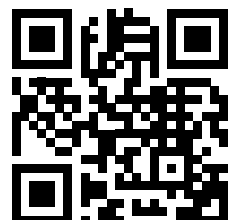

"Mafunzo haya yatashughulikia mapungufu ya ujuzi yaliyobainika wakati wa uongozi na ushauri, na kuimarisha uwezo wa wanufaika kukuza biashara zao," ilisoma sehemu ya taarifa hiyo. Katibu huyo alibainisha kuwa wanufaika wataalikwa kuhudhuria mafunzo hayo kupitia njia rasmi za mawasiliano, akiongeza kuwa ni wale tu walioshiriki katika programu ya awali ya uongozi na ushauri watakaostahili. Alisisitiza kuwa mahudhurio kamili na ushiriki katika mafunzo hayo yatakuwa ya lazima ili wanufaika waweze kufuzu kupata awamu ya pili ya mtaji wa kuanzisha biashara wa Sh25,000. Alisema kuwa programu hiyo inaendelea kuonyesha matokeo chanya, huku wengi wa wanufaika tayari wakiendesha biashara na kupata ujuzi wa vitendo kupitia uongozi na mafunzo.

## MOMBASA WATER SUPPLY AND SANITATION COMPANY LIMITED – WATER SERVICE PROVIDER SPECIAL REGULATORY REGIME

Mombasa Water Supply and Sanitation Company (MOWASSCO) is a water service provider (WSP) licensed by the Water Services Regulatory Board (WASREB) to provide water and sewerage services to residents of Mombasa within Mombasa County as delineated in the License.

PURSUANT to powers granted to WASREB under section 101 (1)(a), (c) and 102(1)(2)(3)(a) of the Water Act 2016, and in order to –

- Safeguard the progressive realization of the right to water to the consumers within the service area designated for this WSP within Mombasa County.
- Address poor governance and management malpractices of the water service provider.
- Improve internal control functions and financial management of the water service provider; and
- Improve the sustainability of the water service provider.

The Water Services Regulatory Board notifies the public that Mombasa Water Supply and Sanitation Company shall be under a special regulatory regime for the next six (6) months. During this time, the special regulatory regime measures shall include, but not be limited to-

- The WSP shall submit a weekly income and expenditure report to WASREB.
- The WSP shall submit bank reconciliation statements to WASREB on a monthly basis.
- The WSP shall submit an operation and maintenance report monthly using the reporting template to be issued by WASREB.
- The WSP shall submit Water quality reports on a monthly basis.
- The WSP shall submit a monthly progress report on progress made in addressing issues raised in the WASREB inspection report.
- All board committees, board meetings, or ad hoc board meetings shall be attended by WASREB.

The special regulatory regime herein takes effect from the date of this Notice.

### INVITATION FOR PUBLIC COMMENTS ON THE PROPOSED DRAFT BLUE CARBON ECOSYSTEMS – NDC IMPLEMENTATION & INVESTMENT PLAN (2025–2035)

Blue Carbon Ecosystems (BCEs); mangroves and sea grasses provide nature-based solutions that support climate change mitigation, coastal resilience, biodiversity conservation and sustainable livelihoods contributing to Kenya's climate commitments under the Paris Agreement to the United Nations Framework Convention on climate Change.

The Government of Kenya is developing the Draft Blue Carbon Ecosystems – Nationally Determined Contribution (NDC) Implementation & Investment Plan (BCE-NDC I&IP), 2025–2035, a national framework for high-integrity Blue Carbon actions, climate resilience, and sustainable coastal development.

The development process is jointly led by the Ministry of Environment, Climate Change and Forestry and the Ministry of Mining, Blue Economy and Maritime Affairs, in collaboration with Fauna & Flora, World Wide Fund (WWF), Wetland International (WI), International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN), The Nature Conservancy and other stakeholders.

The draft Plan has been subjected to stakeholder consultations at county, sectoral and community levels which generated valuable inputs and recommendations.

To ensure the Plan reflects national and regional stakeholder priorities and is technically robust, inclusive, and investment-ready, the two Ministries invites the public to participate by submitting written comments or memoranda on the draft Strategy to reach the undersigned not later than fourteen (14) days from the date of publication of this notice.

# Serikali yatoa ruzuku ya lishe ya mifugo kwa wakulima kufuatia ukame

Katika kipindi cha miezi mitatu iliyopita, Serikali imeanzisha programu za ruzuku ya malisho ya mifugo kwa lengo la kuwakinga wafugaji dhidi ya gharama zinazoozongezeka na athari za ukame wa muda mrefu.

Kupitia Mpango wa Kuimarisha Mifumo ya Chakula (FSRP), mamlaka zinatoa malisho kwa bei nafuu, kusaidia uzalishaji wa malisho, na kuhamasisha mbinu za kilimo zinazostahimili mabadiliko ya tabianchi katika maeneo yaliyoathiriwa na ukame. Mpango huo, uliozinduliwa katika Kaunti ya Mandera, unalenga kulinda maisha na kuimarisha ustahimilivu wa muda mrefu miongoni mwa jamii za wafugaji. Mratibu wa Kitaifa wa Mradi wa FSRP, Hillary Ngeno, alisema ruzuku hizo sasa zinaonekana zaidi kama uwekezaji wa muda mrefu badala ya msaada wa muda mfupi.

“Tunataka kupunguza upotevu wa mifugo katika maeneo ambako malisho yamepungua. Kutokana na mishtuko inayosababishwa

na mabadiliko ya tabianchi, ruzuku hizi husaidia kuzuia vifo vya mifugo kwa wingi, ambavyo vingeharibu kipato, usalama wa chakula na utajiri wa kaya,” alisema.

