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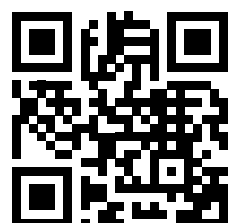

Makubaliano hayo, yaliyoshuhudiwa na Rais wa Ufaransa Emmanuel Macron pamoja na Rais William Ruto wakati wa Mkutano wa Africa Forward: Ushirikiano wa Afrika na Ufaransa kwa Ubunifu na Ukuaji, yanawakutanisha Palais des Thés, kampuni mashuhuri ya chai maalum kutoka Ufaransa; Gatanga Industries Limited, wazalishaji wa chai bora nchini Kenya ikiwemo aina asilia ya chai ya zambarau; pamoja na Equity Group Holdings Plc. Mkataba huo unatarajiwa kufungua fursa mpya za mapato kwa wakulima wadogo wa chai kwa kuweka chai ya zambarau na chai maalum za Kenya katika masoko ya watumiaji wa bidhaa

Serikali imeongeza juhudi za kuboresha na kuimarisha sekta ya bodaboda kwa kuwataka waendeshaji kote nchini kujisajili chini ya SACCOs. Hatua hiyo inalenga kuimarisha usalama, kukuza uwezesaji wa kiuchumi, na kuboresha mpangilio katika sekta hiyo. Akizungumza wakati wa kongamano la uwezesaji wa bodaboda mjini Busia, Katibu Mkuu wa Wizara ya Usalama wa Ndani, Raymond Omollo, alisema sekta hiyo inaendelea kuwa na mchango mkubwa katika uchumi wa nchi kupitia huduma za usafiri na kwa kutoa nafasi za ajira kwa maelefu ya vijana. Dkt. Omollo alisema kuwa kusajili waendeshaji chini ya SACCOs kutasaidia serikali kuwatambua ipasavyo na kuweka mifumo rasmi ya kuwawezesha kiuchumi na kijamii.

“Tunataka waendeshaji wote wa bodaboda wajisajili chini ya SACCOs kote nchini kwa ajili ya utambuzi sahihi na uwezesaji rahisi. vya polisi kwa makosa madogo ziachiliwe. Ninataka kusisitiza kuwa makamanda wote wa polisi wa maeneo na kaunti wahakikishishe agizo hili limetekelezwa ili vijana wetu waendeleo kufanya kazi na kuchangia ukuaji wa uchumi,” alisema. Dkt. Omollo pia alitua wito wa kuwepo kwa mikutano ya mara kwa mara kati ya maafisa wa usalama na waendeshaji wa bodaboda, akisema waendeshaji hao ni washirika muhimu katika

kuimarisha usalama wa jamii kutokana na taarifa wanazokusanya wanapotekeleza kazi zao. “Waendeshaji hawa wana taarifa muhimu kuhusu masuala ya usalama katika jamii zetu. Mikutano ya mara kwa mara kati yao na maafisa wa usalama itasaidia kuimarisha ushirikiano na kuboresha usalama. Gavana wa Kaunti ya Busia, Paul Otuoma, alisema serikali ya kaunti imetenga Shilingi milioni 10 kusaidia programu za mafunzo kwa waendeshaji wa bodaboda kupitia SACCOs na ushirikiano na taasisi za kiufundi.

“Tumetenga Shilingi milioni 10 kufanikisha mafunzo ya bodaboda kupitia SACCOs. Tunashirikiana na Taasisi ya Kiufundi ya Bumbe pamoja na wakufunzi wengine ili kuwapatia waendeshaji ujuzi na maarifa. Baada ya mafunzo hayo watapatiwa leseni,” alisema Otuoma.

Kiongozi wa Wengi katika Seneti, Aaron Cheruiyot, aliwahakikishia waendeshaji kuwa Mswada wa Fedha ujao utashughulikia viwango vya juu vya marejesho ya mikopo ambavyo vimekuwa vikiwaathiri waendeshaji wengi wa bodaboda wanaonunua pikipiki kupitia mikopo.

“Hatuwezi kuendelea kuruhusu watu kulipa gharama sawa na pikipiki mbili au tatu kwa mkopo mmoja. Hili litakuwa jambo la zamani kwa sababu Mswada wa Fedha ujao utadhibiti viwango vya riba za mikopo ili kulinda Wakenya dhidi ya unyonyaji,” alisema.

kutoka taasisi mbalimbali kabla ya kufanya tafiti na ukusanyaji wa data za uga. Mtaalamu wa elimu, Dk. Winda Akach, alisema Mamlaka inayopendekezwa inapaswa kujikita katika kusimamia na kupata taarifa za takwimu badala ya kutoa leseni za utafiti. “Kwa maoni yangu, Mamlaka ya Takwimu isipewe mamlaka ya kutoa leseni. Tayari kuna taasisi za maadili, vyama vya kitaaluma na mifumo ya utawala ya kaunti inayoshughulikia hilo,” alisema. Alisema pia kuna upungufu wa data za umma zilizosashishwa, hali inayowazuia vijana kufanya maamuzi sahihi ya taaluma. Alisema Mamlaka inapaswa kutoa takwimu za soko la ajira zilizo wazi na za kisasa, ikiwemo taarifa za ajira na mchanganyiko wa masomo unaohitajika. “Wanafunzi wanapaswa kujua kama kozi wanazosomea zinaweza kuwapa ajira. Takwimu hizo pia zinaweza kusaidia serikali kuepuka matumizi ya fedha kwenye programu zizozisaidia uchumi,” alisema. Mshauri binafsi wa utafiti, Elisha Otieno wa Integrated Broad-based Analytics Research Consultants, alitaka mfumo wa leseni uwe rahisi na wa gharama nafuu kwa watafiti, washauri na mashirika yasiyo ya kiserikali. Otieno alisema kwa sasa watafiti hulazimika kupata vibali kutoka taasisi kadhaa, ikiwemo Tume ya Kitaifa ya Sayansi, Teknolojia na Ubunifu (NACOSTI) na vyombo vingine vya kitaaluma, jambo linalofanya mchakato kuwa wa gharama na mgumu. “Tunaomba utafiti urahisishwe ili vibali vipatikane kutoka mamlaka moja badala ya taasisi nyingi. Pia tunahitaji uhakikisho kuwa data zetu zinalingana na maadili yote yanazingatiwa,” alisema. Alisema ada za leseni hutofautiana kulingana na aina ya mradi na zinaweza kuwa kikwazo kwa watafiti vijana.

