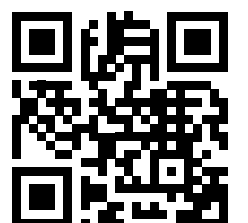

# Kenya katika hali ya tahadhari kuhusu maambukizi ya Ebola

Taasisi ya Utafiti wa Matibabu Kenya (KEMRI) imeimarisha hatua za maandalizi ili kusaidia mwitikio wa nchi dhidi ya uwezekano wa mkurupuko wa ugonjwa wa Ebola, huku serikali ikiendelea kuimarisha ufuatiliaji na juhudi za dharura kufuatia kuripotiwa kwa visa vya ugonjwa huo katika nchi jirani.

Akizungumza baada ya kukagua huduma za Afya Mipakani katika kituo cha mpaka wa Busia na Hospitali ya Kaunti Ndogo ya Alupe, Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa KEMRI, Profesa Elijah Songok, alisema taasisi hiyo imeongeza utayari wake wa kusaidia timu za kitaifa za mwitikio kupitia uimarishaji wa upimaji wa maabara, uzalishaji wa viuatilifu na uanzishaji wa vituo vya kutenga wagonjwa.

Profesa Songok alisema KEMRI imebaini maeneo muhimu ya kuingilia kati, ikiwemo upimaji wa maabara na uthibitishaji wa visa kupitia maabara zake sita za kiwango cha juu zilizoko katika

maeneo mbalimbali nchini.

“Tumeainisha maeneo ambayo KEMRI inaweza kusaidia, ikiwa ni pamoja na kuimarisha upimaji na uthibitishaji wa visa. Virusi hivi hushughulikiwa katika maabara za BSL-3 zilizoko Kilifi, Kericho, Kisumu na Nairobi,” alisema.

Aliongeza kuwa taasisi hiyo inaongeza uzalishaji wa viuatilifu kwa ajili ya hospitali na vituo vya afya mipakani vinavyoshughulikia visa vinavyoshukiwa, huku pia ikitengeneza vifaa vya kupimia ili kuimarisha maandalizi ya nchi.

“Tunaongeza uzalishaji wa viuatilifu kwa hospitali na vituo vya afya mipakani vinavyoshughulikia visa vinavyoshukiwa. Pia tunafanyia kazi vifaa vya kupimia ili tuwe tayari kushughulikia visa vyoovote vitakavyoripotiwa,” alisema.

Mkuu huyo wa KEMRI alisisitiza umuhimu wa kuwepo kwa vitengo vya kutenga wagonjwa vilivyo na vifaa vya kutosha ili kudhibiti milipuko na kuwalinda wahudumu wa afya pamoja na umma. Alisema taasisi hiyo inashirikiana na wadau mbalimbali kuanzisha hospitali zenye wodi za kiwango cha juu za kudhibiti maambukizi, na kufichua kuwa wodi katika Hospitali ya Kaunti Ndogo ya Alupe zitafanywa ukarabati ili kuimarisha maandalizi.

Profesa Songok alisema mafunzo yaliyopatikana kutokana na milipuko ya wagonjwa iliyopita yameboresha kwa kiasi kikubwa uwezo wa Kenya wa kukabiliwa na dharura za kiafya. Alitoa wito wa kuimarishwa kwa uchunguzi katika vituo vya mipakani na njia zisizo rasmi za kuingia nchini, akisema uhama-

sishaji wa jamii na ushirikiano wa sekta mbalimbali ni muhimu katika kuzuia kusambaa kwa ugonjwa huo.

“Hili linahitaji mkabala wa sekta nyingi. Tunahitaji kuboresha mawasiliano na uhamasishaji wa jamii kwa sababu jamii ina jukumu kubwa katika kupambana na janga hili,” alisema.

Aidha, alipendekeza kuanzishwa kwa vituo maalum vya kutenga wagonjwa vilivyo tofauti na hospitali za kawaida ili kupunguza unyanyapaa na kupunguza usumbufu wa huduma za kawaida za afya wakati wa milipuko.

Kauli zake zinajiri wakati Katibu wa Afya ya Umma, Mary Muthoni, aliwahakikishia Wakenya kuwa hakuna kisa cha Ebola kilichoripotiwa nchini licha ya hali ya tahadhari iliyopo.