Ngeno aliongeza kuwa mpango huo utasaidia kulinda maisha ya vijijini kwa kudumisha mifugo, ambayo ni rasilimali ya kiuchumi na chanzo muhimu cha lishe, huku ukilinda kaya dhidi ya hasara za kifedha zisizoweza kurekebisha.

Matokeo ya Tathmini ya Athari za Ukame na Mahitaji ya mwaka 2026 (DINA) chini ya FSRP yanaonyesha hali inazidi kuwa mbaya, ikiwa ni pamoja na kudorora kwa afya ya mifugo, kuongezeka kwa milipuko ya magonjwa, na kushuka kwa asilimia 70 hadi 90 ya mavuno ya mazao yanayotegemea mvua. Vyanzo vingi vya maji ya wazi pia vimekauka, hali inayozidisha uhaba wa chakula katika maeneo yaliyoathiriwa.

Naibu Gavana wa Mandera, Dkt. Ali Maalim, alisema mpango wa ruzuku umefika kwa wakati muafaka huku ukame ukiendelea kuathiri mifugo, malisho, rasili-

iliyobaki,” alisema.

Mshauri Mkuu wa Rais kuhusu Usalama wa Chakula na Uzalishaji wa Mifugo, Dkt. Dominic Menjo, alisisitiza umuhimu wa uwekezaji unaolengwa, ikiwemo maeneo ya kulishia mifugo (feedlots) na mifumo bora ya ufugaji ili kuongeza tija na ufanisi katika sekta hiyo.

Hadi mapema mwaka 2026, hali mbaya ya ukame nchini Kenya, iliyochochewa na kukosekana kwa mvua za msimu wa Oktoba hadi Desemba 2025, imesababisha uhaba mkubwa wa malisho ya mifugo, huku upungufu wa asilimia 60 ukiripotiwa kuathiri maisha ya wafugaji na wakulima.

## Wanafunzi watatu wa Kenya wajishindia ufadhili Chuo cha Olympiad

Wanafunzi watatu wa shule za sekondari nchini Kenya wamepata ufadhili kamili wa masomo kwa miaka mitatu kusoma katika Chuo cha African Olympiad Academy kilichopo Kigali, Rwanda, baada ya kuibuka washindi bora katika Kambi ya Mafunzo ya Rising Stars ya mwaka 2026 iliyofanyika katika Kituo cha Elimu ya Hisabati, Sayansi na Teknolojia barani Afrika (CEMASTE), kampasi ya Karen. Wanafunzi hao, Caleb Tanui (15) wa Shule ya Upili ya Alliance; Michelle Ombuna (15) wa Kenya High School; na Juni Pearl Mumo (15) wa Alliance Girls High School, walipata fursa ya kujiunga na chuo hicho kinachojulikana kwa kukuzwa vipaji bora barani Afrika katika hisabati na informatics. Akizungumza wakati wa hafla ya kufunga kambi hiyo, Kaimu Afisa Mkuu Mtendaji wa CEMASTE, Gladys Masai, kupitia hotuba iliyosomwa kwa niaba yake na Kaimu Mkurugenzi wa Utafiti na Ubunifu wa STEM, Karanja Mutito, aliwapeleleza washiriki kwa kujituma na ustahimilivu wao. Aliwapeleleza wote walioshiriki na kuwahimiza waliopata tuzo kuzipokea kwa unyenyekevu, huku akiwatia moyo kundenalea kuwa na dhamira katika masomo yao. Kambi hiyo ya siku tano ya makazi, iliyofanyika kuanzia Aprili 8 hadi 12, 2026, iliwaleta pamoja wanafunzi 32 waliokuwa na matokeo bora waliochaguliwa kutoka kwa zaidi ya wata-



hiniwa 15,000 kupitia mchakato wa Kenya Mathematics Olympiad. Katika chuo hicho, wanafunzi waliochaguliwa watafuata mtaala maalum unaozungumza mafunzo pamoja na masomo ya Cambridge A-Level, ambao utawandaa kikamilifu kwa mashindano ya kikanda na kimataifa, yakiwemo International Mathematical Olympiad (IMO) na Pan African Mathematics Olympiad (PAMO). Masai alisisitiza kuwa mafanikio katika hisabati yanahitaji ustahimilivu na dhamira, akiwahimiza wale ambao hawakupata ufadhili kuendelea kujaribu ili kufanikiwa. Mpango huo uliundwa kundenalea elimu ya STEM kwa kujumuisha informatics pamoja na hisabati, hivyo kuwapa wanafunzi fursa ya kutumia ujuzi wa uchambuzi na utatuzi wa matatizo. Mwanzilishi mwenza na Mkurugenzi Mtendaji wa African Olympiad Academy, Arun Shanmuganathan, alisema kuwa

mpango huo unalenga kutambua na kukuzwa wanafunzi wenye vipaji vya kipekee wanaoweza kushindana kimataifa. Alisema kuwa wanafunzi walipitia mafunzo makali, wakikabiliana na maswali magumu sana na kufanya mitihani yenye ushindani mkubwa. “Tume wapa mafunzo ya kina katika hisabati ili kuwaandaa kwa mashindano ya kimataifa, pamoja na informatics, ambayo kimsingi ni uandishi wa programu. Wanafunzi wamekuwa wakishindana wao kwa wao, wakikabiliana na maswali magumu sana na kufanya mitihani yenye ushindani mkubwa,” alisema. “Mwisho wa mchakato huo, tuliweza kuchagua wanafunzi watatu bora ambao wamepata ufadhili kamili wa masomo kujiunga nasi katika African Olympiad Academy mjini Kigali,” aliongeza.