“Tunaomba Mamlaka ya Takwimu ya Kenya ihakikishe gharama hizi zinapunguzwa na kuwa rafiki kwa vijana na sekta binafsi,” alisema. Otieno pia alitaka uddhibiti mkali zaidi wa mashirika binafsi na NGOs zinazokusanya data ili kuzuia uhamishaji usioidhinishwa wa data za Kenya nje ya nchi. Mshiriki mwingine, Caleb Danga, aliunga mkono kuanzishwa kwa mamlaka ya kati ya takwimu, akisema itasaidia kuboresha uwajibikaji na kupunguza migogoro inayotokana na takwimu zisizolingana za kitaifa. “Kwa muda mrefu tumekuwa tukiiendesha nchi bila mamlaka sahihi ya kusimamia data. Data inapokuwa na mkanganyiko, hata mgawanyo wa rasilimali unakuwa na tatizo,” alisema. Danga alitaja migogoro iliyotokana na sensa ya watu ya 2019, akisema

takwimu zisizo sahihi zinaweza kuathiri mgao wa mapato kwa kaunti na mipango ya kitaifa. Alitaka pia uwazi zaidi katika ukusanyaji na matumizi ya data binafsi. “Lazima nijue data yangu inakusanywa kwa nini, nani anaikusanya na itatumika vipi,” alisema. Aidha, alihimiza KNBS kutoa ripoti za mara kwa mara kuhusu mwenendo wa uchumi, mabadiliko ya thamani ya ardhi na makadirio ya ajira ili kusaidia maamuzi ya uwekezaji na maendeleo. Kwa mujibu wa ratiba ya ushirikishwaji wa umma ya KNBS, mikutano hiyo inafanyika katika makundi ya kanda zinazohusisha kaunti zote, ikiwa na mikutano Nairobi, Makueni, Embu, Nakuru, Eldoret, Bungoma, Kisumu, Kisii, Mombasa na Isiolo.

Kampuni ya Kenya Electricity Transmission Company (KETRACO) imezindua mpango kabambe wa uhifadhi wa mazingira unaolenga kurejesha Msitu wa Wire uliodhoofika katika Kaunti ya Homa Bay kupitia zoezi kubwa la upandaji miti. wakazi kupanda miti majumbani

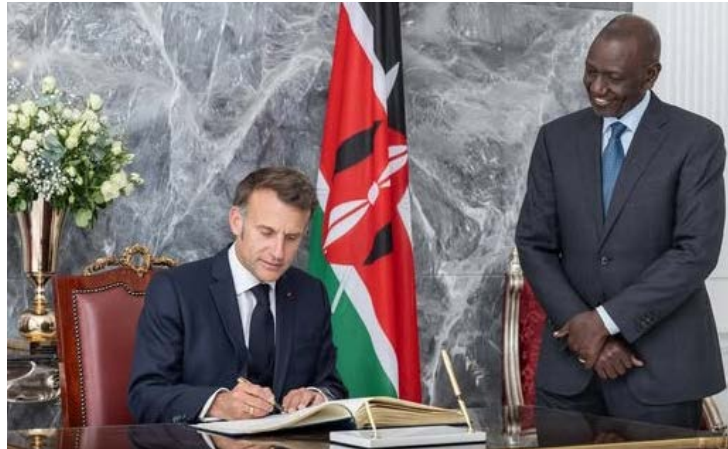

Ushirikiano wa michezo wa Kenya na Ufaransa wafafanua upya ukuzaji wa vipaji Elgeyo Marakwet

Kwa miongo kadhaa, Kaunti ya Elgeyo Marakwet imekuwa ikijivunia kutambulika kimataifa kama chimbuko la mabingwa, ikitoa wanariadha bora wa mbio ndefu waliotawala mashindano ya kimataifa ya riadha. Kuanzia miinuko ya Iten hadi nyanda za juu zenye miamba za Keiyo na Marakwet, riadha imekuwa sehemu muhimu ya maisha ya kijamii na kiuchumi ya kaunti hiyo.

Hata hivyo, nyuma ya mafanikio ya wanariadha wa kiwango cha dunia, kumekuwapo na wasiwasi unaongezeka miongoni mwa wadau wa michezo: haja ya kuanzisha mifumo rasmi ya ukuzaji vipaji ili kudumisha umahiri wa kaunti hiyo katika uwanja wa riadha unaozidi kuwa na uhindani duniani.

Leo hii, dira hiyo inaanza kutimbia kupitia ushirikiano mpya kati ya Kaunti ya Elgeyo Marakwet na mji wa Miramas wa Ufaransa. Mpango huu, viongozi wanasema, unaweza kubadilisha kabisa maendeleo ya michezo ngazi

ya msingi nchini Kenya na kuiweka kaunti hiyo kama mfano wa bara katika ubora wa michezo chini ya mtaala wa Elimu Inayotegemea Umahiri (CBE).

Kiini cha ushirikiano huo ni mpango wa "House of Coaches," uliozinduliwa wakati wa ziara ya ngazi ya juu ya ujumbe kutoka Ufaransa ulioongozwa na Balozi wa Michezo wa Ufaransa, Damien Combrest-Blassel pamoja na Meya wa Jiji la Miramas, Frédéric Vigouroux, mjini Iten—eneo linalotambulika kama kituo bora zaidi duniani cha mafunzo ya wanariadha wa mbio ndefu.

Mpango huo unalenga kui-marisha uwezo wa makocha, kuingiza sayansi ya michezo katika riadha za ngazi ya msingi, na kuendeleza vipaji kupitia ushauri na mafunzo ya kiufundi kwa walimu na makocha.