Akizungumza mjini Kerugoya, Muthoni alisema serikali imeimarisha hatua za ufuatiliaji na maandalizi ya dharura katika vituo vya kuingia nchini ili kulinda taifa dhidi ya uwezekano wa mlipuko wa ugonjwa huo.

“Hatujaripoti kisa chochote cha Ebola nchini Kenya, lakini serikali iko katika hali ya tahadhari ya juu na hatua zote muhimu zimewekwa ili kuwalinda Wakenya,” alisema.

Katibu Mkuu huyo alisema Wizara ya Afya, kwa kushirikiana na mashirika mengine ya serikali, imeanzisha mifumo madhubuti ya uchunguzi na ufuatiliaji katika mipaka ya Kenya. Aliongeza kuwa wahudumu wa afya kote nchini wamepewa mafunzo ya kubaini, kutenga na kushughulikia visa vinavyoshukiwa kuwa vya Ebola, huku timu za mwikitio wa haraka zikiwa tayari kuchukua hatua wakati wowote.

“Wahudumu wetu wa afya wamefunzwa jinsi ya kushughulikia visa vinavyoshukiwa kuwa vya Ebola, na timu za mwikitio ziko tayari kuchukua hatua mara moja iwapo kisa chochote kitagunduliwa,” alisema.

Muthoni alisema wizara hiyo inafanya kazi kwa karibu na vyombo vya usalama, maafisa wa uhamiaji na serikali za kaunti ili kuimarisha ufuatiliaji na uchunguzi katika vituo vyote vya mipakani na njia kuu za usafiri.

# Walimu wapigwa jeki huku nafasi za kupandishwa zikiongezeka hadi 50,000

Naibu Rais, Profesa Kithure Kindiki, amesema serikali itawapandisha vyeo walimu 50,000 kufuatia kuongezwa kwa mgao wa bajeti katika mwaka wa kifedha ujao.

Profesa Kindiki aliwahakikishia walimu kuwa masuala yanayowahusu yamezingatiwa katika bajeti ya mwaka wa fedha 2026/27 ili kuboresha ustawi wao.

“Katika bajeti ijayo, tumetenga fedha za kupandisha vyeo walimu. Awali tulikuwa tumelenga walimu 25,000, lakini baada ya mashauriano zaidi na vyama vya walimu, serikali sasa itawapandisha vyeo walimu 50,000,” alisema.

Akizungumza wakati wa hafla ya shukrani ya Katibu Mtendaji mpya aliyechaguliwa wa tawi la Meru la KUPPET, Njira Muthomi, Naibu Rais alisema baadhi ya walimu watakaonufaika wamekwama katika ngazi moja ya kazi kwa zaidi ya miaka 10.

“Tunafanya kila linaloweza kuboresha ustawi wa

walimu kupitia masharti bora ya kazi na kuongeza idadi yao ili kupunguza mzigo wa kazi kwa kila mwalimu,” aliongeza.

Profesa Kindiki pia aliwahakikishia walimu kuwa masuala yao ya afya yamezingatiwa na kwamba serikali itahakikisha wanapata bima ya afya ya kutosha kupitia Mamlaka ya Afya ya Jamii (SHA).

“Tunahitaji kuboresha vifurushi vya SHA kwa walimu. Tutaharakisha utatuzi wa masuala

yaliyoibuliwa na walimu ili kuhakikisha afya yao inalindwa, kwa sababu ni muhimu kuwa na mwalimu mwenye afya bora,” alisema.

“Walimu ndio watu pekee wanaotumia muda wao mwingi kufikiria ustawi wa watoto wa watu wengine kuliko hata wanao vyofikiria familia zao wenyewe. Kwa sababu hiyo, tunawapongeza kwa kuwa mfano bora wa kujitolea kwa ajili ya wengine,” aliongeza.

Naibu Rais alisema sekta ya elimu itapokea shilingi bilioni 765 katika mwaka wa fedha ujao, ikilinganishwa na shilingi bilioni 500 mwaka wa 2022.

Alisema baadhi ya mafanikio makubwa yaliyopatikana tangu mwaka wa 2022 ni pamoja na kuajiriwa kwa walimu 100,000. Aliongeza kuwa walimu wengine 20,000 wataajiriwa hivi karibuni.

Kindiki pia alisema serikali imejenga madarasa 23,000 na maabara 1,600 kote nchini.

