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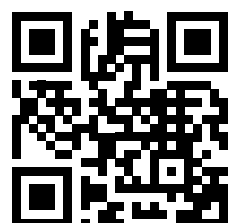

Bunge la Kaunti ya Kakamega limefungua njia kwa uchimbaji wa dhahabu chini ya ardhi wenye thamani inayokadiriwa kufikia Sh680 bilioni katika Eneo Bunge la Ikolomani baada ya kuidhinisha ombi la kampuni binafsi kuanza shughuli zake kufuatia miezi kadhaa ya uchunguzi na ushirikishwaji wa umma.

Mikutano ya hadhara ilianjaliwa kujadili malalamishi yaliyowasilishwa na mashirika ya kijamii pamoja na wakazi waliokuwa na wasiwasi kuhusu uharibifu wa ardhi, ukosefu wa uwazi katika mfumo wa fidia na mpango wa kuwahamisha takriban kaya 800 kutoka eneo lililopendekezwa kwa mradi wa uchimbaji.

Tofauti na uchimbaji wa jadi ambao umekuwa ukitawala Ikolomani kwa muda mrefu, uchimbaji mkubwa unaodhibitiwa unatarajiwa kuunda takriban nafasi 1,000 za ajira za moja kwa moja na kuwajumuisha wachimbaji wa eneo hilo katika ajira rasmi na minyororo ya ugavi.

Serikali imeanza kusambaza tarakilishi (laptops) na bodi mahiri za mwingiliano (interactive smart boards) kwa shule za umma 10,382 za ngazi ya junia nchini kote.

Chini ya mpango huo, kila shule itapokea kompyuta mpakato moja na bodi mahiri moja ya mwingiliano kwa lengo la kuimarisha ujifunzaji wa kidijitali na kusaidia utekelezaji wa mfumo wa Elimu ya Misingi ya Umahiri (Competency-Based Education - CBE).

Mpango huo, unaotekelezwa chini ya Mradi wa Kuimarisha Uchumi wa Kidijitali Kenya (Kenya Digital Economy Acceleration Project - KDEAP), unaashiria hatua muhimu katika ajenda ya mabadiliko ya kidijitali nchini na juhudi zinazoendelea za kuboresha sekta ya elimu kwa kutumia teknolojia za kisasa.

wadau wa elimu, washirika wa maendeleo na wawakilishi wa sekta ya Teknolojia ya Habari na Mawasiliano (ICT).

Katibu wa Idara ya Utangazaji na Mawasiliano ya Simu, Stephen Isaboke, alisema mpango huo unaonyesha dhamira ya serikali ya kuwaandaa wanafunzi kwa mustakabali unaozidi kutegemea teknolojia.

“Tukio hili linaashiria hatua muhimu katika safari ya Kenya ya mabadiliko ya kidijitali na

linaonyesha dhamira yetu ya kuwaandaa wanafunzi kwa mustakabali ambapo teknolojia itachukua nafasi kubwa zaidi katika namna tunavyojifunza, kufanya kazi na kuunda fursa,” alisema Isaboke.

Mpango huo ni sehemu ya dira pana ya serikali ya kujenga uchumi unaunganishwa kidijitali na unaotegemea maarifa chini ya Ajenda ya Mageuzi ya Kiuchumi kutoka Chini kwenda Juu (Bottom-Up Economic Trans-

formation Agenda - BETA).


Kulingana na Isaboke, mpango huo unaunga mkono uwekezaji unaoendelea chini ya Programu ya Barabara Kuu ya Kidijitali (Digital Superhighway Programme), ambayo inahusisha usambazaji wa kilomita 100,000 za miundombinu ya nyaya za nyuzi macho (fibre optic) na uanzishwaji wa vituo 1,450 vya kidijitali katika wadi zote nchini Kenya.

Alisisitiza kuwa ujumuishaji wa kidijitali unasalia kuwa kipaumbele muhimu, akibainisha kuwa wanafunzi katika maeneo ya mbali wanapaswa kupata fursa sawa na wale wa mijini.


“Iwe mwanafunzi yuko Turkana, Mandera, Marsabit, Kwale, Kisumu au Nairobi, kila mtoto anastahili kupata fursa sawa na mustakabali sawa wa kidijitali,” alisema.

Katibu Mkuu huyo alitaka jamii kutumia teknolojia kwa uwajibikaji shuleni na kuwataka wadau kulinda miundombinu ya elimu kufuatia matukio ya hivi karibuni ya migomo na moto katika baadhi ya shule nchini.