Gavana Wisley Rotich anasema ushirikiano huo ulitokana na uelewa kwamba kipaji pekee hakitoshi tena kuhakikisha mafanikio endelevu ya riadha. "Nilipoingia ofisini, nilijiuliza kwa nini hatutawali tena katika mbio kama za mita 800 na mita 3,000 kama zamani," alisema Rotich wakati wa uzinduzi rasmi mjini Iten.

kubwa ilikuwa upungufu wa uwezo wa ukocha, licha ya kuwepo kwa vipaji vingi mashuleni," aliongeza. Kwa mujibu wa Gavana huyo, serikali ya kaunti ilianza

mazungumzo na Jiji la Miramas baada ya Olimpiki za Paris 2024, kwa lengo la kuanzisha mifumo endelevu wa maendeleo ya michezo unaovuka vipaji vya mtu mmoja na kuelekea mifumo ya kitaasisi. Awamu ya kwanza ya mpango huo ilihusisha makocha 12 kutoka Elgeyo Marakwet kusafiri Ufaransa kwa mafunzo maalum kuhusu mbinu za kisasa za ukocha, tiba ya michezo, ustawi wa wanariadha, saikolojia na usimamizi wa utendaji. Mpango huo ulitekelezwa kwa ushirikiano na Shirikisho la Riadha Kenya (Athletics Kenya) na Kamati ya Olimpiki ya Kitaifa ya Kenya. Baada ya kurejea nchini,

makocha hao walipata uthibitisho wa kitaaluma katika Chuo Kikuu cha Nairobi kabla ya kuanza mpango wa ushauri katika kaunti nzima unaolenga walimu wanaosimamia shughuli za michezo mashuleni.

Rotich alisema kuwa kaunti hiyo tayari imewafunza takribani makocha 900 kutoka shule za msingi, shule za upili za chini (Junior Secondary) na shule za sekondari katika kaunti nzima.

"Tulikubaliana kwamba kila shule iwe na mwalimu wa michezo aliyefunzwa uwezo wa kutambua na kukuza vipaji mapema," alisema. Madhara ya mpango huo tayari yanaonekana katika mashindano ya riadha ya shule.

"Mvulana bora na msichana bora katika mashindano ya kitaifa ya riadha yaliyofanyika hivi karibuni walitoka Elgeyo Marakwet, hasa kutoka shule ambazo walimu wao walinufaika na mafunzo ya Miramas," Rotich alibainisha.

"Tuna pia wanafunzi wanaweza wanaojiandaa kuiwakilisha Kenya Arusha, jambo linaloonyesha athari za kuwekeza katika ukocha," aliongeza.

Wachambuzi wa michezo wanaona kuwa mpango huo unaashiria mabadiliko kutoka mfumo wa jadi usio rasmi wa ukuzaji wanariadha ambao umekuwa ukitawala riadha ya Kenya, kuelekea mfumo wa kisayansi na wa kilimu.

Chini ya mtaala wa Elimu Inayotegemea Umahiri (CBE), michezo na sanaa zimeibuka kama njia muhimu za maendeleo ya wanafunzi, zikihitaji walimu waliopata mafunzo ya kitaaluma kuweza kukuza vipaji maalum.

Wizara yapiga jeki vijana katika kilimo kupitia programu za ushauri na kubadilishana

Serikali imeongeza juhudi za kuwawezesha vijana katika sekta ya kilimo kupitia mpango wa kubadilishana uzoefu na ushauri (mentorship exchange programme) unaowaleta pamoja vijana wabunifu na wataalamu kutoka China na nchi mbalimbali za Afrika. Mpango huo unaotekelezwa chini ya Jukwaa la Ushirikiano kati ya China na Afrika (FOCAC) na Mpango wa Maendeleo wa Kimataifa (GDI), unalenga kuboresha kilimo, kuimarisha usalama wa chakula, na kuinua maisha ya vijijini kupitia uhawilishaji wa teknolojia,

mafunzo ya ufundi, na mbinu za maendeleo endelevu ya kijani. Mpango huo unalenga kuwapa vijana ujuzi wa vitendo katika usindikaji wa mazao, kuimarisha minyororo ya thamani, na mbinu za kilimo kinachochochewa na ubunifu na teknolojia. Akizungumza katika kikao na wawakilishi wa Young Global South Rural Enterprises Initiative jijini Nairobi, Katibu wa Kilimo katika Wizara ya Kilimo na Mifugo, Peter Owoko, alisisitiza dhamira ya serikali kuunga mkono ushiriki wa vijana katika sekta ya kilimo. Ujumbe uliokuwepo ulijumuisha Prof. Li Li kutoka Chuo Kikuu cha Kilimo cha China (CAU), Yanchen Qi, mwanafunzi wa

PhD wa CAU anayeishi Tanzania chini ya mpango huo wa kubadilishana uzoefu, pamoja na wanufaika wa Kenya Irene Kagera na Julius Waweru. Owoko alisisitiza umuhimu wa ufuatiliaji wa karibu ili kuhakikisha wanufaika wanaendelea kuleta matokeo chanya katika jamii zao.

Alitoa wito wa kupanua na kuendeleza kibiashara ubunifu uliotengenezwa chini ya mpango huo, akibainisha kuwa vijana wana nafasi muhimu katika kubadilisha sekta ya kilimo na kuchochea ukuaji wa uchumi. Katibu huyo pia alipendekeza kuingizwa kwa kilimo cha mijini katika mpango huo ili

kuongeza fursa kwa vijana wa mijini na kuboresha maisha yao. "Kuwawezesha vijana kwa ujuzi wa vitendo wa kilimo na ubunifu ni muhimu katika kufanikisha usalama wa chakula na maendeleo endelevu," alisema Owoko. Li Li aliwapongeza washiriki wa Kenya kwa utendaji wao mzuri, akisisitiza umuhimu wa ushirikiano kati ya sekta ya umma na binafsi katika kuimarisha ushauri na kujenga uwezo. Alibainisha kuwa mpango huo unawawezesha vijana na wanafunzi kujifunza, kufanya utafiti na kubuni, huku ukikuza teknolojia nafuu na zinazofaa kwa mageuzi ya kilimo. Kwa mujibu wa Li, mpango huo pia unaimarisha ushirikiano wa kimataifa kwa kuunganisha wanafunzi na watafiti kutoka nchi mbalimbali ili kubadilishana uzoefu na mbinu bora. Washiriki wanatarajiwa kuhamisha ujuzi na maarifa waliopata kwa wakulima wengine, hivyo kuchangia katika kujenga uwezo mpana katika sekta ya kilimo.