Aidha, alisema wakufunzi 3,300 zaidi wameajiriwa katika taasisi za Mafunzo ya Ufundi na Teknolojia (TVET), huku mageuzi mbalimbali yaliyowezesha kuongezeka kwa uandikishaji wa wanafunzi yakitekelezwa.

Tume ya Utumishi wa Umma (PSC) imewaonya maafisa wakuu serikalini dhidi ya unyanyasaji wa kingono na ukatili dhidi ya wahitimu wanaofanya mafunzo ya vitendo (interns) waliopangiwa katika wizara, idara na mashirika mbalimbali ya serikali. kufukuzwa kazi na kufunguliwa mashaka. Meja, ambaye alizungumza na wasimamizi (mentors) kadhaa katika mpango wa mafunzo ya vitendo wakati wa mafunzo ya wiki moja, aliwataka maafisa hao kuripoti mara moja visa vyovyote vya unyanyasaji na kuchukua hatua stahiki dhidi ya wahusika. Meja alisema mpango wa mafunzo ya vitendo ulioanza mwaka 2019 unawapa wahitimu fursa ya kupata uzoefu muhimu wa kazi akibainisha kuwa zaidi

ya wahitimu 37,000 tayari wamenufaika.

Aliongeza kuwa mwaka huu Tume imewapangia wahitimu 8,268 katika wizara, idara na mashirika ya serikali, huku wahitimu 3,134 wa awali wakipata ajira za kudumu katika serikali kuu na serikali za kaunti.

Pia aliibua wasiwasi juu ya ulegevu wa kazi wa maafisa wa umma, ambao umeathiri vibaya tija ya serikali, licha ya wafanyakazi wasiopungua milioni moja kuchota zaidi ya Sh1 trilioni za mishahara na marapurupu kila mwaka.

“Tafiti za Tume ya Mishahara na Marapurupu zimebainisha kuwa sekta ya kibinafsi ina tija mara tatu ikilinganishwa na utumishi wa umma,” Meja alisema.

## Maelfu Nyandarua kupata umeme kwa Sh1.6bn katika mradi wa maili ya mwisho

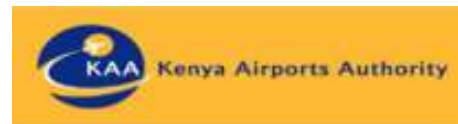

Maelfu ya wakazi wa Kaunti ya Nyandarua watanufaika na mpango mkubwa wa umeme vijijini wenye thamani ya mabilioni ya shilingi. Hii inafuatia mgao wa serikali wa shilingi bilioni 1.6 kwa ajili ya miradi ya kuunganisha umeme wa mwisho (last-mile connectivity) katika kaunti hiyo. Kati ya mgao huo, Jimbo la Ol Kalou litapokea shilingi milioni 204, fedha ambazo zitawezesha kuunganishwa kwa zaidi ya kaya 1,700 kwenye umeme.

Akizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi wa zoezi hilo katika Kijiji cha Manyatta, Wadi ya Rurii, Katibu Mkuu wa Wizara ya Nishati, Alex Wachira, alisema: “Serikali imejizatiti kuhakikisha vijiji vya mbali na vilivyopuuzwa awali vinaunganishwa na gridi ya taifa ya umeme.” Wachira, ambaye aliongoza pia uzinduzi wa Mradi wa Umeme wa Kijiji cha Marewa katika Jimbo la Ol Kalou, aliongeza kuwa upatikanaji wa umeme utaboresha maisha ya wananchi na kuchochea maendeleo katika eneo hilo.

### IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MINOR TRAFFIC (MINOR OFFENCES) RULES 2016 ENFORCEMENT FRAMEWORK UNDER SECTION 117 OF THE TRAFFIC ACT (CAP. 403)

Following the withdrawal of the earlier notice on the rollout of the Minor Traffic Offences System, the National Transport and Safety Authority (NTSA), in collaboration with the Office of the Attorney General, National Police Service (NPS), the Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions (ODPP), the Judiciary, and other relevant enforcement agencies, has reviewed the minor traffic offences and developed internal procedures to guide the implementation framework.

The National Transport and Safety Authority (NTSA) wishes to notify members of the public that the Government will operationalize a **modernized enforcement framework** for minor traffic offences under Sections 117 of the Traffic Act (Cap. 403), effective **1<sup>st</sup> June, 2026**.