# Kenya yalenga kuinua pato kutoka sekta ya nguruwe ifikapo 2030

Kenya imeongeza juhudi za kubadilisha mnyororo wa thamani wa nguruwe, ikilenga ukuaji wa asilimia 125 ifikapo mwaka 2030 huku serikali ikichukua hatua kushughulikia mapungufu ya uzalishaji, yakiwemo gharama kubwa za chakula cha mifugo, mifumo dhaifu ya masoko, na changamoto nyingine za kimuundo zinazothiri sekta ya mifugo. Akizungumza wakati wa Kongamano la Kitaifa la Uhamasishaji kwa Wadau kuhusu Mnyororo wa Thamani wa Nguruwe, Katibu Mkuu wa Maendeleo ya Mifugo, Jonathan Mueke, alisema sekta hiyo ina fursa kubwa ya uwekezaji na ukuaji katika uchumi wa kilimo nchini. “Mfumo wa ufugaji nguruwe ni miongoni mwa minyororo ya thamani ya mifugo inayokua kwa kasi zaidi nchini,” alisema Mueke, akibainisha kuwa idadi ya nguruwe nchini kwa sasa inakadiriwa kufikia takribani 981,182. Alisema mahitaji ya nyama ya nguruwe mwaka 2025 yalikuwa yakikadiriwa kufikia tani za metriki 38,500 ikilinganishwa na uzalishaji wa tani za metriki

23,000, huku sekta hiyo ikikadiriwa kuwa na thamani ya takribani Shilingi bilioni 20. Hata hivyo, matumizi ya kila mtu bado ni ya chini, yakisimama katika kilo 0.4 ikilinganishwa na wastani wa dunia wa kilo 0.8. Mueke alibainisha kuwa makadirio ya mahitaji yanaonyesha kuwa matumizi yanaweza kuongezeka kwa hadi asilimia 125 ifikapo mwaka 2030, akieleza kuwa takwimu za sasa zinaonyesha kuwepo kwa fursa ambazo bado hazijatumika kikamilifu katika sekta hiyo. “Takwimu hizi zinaonyesha wazi kuwa nyama ya nguruwe ina fursa kubwa ambayo bado haijatumika kikamilifu. Mnyororo wa thamani wa nguruwe unachangia moja kwa moja katika mapato ya kaya na ajira, hasa kwa wakulima wadogo ambao wanachangia takribani asilimia 80 ya wazalishaji wetu,” alisema. Katibu Mkuu huyo alibainisha kuwa sekta hiyo inajukumu muhimu katika kuimarisha usalama wa chakula na

lishe, kukuza viwanda, na kuunda ajira kupitia usindikaji, usafirishaji na biashara ya rejareja, na inaendana na Ajenda ya Serikali ya Mabadiliko ya Kiuchumi kutoka Chini kwenda Juu (BETA). Alihimiza upanuzi wa haraka wa uzalishaji na uongezaji thamani ili kukidhi mahitaji yanayooongezeka, akibainisha kuwa mabadiliko wa mienendo ya matumizi mijini yanafungua fursa mpya za ukuaji. “Nyama ya nguruwe ni chakula chenye virutubisho vingi, chenye protini bora na virutubishi muhimu kama vile chuma, zinki na vitamini B. Hutoa nishati inayosaidia maisha yenye shughuli na uzalishaji,” alisema, akiongeza kuwa uzalishaji wa nyama ya nguruwe kwa njia bora unaweza kusaidia kupunguza utapiamlo na kuboresha mlo mseto. Hata hivyo, Mueke alionya kuwa sekta hiyo bado inakumbwa na changamoto kubwa, zikiwemo uzalishaji mdogo kutokana na mifumo duni ya mbeu na uzalishaji, gharama kubwa za chakula cha mifugo, huduma dhaifu za ugani, na uelewa mdogo miongoni mwa wakulima. Alitaja pia vitisho vya magonjwa, hasa homa ya nguruwe ya Afrika (African swine fever) kati ya hatari zingine.

Serikali ya Kaunti ya Turkana imezindua kituo cha afya cha Ngazi ya II katika eneo la Kakiteitei, Kaunti Ndogo ya Suguta, ikiwa ni hatua ya kuboresha upatikanaji wa huduma muhimu za afya kwa wakazi wa eneo hilo lililo vigumu kufikika.

Kituo hicho chenye thamani ya Shilingi milioni 9 kilifunguliwa rasmi Waziri wa Kaunti (CECM) anayeshughulikia Afya na Huduma za Usafi, Dkt. Esekon Joseph Epem. Aliandamana na MCA wa wadi ya Kapedo/Napeitom, Willy Naliwo, na MCA wa wadi ya Lokori/Lochodin, Willy Napuyo.

Akizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi huo, Dkt. Epem alibainisha kuwa Kakiteitei kwa muda mrefu imekuwa ikichukuliwa kuwa eneo lililo vigumu kufikika, hasa katika upatikanaji wa huduma za afya, kutokana na miundombinu duni ya barabara na hali ya ukosefu wa usalama inayojirudia.