Waziri anayehusika na Vyama vya Ushirika, Wycliffe Oparanya, amewahimiza wakulima wa eneo la Magharibi mwa Kenya kuanza kulima kahawa, akisema inalipa

zaidi kiuchumi kuliko mazao ya jadi kama miwa na mahindi. Akizungumza katika Shule ya Upili ya Bukhalalire katika Sub-kaunti ya Butula wakati wa kongamano la uhamasishaji kuhusu kilimo cha kahawa, upatikanaji wa soko na programu za serikali za msaada, Oparanya aliwahimiza

wakulima kubadili mtazamo wao na kuwekeza zaidi kwenye kilimo cha kahawa ili kuboresha maisha yao. “Kwa muda mrefu, eneo la Magharibi limekuwa likitegemea miwa na mahindi, lakini mapato yamepungua. Hali ya hewa yetu inafaa kwa kilimo cha kahawa

ambacho kina faida kubwa zaidi. Shamba moja la ekari linaweza kutoa zaidi ya Sh milioni 1 ndani ya miaka 2 hadi 3, jambo linalofanya iwe mradi wenye faida,” alisema Oparanya.

Waziri huyo alibainisha kuwa serikali imewekeza pakubwa katika kukuza kilimo cha kahawa kupitia utoaji wa miche na mafunzo kwa maafisa ugani ili kuwasaidia wakulima.

“Tunawafunza maafisa ugani wawili kutoka kila wadi nchini ili kuwaongoza na kufuatilia wakulima wa kahawa. Pia tumsambaza miche kwa wakulima wengi ili kuhamasisha uzalishaji wa kahawa,” aliongeza.

Oparanya alifichua kuwa mipango iko mbioni ya kusajili SACCO ya ushirika katika eneo la Magharibi ili kuwawezesha wakulima kiuchumi.

“Tunalenga kuanzisha ushirika imara Magharibi mwa Kenya wenye zaidi ya wanachama 300,000 kufikia Desemba na baadaye kuupanua nchi nzima hadi kufikia wanachama milioni moja. Kupitia ushirika huu, wakulima wataweza kukabiliana na changamoto kama ada za shule na malipo ya SHA,” alisema.

Wakati wa mkutano huo wa uhamasishaji, CS huyo aligawa miche ya kahawa kwa wakulima

na kusisitiza dhamira ya serikali kuendelea kuunga mkono kilimo hicho.

Mbunge wa Butula, Joseph Oyula, aliwahimiza wakazi kuchangamkia kilimo cha kahawa akibainisha kuwa eneo hilo lilikuwa zamani eneo la kilimo cha kahawa.

“Butula ilikuwa eneo la kupanda kahawa na tunahitaji kulifufua tena. Kilimo cha kahawa kinaweza kusaidia kutokomeza umaskini katika jamii zetu. Maono yangu ni kuona Butula ikiwa mojawapo ya maeneo yanayoongoza katika uzalishaji wa kahawa ndani ya miaka mitatu ijayo,” alisema Oyula.

Aliunga mkono mpango wa usajili wa SACCO akisema utaboresha masoko ya kahawa na kuwapa wakulima fursa ya mikopo kwa uwekezaji.

“Vyama imara vya ushirika vitakuwa muhimu katika kuuza kahawa yetu na kubadilisha maisha yetu. Pia tuna sekta ya mianzi inayozalisha bidhaa kama mkaa wa mianzi, na ninawahimiza wananchi pia kupanda mianzi,” aliongeza.

Mbunge wa Lugari, Nabii Nabwera, aliunga mkono kauli hizo akiwataka wakazi kujiunga na ushirika na kuwekeza katika kilimo cha kahawa.

Wanafunzi wa ECDE kaunti ya Nyamira kunufaika na programu mpya ya lishe

Serikali ya Kaunti ya Nyamira imezindua mpango wa ulishaji uji kwa wanafunzi wa elimu ya awali (ECDE) katika vituo vyote vya kaunti, hatua inayolenga kuboresha lishe ya watoto, afya na mahudhuri shuleni. Mpango huo unaojulikana kama Ujiafya Masomo Bora ulizinduliwa rasmi katika Shule ya Msingi ya Riomoro, Kata ya Kemera. Akizungumza wakati wa hafla hiyo, Gavana wa Kaunti ya Nyamira, Amos Nyaribo, alisema mpango huo wa uji wenye virutubisho unalenga kukidhi mahitaji ya lishe kwa wanafunzi wadogo na kuimarisha ukuaji wao wa kiakili, huku ukiwahamasisha kuendelea kuhudhuria masomo. Gavana huyo alibainisha kuwa mpango huo tayari umeanza kuleta matokeo chanya tangu kuanzishwa kwake, hasa katika kuongeza uan-

dikishaji na kupunguza utoro miongoni mwa wanafunzi wa ECDE katika kaunti hiyo. “Tangu kuanzishwa kwa mpango wa UjiAfya, vituo vya ECDE vimeongeza uandikishaji kutoka wanafunzi 30,000 hadi 34,000 katika mwaka huu wa masomo. Pia umepunguza kwa kiasi kikubwa utoro, na kufanya uzoefu wa kufundisha na kujifunza kuwa bora zaidi kwa walimu na wanafunzi,” alisema Nyaribo. Kwa mujibu wa gavana huyo, mpango wa uji wenye virutubisho ni sehemu ya mkakati mpana wa serikali ya kaunti kuboresha ustawi na msingi wa elimu ya watoto katika umri wa awali. Nyaribo pia alifichua kuwa serikali ya kaunti, kwa kushirikiana na shirika la EIDU, imeanzisha pia programu ya elimu ya kidijitali katika vituo vya ECDE ili kuwapa wanafunzi ujuzi wa msingi wa teknolojia tangu hatua za awali. Mpango huo wa elimu

ya kidijitali unawawezesha walimu kutumia mbinu za kufundishia zilizoandaliwa pamoja na teknolojia katika shughuli za kila siku darasani ili kuboresha matokeo ya ujifunzaji. Gavana huyo alisema mpango huo ulianza kwa majaribio katika shule 120 mwaka jana kabla ya kupanuliwa hadi vituo vyote 408 vya ECDE katika Kaunti ya Nyamira mwaka huu. Aliwashukuru washirika wa maendeleo kwa kuunga mkono juhudi za serikali ya kaunti katika kuboresha ubora wa elimu na ustawi wa watoto. “Tunashukuru sana Kenya Industrial Research and Development Institute kwa kuhakikisha ugavi wa mara kwa mara wa unga wenye virutubisho kwa mpango wa UjiAfya, na EIDU kwa kuunga mkono ujifunzaji unaosaidiwa na teknolojia. Programu hizi zimeboresha sana ukuaji na maendeleo ya wanafunzi wetu katika nyanja zote,” alisema.