The primary objectives of this framework are to:

- 1) Enhance **road safety** for all users
- 2) Increase **compliance** with traffic laws;
- 3) Reduce **congestion** in traffic courts;
- 4) Promote **transparency, accountability, and efficiency** in traffic enforcement

Under the **new framework**, motorists who commit any of the offences listed in the Traffic (Minor Offences) Rules, 2016 will no longer need to appear in court immediately. Instead, they may receive a **Police Notification of Traffic Offence**. Offences can be detected either by police officers during **routine enforcement** or **electronically** via traffic cameras and other digital monitoring systems. Once sufficient evidence is gathered, the **notification** will be issued to the **driver** or the registered **vehicle owner**.

These notifications may be served in several ways, including **personal delivery** by police officers, **affixing** the notice to the vehicle, or **electronically** via **SMS, email**, or approved **digital** traffic enforcement **platforms**. Motorists are therefore strongly encouraged to ensure their contact details in the NTSA registration system are accurate and up to date.

Each notification will be based on the Police Notification of a Traffic Offence and shall contain key details such as the nature of the offence, the date, time and location it occurred, the prescribed penalty, payment instructions, and response deadlines. Upon receiving a notice, motorists have two options: they may **admit** liability and **pay** the prescribed fine within the stipulated period, or they may **dispute** the allegation in court. If the motorist chooses to **pay** the fine, the matter can be **settled without** the need for a **court appearance**. However, the court retains the power to reduce or refund the penalty based on mitigating circumstances (if any) and administer demerit points against the driver's licence where appropriate.

Failure to respond, pay fines, or appear in court when required may result in **harsher penalties** imposed by the COURTS. Motorists have the **RIGHT** to access evidence, such as photographs or video recordings, supporting the alleged offence.

Finally, NTSA **assures** the public that all personal data collected will be handled in accordance with the Constitution and the Data Protection Act.

Zaidi ya wakulima 100 kutoka vijiji vya Lokipetot na Naurenpuu katika eneo la Turkana Central wamegawiwa ekari 53 za ardhi katika mpango maalum unaolenga kuongeza kujitosheleza kwa chakula katika eneo hilo. Wakulima hao walieleza furaha yao baada ya kila mnufaika kupewa nusu ekari ya ardhi. Walisema wako tayari kuanza kilimo, wakitumia fursa ya mvua zinazoendelea kunyesha kwa sasa. “Kuna haja ya kutumia mashine za kilimo ili wakulima waanze kulima na kunufaika na maji yanayotiririka katika Mto Turkwel,” alisema Charles Namus, Mwenyekiti wa Kamati ya Usimamizi wa Umwagiliaji ya Lokipetot. Katibu huyo alisisitiza kuwa serikali inaendelea kuweka kipaumbele katika mageuzi ya kidijitali chini ya Ajenda ya Mabadiliko ya Kiuchumi ya Mfumo wa Chini kwenda Juu (BETA), ambapo "barabara kuu ya kidijitali" na uchumi wa ubunifu ni nguzo muhimu za maendeleo ya kitaifa. Alifichua kuwa serikali inaongeza kasi ya utekezaji wa miundombinu ya kidijitali kupitia upanuzi wa mtandao wa nyaya za fibre optic, uanzishaji wa vituo vya kidijitali na uwekaji wa maeneo ya Wi-Fi ya umma nchini kote. Isaboke alisema Serikali inajenga takribani kilomita 100,000 za nyaya za fibre optic nchi nzima, ikiwemo maeneo ya vijijini yasiyo na huduma za kutosha, ili kuimarisha mawasiliano na kupunguza pengo la kidijitali. Aliongeza kuwa vituo vya kidijitali vilivyo na kompyuta na upatikanaji wa intaneti vinaanzishwa

katika kata mbalimbali nchini ili kuwapa vijana ujuzi wa kidijitali na kuunga mkono ubunifu. Aidha, serikali inaweka maeneo 5,000 ya Wi-Fi ya bure katika masoko, shule, hospitali na maeneo mengine ya umma ili kuongeza upatikanaji wa intaneti. "Mwekezaji huu unalenga kuimarisha mawasiliano, kusaidia mifumo ya ubunifu na kuunda mazingira wezeshi kwa sekta za ubunifu na vyombo vya habari kustawi ndani ya uchumi wa kidijitali," alieleza. na maendeleo yameanza kuingia ikiwemo ujenzi wa Huduma Centre, masoko pamoja na manufaa mengine. Seneta wa Uasin Gichu, Jackson Mandago, ambaye alimsindikiza Waziri huyo, pia alisisitiza