“Kakiteitei imekuwa mojawapo ya maeneo yanayochukuliwa kuwa magumu kufikika, hasa linapokuja suala la huduma za afya. Tumeleta dawa na wahudumu ili kuhakikisha kuanzia sasa kituo hiki kinafanya kazi kikamilifu,” alisema Dkt. Epem.

imewekwa katika kituo cha Kaunti Ndogo cha Lokori kuhudumia Turkana Mashariki, na nyingine katika kituo cha Kaunti Ndogo cha Kapedo kuhudumia wakazi wa Lomelo, Napeitom, Ngilukia, Achemchem na Kakiteitei,” aliongeza. Dkt. Epem pia aliwahi-miza wafanyakazi wanya wa kituo hicho kuipa kipaumbele usajili wa SHA, akibainisha kuwa idadi kubwa ya wakazi bado hawajasajiliwa. Kwa kuwa huduma sasa ziko karibu zaidi kuliko hapo awali, usajili wa SHA unatarajiwa kuongezeka na kuimarisha hifadhi-data ya kaunti.

wamekumbana na changamoto za muda mrefu, si tu katika kupata huduma za afya bali pia maji, usafi na usalama.

“Kwa kuwa kituo hiki sasa kinafanya kazi kikamilifu, hiyo ni changamoto moja iliyotatuliwa. Tuko hatua moja karibu zaidi kuhakikisha watu wanapata huduma muhimu karibu nao kuliko hapo awali,” alisema.

Margaret Abei, muuguzi wa afya ya umma wa Kaunti Ndogo ya Kapedo/Napeitom, alieleza kuwa kuanza kwa huduma katika kituo cha Kakiteitei ni hatua kubwa kwa wakazi wa eneo hilo, hasa wanawake na watoto.

“Kituo hiki kitabadilisha hali. Wakazi sasa wanaweza kupata huduma hapa, hasa akina mama na watoto ambao hapo awali hawakuweza kutokana na ukosefu wa usalama walipokuwa wakisafiri umbali mrefu kutafuta huduma za afya,” alisema.

Chuo cha Taifa cha Kisumu kitakuwa kitovu cha kikanda cha ubora katika mafunzo ya uchumi wa buluu kupitia utekelezaji wa mpango wa B-STEP. Mpango huo, chini ya Mpango wa Ujuzi kwa Afrika (SIFA), utawezesha taasisi hiyo kuanzisha Kituo cha kipekee cha Mafunzo ya Ujuzi wa Buluu na Biashara (B-STEP) kitakachohudumia Kenya, eneo la Bonde la Ziwa Victoria na kanda pana ya Afrika. Kituo hicho kitajumuishia jengo la utawala, kumbi za mihadhara

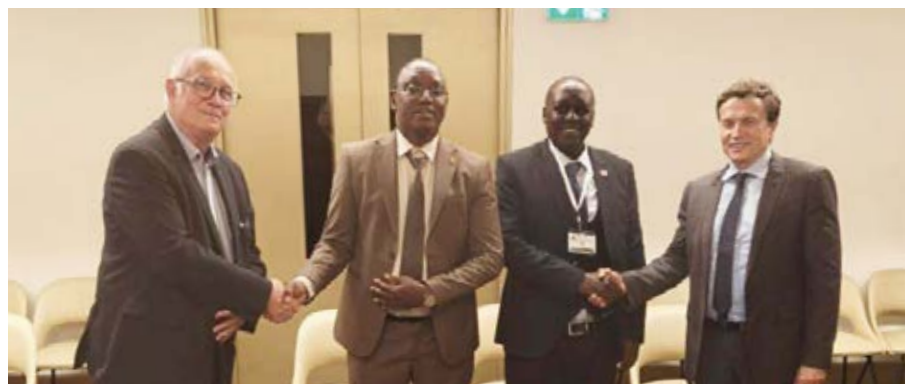

The **Kenya Nuclear Regulatory Authority** is established under Section 5 of the Nuclear Regulatory Act, Cap 243 Laws of Kenya. This Act provides a framework for the regulation of safe, secure, and peaceful utilization of atomic energy and nuclear technology, as well as the production and use of radiation sources and radioactive waste management. The Authority hereby notifies stakeholders of the following protocols for containerized and non-containerized cargo:

- Mandatory screening:** All cargo entering or exiting Kenyan ports of entry must undergo specialized screening to detect and prevent illicit trafficking of special nuclear and other radioactive materials.
- Radiation portal monitors:** Containerized cargo must pass through monitors stationed at strategic points, such as the Mombasa Port and Inland Container Depots. These monitors provide non-intrusive, high-sensitivity detection of gamma and neutron radiation. All legitimate radioactive sources must be accompanied by a valid KNRA Import License. Accurate documentation, including the correct Harmonized System (HS) codes, is required.

#### Requirements for importers and agents

- Traffic flow:** Importers and agents must ensure truck drivers and terminal operators follow designated traffic flows to avoid bypassing security checkpoints.
- Cooperation:** Cooperation with the Authority and multi-agency teams is essential to minimize clearance delays.
- Verification fees:** As provided in the Third Schedule of the Legal Notice 160.

## Mwanamke wa Nandi ajenga biashara ya usambazaji nafaka kaunti

Katika Wadi ya Songhor Soba, Kaunti Ndogo ya Tinderet, mwanamke mmoja amejijweka katika nafasi ya kipekee ya ujasiriamali. Amejenga biashara ambayo haibadilishi maisha yake pekee, bali pia inabadilisha muundo wa uchumi wa jamii yake. Jane Chebet, mfanyabiashara mwenye umri wa miaka 39, amekua kutoka biashara ndogo ya uuzaji wa nafaka na kuwa biashara kubwa inayosambaza mazao ya nafaka katika Kaunti ya Nandi na maeneo mengine, ikiwa ni ushahidi wa nguvu ya uwezesaji wa kiuchumi kwa wanawake. Miaka 15 iliyopita, safari ya Chebet ilianza kwa unyenyekevu akiwa na mtaji wa Shilingi 5,000 alizokopa kutoka kikundi cha wanawake cha kuweka akiba kwa pamoja (table banking). Alianza kwa kununua kiasi kidogo cha mahindi na maharagwe kutoka kwa wakulima na kuuza tena sokoni. Wakati huo, faida ilikuwa ndogo kiasi cha kutosheleza mahitaji ya kila siku ya familia yake. Hata hivyo, aligundua haraka kuwa biashara ya nafaka, ikiwa itaendeshwa vizuri, ilikuwa na uwezo mkubwa kutokana na nguvu ya kilimo katika eneo hilo. “Niliona wakulima wakikosa wanunuzi wa uhakika wakati

