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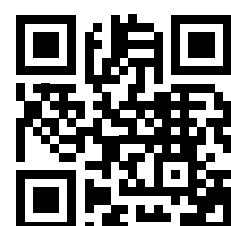

NA ERASTUS GICHOHI (KNA)
Kaunti tano za maeneo kame na nusu kame (ASAL) zinatarajiwa kunufaika na mradi wa maji ya chini ya ardhi wenye thamani ya Sh bilioni 13.5 unaolenga kukabiliana na uhaba sugu wa maji.

Serikali imeanza kutekeleza Mradi wa Uhimilivu wa Maji ya Chini ya Ardhi katika kaunti za Turkana, Mandera, Wajir, Marsabit na Garissa. Mradi huo, unao-fadhiliwa na Serikali ya Kitaifa kwa ushirikiano na Benki ya Dunia, unatarajiwa kutoa suluhu ya muda mrefu katika maeneo yanayokumbwa na ukame mara

kwa mara, ambapo vipindi vya ukame vimeharibu maisha ya wananchi kwa miongo kadhaa. Kwa miaka mingi, kaunti hizi zimekumbwa na ukame wa muda mrefu uliosababisha hasara kubwa ya mifugo, vifo vya wanyamapori na kuangamia kwa vyanzo vya riziki vya jamii. Mradi huo ukikamilika, utatoa

chanzo cha maji cha uhakika na endelevu, kuunda fursa mpya za kiuchumi na kuimarisha uwezo wa jamii zilizoathirika kusta-himili changamoto za mabadiliko ya tabianchi na ukame. Waziri wa Maji, Usafi wa Maz-ingira na Umwagiliaji, Mhandisi Eric Muuga, alitangaza mradi huo wakati wa ufunguzi wa Kongamano la Maji Yasiyolipiwa (Non-Revenue Water Conference) mjini Naivasha. Alieleza wasiwasi wake kuhusu ongezeko la upotevu wa maji yaliyoti-biwa, akibainisha kuwa watoa huduma hupoteza karibu nusu ya maji hayo kutokana na uvujaji, uharibifu wa miundombinu na miundombinu chakavu. “Mapato yanayopotea kutokana na maji yasiyolipiwa yame-ongezeka kutoka asilimia 44 hadi asilimia 48 katika kipindi cha mwaka mmoja uliopita, hali ambayo haiwezi kudumishwa,” alisema Mhandisi Muuga. Aliwataka watoa huduma za maji kutumia mifumo ya mita za kisasa (smart meters) ili kupunguza uvujaji wa maji na kuboresha ufanisi wa shughuli zao, akionya kuwa hasara hizo zinaigharimu sekta hiyo zaidi ya Sh bilioni 15 kila mwaka.

Aliongeza kuwa mifumo ya kisasa ya utozaji bili na ufuatiliaji ulioboreshwa itaongeza kwa kiasi kikubwa ukusanyaji wa mapato na utoaji wa huduma. Pia alibainisha kuwa Sheria ya Maji ya mwaka 2024 imefungua fursa mpya za ushirikiano kati ya sekta ya umma na sekta binafsi unao-lenga kupanua upatikanaji wa maji na kuimarisha ustahimilivu dhidi ya mabadiliko ya tabianchi. Katibu wa Wizara ya Maji na Usafi wa Mazingira, Julius Korir, aliunga mkono kauli hizo, akitaja uvujaji wa maji, uharibifu wa miun-dombinu na uchakavu wa mifumo kama sababu kuu za hasara hizo. Pia alieleza kuwa gharama kubwa za umeme ni mzigo kwa watoa huduma, akiwahimiza kutumia mifumo mseto ya nishati ili kupunguza gharama na kuongeza miunganisho ya huduma za maji. Korir alisema serikali itaanzisha malengo yanayotegemea utendaji kazi ili kuboresha uwajibikaji na ufanisi katika sekta hiyo. Mwakilishi wa Baraza la Maga-vana na Gavana wa Kaunti ya Laikipia, Joshua Irungu, alisema karibu nusu ya maji yaliyoti-biwa hayazalishi mapato, jambo lin-alowagharimu watoa huduma mabilioni ya shilingi kila mwaka.