Mwea yaboresha usambazaji maji kaunti ikielekea kupanua Soko la Wang'uru

Gavana wa Kaunti ya Kirinyaga, Anne Waiguru, amezindua mpango mkubwa wa maendeleo katika eneo la Mwea, akizindua rasmi mradi mkubwa wa usambazaji maji na kutenga ardhi kwa ajili ya upanuzi wa Soko la Wang'uru. Akizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi wa Mradi wa Ukarabati na Upanuzi wa Mfumo wa Usambazaji Maji wa Mwea uliofanyika Mutithi, pamoja na ukaguzi wa eneo la soko la Wang'uru, Waiguru alisema miradi hiyo miwili inalenga kuboresha maisha ya wananchi kupitia miundombinu inayosaidia familia, wakulima na wafanyabiashara. Mradi wa maji, ambao ni miongoni mwa miradi mikubwa ya miundombinu ya kaunti, unatarajiwa kuongeza upatikanaji wa maji safi na salama kwa maelfu ya wakazi, huku ukiunga mkono shughuli za kilimo, biashara na maendeleo ya biashara ndogo ndogo. Serikali ya Kaunti inawekeza Shilingi milioni 200 katika mradi huo, unaojumuishia ujenzi wa mtandao wa mabomba zaidi ya kilomita 57 katika eneo la Mwea. Ukikamilika, mradi huo utanufaisha takribani kaya 30,000 katika wadi nane ambazo ni Gathigiriri, Tebere, Thiba, Mutithi, Wamumu, Murinduko, Nyangati na Kangai. Maji yatatokana na mito ya Kiringa na Thiba kabla ya kutibiwa katika Kituo cha Matibabu ya Maji cha Muratiri, ambacho kina uwezo wa kuzalisha mita za ujazo 30,000 kwa siku. Kisha maji yatasambazwa kupitia mfumo wa mtiririko wa mvuto hadi vituo vikuu kama Kerugoya, Kutus, Kagio, Kandongu na Sagana. Mpango huo pia unajumuisha upanuzi wa mabomba ili kupeleka maji karibu zaidi na wananchi. Mstari mkuu kutoka Kutus hadi Kimbimbi utanufaisha Gathigiriri, Tebere na Thiba, huku mwingine kutoka Kandongu hadi Mutithi

utanufaisha Mutithi na Wamumu. Mabomba mengine yatafika katika Kaya za Kangai, wakati ukarabati wa kituo cha Nyamindi utaimarisha usambazaji wa maji katika maeneo ya juu ya Mwea. Katika Murinduko, mradi wa maji wa umwagiliaji wa Mugaro utanufaisha takribani wakulima 2,700. Waiguru alisema upatikanaji bora wa maji utapunguza utegemezi wa vyanzo visivyo salama, kupunguza magonjwa yatokanayo na maji machafu na kuongeza shughuli za kiuchumi kama kilimo cha umwagiliaji, ufugaji na ukuaji wa biashara ndogo. Pamoja na mradi wa maji, Gavana alikagua ekari tatu za ardhi zilizotengwa kwa ajili ya ujenzi wa Awamu ya Pili ya Soko la Wang'uru baada ya kukamilika kwa awamu ya kwanza ya soko hilo. Alibainisha kuwa upanuzi huo umetokana na ongezeko la mahitaji ya nafasi ya biashara kutoka kwa wafanyabiashara na wakazi wa eneo hilo. Mradi huo, utakotekelezwa kwa pamoja

na serikali ya kitaifa, unatarajiwa kunufaisha takribani wafanyabiashara 1,500 kutoka Wang'uru na wadi jirani za Tebere, Thiba na Nyan-gati. Soko hilo litakuwa na jengo la kisasa la ghorofa mbili lenye vibanda vya biashara vilivyopangwa, vituo vya ICT vyenye Wi-Fi ya bure, saluni, maduka ya nguo, huduma za kucha na chumba cha watoto (crèche), pamoja na mifumo bora ya mifereji, usafi wa mazingira, maji na umeme. Waiguru alisema ushirikiano kati ya serikali ya kaunti na serikali ya kitaifa ni muhimu katika utekelezaji wa miradi mikubwa ya maendeleo. Alibainisha kuwa kaunti tayari imetoa ardhi kwa ajili ya mradi huo huku serikali ya kitaifa ikitarajiwa kufadhili ujenzi, akisema ushirikiano huo unaharukisha utoaji wa huduma na ukuaji wa uchumi. Kwa sasa, masoko yaliyojengwa na kaunti yanahudumia takribani wafanyabiashara 5,400, huku karibu 20,000 wengine wakiyatumia kila siku kwa shughuli za biashara.

Kenya yataka uadilifu uanahabari enzi ya AI

Serikali imeahidi kuimari-sha uhuru wa vyombo vya habari, kulinda uadilifu wa taarifa, na kujenga mfumo imara wa kidijitali, wakati Afrika ikiendelea kukumbwa na mabadiliko makubwa yanay-osababishwa na Akili Unde (AI) na majukwaa ya kidijitali. Akizungumza katika Mkutano wa Vyombo vya Habari Afrika (Africa Media Summit) ulio-fanyika Nairobi, Katibu Mkuu wa Idara ya Utangazaji na Mawasiliano ya Simu, Stephen Isaboke, alisisitiza umuhimu wa vyombo vya habari barani Afrika kukumbatia maendeleo ya teknolojia huku vikizingatia uandishi wa habari wa maadili na maadili ya kidemokrasia. PS huyo alisema Afrika imeingia katika enzi muhimu ya kidijitali inayobadilisha kwa kina namna taarifa zinavyotengenezwa, kusambazwa na kutumiwa. “Tunaishi katika mabadiliko kamili kutoka ulimwengu wa kabla ya kidijitali kwenda ulimwengu wa baada ya kidijitali,” alisema, akibainisha kuwa mageuzi hayo yamebadilisha kabisa utendaji wa vyombo vya habari duniani. Isaboke alizipongeza taasisi zilizoandaa mkutano huo, zikiwemo Shirika la Ushirikiano wa Kiuchumi na Maendeleo (OECD) na Baraza la Vyombo vya Habari Kenya (Media Council of Kenya), kwa kuandaa majadiliano kuhusu uadilifu wa taarifa, majukwaa ya kidijitali na mustakabali wa vyombo vya habari barani Afrika. Pia aliwapongeza wanahabari wakuu na viongozi wa sekta hiyo waliohudhuria, wakiwemo wawakilishi wa Kenya Editors Guild, Kenya Union of Journalists, Media Complaints Commission na mashirika ya vyombo vya habari ya kikanda, akiwataja kama nguzo muhimu katika kulinda uhuru wa vyombo vya habari na taaluma ya uandishi.