umuhimu wa umoja miongoni mwa jamii za wachache, akibainisha kuwa bila umoja, haziwezi kutetea maslahi yao. Aliwataka jamii zilizotengwa kujisajili kwa vitambulisho vya taifa ili kupata huduma za serikali.

Josphat Lowoi, Mkuu wa Ofisi ya Mtendaji wa Rais, Kitengo cha Masuala ya Wachache na Jamii Zilizotengwa, alisisitiza kuwa Sera ya Kitaifa ya Makundi ya Kikabila ya Wachache, Wenyeji na Jamii Zilizotengwa imeundwa kuhakikisha mgawanyo sawa wa rasilimali katika maeneo yote nchini. ## Ndani ya karakana Kericho ambapo ufundi hukutana na ubunifu

Sauti ya midundo ya mashine za kushona, harufu ya mbaio mpya zilizokatwa, na mgongano wa zana za useremala hujaza karakana ndogo ya kutengeneza samani mjini Kericho. Wateja huingia ndani kukagua seti za sofa zenye umaridadi, vitengo vya ukutani vilivyong'arishwa, na samani maalum zilizopangwa kwa uangalifu kwa ajili ya kuonyeshwa. Katikati ya shughuli hizo zote, yupo William Ochieng, akiongoza wafanyakazi wake kwa ujasiri huku akijadiliana miundo na wateja. Wateja wachache wanuingia katika karakana yake wanajua kwamba miaka michache iliyopita, fundi huyo mwenye sauti ya upole alikuwa gerezani akitumikia kifungo kirefu ambacho kilionekana kama kingewelegeza maisha yake yote yaliyosalia. Hata hivyo, hadithi ya Ochieng inasimama kama ushahidi wenye nguvu wa uwezo wa kubadilisha maisha kupitia imani, azma, mafunzo ya ufundi stadi na nafasi ya pili maishani. Safari yake kutoka mfungwa hadi mwajiri, mshauri na mjasiriamali inaonesha jinsi urekebishaji unavyoweza kufungua uwezo wa binadamu na kuunda fursa zinazowanufaisha si tu watu binafsi bali pia familia, jamii na uchumi kwa ujumla. Kwa Ochieng, gereza halikuwa mwisho wa hadithi yake. Badala yake, lilikuwa ngazi



isiyo ya kawaida iliyomsaidia kujijenga upya maishani. Amezaliwa 1989 katika Kaunti ya Homa Bay, Ochieng alikulia katika familia ya hali ya chini ambapo maisha yalizunguka kazi ngumu na kujikimu. Kama watoto wengi kutoka mazingira magumu kiuchumi, safari yake ya elimu ilikatizwa na changamoto za kifedha. Alimaliza elimu ya msingi lakini hakuweza kuendelea zaidi. Licha ya vikwazo hivyo, alibeba ndoto za kujijengea maisha bora yeye na familia yake. Hata hivyo, ndoto hizo zilionekana kuvunjika Februari 2019 alipohukumiwa kwa kosa la unajisi na kuhukumiwa kifungo cha miaka 15 katika Gereza Kuu la Kericho. Hukumu hiyo ya kifungo ilikuja kama pigo kubwa. Akitenganishwa ghafla na familia, marafiki na ulimwengu wa nje, Ochieng alijikuta akikabiliana na maisha yasiyo

na matumaini na yasiyo na uhakika. Wazo la kutumia zaidi ya muongo mmoja gerezani lilimlema kisaikolojia. Kwa wafungwa wengi, hali kama hizi huweza kuzaa kukata tamaa, uchungu na kukosa matumaini. Lakini katikati ya changamoto za maisha ya gerezani, Ochieng alifanya uamuzi ambao ulibadilisha mwelekeo wa maisha yake ya baadaye. Badala ya kuruhusu hali yake imleeme, aliamua kutumia kila fursa iliyokuwepo kujiboresha. Alichagua kujijengea badala ya kujihurumia, nidhamu badala ya kukata tamaa, na kujifunza badala ya majuto. “Nilijiambia kwamba kama nitapata nafasi nyingine maisihani, ningependa kuwa tayari,” anakumbuka. Uamuzi huo ulianza safari ya mabadiliko ya kipekee. Ndani ya gereza, Ochieng alijitosa katika programu za