Chai ya Zambarau (Purple Tea) ya kipekee kutoka Kenya imezinduliwa rasmi katika soko la kimataifa kwenye Hoteli ya Crillon jijini Paris, Ufaransa, katika hafla iliyotajwa kuwa hatua muhimu katika juhudi za nchi kuondoka kwenye utegemezi wa kuuza mazao ghafi na kuingia katika masoko ya bidhaa za thamani ya juu duniani. Watumiaji wa Ufaransa, wataalamu wa chai na wadau wa sekta hiyo walipata fursa ya kuonja chai hiyo adimu inayolimwa kwenye miteremko ya volkeno ya Kaunti ya Murang'a, wakisifu harufu yake ya maua, ladha ya matunda na kiwango chake kikubwa cha vioksidishaji (antioxidants). "Huu ni mwanzo wa kuibadilisha chai kutoka kuwa zao la kawaida la biashara hadi kuwa bidhaa ya hadhi ya juu," alisema Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa Equity Group, Dkt. James Mwangi. "Kuingia katika soko la bidhaa za thamani ya juu kuna uwezo wa kuboresha maisha ya wananchi, kupanua upatikanaji wa elimu na huduma za afya, na kuwezesha uwekezaji wenye manufaa katika ngazi ya kaya." Mwenyekiti wa Equity Group Holdings, Profesa Isaac Macharia, alisisitiza umuhimu wa ushirikiano katika kufanikisha mpango huo. "Uzinduzi huu unaonyesha kile kinachowezekana pale wakulima, washirika wa sekta, taasisi za kifedha na masoko ya kimataifa wanapofanya kazi pamoja kwa maono ya pamoja," alisema. "Kwa kuiweka chai maalumu ya Kenya katika masoko ya kimataifa ya hadhi ya juu, hatuungezi tu thamani ya mazao yetu ya kilimo bali pia tunaunda fursa endelevu za kiuchumi zinazoweza kubadilisha maisha ya jamii za vijijini," alisema Prof. Macharia. Katika Mkutano wa G7 uliofa-nyika Évian, wapishi kutoka Ikulu ya Élysée walitengeneza chokoleti nyeusi iliyochanganywa na chai ya Grand Cru kutoka Kenya, wakionyesha jinsi bidhaa hiyo inaweza kubadilishwa kuwa bidhaa za thamani ya juu zinazolenga walaji wa kimataifa wenye mahitaji maalumu.

Mpango huo ulizinduliwa rasmi na Katibu Mkuu wa Idara ya Petroli, Kello Harsama, pamoja na Katibu Mkuu wa Idara ya Nishati, Alex Wachira, ambao walisema

kuwa ni sehemu ya mkakati wa serikali wa kupunguza utegemezi wa kuni na kuharakisha mpito kuelekea matumizi ya nishati safi na nafuu majumbani. Wakizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi huo, makatibu hao wakuu walisema kuwa kundeleva kutegemea kuni kumelewa kuwa chanzo cha ukataji miti na uharibifu wa mazingira, hivyo kufanya matumizi ya nishati safi ya kupikia kuwa muhimu katika kufanikisha malengo ya nchi ya uhifadhi wa misitu.

Alisema Ol Kalou imetengewa Shilingi milioni 260 kwa ajili ya kutekeleza miradi 36 ya umeme, huku takriban kaya 2,600 zikitarajiwa kuunganishwa na gridi ya taifa kufikia Desemba mwaka huu.

na nishati za jadi za kupikia. Alieleza kuwa kaya nyingi za vijijini bado zinategemea kuni na mkaa, hali inayowaweka wanawake na watoto katika hatari ya magonjwa ya mfumo wa upumuaji yanayosababishwa na kuvuta moshi kwa muda mrefu. Katibu Mkuu huyo wa Idara ya Petroli pia aliwataka wakazi kuunga mkono mipango ya maeendeleo ya serikali, akisema kuwa ushiriki wa wananchi ni muhimu katika kuharakisha utoaji wa huduma na kuboresha maisha yao. Kuhusu upatikanaji wa umeme, Katibu wa Idara ya Nishati, Alex Wachira, alitangaza kuwa serikali imetenga Shilingi bilioni 1.6 kwa miradi ya kuunganisha umeme katika eneo kubwa la Nyandarua. Alisema kuwa Eneo Bunge la Ol Kalou limetengewa Shilingi milioni 260 kwa utekelezaji wa miradi 36 ya umeme, huku takriban kaya 2,600 zikitarajiwa kuunganishwa na gridi ya taifa kufikia Desemba mwaka huu. Wachira alisema uwekezaji katika umeme na nishati safi ya kupikia unakamilishana kwa kupanua upatikanaji wa huduma za kisasa za nishati huku ukichangia usimamizi endelevu wa mazingira. Mshauri Mkuu wa Rais wa Masuala ya Uchumi, Moses Kuria, alisema mpango huo wa usambazaji wa gesi ya LPG utafaidi kaya katika kila wadi ya Eneo Bunge la Ol Kalou. Alisema wakazi walikuwa wameomba gesi ya kupikia ya bei nafuu kwa miaka mingi na akaeleza imani yake kuwa mpango huo utapunguza kwa kiasi kikubwa utegemezi wa kuni, kudhibiti ukataji miti ovyo na kuchangia uhifadhi wa misitu.