Isaboke alisema Kenya bado imejizatiti kuwa na mazingira ya vyombo vya habari yaliyo “huru, yenye uwajibikaji, ubunifu na yanayoweza kuendana na mabadiliko ya teknolojia,” akibainisha kuwa mfumo huo unaungwa mkono na Katiba, kanuni za kisasa za utangazaji, mfumo ya usalama wa mtandao na mageuzi ya utawala wa kidijitali. Kwa mujibu wake, Kenya ina moja ya mifumo imara zaidi ya vyombo vya habari barani Afrika, inayochochewa na upanuzi wa miundombinu, ongezeko la matumizi ya simu za mkononi na kuongezeka kwa upatikanaji wa intaneti. “Kenya ina mojawapo ya mandhari thabiti zaidi ya

vyombo vya habari si tu Afrika, bali duniani,” alisema. Alibainisha kuwa matumizi ya simu nchini Kenya yamezidi asilimia 100, hali inayoashiria kuwa wananchi wengi wanamiliki laini zaidi ya moja na hutegemea zaidi mawasiliano ya kidijitali. PS huyo alisema uwekezaji wa serikali katika miundombinu ya nyuzi za macho (fibre), bara-bara kuu za kidijitali (digital superhighways) na miradi ya uchumi wa ubunifu unalenga kuongeza upatikanaji wa intaneti kote nchini na kuimarisha ujumuishaji wa kidijitali. Isaboke alisema sekta ya utangazaji imekua kwa kasi, ikiwa na zaidi ya watangazaji 200 waliopewa leseni wakiwemo

televisheni, redio na vyombo vya jamii, jambo linaloimarisha uwiano na ushiriki wa wananchi katika habari. Hata hivyo, alibainisha kuwa kuna mabadiliko makubwa katika

Isaboke alisema sekta ya utangazaji imekua kwa kiasi kikubwa, huku zaidi ya watangazaji 200 walioidhinishwa wakienza TV, redio na vyombo vya habari vya jamii, kuimarisha wingi wa vyombo vya habari na ushiriki wa raia.

namna wananchi wanavyopata taarifa, ambapo zaidi ya nusu ya Wakenya sasa hupata habari na burudani kupitia majukwaa ya kidijitali na mitandao ya kijamii.

Majukwaa ya kidijitali sasa ndiyo yanayoongoza kwa kasi katika matumizi ya taarifa, yaki-chochewa na matumizi ya simu na mifumo ya algoritmi,” alisema. PS huyo alieleza kuwa mabadiliko hayo yameathiri pia mifano ya biashara ya vyombo vya habari vya jadi, hali inayovifanya vyumba vya habari kubadili mikakati kwa kutumia mbinu za kidijitali kwanza, usajili wa malipo (subscriptions), utofauti wa maudhui na uandishi unaotumia data. Isaboke alionya kuwa kanuni za utangazaji hazuwezi tena kujikita tu katika usimamizi wa masafa ya redio, kwa kuwa majukwaa ya kidijitali sasa yanawezesha watu binafsi kufikia mamilioni ya wasikilizaji bila leseni za kawaida za utangazaji. “Ni lazima zibadilike ili kushughulikia mifumo iliyounganishwa ya maudhui huku zikilinda maslahi ya umma, ushindani na uadilifu wa taarifa,” alisema. PS huyo alieleza fursa zinazojitokeza katika uchumi wa kidijitali Afrika, akibainisha kuwa bara hilo lina zaidi ya watumiaji wa intaneti milioni 615, ambapo karibu asilimia 90 ya matumizi ya mtandao yanategemea simu za mkononi. Isaboke alisema majukwaa ya kidijitali yameongeza sauti za Waafrika na kuwezesha kuibuka kwa wabunifu wanya, wata-yarishaji podikasti, wachapishaji wa kidijitali na wanahabari wa raia, hasa miongoni mwa vijana. “Watayarishaji vijana kwenye majukwaa kama Facebook, Instagram na X wanabadilisha mijadala ya umma na kufikia hadhira ambayo vyombo vya jadi vilishindwa kufikia,” alisema. Hata hivyo, alionya kuwa taarifa potofu, na maudhui ya bandia yanayotengenezwa na AI ni tishio kubwa kwa imani ya umma, taasisi za kidemokrasia na uadilifu wa uchaguzi.

Tuzo hizo zilizinduliwa wakati wa maadhimisho ya Siku ya Kimataifa ya Wauguzi na Wakunga 2026 chini ya kaulimbiu isemayo, “Wauguzi Wetu, Wakunga Wetu, Mustakabali Wetu: Wauguzi Wenye Uwezeshaji Huokoa Maisha.” Akizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi huo uliosadifu wiki ya maadhimisho ya Wauguzi Kimataifa 2026 katika viwanja vya Carnival, Waziri wa Afya Aden Duale aliwataja wauguzi na wakunga kuwa nguzo kuu ya mfumo wa afya nchini, akisema jukumu lao linavuka utoaji wa

huduma za kitabibu na linajumuishwa kutoa matumaini, huruma na heshima kwa wagonjwa. Mpango huo unalenga kutambua ubora katika utendaji wa kliniki, uongozi, elimu, utafiti, ubunifu, huduma ya afya ya msingi na ujasiriamali ndani ya taaluma ya uuguzi na ukunga. “Wauguzi na wakunga si tu kundi ndani ya wafanyakazi wa afya. Ninyi ni uso wa kibinadamu wa huduma za afya. Ninyi mnasimama katika nyakati za hofu, sintofahamu, uponyaji na matumaini,” alisema Duale. Alisema mfumo huo wa tuzo unaashiria dhamira ya serikali ya kutambua huduma na ubora miongoni mwa wahudumu wa afya huku ukihamasisha vizazi vijavyo ndani ya taaluma hiyo. “Mpango huu si wa sherehe tu; una maana kubwa ya kiishara. Ni dhamira ya kitaifa ya kutambua ubora, kusherehekea huduma