“Teknolojia inapaswa kuwa nyenzo inayochochea udadisi, ubunifu na matumaini, si chanzo cha kufadhaika au uharibifu,” alisema.

Serikali imetoa wito wa kuchukuliwa kwa hatua za haraka duniani kote kuondoa kemikali hatari za kilimo na kukomesha kile alichotaja kama viwango viwili vinavyowaweka wakulima katika nchi zinazoendelea kwenye hatari

ya kutumia kemikali ambazo zimepigwa marufuku kwingine kutokana na athari za kiafya na kimazingira.

Akizungumza jijini Nairobi wakati wa ufunguzi wa Mkutano Mkuu wa Shirika la Wakulima Duniani (WFO) wa mwaka 2026, Waziri wa Kilimo Mutahi Kagwe alihimiza serikali, wasimamizi, wazalishaji na mashirika ya

kimataifa kuoanisha viwango vya kimataifa kuhusu kemikali za kilimo na kuweka ustawi wa wakulima katikati ya sera na uwekezaji wa kilimo.

“Kulimudu kilimo chini ya viwango viwili hakukubaliki,” Kagwe alisema, akisisitiza kuwa bidhaa zinazotambuliwa kuwa hatarishi katika nchi moja hazipaswi kuuzwa katika nchi

Uwekezaji kwa wakulima unapaswa kutazamwa kama uwekezaji wa kimkakati katika ukuaji wa uchumi, usalama wa chakula

nyingine kwa sababu tu kanuni zake ni dhaifu.

Akihutubia wajumbe kutoka sehemu mbalimbali duniani, wakiwemo mashirika ya wakulima, washirika wa maendeleo, viongozi wa biashara ya kilimo na watunga sera, alisisitiza kuwa maisha na afya ya wakulima katika nchi zinazoendelea lazima yaheshimiwe kwa usawa.

Kagwe alionya kuwa kemikali hatarishi za kilimo na pembejeo bandia zinaendelea kuhatarisha usalama wa chakula, afya ya umma, uendelevu wa mazingira na masoko ya kuuzwa nje.

Alitoa wito wa ushirikiano thabiti zaidi ili kupambana na biashara haramu, utengenezaji bandia na matumizi mabaya ya pembejeo za kilimo.

Alisisitiza kuwa kulinda wakulima kunapaswa kuzidi kuongeza tija na upatikanaji wa masoko, na kujumuisha pia kulinda afya na ustawi wao.

Waziri alihimiza jumuiya ya kimataifa kuweka wakulima, si tu kwenye mifumo ya chakula, bali katikati ya mijadala ya sera za kilimo duniani, akibainisha kuwa umakini wa kutosha haujapeanwa kwa ustawi, heshima na ustawi wa wakulima.

Alipinga ukosefu wa usawa wa muda mrefu katika kilimo cha kimataifa, akisema kuwa uwekezaji kwa wakulima unapaswa kuonekana kama uwekezaji wa kimkakati katika ukuaji wa uchumi, usalama wa chakula na uthabiti wa kitaifa.

Kagwe pia alitoa wito wa marekebisho katika ufadhili wa kilimo na kuangazia juhudi za Kenya za kuboresha kilimo kupitia teknolojia na mifumo inayotegemea takwimu, ikiwemo Mfumo Shirikishi wa Usimamizi wa Kilimo wa Kenya (KIAMIS).

Kagwe alihimiza viongozi kuhakikisha kila sera, uwekezaji na mapendekezo yatakayotokana na mkutano huo yanaongozwa na kanuni moja: kuweka wakulima kwanza.

EACC yatoa tahadhari kuhusu vyeti bandia, ulaghai kitaaluma

Taasisi ya Maadili na Kupambana na Rushwa (EACC) imeeleza wasiwasi wake kuhusu ongezeko la visa vya udanganyifu wa kitaaluma, wizi wa mawazo (plagiarism) na vyeti bandia vya masomo miongoni mwa vijana, ikionya kuwa mwenendo huo unadhoofisha uadilifu na kuharibu imani ya umma kwa taasisi mbalimbali.

Akizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi wa Kluba ya Maadili na Uadilifu katika Chuo Kikuu cha Mount Kenya (MKU), Mwenyekiti wa EACC, Dkt. David Oginde, alisema kutokuwa waaminifu kumekuwa kukikubalika kwa kiasi kikubwa katika baadhi

ya makundi ya jamii, yakiwemo wanafunzi wa vyuo vikuu.