(AI-powered Clinical Decision Support System - cDSS), kwa mujibu wa Mkurugenzi wa Hospitali ya Rufaa na Mafunzo ya Kaunti ya Nakuru (NCRTH), Dkt. Santosh Devaraj, unatarajiwa kuwasaidia wahudumu wa afya kutoa huduma sahihi zaidi, kwa wakati unaofaa na zinazoringatia ushahidi wa kitaalamu. Dkt. Devaraj alieleza kuwa cDSS ni zana ya kidijitali iliyoungwa kuboresha maamuzi ya kitabibu na matokeo ya wagonjwa katika usimamizi wa magonjwa yasiyoambukiza. “Zana hii imeundwa kuwapatia madaktari marejeleo ya kitabibu ya papo kwa papo

yanayotegemea ushahidi wa kisayansi na yanayolingana na miongozo ya matibabu ya Wizara ya Afya, kwa lengo la kusaidia maamuzi ya kitabibu yenye uthabiti zaidi wakati wa kuhudumia wagonjwa,” alieleza. Mkurugenzi huyo aliongeza kuwa, “Mfumo huu umekusudiwa kusaidia na kukamilisha, wala si kuchukua nafasi ya, uamuzi wa kitaalamu wa wahudumu wa afya. Teknolojia inapaswa kutumika kama mwongozo na chombo cha usaidizi kwa madaktari, huku maamuzi ya mwisho yakibaki mikononi mwa wataalamu wa afya waliohitimu.”

KECOBO SUSPENDS KAMP COPYRIGHT AND RELATED RIGHTS LIMITED's OPERATING LICENCE FOR 90 DAYS BEGINNING JULY 1, 2026

The Kenya Copyright Board (KECOBO) is a State Corporation established under Section 3 of the Copyright Act, 2001 (Revised 2022) and mandated under section 5 of the Copyright Act 2001 (Revised 2022) to license regulate and supervise the activities of collective management organizations (CMOs).

In exercise of its statutory powers, KECOBO Board of Directors resolved to suspend the operating license issued to KAMP Copyright and Related Rights Limited (KAMP) for a period of Ninety (90) Days, effective 1st July 2026.

In order to safeguard the interests of rights holders, during the period of suspension of KAMP's license, Performing and Audio-Visual Rights Society of Kenya (PAVRISK) shall collect royalties for and on behalf of the right ordinarily represented by KAMP within the sectors allocated to KAMP under the applicable licensing framework.

All monies collected in respect of such right shall be deposited into a separate designated bank account, maintained independently from PAVRISK's operational and distributable funds.

The monies so collected shall be held in trust and shall not be distributed, transferred, applied or otherwise utilized for any purpose unless and until KECOBO issues further written directions regarding their management and distribution.

Alisema mpango huo unalenga kuoanisha mafunzo ya ufundi na mahitaji ya soko la ajira kwa kuhakikisha sekta za viwanda zinashiriki katika uandaaji wa mitaala chini ya mfumo wa Competency-Based Education and Training (CBET).

Mwalimu wa ujenzi na msemaji wa Kituo cha Mafunzo ya Ufundi cha Kisauni, Zablon Randu Nzai, alisema taasisi hiyo inatoa kozi mbili zinazofadhiliwa na KBEST, ambazo ni Malazi na Utunzaji wa Wageni pamoja na Utengenezaji wa Keki na Uokaji, kwa wanafunzi 30 kwa ada iliyopunguzwa ya Sh5,000.

Alisema ada hiyo inaweza kulipwa kwa awamu tatu za Sh2,500, Sh1,500 na Sh1,000, ikilinganishwa na ada ya kawaida ya Sh36,000 baada ya nafasi zinazofadhiliwa kujazwa.