wafanyabiashara mijini wakihitaji bidhaa kwa uhakika. Niliamua kuziba pengo hilo,” anakumbuka. Kilichoanza kama njia ya kujikimu kilibadilika na kuwa biashara iliyopangwa. Ndani ya miaka mitatu, Chebet aliongeza mtaji wake hadi Shilingi 50,000 kupitia akiba na kuwekeza tena faida. Alipanua mtandao wake wa wakulima, akaanza kununua kwa wingi wakati wa mavuno, na akaanzisha njia za msingi za kuhifadhi nafaka ili kupunguza upotevu baada ya mavuno. Leo, biashara yake hushughulikia wastani wa tani 20 hadi 25 za nafaka kwa mwezi, ikijumuisha mahindi, maharagwe, mtama na ulezi. Wakati wa msimu wa mavuno, kiwango huongezeka hadi zaidi ya tani 40. Kwa bei ya mahindi ya takribani Shilingi 4,000 kwa gunia la kilo 90 na maharagwe yakifikia hadi Shilingi 8,000 kwa gunia, mauzo yake ya kila mwezi hufikia kati ya Shilingi 800,000 hadi 1,000,000, kulingana na hali ya soko. Wateja wake wameongezeka kwa miaka. Kilichoanza kama mauzo kwa wakazi wa eneo hilo kimepanuka na kufikia mikataba ya usambazaji kwa shule, viwanda vidogo vya kusaga nafaka na wafanyabiashara katika miji ya Kapsabet, Nandi Hills na Eldoret. Pia ameanza kutumia mifumo ya malipo ya simu, jambo linalofanya biashara kuwa rahisi na salama zaidi. Ukuaji wa biashara yake ume-

ongeza kipato chake na pia kuunda ajira. Kwa sasa anaajiri wafanyakazi wa kudumu watano wanaosaidia kuchambua, kukausha, kufunga na kuweka kumbukumbu za biashara, pamoja na vibarua wa muda

wakati wa msimu wa mavuno. Wengi wa wafanyakazi hao ni vijana wa eneo hilo ambao hapo awali walikosa ajira ya kudumu. “Kuwapa vijana ajira ni jambo ninalolichukulia kwa uzito kwa sababu nilikuwa katika hali ya kukosa kipato,” anasema. Zaidi ya ajira, biashara yake inasaidia wakulima wengi wa eneo hilo kwa kuwapatia soko la uhakika la mazao yao. Mara nyingi hununua moja kwa moja kwa

bei ya haki, jambo linalopunguza utegemezi kwa madalali wanaowanyanyasa wakulima wakati wa mavuno mengi. Hata hivyo, mafanikio yake hayajaja bila changamoto. Miaka ya mwanzo, Chebet alikumbana na mashaka kutoka kwa baadhi ya wanajamii waliodhani biashara kubwa ni ya wanaume. Upatikanaji wa mikopo pia ulikuwa changamoto kubwa, kwani taasisi za kifedha zilihitaji dhamana ambayo hakuwa nayo. Bila kukata tamaa, alitegemea vikundi vya akiba vya wanawake na polepole akaanza kujenga historia ya kifedha iliyomwezesha kupata mikopo mikubwa zaidi. Kufikia mwaka 2018, alipata mkopo wake wa kwanza wa benki wa Shilingi 300,000, aliutumia kujenga ghala la kuhifadhi nafaka lenye uwezo wa tani 100. Hii ilipunguza sana hasara zinazotokana na wadudu na unyevu, na kuongeza faida yake. Ustahimilivu wake unaakisi hali pana inayowakumba wanawake wengi wajasiriamali nchini Kenya, ambapo upatikanaji wa fedha na rasilimali bado ni changamoto kubwa. Hata hivyo, hadithi yake pia inaonyesha uwezo mkubwa uliofichika pale wanawake wanapopewa fursa ya kiuchumi. Kupitia kipato kilichoongezeka, Chebet ameweza kuwapeleka watoto wake wanne shuleni, kuboresha maisha ya familia yake na kuwekeza katika miradi mingine kama ufugaji wa ng’ombe na maziwa. Pia amekuwa mlezi na kielelezo kwa wanawake wengine katika Songhor Soba, ambapo amewafundisha zaidi ya 25 kuhusu ujumuishaji wa nafaka, mbinu za kuhifadhi na ujuzi wa msingi wa usimamizi wa fedha.

# Jinsi mkakati wa mazao mawili unavyomsaidia mkulima kujikimu misimu isiyotabirika

**K**ilimo bado ni njia ya maisha na pia dau la kila siku dhidi ya hali ya hewa kwa kaya nyingi za vijijini.

Hata hivyo, John Kirui kutoka eneo la Meteitei katika Kaunti Ndogo ya Tindiret anabadilisha mtazamo huo wa kawaida.

Katika shamba lake dogo la ekari mbili, amefanya uamuzi wa makusudi unaonesha uzoefu na pia mbinu ya kujinusuru; ekari moja imepandwa mahindi na nyingine vitunguu. Kwa Kirui, hii si mabadiliko ya kawaida ya upangaji wa mazao bali ni jibu kwa miaka ya kutokuwa na uhakika uliosababishwa na mabadiliko yasiyotabirika ya mvua. Kama wakulima wengi wadogo katika eneo hilo, anategemea kabisa kilimo cha mvua, maana kila msimu huanza kwa matumaini makubwa lakini mara nyingi huishia katika sintofahamu.