mafunzo ya ufundi stadi, akiwa na azma ya kutoka akiwa na ujuzi ambao ungeweza kumsaidia yeye na familia yake. Aliandikishwa katika kila kozi ya vitendo aliyoweza kupata na haraka akagundua mapenzi yake kwa kazi za kiufundi. Kwa miaka mingi, alipata mafunzo ya useremala na utengenezaji samani, upholstery, uashi, ushonaji, usanifu majengo na upangaji wa nyumba. Alijifunza jinsi ya kutengeneza fremu za samani, kushona vifaa vya sofa, kusoma michoro ya majengo na kubuni miundo inayofanya kazi. Kili choanza kama njia ya kupitisha muda polepole kilibadilika kuwa dhamira ya kibinafsi. Kila ujuzi mpya ulimarisha imani yake na kupanua maono yake ya baadaye. Wafungwa wenzake na maafisa wa gereza walianza kutambua juhudi zake. Wakati wengine waliona gereza kama mahali pa

## Chumba cha michezo chaleta uponyaji na matumaini kwa wagonjwa wadogo

Ndani ya wodi ya watoto katika Hospitali ya Kufundishia na Rufaa ya Homa Bay, kicheko kinapita juu ya sauti ya kawaida ya mashine za hospitali na hatua za haraka za watu wanaopita. Watoto wagonjwa hukusanyika katika chumba cha kuchezea kilichopakwa rangi ang'avu, baadhi wamekaa sakafuni wakipaka rangi picha, wengine wakisoma namba zilizoandikwa ukutani, huku wachache wakipanga tofali za vinyago chini ya uangalizi wa wazazi wanaotabasama. Kwa watoto wanaopambana na magonjwa kama malaria, nimonia na kuhara, chumba hicho kinatoa zaidi ya burudani. Kinatoa faraja, msaada wa kihisia na, kwa mujibu wa wahudumu wa afya, njia ya haraka zaidi ya kupona. Chumba hicho cha michezo chenye rangi nyingi kinasimama tofauti kabisa na wodi iliyojaa wagonjwa nje. Kuta zake zimepambwa kwa michoro ya furaha ya wanyama, maua, ndege na namba. Viti vidogo vya watoto na meza vinajaza kona moja, huku rafu zikiwa na vitabu,

kalamu za rangi, mafumbo na vinyago. Kwa muda mfupi, watoto husahau kuwa wao ni wagonjwa. “Tunaelewa kwamba watoto hupona si kupitia dawa pekee bali pia kupitia furaha na msaada wa kihisia,” anasema Carolyne Adongo, Mkurugenzi wa Huduma za Uuguzi katika hospitali hiyo, akiwaangalia watoto wakimba pamoja. Chumba hicho kilianzishwa takriban miaka sita iliyopita kama sehemu ya mbinu ya tiba inayolenga kuwasaidia watoto kupona wakiwa wanapata matibabu. Kwa mujibu wa Adongo, watoto wengi huja wakiwa na hofu, msongo wa mawazo na wakikataa matibabu. “Wengine hulika kila wanapoona madaktari au wauguzi wakikaribia na dawa. Lakini baada ya kutumia muda katika chumba cha michezo, polepole huanza kujisikia huru na kuanza kuwasiliana kwa urahisi na wahudumu wa afya,” anaeleza. Chumba hicho huwaruhusu watoto kucheza pamoja na wazazi wao, kikijenga mfumo thabiti wa msaada wa kihisia wakati wa matibabu. Akina mama na baba huketi kando ya watoto wao wakisoma namba kwa sauti, wakipaka rangi na kushiriki michezo rahisi kuwahamasisha. Mtoto mmoja anacheka kwa sauti baada ya kutambua wanyama waliopakwa ukutani. Karibu naye, mwingine

