Katibu huyo alitoa kauli hizo katika hotuba iliyosomwa kwa niaba na Mkurugenzi wa Utawala katika Idara ya Uhamiaji na Huduma za Uraia, Serser Chelulei, wakati wa Warsha ya Kitaifa ya Ushauriano kuhusu Ripoti ya Maendeleo ya Hiari ya Mkataba wa Kimataifa wa Uhamiaji Salama, Wenye Utaratibu na wa Kawaida nchini Kenya, iliyofanyika katika hoteli moja jijini Nairobi. Dkt. Belio alibainisha kuwa hati hiyo, inayobainisha mikakati na hatua za Kenya kukabiliana na changamoto za uhamiaji katika eneo hili, pia itaimarisha ukusanyaji wa takwimu, kuboresha ulinzi wa wahamiaji walio katika mazingira hatarishi na kuimarisha mfumo wa kisheria wa kukabiliana na biashara haramu ya binadamu na usafirishaji haramu wa watu nchini.



RECOGNIZED ENGINEERING DEGREE PROGRAMMES

The Engineers Board of Kenya is a statutory body established under Section 3(1) of the Engineers Act, 2011. The Board has the overall mandate of developing and regulating engineering practice in Kenya. The development and regulation of engineering practice is considered a key component to the achievement of infrastructure foundation under the country's Vision 2030 Development Blueprint.

One of the functions of the Board under section 7 (1) (i) of the Engineers Act, 2011 is to evaluate other engineering programmes both local and foreign for recognition by the Board.

Pursuant to section 8 of the Engineers Act, 2011, the Board established a Committee (Engineering Accreditation Committee – EAC Kenya) whose overall objective is to enhance the quality and standards of engineering education in Kenya, in alignment with international benchmarks, including the Washington Accord under the International Engineering Alliance. In June 2025, the Board acceded as a provisional signatory of Washington Accord.

The Board wishes to bring to the attention of the public the following recognized local engineering programmes. The Board shall only register persons who have pursued courses that are duly recognized by the Board.

Serikali sasa inatafuta upya mkataba wa miaka mitano na Shirikisho la Kimataifa la Magari (FIA) ili kuendelea kuwa mwenyeji wa mashindano maarufu duniani ya WRC Safari Rally. Serikali iliingia mkataba na shirika hilo la kimataifa mwaka 2021 kuandaa mashindano ya Safari Rally baada ya kusitishwa kwa miaka 19, hatua iliyoza msi-simko mpya kwa wapenzi wa mashindano ya magari nchini na kimataifa huku pia ikichochea ukuaji wa uchumi kwa hoteli za ndani na waandaji wa matukio. Mashindano ya mwaka 2026 yamevutia madereva 45 kutoka mataifa mbalimbali, wakiwemo washiriki 17 kutoka Kenya, hali inayoonesha kuongezeka kwa idadi ya madereva wa ndani katika mashindano hayo makubwa ya kimataifa ya mbio za magari. Tukio hilo la kila mwaka la kusimua limechangia mabilioni ya shilingi katika uchumi wa Kenya, huku mji wa Naivasha na maeneo yake ya jirani ukiwekwa kwenye ramani ya dunia kama kitovu kikuu cha mashindano hayo, jambo lililovutia faida za kiuchumi pamoja na maendeleo ya miundombinu. Tayari hoteli, nyumba za kulala wageni na malazi ya AirBnB yamejaa kabisa kwa mashindano ya siku

tatu, huku wafanyabiashara wadogo wakijitayarisha kunufaika na ongezeko la wageni na fedha za kigeni. Hatua ya sita na ya mwisho ya mashindano hayo inatarajiwa kuwapa maelfu ya watazamaji burudani ya kipekee huku madereva wakikabiliana na njia zenye matope na changamoto kubwa, tofauti na mazingira ya vumbi yaliyoshuhudiwa katika mashindano ya mwaka uliopita. Naibu Rais Profesa Kithure

Kindiki alisema kuwa tukio hilo linatarajiwa kuvutia zaidi ya watazamaji 600,000, ongezeko kutoka watazamaji 400,000 waliohudhuria mwaka uliopita, huku takriban watu milioni 80 wakitarajiwa kufuatilia mashindano hayo kote duniani. Ili kuhakikisha mafanikio ya mashindano hayo ya kila mwaka, Profesa Kindiki alisema serikali imetoa shilingi milioni 400 kuunga mkono tukio hilo,

akiongeza kuwa serikali inalenga kuongeza muda wa mkataba huo ili kukuza vipaji vya madereva wa ndani. Profesa Kindiki pia alisema zaidi ya maafisa wa usalama 100,000 wamewekwa katika maeneo muhimu ya njia za mashindano ili kudhibiti msongamano wa magari, huku madereva wakitarajiwa kukabiliana na ardhi ngumu pamoja na wanyamapori wakati maelfu ya mashabiki wakishangilia.