Kwa miaka mingi, Kirui ameshuhudia mahindi yake yakiharibiwa na mabadiliko ya hali ya hewa. Katika baadhi ya misimu, ukame mkali hutokea wakati mazao yanakaribia kukomaa, na kusababisha mimea kunyauka na mavuno kupungua kwa kiasi kikubwa. Katika misimu mingine, mvua nyingi hufurika mashamba yake, kuchelewesha ukuaji na kusababisha magonjwa

ya mimea. Kila msimu mbaya au wenye mavuno duni huleta matokeo yale yale: kupoteza kipato na kuongezeka kwa utegemezi.

Ni kutokana na uzoefu huu ambapo uamuzi wake wa kubadilisha kilimo ulizaliwa. Badala ya kuendelea kutegemea mahindi pekee, Kirui alianzisha kilimo cha vitunguu katika nusu ya shamba lake, akilenga kupunguza hatari na kuongeza nafasi ya kupata angalau faida sehemu ya msimu bila kujali mvua zitakavyokuwa.

“Niligundua kuwa kutegemea zao moja ni hatari sana,” anasema akiwa katikati ya mistari ya mahindi upande mmoja na miche ya vitunguu upande mwingine. “Mvua ikikosekana, kila kitu kinaharibika. Lakini nikipanda mazao tofauti, siwezi kupoteza kila kitu.”

Muundo wa shamba lake sasa unaonyesha hadithi ya uwiano na mabadiliko. Ekari moja imepandwa mahindi, zao muhimu kwa chakula cha familia. Ekari nyingine iko chini ya vitunguu, ambavyo anaona kama njia ya mkakati wa kujikinga na chanzo mbadala cha kipato. Vitunguu, anaeleza, havi-kuchaguliwa kwa bahati. Tofauti na mahindi ambayo huhitaji mvua kwa mpangilio sahihi, vitunguu vinaweza kustahimili mabadiliko ya unyevu na huweza kutoa mavuno chini ya usimamizi mzuri. Pia huchukua muda mfupi kuvunwa na vinaweza kuleta mapato mazuri sokoni wakati hali inaruhusu. Hata hivyo, Kirui anakiri kuwa zao hilo pia

lina changamoto, hasa katika mfumo wa kilimo unaotegemea mvua pekee.

Kilimo katika Meteitei na maeneo mengine ya Tindiret kimekuwa kigumu zaidi katika miaka ya hivi karibuni. Wakulima wanazungumzia misimu isiyotabirika, ambapo mvua hucheleva, hukoma ghafla au hunyesha kwa wingi kupita kiasi kwa muda mfupi. Kwa wakulima kama Kirui, mabadiliko haya yamefanya mbinu za kilimo za jadi kuwa zisizo na uhakika zaidi.

Bila umwagiliaji au mifumo ya kisasa ya maji, Kirui hutegemea uchunguzi na uzoefu kuamua wakati wa kupanda. Huchunguza anga, kugusa udongo na kufanya maamuzi yanayoamua hatima ya mazao yake kwa msimu mzima. Hata hivyo, pamoja na uzoefu huo, kutokuwa na uhakika bado ni sehemu ya maisha yake ya kila siku.

“Sipati tena uwezo wa kutabiri hali ya hewa kama zamani,” anasema. “Wakati mwingine unapanda ukitarajia

mvua inachelewa. Wakati mwingine inanyesha sana. Unalazimika kubadilika kadiri hali inavyokuwa,” anaongeza.

Kuanzishwa kwa kilimo cha vitunguu katika shamba lake kunaonyesha mabadiliko mapana ya fikra miongoni mwa wakulima wa eneo hilo. Ingawa mahindi bado ni zao kuu kwa sababu ya umuhimu wake wa chakula na utamaduni, kuna uelewa unaongezeka kuwa kutegemea zao moja ni hatari zaidi. Katika shamba la Kirui, tofauti kati ya mazao hayo mawili inaonekana wazi. Mahindi yamesimama wima katika mistari iliyopangwa, yakisubiri mzunguko wa mvua uamue hatima yake. Vitunguu, vilivyo karibu na ardhi, vinakua kwa utaratibu wake, vikitoa matumaini tofauti ambayo hayategemei matokeo moja tu.

Anaeleza mkakati wake kwa urahisi, “Mahindi ni chakula, vitunguu ni akiba ya usalama. Ndivyo ninavyoviona sasa.”

Mkakati huu wa mazao mawili hauondoi kabisa hatari. Mazao yote mawili bado yanategemea mvua, na ukame mrefu au mvua nyingi kupita kiasi bado vinaweza kuathiri yote kwa pamoja. Hata hivyo, Kirui anaamini kuwa tofauti yake iko katika kupunguza utegemezi wa matokeo moja tu. Hata mahindi yakiharibiwa, vitunguu vinaweza kusaidia kuokoa msimu.

Mbinu za kilimo katika kaunti ndogo hiyo zinaendelea kubadilika kadiri wakulima wanavyokabiliana na hali ya kutotabirika kwa tabianchi. Maafisa ugani katika eneo hilo wanaeleza kuwa wakulima zaidi wanakumbatia kilimo mseto kama njia ya kukabiliana na changamoto. Mabadiliko haya hayaendeshwi tu na programu rasmi, bali pia na uzoefu halisi wa misimu ya hasara inayowalazimisha wakulima kufikiria upya

**A**ngalau tani 13 za mbegu zilizothibitishwa na zinazostahimili mabadiliko ya tabianchi zimegawiwa kwa wakulima katika Bonde la Kerio kupitia mpango maalum wa Serikali ya Kaunti ya Elgeyo Marakwet, unaolenga kuongeza uzalishaji wa kilimo na kuimarisha uwezo wa kukabiliana na mabadiliko ya tabianchi katika maeneo kame na nusu kame.