anapaka rangi kwa uangalifu huku mama yake akimwongoza kwa upole. Kwa wazazi wengi wanaokeshwa usiku kucha kando ya vitanda vya hospitali, nyakati hizi huleta nafuu na matumaini adimu. Licha ya mafanikio ya mpango huo, wodi ya watoto bado inakabiliwa na msongamano mkubwa. Wodi hiyo ilipangwa kuhudumia watoto 35 pekee, lakini wakati wa msimu wa malaria idadi huongezeka sana. “Wakati mwingine tunapokea kati ya watoto 89 hadi 95. Kwa sababu ya msongamano, baadhi hulazimika kulala kitanda kimoja. Wakati mwingine watoto watatu hushiriki kitanda kimoja, jambo ambalo si la starehe,” anasema Adongo. Shinikizo hilo huwakumba

pia wazazi na wafanyakazi. Wauguzi husogea haraka kutoka kitanda kimoja hadi kingine kuhakikisha kila mtoto anapata huduma, huku wazazi wakihangaika kupata nafasi ya kukaa karibu na watoto wao wagonjwa. “Pia tuna changamoto ya rasilimali watu. Idadi ya wauguzi na wahudumu wa afya haitoshi kulingana na wagonjwa tunaowapokea kila siku,” anasema Adongo. Licha ya changamoto hizo, wahudumu wa afya bado wamejitolea kuhakikisha watoto wanapata si matibabu pekee, bali pia huduma ya kihisia. Kwa mujibu wa muuguzi wa watoto Josiah Orwa, chumba hicho cha michezo kimebadilisha uhusiano kati ya wagonjwa wadogo na wahudumu wa afya. “Watoto wanapowasiliana nasi kupitia michezo, huacha kuwa na hofu na madaktari na wauguzi. Inakuwa rahisi kuwapa dawa kwa sababu tayari wamezoeana nasi,” Orwa anasema. Anaeleza kuwa baadhi ya watoto huletwa hospitalini wakiwa wamejifunga ndani, wakikataa dawa na chakula. Lakini baada ya kutumia muda katika chumba cha michezo, hali yao hubadilika. “Bila kucheza, kupona kun-

aweza kuchelewa. Watoto wanahitaji mwingiliano na furaha ili kupona kiakili na kimwili,” anaongeza muuguzi huyo. Anaeleza kwa mvulana mdogo anayepanga kwa utulivu tofali za vinyago akiwa na watoto wengine. Inasemekana mtoto huyo alikuwa akikataa kuongea au kula baada ya kulazwa na nimonia. Baada ya siku kadhaa katika chumba cha michezo, alianza polepole kufunguka na kushirikiana na wauguzi na watoto wengine. Wazazi wanasema mabadiliko yanaonekana wazi. “Mtoto wangu alipolazwa alikuwa dhaifu na hana furaha. Lakini baada ya kuja kucheza hapa na watoto wengine, alibadilika na kuwa mchangamfu tena,” anasema Cynthia Obana, ambaye mtoto wake anapokea matibabu hospitalini hapo. Akiendelea kuzungumza, mtoto wake aliyeketi sakafuni anacheka huku akipaka rangi picha. “Mtoto wangu anaweza kuwasiliana na watoto wengine na kushiriki shughuli ndogo kama kusoma namba na kupaka rangi. Hii imeboresha sana kupona kwake,” anasema.

Ugonjwa wa seli mundu (SCD) ni kundi la magonjwa ya kurithi ya damu ambayo husababisha chembe nyekundu za damu kuwa ngumu, kunata na kuchukua umbo la mwezi mwandamo. Badala ya kutiririka kwa urahisi ndani ya mishipa ya damu, chembe hizi zisizo za kawaida zinaweza kuziba mzunguko wa damu, kupunguza usambazaji wa oksijeni na kusababisha maumivu makali, uharibifu wa tishu na upungufu wa damu wa muda mrefu. Matibabu ya ugonjwa huu hulenga kudhibiti maumivu, kuzuia mataizo na kushughulikia chanzo cha kijeni cha ugonjwa huo. Mbinu zake ni pamoja na matumizi