To avoid any penalties, all candidates should confirm the order and correctness of spelling of their names as they should appear on their certificates from **Monday, 27th July 2026**. This confirmation will be done through filling in the relevant form which is maintained in the respective Schools. After this, any changes to the details in the certificate requested after graduation will attract a fee of **KShs. 3,000 (Kenya shillings three thousand)**.

(iii) Rehearsal

Graduands wishing to participate in the ceremony **MUST** attend in person the rehearsals at the **Graduation Square on Thursday, 13th August 2026 at 10.00 a.m.** Graduands attending the rehearsal must be seated by the stated hour and be in complete graduation attire. (iv) Fees

Alisisitiza kuwa upangaji bora wa matumizi ya ardhi utalinda maeneo yaliyotengwa kwa ajili ya barabara, kuwakinga wakazi dhidi ya hatari za mazingira na kuhakikisha ukuaji endelevu wa mji. Mbali na uzalishaji wa viazi, gereza hilo pia linaendelea kilimo cha bustani za matunda na linaendelea kupanda miti ya matunda, miti tiba na miti ya asili kama sehemu ya mpango wake wa kuhifadhi mazingira unaotekelezwa siku ya pili ya kila mwezi. Programu hiyo ya marekebisho pia inatarajiwa kuwapa wafungwa ujuzi wa kisasa wa kilimo ambao watautumia kujipatia kipato baada ya kumaliza vifungo vyao. Afisa wa Programu wa JICA, Simon Kariuki, alisema shirika hilo linaisaidia Huduma ya Magereza ya Kenya kupitia uhamishaji wa ujuzi wa kiufundi katika uzalishaji wa mbegu za viazi. “Jukumu letu ni kuiunga mkono serikali kwa kujenga uwezo wa kiufundi ili maafisa wa magereza na wafungwa wapate maarifa na ujuzi unaohitajika kuzalisha mbegu bora za viazi. Ujuzi huu pia utawanufaisha wakulima watakaopata mbegu zilizoidhinishwa pamoja na mbinu bora za kilimo,” alisema. Mkurugenzi wa Mashamba katika Huduma ya Magereza ya Kenya, Patrick Kariri, alisema ujenzi wa uwezo unaendelea kuwa kiini cha programu hiyo. “Wafungwa wengi wanatoka katika jamii za wakulima. Kwa kuwafundisha teknolojia za kisasa za uzalishaji wa mbegu, wataweza kujitegemea na kujihusisha na kilimo cha kibiashara baada ya kurejea katika jamii,” alisema.

Ripoti hiyo ilionyesha kuwa Mahakama ilifikia kiwango cha asilimia 104 cha utatuzi wa kesi katika mwaka wa fedha wa 2024/2025, ikidhihirisha maendeleo makubwa katika usimamizi wa haki. Kulingana na ripoti hiyo, Mahakama ilitatua kesi 647,666 dhidi ya kesi mpya 621,525 zilizowasilishwa katika kipindi hicho. Utendakazi huo ulioborotishwa uliuhusishwa na kuimarishwa kwa usimamizi wa kesi, upanuzi wa Mahakama za Madai Madogo, kuongezeka kwa matumizi ya teknolojia ikiwemo mfumo wa uwasilishaji wa kesi kwa njia ya kielektroniki

(e-filing) na usikilizwaji wa kesi kwa njia ya mtandao, pamoja na utekelezaji endelevu wa mageuzi ya usimamizi wa utendakazi. Akizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi huo, Jaji Mkuu Koome alisema ripoti hiyo inaakisi miaka kumi ya mageuzi endelevu yaliyolenga kuibadilisha Mahakama kuwa taasisi yenye uwajibikaji zaidi, ufanisi mkubwa na inayoweka wananchi mbele.

“Hatupimi utendakazi kwa ajili ya kupima tu. Tunatumia ushahidi kuboresha maamuzi, kuimarisha uwajibikaji na kuhakikisha kila Mkenya anapata haki kwa wakati na yenye ubora,” alisema. Koome alibainisha kuwa ingawa Mahakama imepiga hatua kubwa katika kupunguza mlundikano wa kesi na kuboresha uzalishaji wa kazi, awamu inayofuata ya mageuzi itajikita katika kubore-

sha ubora wa haki, kukumbatia ubunifu na kuhakikisha mageuzi hayo yanatafsiriwa kuwa uzoefu bora kwa watumiaji wa huduma za mahakama. Alisema teknolojia, ikiwemo akili mnemba (AI), inapaswa kutumika kwa uwajibikaji ili kuongeza ufanisi huku ikilinda uhuru wa mahakama, usawa na imani ya umma katika usimamizi wa haki. Mwenyekiti anayemaliza muda