Ugawaji huo ulijumuisha tani 6.5 za mbegu za maharagwe aina ya Nyota zinazostahimili ukame, tani 4.32 za mbegu za mahindi za kukomaa haraka aina ya DH04 kwa maeneo kame, na tani 2.5 za mbegu za mtama, zote zikichaguliwa kutokana na uwezo wake wa kutoa mavuno mengi, kukomaa mapema na kustahimili uhaba wa unyevu. Wanufaika walitoka katika maeneo ya Endo, Arror, Lower Sambirir, Lower Emsoo na Lower Tambach, ambayo yana-

julikana kwa mvua zisizo za uhakika na vipindi vya ukame vinavyorudiwa mara kwa mara. Gavana Wisley Rotich, aliyenyoza zoezi hilo pamoja na maafisa

wa kiufundi kutoka Idara ya Kilimo, alisisitiza umuhimu wa kimbakati wa msaada wa pembejeo katika kuongeza uzalishaji wa mashamba katika mazingira

ya mabadiliko ya tabianchi. “Bonde la Kerio lina uwezo mkubwa katika uzalishaji wa kilimo. Kupitia utoaji endelevu wa pembejeo na kuendelea kilimo kinachozingatia mabadiliko ya tabianchi, tunawawezesha wakulima wetu kufikia mavuno bora licha ya changamoto za mazingira zilizopo,” alisema Rotich. Gavana huyo alisema pembejeo hizo zilizogawiwa zinatarajiwa kuwezesha kilimo katika takribani ekari 1,400 chini ya kilimo cha kutegemea mvua. “Tunalenga kuweka takribani ekari 1,400 chini ya uzalishaji wa mazao. Kwa undani, tani 6.5 za maharagwe ya Nyota zitafunika ekari 324, tani 4.32 za mahindi zitapandwa katika takribani ekari 430, na tani 2.5 za mbegu za mtama zitatumika katika takribani ekari 630,” alisema.

**K**aunti ya Kisumu inaongeza uwekezaji katika Vituo vya Mafunzo ya Ufundi Stadi (VTCs) ili kuwahudumia maelfu ya vijana wanaokosa nafasi za kujiunga na vyuo vikuu kila mwaka. Afisa Mkuu wa Kaunti anayeshughulikia Elimu, Mafunzo ya Ufundi, Ubunifu na Huduma za Jamii, Bovince Ochieng, alisema kuwa serikali ya ugatuzi inalenga wahitimu wa shule za sekondari wanaoshindwa kujiunga na vyuo vikuu, na kuwahimiza kujiunga na taasisi za Elimu na Mafunzo ya Ufundi Stadi (TVET). Akizungumza katika mahojiano na KNA ofisini kwake, Ochieng alisema kaunti inaiweka upya elimu ya ufundi kama njia mbadala ya vitendo na yenye ushindani dhidi ya njia za kitaaluma za vyuo vikuu. “Tunahitaji vijana ambao hawafiki vyuoni kupata ujuzi unaohitajika katika soko la ajira badala ya kubaki bila shughuli,” alisema. Mpango huo tayari umeanza kuleta matokeo chanya ambapo takriban wanafunzi 3,165 kutoka Vituo 28 vya Mafunzo ya Ufundi (VTCs) walihitimu mwezi uliopita. Ochieng alisema hili linaonyesha ongezeko la uhitaji wa mafunzo ya ufundi, akiongeza kuwa idara ya TVET inajenga ushirikiano na sekta mbalimbali na wadau ili kupanua programu za mafunzo. Afisa huyo mkuu alisema mahafali hayo yanaonesha athari ya uwekezaji endelevu wa kaunti na washirika wake katika kuongeza upatikanaji wa mafunzo ya ujuzi.

Kitaifa, zaidi ya watahiniwa

900,000 huketi mtihani wa Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education (KCSE) kila mwaka, lakini takriban 200,000 pekee hupata nafasi ya moja kwa moja kujiunga na vyuo vikuu. Katika Kaunti ya Kisumu, takriban watahiniwa 28,000 walifanya mtihani wa KCSE mwaka jana, ambapo karibu 16,000 walipata daraja D+ na chini. “Hii ni idadi kubwa ya vijana ambao huenda wasiende vyuoni. Tunawahimiza wachukue mafunzo ya ufundi kama njia mbadala,” alisema. Ili kuongeza uwezo, kaunti imeongeza ajira ya waku-funzi, ikiandikisha wakufunzi 25 katika mwaka wa fedha uliopita na inapanga kuajiri idadi sawa mwaka huu. Wakati huo huo, imewekeza katika warsha na vifaa vya kisasa ili kuendana na mahitaji ya sekta. Ochieng alisema kaunti ilitumia Shilingi milioni 18 kwa zana na vifaa mwaka uliopita na imetenga Shilingi milioni 20 katika mwaka huu wa fedha. Mpango huo pia unasaidiwa na washirika wengine wa maendeleo ikiwemo Kenya Blue Economy Skills Training (KBEST), pamoja na Pratham na Tools to Work, ambapo wametoa vifaa na msaada wa kiufundi.