Bandari ya Lamu yapokea shehena ya gari la RoRo

Bandari ya Lamu imefikia hatua muhimu baada ya kupokea kwa mara ya kwanza meli ya kubeba magari ya Roll-On-Roll-Off (RoRo), hatua inayozidi kuimarisha hadhi ya kituo hicho kama kitovu kinachokua cha usafiri wa majini katika kanda. Meli ya MV Grande Auckland, ambayo ni meli maalum ya kubeba magari (Pure Car Carrier - PCC) yenye uwezo wa kubeba magari 900 na yenye asili ya Ulaya, iliwasili kwa mara ya kwanza katika Bandari ya Lamu iliyopo Kililana, Lamu Magharibi leo, na kushusha magari 469 kati ya magari 1,200 yaliyokuwa yamepakwiwa. Magari hayo, yaliyotengenezwa barani Ulaya katika kipindi cha miaka miwili iliyopita, awali yalikuwa yakielekezwa katika nchi za Mashariki ya Kati na yalipangwa kushushwa katika Bandari ya Jebel Ali katika Ghuba ya Uarabuni - ambayo ndiyo bandari kubwa na yenye shughuli nyingi zaidi katika eneo hilo. Hata hivyo, kuongezeka kwa mvutano uliosababishwa na mzozo

unaoundelea katika Ghuba ya Uajemi kulilazimisha meli hiyo kubadilisha njia na kuelekwa Lamu. Magari yaliyosalia yatafirishwa kwenda Mumbai, India, huku meli hiyo ikiondoka Bandari ya Lamu siku ya Jumatano. Akizungumza wakati wa mapokezi ya meli hiyo, Meneja Mkuu wa Bandari ya Lamu Kapteni Abdulaziz Mzee alisema hatua hiyo inaonesha kuongezeka kwa mara ya kwanza katika uwezo wa kiutendaji wa bandari hiyo. "Tumepokea kwa mara ya kwanza kabisa meli ya kubeba magari, MV Grande Auckland, hapa Bandari ya Lamu. Kuwasili kwa mara ya kwanza kwa meli hii kunatoa fursa kwa wadau wengine na kampuni za usafirishaji wa mizigo kuwa na imani na Bandari ya Lamu" alisema Kapteni Mzee. Alimkabidhi cheti cha kuashiria ziara ya kwanza nahodha wa meli hiyo, Kapteni Uros Golsuf, na kuipongeza kampuni ya Nisomar Shipping Agency Limited kwa kuichagua Lamu kama kituo kinachopendelewa cha usafirishaji

Akizungumza jijini Nairobi, Afisa Mkuu Mtendaji wa Shirika la Nishati ya Nyuklia na Umeme (NuPEA) Justus Wabuyabo alisema mkutano huo unaashiria hatua muhimu katika safari ya Kenya kuelekea kupitisha matumizi ya nishati ya nyuklia

Muswada unaopendekezwa wa Marekebisho ya Sheria za Faida za Uzeeni wa 2024 unalenga, miongoni mwa mambo mengine, kuruhusu wanachama kupata sehemu ya mafao yao ya uzeeni kabla ya kufikia umri wa kisheria wa kustaafu wa miaka 60. Akizungumza mjini Kakamega wakati wa kikao cha ushirikishwaji

wa umma, Afisa wa Sheria katika RBA, Anthony Kiaraha, alisema mabadiliko hayo yanapendekeza kuanzishwa kwa mfumo wa "vyungu viwili" (two-

pot system) utakaoruhusu wanachama kupata sehemu ya akiba yao mapema kwa mahitaji maalum kama vile elimu, makazi au matibabu.

"Marekebisho haya yanayopendekezwa yanalenga kuruhusu wanachama wa mifuko ya pensheni kupata sehemu ya akiba yao wanapokumbwa na matatizo ya kifedha bila kulazimika kuacha kazi zao, huku pia yakihakikisha hawataingia katika umaskini wanapofikia uzee," alisema Kiaraha. Ili kushughulikia tatizo la michango ya pensheni ambayo haijawasilishwa hasa kutoka kwa serikali za kaunti na taasisi za umma, RBA inapendekeza kurekebisha sheria ili kuwawajibisha moja kwa moja Wakurugenzi Wakuu (CEO) na maafisa wa uhasibu wanaoshindwa kuwasilisha makato ya kisheria.