wake wa Kamati ya Usimamizi wa Haki, Jaji Agnes Murgor, alisema ripoti hiyo ni kielelezo cha miaka kumi ya mabadiliko ya kitaasisi yaliyochochewa na uwajibikaji, ubunifu na maboresho endelevu. Alisema tathmini hiyo ilifanywa katika vituo vyote vya mahakama na vitengo vya utawala na timu sita za tathmini, zikitoa tathmini huru kuhusu usimamizi wa kesi, uzalishaji wa kazi mahakamani, huduma za sajili, mifumo mbadala ya utatuzi wa migogoro na utendakazi wa taasisi kwa ujumla. “Mfumo wa PMMU ni zaidi ya chombo cha kupima utendakazi. Ni mfumo wa kimkakati wa Mahakama wa kuimarisha ufanisi wa taasisi, kukuza uwajibikaji na kuendeleza maboresho ya kudumu,” alisema. Murgor aliongeza kuwa matokeo ya tathmini hiyo yataongoza mipango ya baadaye, upangaji wa bajeti na maamuzi ya sera, huku yakibainisha maeneo yanayohitaji uwekezaji zaidi katika miundombinu, rasilimali watu na vifaa vya uendeshaji. Msajili Mkuu wa Mahakama, Winfridah Mokaya, alisema utekelezaji wenye mafanikio wa mfumo wa usimamizi wa utendakazi katika kipindi cha miaka kumi iliyopita umeboresha utoaji wa huduma.

Kilichoanza kama mradi mdogo wa ufugaji samaki kwenye mwambao wa Ziwa Victoria sasa kimekua na kuwa mmoja wa wazalishaji wakubwa wa samaki aina ya tilapia barani Afrika, huku Victory Farms ikilenga kufanikisha azma ya kuwapatia zaidi ya Waafrika bilioni mbili samaki wa bei nafuu na wanaozalishwa ndani ya bara hilo katika kipindi cha miaka kumi ijayo. Dira hiyo ilijadiliwa kwa kina wakati wa maa-dhimisho ya Siku ya 11 ya Waanzilishi wa kampuni



hiyo yaliyofanyika katika shamba lake kuu la samaki la Roo Beach, Suba South, ambapo viongozi wa kampuni,

1. Afisa Mtendaji Mkuu na mwanzilishi mwenza wa Victory Farms, Joe Rehmann, akihutubia wafanyakazi, wadau na wanajamii wakati wa sherehe za Siku ya Waanzilishi wa kampuni hiyo huko Sindio.
2. Uvunaji wa samaki kutoka kwenye vizimba katika eneo la Roo Beach, Sindio, Kaunti ya Homa Bay, ambapo Victory Farms inaendesha kituo chake kikuu cha ufugaji wa samaki. Picha na Sitna Omar, PICHANA SITNA OMAR,

wafanyakazi, wanajamii na wadau walitathmini mafanikio yaliyopatikana na kuweka

wazi mipango ya kuongeza uzalishaji, kuunda nafasi zaidi za ajira na kuimarisha usalama wa chakula barani Afrika. Afisa Mkuu wa Maendeleo wa Victory Farms, Caesar Asiyo, alisema mkakati wa muda mrefu wa kampuni hiyo unaenda zaidi ya Afrika Mashariki na unalenga kuongeza upatikanaji wa samaki wenye lishe bora kwa bei nafuu huku ukiboresha maisha ya wananchi kupitia ajira na maendeleo ya biashara za ndani.

“Tunatazama zaidi ya Afrika Mashariki, tukiwa na lengo la kulisha zaidi ya Waafrika bilioni mbili katika kipindi cha miaka kumi ijayo. Mafanikio yetu makubwa hayatakuwa tu katika idadi ya samaki tunaovuna, bali katika ajira tunazounda, familia tunazosaidia na jamii zinazokua pamoja nasi,” alisema.

Kwa sasa, Victory Farms inaajiri zaidi ya watu 1,000 moja kwa moja, jambo linaloifanya kuwa mmoja wa waajiri wakubwa zaidi wa sekta binafsi katika Kaunti ya Homa Bay. Maelfu ya watu wengine pia hujipatia riziki kupitia shughuli zinazohusiana na kampuni hiyo, ikiwemo biashara ya samaki, usafirishaji, utengenezaji wa chakula cha samaki, usambazaji wa pembejeo na usambazaji wa bidhaa za rejareja.