Ili kuingiza teknolojia katika mafunzo, Afisa Mkuu huyo alisema kaunti imeanzisha vituo vya kidijitali vya jamii katika baadhi ya vituo vya Ahero, Akado na Katito, ambapo wanafunzi wanaweza kupata ujuzi wa kidijitali na fursa za kazi mtandaoni.

Ochieng aliongeza kuwa kaunti pia inafanya kazi kwa karibu na wadau wa sekta, wasimamizi na taasisi za mafunzo ili kushughulikia pengo kati ya mafunzo na mahitaji ya soko la ajira.

Okoth alisema kuwa wakati wa zoezi hilo, mifugo pia itasajiliwa kwa kutumia teknolojia ya muzzle ili kusaidia kuitambua iwapo itaibwa au kuhamishwa maeneo mengine. Mkurugenzi wa Kaunti wa



Maafisa wa mifugo wakiwa na ng’ombe katika uwanja wa Shule ya Msingi ya Majengo katika Kaunti Ndogo ya Usigu, kaunti ya Siaya huku mwenzao akimsajili kwa kutumia teknolojia ya midomo, mfumo wa hali ya juu wa utambulisho wa kibayometriki unaoendeshwa na AI ambao hutumia mifumo tata kwenye midomo wa mnyama haswa ng’ombe, nyati na mifugo sawa kuwatambua.

Clay Ngoye, alisema usajili wa mifugo kwa kutumia teknolojia utasaidia kupunguza wizi wa mifugo. “Kama vile binadamu hutumia alama za vidole kutambulika, teknolojia hii mpya inasaidia kutambua mnyama,” alisema. Mfugaji Joseph Buoga Ogumbo alisifu serikali ya kitaifa na ya kaunti kwa mpango huo, lakini akaomba taarifa za mapema kuhusu maeneo ya zoezi hilo.

Wataalamu wa afya wameeleza wasiwasi wao kuhusu ongezeko la magonjwa ya macho na koo katika eneo la Ukanda wa Kati wa Kenya, wakionya kuwa kuchelewa kutambua matatizo ya macho kunaweza kusababisha madhara makubwa, ikiwemo upofu. Madaktari wamesema visa vya magonjwa ya macho, hasa ugonjwa wa jicho (cataracts), vinaongezeka, hali wanayoihusisha kwa sehemu na ukaribu wa eneo hilo na Ikweta na kuongezeka kwa mionzi hatari ya urujuani (UV). Wataalamu hao wamesisitiza haja ya wananchi kuipa afya kipaumbele kupitia uchunguzi wa mara kwa mara na kujikingira na hatari za kimazingira. Wakiongozwa na mtaalamu wa macho Dkt. Deepak Bhatra wakati wa kambi ya bure ya matibabu ya macho, masikio, pua na koo iliyofanyika katika Chuo Kikuu cha Ufundi cha Kitaifa cha Michuki katika Jimbo la Kangema, walisema kuathiriwa kwa muda mrefu na jua moja kwa moja bila kinga ni chanzo kikuu cha matatizo ya macho. “Mfiduo wa muda mrefu wa miale ya jua bila kinga unaweza kuathiri sana macho na hatimaye kusababisha upotevu wa uwezo wa

kuona,” alisema Dkt. Bhatra. Mtaalamu huyo alibainisha kuwa mtoto wa jicho bado ni moja ya magonjwa ya macho yanayoongoza katika eneo hilo kutokana na kiwango kikubwa cha mionzi ya urujuani. “Tunaona pia visa vya spring catarrh, hali ya mizio ambapo macho huwa mekundu, huwasha na kutoa machozi, na tunashauri wagonjwa kuvaa miwani ya giza ili kuepuka kuzidisha hali hiyo wanapopata matibabu,” aliongeza. Dkt. Bhatra aliwahimiza watu, hasa wanaofanya kazi nje na mashambani, kuvaa miwani ya kinga ya UV na kuzingatia usafi kwa kunawa macho kwa majisafi. “Kuendelea kuathiriwa na miale hatari ya jua bila kinga

huongeza hatari ya kupungua kwa uwezo wa kuona na katika hali mbaya inaweza kusababisha upofu,” alionya. Wakati huo huo, kambi hiyo ilibaini ongezeko la maambukizi ya koo, hasa miongoni mwa vijana. Mtaalamu wa masikio, pua na koo (ENT) Dkt. Arpitta Singhal alisema ingawa tonsils ni sehemu ya kawaida ya mfumo wa kinga ya mwili, maambukizi ya mara kwa mara yanaweza kuhitaji matibabu maalum. “Tonsils ni tishu za kawaida za limfu ambazo hupungua kadri umri unavyoongezeka kutoka miaka 12 hadi 14, lakini iwapo mtu anahitaji matibabu mara tisa hadi kumi kwa mwaka kutokana na maambukizi ya koo, basi kuna haja ya matibabu ya kudumu,” alisema.

Dkt. Singhal aliwashauri wakazi kuchukua hatua za kinga kama kunywa vinywaji vya uvuguvugu na kuepuka kuathiriwa sana na baridi. Mratibu wa Shree Jain Foundation, Vinay Shah, alisisitiza umuhimu wa programu za uhamasishaji wa afya katika kuboresha upatikanaji wa huduma za matibabu. “Uchunguzi wa mara kwa mara husaidia kugundua magonjwa mapema na kuhakikisha matibabu ya haraka, jambo linaloweza kuzuia madhara ya muda mrefu,” alisema. Mkuu wa Chuo cha Ufundi cha Kitaifa cha Michuki, Ann Mbogo, aliwahimiza wakazi kutumia fursa hizo, akibainisha kuwa kugundua magonjwa mapema ni muhimu katika kuzuia matatizo makubwa ya kiafya.