na kuinua vielelezo bora ndani ya taaluma hii,” aliongeza. Waziri huyo wa Afya alisema licha ya changamoto kama uhaba wa watumishi, mzigo mkubwa wa kazi na shinikizo la kihisia, wauguzi na wakunga wameendelea kutoa huduma muhimu nchini, ikiwemo katika maeneo ya mbali na yasiyo na huduma za kutosha. Duale alisema serikali itaendelea

kujikita katika kuboresha ustawi wa wahudumu wa afya kupitia uwekezaji katika ajira, mafunzo ya kitaaluma, huduma za afya ya akili na mazingira bora ya kazi. Alitambua mchango wa washirika wa maendeleo, ikiwemo Johnson & Johnson Foundation, katika kusaidia mafunzo ya uongozi na kujenga

uwezo kwa wauguzi na wakunga. Katibu Mkuu wa Afya ya Umma na Viwango vya Kitaaluma, Mary Muriuki, alisema wauguzi wanachangia karibu asilimia 70 ya wafanyakazi wa sekta ya afya nchini na wanaendelea kuwa na jukumu kuu katika kufanikisha huduma ya afya kwa wote. Alisema wauguzi wanatoa huduma muhimu katika afya ya mama na mtoto, chanjo, huduma za dharura, udhibiti wa magonjwa sugu na msaada wa afya ya akili katika kaunti zote 47 nchini. Jiwa kufadhili ujenzi, akisema ushirikiano huo unaharakisha utoaji wa huduma na ukuaji wa uchumi. Kwa sasa, masoko yaliyojengwa na kaunti yanahudumia takribani wafanyabiashara 5,400, huku karibu 20,000 wengine wakiyatamia kila siku kwa shughuli za biashara. Kaunti tayari imekamalisha ujenzi wa masoko 18 ya kisasa na kupata masoko 12 ya ziada kupitia ushirikiano na serikali ya kitaifa, ikiwemo miradi katika Kimbimbi, Kiumbu, Kutus, Mukarara, Kagio, Kibingoti na Wamumu.

Ol Pejeta yaimarisha juhudi za kuokoa vifaru weupe walio hatarini kuangamia

Hifadhi ya Ol Pejeta imeongeza juhudi za kuifua aina ya faru weupe wa kaskazini walio hatarini kutoweka kabisa kupitia teknolojia za kisasa za uzazi na programu za urutubishaji wa viini (surrogacy), zikilenga kuzuia spishi hiyo kutoweka kabisa. Kwa mujibu wa hifadhi hiyo, muungano wa BioRescue ulitekeleza upandikizaji wa viini vitatu vya viini vya mimba (embryo transfer) kwa faru weupe wa kusini walioteuliwa kuwa wajawazito mbadala katika Ol Pejeta katika nusu ya pili ya mwaka 2024. Mpango huo unakuwa wakwanza duniani kujaribu upandikizaji wa viini vya mimba kwa faru, hatua inayochukuliwa kuwa mafanikio makubwa katika juhudi za kimataifa za uhifadhi wa wanyamapori. Mkurugenzi Mtendaji wa Hifadhi ya Ol Pejeta, Justin Heath, alisema kuwa licha ya upandikizaji huo kutokufanikisha mimba za muda mrefu, wahifadhi na wanasayansi wanaohusika bado wamebaki na matumaini na dhamira ya kuendelea. Heath alibainisha kuwa mradi huo hivi karibuni umeonye-

sha maendeleo ya kutia moyo baada ya mafanikio ya kuku-sanya seli za yai kutoka kwa Fatu, mmoja wa faru weupe wa kaskazini waliobaki duniani. "Mwaka huu mapema ulileta

Inatia moyo kuona hili likiakisiwa katika mazungumzo mapana ya uhifadhi

matumaini mapya. Ukusan-yaji uliofanikiwa wa seli ya yai kutoka kwa Fatu ulizalisha kiini kimoja kipya cha faru weupe wa kaskazini, na kufikisha jumla ya viini kuwa 39," Heath alisema katika taarifa hiyo. Aliongeza kuwa faru wawili wapya wa kusini walioteuliwa kuwa mama mbadala pia wamejumuishwa katika mpango huo, hatua inayoongeza idadi ya wanyama wanaotarajiwa kusaidia upandikizaji wa viini siku zijazo. Kwa mujibu wa Heath, uhifadhi wa spishi zilizo hatarini hauhitaji tu ubunifu wa kisayansi, bali pia ushirikishwaji wa umma, uwa-jibikaji wa kimaadili na uhifadhi wa mazingira ili kuhakikisha mafanikio ya mipango hiyo. "Ni faraja kuona hili likidhihirika katika mazungumzo mapana ya uhifadhi na kujitolea huku haku-japotea bila kuonekana," alisema. Heath pia alifichua kuwa Profesa Thomas Hildebrandt, anayehusika na Mradi wa BioRescue, hivi karibuni alitunukiwa Tuzo ya kwanza ya Smart Wildlife Conservation huko Stockholm kwa kutambua mchango wake katika uhifadhi wa wanyamapori na utafiti wa kisayansi. Mkurugenzi huyo alibainisha kuwa tuzo hiyo pia ni heshimakwa juhudi za pamoja za wanasayansi,

wahifadhi, wataalamu wa mifugo na washirika wanaounga mkono jitihada za kurejesha faru weupe wa kaskazini. Alisisitiza kuwa maendeleo yanayofikiwa maabara ni sehemu moja tu ya dhamira pana ya kuokoa spishi hiyo isitoweke. Kwa mujibu wa Heath, mafanikio ya kurejesha idadi ya faru weupe wa kaskazini pia yanategemea uwepo wa makazi yaliyolindwa, mifumo ikolojia yenye afya na timu za uhifadhi zinazofanya kazi kila siku kulinda wanyamapori. "Tunaendelea kufanya kazi kwa bidii kurejesha na kulinda makazi ambayo idadi ya baadaye ya faru weupe wa kaskazini itahitaji, na Ol Pejeta ndipo mustakabali huo unaanzia," Heath alisema. Licha ya changamoto zinazokabili mpango huo, hifadhi hiyo bado ina matumaini na imejikita katika kufikia malengo yake ya muda mrefu ya uhifadhi. Fatu ni mmoja wa faru weupe wa kaskazini wawili waliobaki duniani na kwa sasa anaishi katika Hifadhi ya Ol Pejeta nchini Kenya pamoja na mama yake, Najin. Wawili hao ndio pekee waliosalia wa spishi ya faru weupe wa kaskazini baada ya kifo cha dume la mwisho, Sudan, mwaka 2018.