Dkt. Oginde alisema tume hiyo imeelemewa na uchunguzi unaohusishwa vyeti vya kitaaluma vya kughushi, baadhi vikihusishwa na watu wanaoshikilia nyadhifa za juu katika taasisi za umma na binafsi.

Alibainisha kuwa visa vya wizi wa mawazo na aina nyingine za udanganyifu wa kitaaluma pia vinaongezeka katika taasisi za elimu ya juu. “Inasikitisha kwamba tafiti zinaonyesha vijana wengi hawaoni ubaya wowote katika kutokuwa waaminifu,” alisema Dkt. Oginde. Aliwahimiza wanafunzi kukataa njia za mkato za mafanikio na badala yake kukumbatia uadilifu, bidii na uaminifu kama

msingi wa mafanikio binafsi na maendeleo ya taifa. “Kwa nini uende chuo kikuu halafu ushindwe kupata cheti halali kinachoonyesha wewe ni nani? Hakuna taifa ambalo limewahi kustawi kupitia ufisadi. Ukuu hujengwa kwa uaminifu, bidii na uaminifu wa kua-minika,” alisema. MKU, Mkuu wa Huduma za Uzalendo wa Shirika na Mkurugenzi wa Ushirikiano na Uhusiano, Prof. Peter Wanderi, alisema chuo hicho kinaimarisha elimu yenye msingi wa maadili kupitia somo la pamoja kuhusu maadili, uadilifu na uraia mwema. “Tunahitaji kuendelea kuzungumzia uadilifu wakati wote na pia kuutekeleza,” alisema Prof. Wanderi.

Waziri huyo alisisitiza kuwa ingawa wanafunzi wanaweza kuwa na malalamiko halali, vurugu na uharibifu wa mali haviwezi kuhalalishwa.

“Malalamiko yoyote yanapaswa kushughulikiwa kupitia njia sahihi bila kutumia vitendo vya kinyume cha sheria au vurugu. Wote wataka-

Wakati wajumbe kutoka sehemu mbalimbali za dunia wanapokutana Mombasa na Kilifi kwa ajili ya Mkutano wa 11 wa Our Ocean Conference (OOC11), tukio hilo litawakilisha zaidi ya mjadala wa kimataifa kuhusu uendeleo wa bahari. Kama taifa la kwanza barani Afrika kuandaa mkutano huo tangu kuanzishwa kwake mwaka 2014, Kenya itatoa jukwaa la kuhamasisha uwekezaji, kuimarisha ushirikiano, na kuendeleza suluhisho za vitendo zinazosaidia maendeleo endelevu ya bahari.

Hatua hiyo inawezesha utekelezaji wa motisha za kodi zinazotolewa kwa wawekezaji chini ya Sheria ya Kanda Maalum za Kiuchumi ya mwaka 2015 na kuigeza hifadhi hiyo kuwa eneo linalofanya kazi kikamilifu kwa shughuli za viwanda na uwekezaji. mwaka 2026 ambazo zimeruhusu kampuni zinazozalisha umeme kuuza umeme moja kwa moja kwa watumiaji wakubwa. Mpango huo unaweza kuwapa wawekezaji wa viwanda viwango vya bei ya umeme vilivyo chini ya viwango vya kawaida vya rejareja, jambo litakaloongeza ushindani wa hifadhi hiyo. Hifadhi hiyo ya nishati safi iko ndani ya maeneo ya jotoardhi ya Olkaria, Naivasha, ambayo ni makazi ya mojawapo ya hazina kubwa zaidi za jotoardhi duniani, na kuwapa wawekezaji nishati safi ya asilimia 100 isiyokatizwa, manufaa yote ya SEZ na upatikanaji wa moja kwa moja wa mvuke wa jotoardhi. SEZ hiyo ina ukubwa wa zaidi ya ekari 8,000 na imeundwa kuwa kichocheo muhimu cha uwekezaji wa viwanda, utengenezaji wa bidhaa kwa kutumia nishati safi na uzalishaji unaozunguza masoko ya nje, huku eneo lake la kimkakati kando ya njia kuu za usafiri, ikiwemo Reli ya Kisasa (SGR), likiawezesha wawekezaji kufikia kwa urahisi masoko ya ndani na ya kikanda. KenGen inaendeleza hifadhi hiyo kwa awamu nne zitakazokamilika ifikapo mwaka 2045, na kuibadilisha Olkaria kutoka eneo la uzalishaji wa nishati pekee kuwa jiji kamili la viwanda vya kijani. Hifadhi hiyo tayari imepokea wawekezaji watano kutoka sekta muhimu za kimkakati, zikiwemo vituo vya data, uzalishaji wa mbolea ya kijani, teknolojia ya usafiri wa umeme, utengenezaji wa bidhaa za chuma, usafirishaji na uzalishaji wa bidhaa mbalimbali. Miongoni mwa waliokwisha kujitolea kuwekeza ni Synergetic Development Group, ambayo imesaini makubaliano ya kuanzisha kituo jumuiishi cha usafirishaji wa bidhaa za chuma na kiwanda cha kutengeneza bidhaa za chuma katika hifadhi hiyo, kwa kutumia megawati 18 za umeme wa jotoardhi, ekari 10 za ardhi na mita za ujazo 360 za maji kila mwaka.

