BUDGET TIPS/SUGGESTIONS TO THE CABINET SECRETARY, THE NATIONAL TREASURY FOR CONSIDERATION WHILE PREPARING THE BUDGET STATEMENT FOR THE FY 2026/27

The Cabinet Secretary for the National Treasury, Hon. FCPA John Mbadi Ng'ongo, EGH, is expected to deliver the Budget Statement for the FY 2026/27 to Parliament on 11th June 2026. As part of the finalization process, the Cabinet Secretary invites views, proposals, and innovative ideas from the public on economic policy, expenditure priorities, and tax measures for the FY 2026/27 Budget. Submissions are encouraged to be specific, practical, and aligned to the following priority areas:

- i) Measures to consolidate and scale up gains under the Bottom-Up Economic Transformation Agenda (BETA);
- ii) Interventions to reduce the cost of living, enhance food security, and expand opportunities for youth, women, and vulnerable groups in entrepreneurship, sustainable employment and leadership;
- iii) Proposals to scale up human capital, advance a net-export economy, ensure reliable and affordable energy, and strengthen transport and logistics;
- iv) Measures to strengthen macroeconomic stability and resilience, including responses to climate-related shocks and global geopolitical developments;
- v) Proposals to enhance domestic revenue mobilization, broaden the tax base, and improve compliance, while minimizing the burden on households and businesses;
- vi) Strategies to promote fiscal discipline and prudent management of public resources; and
- vii) Any other proposals to support inclusive, sustainable growth and economic transformation.