ya dawa za kila siku kama vile hydroxyurea, kuongezewa damu, huduma za msaada wa maisha ya kila siku, na pia chaguzi zinazoweza kuponya kabisa kama upandikizaji wa seli shina na tiba mpya zinazoibuka za kijeni. Kwa mujibu wa Wizara ya Afya, ugonjwa wa seli mundu (SCD) huathiri takriban watoto 14,000 wanaozaliwa kila mwaka nchini Kenya. Kiwango cha maambukizi kitaifa ni takriban asilimia 0.9, lakini sifa ya kubeba vinasaba vya ugonjwa (SCT) hufikia asilimia 10 hadi 40 katika maeneo yenye maambukizi makubwa ya malaria kama Pwani, Magharibi na Nyanza. Bila uchunguzi wa mapema, asilimia 50 hadi 90 ya watoto hawa hawafiki umri wa miaka mitano. Takwimu zinaonesha kuwa

takriban asilimia 21 ya watoto katika Kaunti ya Kisumu hubeba sifa ya seli mundu, na karibu asilimia 4.5 huzaliwa wakiwa na ugonjwa huo. Wataalamu wanasema ugonjwa huo umeenea zaidi katika kaunti hiyo kwa sababu kubeba sifa hiyo hutoa kinga ya asili dhidi ya malaria kali, ambayo ni ya kawaida katika eneo hilo.

Hii inafanya eneo la Ziwa, hasa Kisumu, kuwa na kiwango cha juu zaidi cha ugonjwa wa seli mundu (SCD) nchini Kenya. Kwa sababu hiyo, baadhi ya vituo vya afya vya kaunti kama Hospitali ya Mafunzo na Rufaa ya Jaramogi Oginga Odinga (JOTRH) na Pap Onditi huko Nyakach vimeanzisha uchunguzi wa watoto wachanga na teknolojia za kisasa

za kupima ugonjwa huo mapema. Mipango ya usimamizi wa ugonjwa huu inalenga ugawaji wa dawa ya hydroxyurea kwa wagonjwa, mafunzo kwa wahudumu wa afya ya jamii, na kuongezewa damu mara kwa mara ili kuokoa maisha. Kwa maelfu ya familia za Kenya, ugonjwa wa seli mundu ni zaidi ya hali ya kiafya. Ni mapambano ya kila siku dhidi ya maumivu, unyanyapaa, umaskini na upatikanaji mdogo wa huduma za afya. Matibabu ya SCD katika kaunti hizi yanaungwa mkono chini ya orodha ya dawa muhimu. Ili kupata huduma na dawa endelevu, wagonjwa wanapaswa kuhakikisha michango yao katika Mfuko wa Bima ya Afya ya Jamii (SHIF) iko sawa. Ili kuboresha matibabu na usimamizi wa saratani katika eneo hilo, Hospitali ya Mafunzo na Rufaa ya Jaramogi Oginga Odinga (JOTRH) ilianzisha mwezi Machi mwaka huu kituo kipya kinachoitwa JOTRH Victoria Annex.

Huduma ya Misitu ya Kenya Kenya Forest Service imeongeza juhudi za kurejesha misitu iliyoharibiwa katika Kaunti ya Homa Bay Homa Bay County huku changamoto zinazoongezeka zikichangiwa na mimea vamizi hasa Lantana camara.

Akizungumza wakati wa zoezi la upandaji miti la "Back to School with a Seedling" katika Shule ya Msingi ya Lake Lake Primary School mjini Homa Bay, Msimamizi wa Misitu wa Kaunti Sharon Cheluget alisema mimea vamizi inaendelea kutishia vituo kadhaa vya misitu katika kaunti hiyo.

Kwa mujibu wa Cheluget, misitu iliyoathirika zaidi ni vituo vya misitu vya Wire, Koderi na Homa Hills, ambako shughuli haramu kama ukataji miti na ucho-maji mkaa zimeendelea kudhoofisha juhudi za uhifadhi. Afisa Mkuu wa Misitu Kaunti ya Homa Bay, Sharon Cheluget, Kamishna Eli Kisulu, Balozi wa Miti na Nuhu Omollo Masoud, Mlezi, chamacha Panda miti kwa ajili ya Mazingira bora wakati wa shughuli ya upandaji miti katika Shule ya Msingi ya Ziwa katika mji wa Homa Bay.

Tutaendelea kuwashirikisha wadau ili kusaidia kusafisha maeneo yaliyoathirika," aliongeza.

Alisema KFS imeingilia kati kusaidia juhudi za urejeshaji kupitia uzalishaji wa miche, uanzishaji wa vitalu vya miti na kutoa mwongozo wa kitaalamu.