Makamu wa Rais wa Chama cha Biashara cha Denmark, Jakob Ellemann-Jensen, alieleza

Kenya kuwa mojawapo ya masoko yenye kuvutia zaidi kwa ukuaji barani Afrika, hasa katika nyanja za nishati jadidifu, teknolojia ya kidijitali, sayansi za maisha na usafirishaji wa bidhaa. “Kwa sasa, Kenya ni mojawapo ya masoko yenye kuvutia zaidi kwa ukuaji barani Afrika. Kupitia ushirikiano na KEPSA, kampuni za Denmark zitapata jukwaa imara la ndani na fursa ya kufikia mfumo uliopo wa biashara katika Afrika Mashariki,” alisema.

Ellemann-Jensen aliongeza kuwa ushirikiano huo utasaidia kuimarisha uhusiano kati ya kampuni za Denmark na masoko ya Afrika Mashariki huku ukihamasisha uwekezaji wa muda mrefu na ukuaji endelevu wa uchumi. “Tunaona fursa kubwa katika kujenga madaraja imara zaidi kati ya kampuni za Denmark na masoko ya Afrika Mashariki. Hili si suala la biashara pekee, bali pia la kujenga ushirikiano wa muda mrefu, uwekezaji na ukuaji wa pamoja,” alisema. Kenya yaangazia ripoti za marufuku ya ajira kwa wajakazi nchini Kuwait

Serikali ya Kenya imewahakikishia wanaotafuta ajira na wadau wa uhamiaji wa kazi kufuatia ripoti zilizoenea zikidai kuwa Kuwait imeweka marufuku mpya ya kuajiri wafanyakazi wa nyumbani kutoka Kenya. Katika taarifa iliyotolewa na Ubalozi wa Kenya nchini Kuwait tarehe 10 Juni, serikali ilifanua kuwa Kenya haijapigwa marufuku upya kutuma wafanyakazi wa nyumbani kwenda Kuwait ulisitishwa kwa hiari na Kenya karibu muongo mmoja uliopita na bado msimamo huo unaendelea kutumika. Ufafanuzi huo umefuatia ripoti kutoka vyombo vya habari vya kikanda na kimataifa kwamba Kuwait imezuia ujiri wa wafanyakazi wa nyumbani kutoka nchi 10 zilizodhinishwa huku ikiwatenga wengine 27, zikiwemo Kenya, chini ya kanuni mpya zilizorekebisha zinazosimamia sekta ya ajira ya wafanyakazi wa nyumbani. Kwa mujibu wa Ubalozi wa Kenya, mawasiliano ya hivi karibuni kutoka kwa mamlaka za Kuwait yanaakisi tu hali iliyokuwepo kwa muda mrefu na hayapaswi kutafiriwa kama sera mpya inayolenga Kenya au wafanyakazi wa Kenya. “Kenya haijapigwa marufuku upya kutuma wafanyakazi wa nyumbani Kuwait. Serikali ya Kenya ilisitisha kwa hiari uhamiaji wa wafanyakazi wa nyumbani kwenda Kuwait takribani miaka kumi iliyopita, na msimamo huo bado unaendelea,” ubalozi ulisema. Ufafanuzi huo umejiri baada ya ripoti kadhaa za vyombo vya habari kuonyesha waraka uliotolewa na Wizara ya Mambo