Aidha, kupitia mfumo huu mpya, wamiliki wa magari hawatalazimika kusubiri siku au wiki kupata logi zao. Badala yake, eLogbook zitatolewa mara moja baada ya uhamisho au usajili wa gari, jambo linalofanya

mchakato mzima kuwa wa haraka na wa uwazi zaidi. Ili kudhibiti udanganyifu wa vyeti bandia, mfumo mpya utatumia usimbaji fiche wa usalama pamoja na teknolojia ya QR code inayowawezesha benki, bima na wanunuzi kuthibitisha mmiliki halisi wa gari kwa urahisi kupitia skani moja. Kwa kuongezeka kwa umiliki wa magari, changamoto za kughushi logi na udanganyifu zimekuwa zikiongezeka, hali iliyosababisha NTSA kuachana na mfumo wa karatasi ili kuziba mianya inayotumiwa na walaghai. Mfumo huu mpya pia utaiwezesha polisi kuthibitisha umiliki wa magari kwa haraka zaidi kwa wakati

Mwenyekiti wa Ushirika wa Uvouni, Francis Kilango, alisema wakulima wana matumaini ya kupata mavuno mazuri kutokana na hali nzuri ya hewa na mafanikio ya majaribio ya awali ya zao hilo katika msimu wake wa

kwanza katika eneo hilo. Kilango alibainisha kuwa zao hilo limeibua hamasa miongoni mwa wakulima kutokana na uwezo wake wa kupunguza gharama ya maisha kupitia uzalishaji wa mafuta ya kupikia ndani ya eneo hilo, pamoja na kuunda chanzo kipya cha mapato kupitia uzalishaji wa mafuta yaliyoongezwa thamani. Hata hivyo, alitoa wito kwa serikali na sekta binafsi kusaidia kuhakikisha kuna soko la uhakika la mazao ya alizeti ili kuwahamisha wakulima zaidi kujihusisha na kilimo hicho kwa kiwango cha biashara. Zao hilo linaendelea kupata umaarufu katika maeneo mbalimbali ya Yatta, ambapo wakulima wanaliangalia kama zao madala la biashara linalokamilisha pamba, mahindi na maharagwe katika kuongeza mapato, hasa katika mazingira yanayokumbwa na mabadiliko ya tabianchi.

Wasichana wa Vokoli wavuna samaki 2,000

Wanafunzi wa Shule ya Sekondari ya Wasichana ya Vokoli wamenufaiika na mradi jumuiishi wa ufugaji wa samaki unaolenga kuboresha lishe shuleni baada ya kuvuna zaidi ya samaki 2,000 kutoka kwenye bwawa lao, lililoanzishwa chini ya Shirika la Maendeleo la Norway (NORAD). Mradi huo, unaofadhiliwa na NORAD kwa ushirikiano na Mfuko wa Kimataifa wa Maendeleo ya Kilimo (IFAD) pamoja na Serikali ya Kaunti ya Vihiga, unalenga kuendeleza lishe endelevu na usalama wa chakula miongoni mwa wanafunzi. Mpango huo umeundwa kama mfumo jumuiishi wa kilimo, ukichanganya ufugaji wa samaki, ufugaji wa kuku na kilimo cha mboga. Katika mfumo huo, kila kipengele husaidiana; kwa mfano, taka za kuku zinaweza kutumika kurutubisha mabwawa ya samaki, huku maji kutoka mabwawa yakitumika kumwagilia mboga. Mbinu hii huongeza matumizi bora ya rasilimali, hupunguza upotevu wa mali ghafi, na huhakikisha upatikanaji wa lishe bora kwa wanafunzi kupitia

protini, vitamini na madini muhimu. Wanafunzi wa Vokoli Girls walishiriki kikamilifu katika usimamizi wa bwawa la samaki, wakipata ujuzi wa vitendo katika ufugaji wa samaki huku pia wakifunzwa kwa kazi moja kwa moja na mazao hayo. Akizungumza wakati wa mavuno hayo, Afisa Mkuu wa Kilimo wa Kaunti, Dkt. Betty Mulianga, alisema mpango huo unalenga kuongeza upatikanaji wa virutubisho muhimu kwa wanafunzi. "Lengo la mradi huu ni kuhakikisha kwamba wanafunzi wetu wanapata virutubisho muhimu, hasa protini na vitamini, kupitia vyanzo vya chakula vinavyopatikana kwa urahisi," alisema. Alibainisha kuwa awamu inayofuata ya mpango huo itaongeza mfumo jumuiishi kwa kujumuisha kilimo cha matunda, hatua itakayoboresha zaidi lishe shuleni na kupanua vyanzo vya chakula kwa wanafunzi. "Pia tunataka kuendeleza ufugaji wa samaki shuleni kwa sababu samaki ni chanzo bora cha protini na ni rahisi kuandaa. Katika siku zijazo, tunatarajia watu wengi zaidi kuonyesha nia katika mnyororo huo wa thamani," aliongeza.

Mradi huo unaofadhiliwa na Benki ya Maendeleo ya Afrika (AfDB), Umoja wa Ulaya (EU) na Serikali ya Kenya kwa gharama ya Shilingi bilioni 15, unatarajiwa kuimarisha muunganiko wa kikanda, kuongeza biashara na kuchochea utalii baada ya kukamilika. Malipo hayo ya fidia yanatarajiwa kuwezesha wakandasi kuharakisha kazi za ujenzi ambazo zilipungua kasi kutokana na changamoto za upatikanaji wa ardhi. Naibu Mkurugenzi wa

KeNHA na Mratibu wa Mradi, Mhandisi Cleophas Makau, akizungumza wakati wa ukaguzi wa mradi huo, alisema NLC tayari imefanya tathmini ya waliopaswa kulipwa fidia na kwamba Shilingi bilioni 3.15 tayari zimekwishatolewa kwa ajili ya fidia ya ardhi.

"Tume ya Kitaifa ya Ardhi inaendelea na mchakato wa kulipa fidia kwa PAPs. Wamefanya kazi kubwa ya malipo. Ninaamini mnaona watu ambao tayari wamelipwa," alisema Mhandisi Makau. "Pia tumewapa muda wa kuondoa mali zao," aliongeza.