ya Ndani ya Kuwait ukipunguza ujiri wa wafanyakazi wa nyumbani kwa nchi zilizodhinishwa kama Afrika Kusini, Ethiopia, Filipino, India, Nepal, Sri Lanka na Vietnam, huku Kenya na nchi nyingine kadhaa za Afrika zikizuiwa. Ubalozi ulisitiza kuwa vuzuizi hivyo vinahusu tu kundi la wafanyakazi wa nyumbani na haviathiri sekta nyingine ambapo Wakenya bado wanaendelea kupata ajira nchini Kuwait. “Makundi mengine yote ya wafanyakazi wa Kenya bado yanastahili kutafuta fursa za ajira nchini Kuwait kwa mujibu wa sheria na kanuni zinazotumika za nchi zote mbili,” taarifa hiyo ilibainisha. Kenya na Kuwait kwa sasa zinafanya mazungumzo yanayolenga kuunda mfumo wa pande mbili wa kazi utakaoweka taratibu, ulinzi na mifumo ya kusimamia ushirikiano wa baadaye katika sekta ya ajira ya wafanyakazi wa nyumbani. Uhamiaji wa kazi umekuwa nguzo muhimu ya mkakati wa ajira wa Kenya, huku maelfu ya vijana wakitafuta fursa nje ya nchi, hasa katika nchi za Ghuba. Kuwait bado ni mojawapo ya maeneo wanayokwenda wafanyakazi wa Kenya, hasa katika sekta za afya, ukarimu, ujenzi na kazi za kiufundi. Ubalozi ulibainisha kuwa wafanyakazi wa Kenya wanaendelea kuwa na sifa nzuri nchini Kuwait kutokana na weledi wao, ujuzi na maadili ya kazi, hali inayochangia pakubwa katika sekta mbalimbali za uchumi wa nchi hiyo. Maendeleo haya yanajiri wakati ambapo Kuwait inaendelea na mageuzi mapana ya soko lake la ajira. Hatua mpya zilizochukuliwa na mamlaka za Kuwait ni pamoja na usimamizi mkali zaidi wa ujiri wa wafanyakazi wa nyumbani, matumizi ya mifumo ya kidijitali katika huduma za

visa na udhamini, pamoja na kanuni zilizorekebisha zinazosimamia ajira ya wafanyakazi wa nyumbani na madereva. Wataalamu wa masuala ya kazi wanasema ufafanuzi huu ni muhimu kwa kuwa taarifa kuhusu marufuku mpya zilikuwa zimesababisha wasiwasi kwa wanaotarajia kwenda kufanya kazi nje ya nchi na mashirika ya ujiri nchini Kenya. Serikali katika miaka ya hivi karibuni imeongeza juhudi za kukuza uhamiaji salama na uliodhibitiwa wa kazi, huku ikipambana na mashirika yasiyo rasmi ya ujiri yanayotuhumiwa kuwanyonya wanaotafuta ajira. Katibu Mkuu wa Idara ya Kazi na Maendeleo ya Ujuzi, Shadrack Mwadime, amewahi kusema kuwa serikali imejikita katika kuimarisha usimamizi wa mashirika binafsi ya ujiri ili kulinda Wakenya wanaotafuta ajira nje ya nchi. Ameerza pia umuhimu wa mifumo ya uwazi na iliyopangwa ya uhamiaji wa wafanyakazi kama sehemu ya ajenda pana ya ajira nchini. Mwadime pia amesema kuwa ajira za nje ya nchi ni sehemu muhimu ya mkakati wa taifa wa kutengeneza ajira, hasa kwa idadi kubwa ya vijana. Akizungumza katika mikutano ya kimataifa ya kazi, amesisitiza kuwa serikali inaendelea kuchukua hatua za makusudi kupanua ajira zenye hadhi bora ndani na nje ya nchi. Ubalozi pia umebainisha kuwa Kuwait mara kwa mara hupitia upya kanuni zake za kazi ili kuboresha usimamizi, kurahisisha taratibu za ujiri na kuimarisha ulinzi kwa wafanyakazi na waajiri. Imehakikishia umma kuwa uhusiano wa uhamiaji wa kazi kati ya Kenya na Kuwait bado uko imara licha ya vuzuizi vya sasa vinavyoathiri wafanyakazi wa nyumbani.

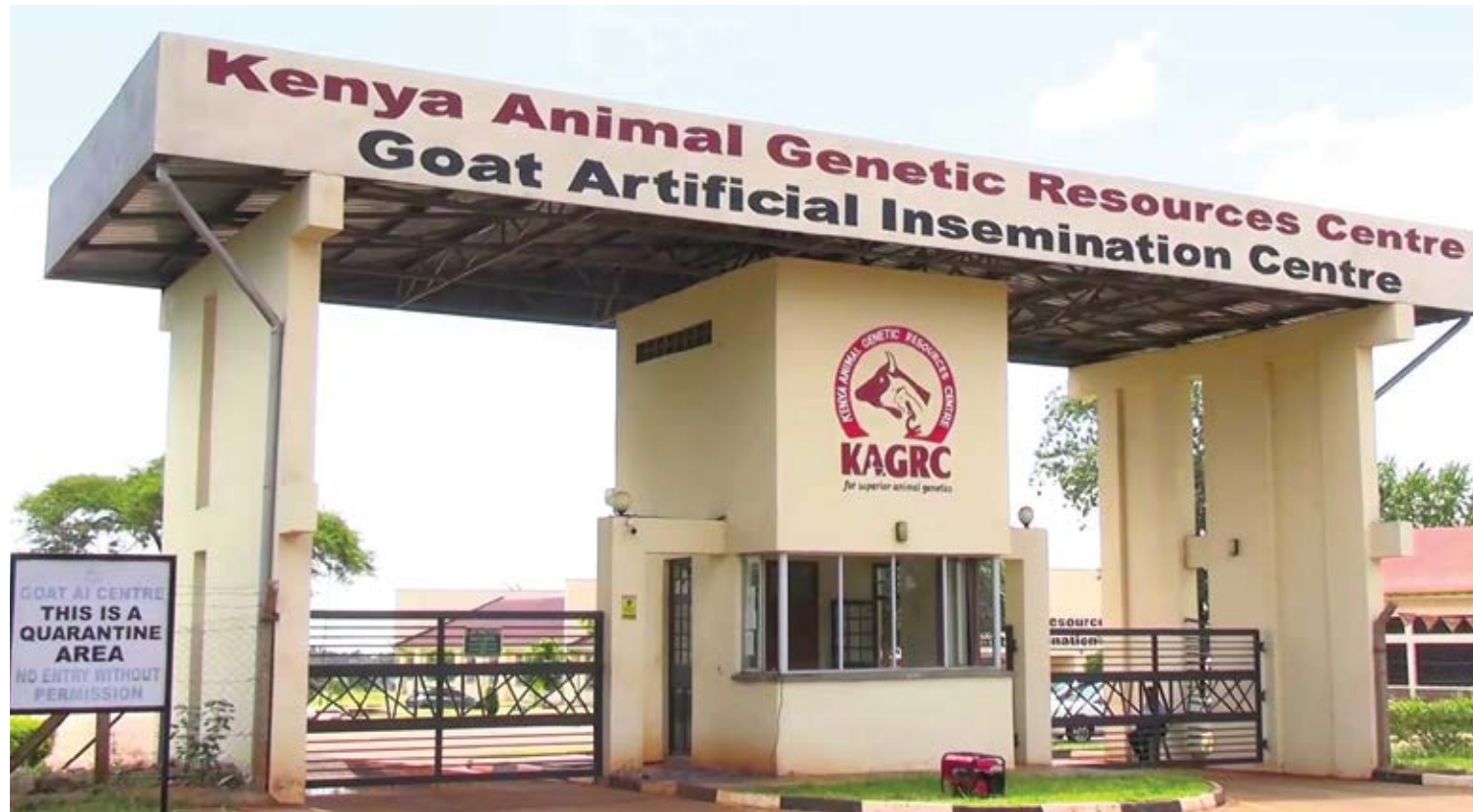

alizeti unawaunganisha moja kwa moja wakulima na masoko ya malisho ya mifugo pamoja na viwanda vya kuchakata mafuta ya kupikia, jambo linalofanya kuwa mojawapo ya uwekezaji wa kilimo wenye uthabiti na faida kubwa,” Ochiaga alithibitisha. Mradi huo unalenga kuanzisha mnyororo kamili wa thamani kuanzia uzalishaji hadi usindikaji na uuzaji. Mbegu za alizeti zitachakatwa kuwa mafuta ya kupikia, huku mashapo ya alizeti yakitumika katika utengenezaji wa malisho ya mifugo, hivyo kuunda soko la uhakika kwa wakulima na kupunguza utegemezi wa mafuta ya kupikia yanayoagizwa kutoka nje.