Mkurugenzi Mtendaji na mwanzilishi mwenza wa kampuni hiyo, Joe Rehmann, alisema kampuni imevuka malengo iliyojiwekea ilipoanza shughuli zake mwaka 2015 ikiwa na mabwawa yasiyozidi 10 na vizimba vichache vya kufugia samaki majini.

“Mahali tulipo leo ni shamba letu la kwanza na bado ndilo kubwa zaidi. Tulipoanza miaka 11 iliyopita, lengo letu lilikuwa kuzalisha tani 10,000 za samaki na kuajiri watu 500. Tulifikia malengo hayo miaka kadhaa

iliyopita. Leo tuna zaidi ya wafanyakazi 1,000, na hiyo ndiyo hatua yetu kubwa zaidi kwa upande wa rasilimali watu,” alisema.

Kwa mujibu wa Rehmann, uwekezaji endelevu kwa watu, teknolojia na ushirikiano mzuri na jamii zinazozunguka kampuni hiyo umeiwezesha kupanuka kwa kasi huku ikiendelea kudemisha uzalishaji thabiti.

“Ukuaji tulioupata umeweze kana tu kwa kuwekeza kwa watu na teknolojia. Pia tumepata msaada mkubwa kutoka kwa jamii yetu na wadau mbalimbali kwa sababu hakuna jambo kama hili linalowezekana bila ushirikiano,” aliongeza.

Uzalishaji wa kampuni hiyo umeendelea kuongezeka kwa kasi katika kipindi cha muongo mmoja uliopita. Kwa sasa, Victory Farms huuza wastani wa tani 1,400 za tilapia kila mwezi na hivi karibuni ilivuka kiwango chake cha kwanza cha mauzo ya zaidi ya tani 2,000 kwa mwezi katika shughuli zake nchini Kenya na Rwanda.

Kampuni hiyo inapanga kupanua shughuli zake nchini Tanzania mara tu itakapopata idhini zinazohitajika kutoka kwa mamlaka husika, na pia inajiandaa kuingia katika soko la Uganda kama sehemu ya mkakati wake wa ukuaji wa kikanda.

Licha ya upanuzi huo wa haraka, mahitaji ya samaki bado yanazidi kiwango cha uzalishaji kote Afrika Mashariki. Viongozi wa kampuni hiyo wanasema samaki ni miongoni mwa vyanzo bora zaidi vya protini ya wanyama vyenye bei nafuu, lakini uzalishaji haujaendana na kasi ya ukuaji wa idadi ya watu katika eneo hilo.

Madini David Onyonga alisisitiza kuwa ushirikishwaji wa umma ni hitaji la kikatiba linalolenga kuhakikisha wananchi wanapata nafasi ya kutoa maoni kuhusu sheria zinazogusa maisha na

shughuli zao za kiuchumi. “Katiba inatutaka kwamba kabla serikali haijatunga sheria, lazima tushauriane na wananchi ambao ndio wanufaika wakuu na watumiaji wa sheria hizo,”

Mjumbe wa Kamati ya Utendaji ya Kaunti ya Kirinyaga anayesimamia Nishati, Madini na Mazingira, James Kinyamutu, ambaye pia alikaribisha mashauriano hayo, alieleza zoezi hilo kuwa hatua muhimu katika kuhakikisha jamii zinanufaika na shughuli za uchimbaji madini katika maeneo yao. Miguel, mwakilishi wa Chama cha Ushirika cha Wachimbaji Madini Wadogo cha Mbeere, alisema kuwa tafsiri zilizopo za uchimbaji madini wa kiwango cha chini hazilingani tena na hali halisi ya sekta hiyo.

Mombasa yaongeza juhudi za urejelezaji kupitia mpango wa kutenganisha taka

NA SADIK HASSAN (KNA)

Shirika la Uwajibikaji wa Watengenezaji kwa Bidhaa Zao Baada ya Matumizi nchini Kenya (KEPRO), kwa ushirikiano na Serikali ya Kaunti ya Mombasa, limezindua mpango wa kutenganisha taka katika ngazi ya kaya unaolenga kaya 1,000 kote kaunti hiyo kama sehemu ya juhudi za kuhimiza usimamizi endelevu wa taka, kuimarisha urejelezaji na kuunda ajira za kijani. Mpango huo unaendeleza hatua ambazo tayari zimechukuliwa na serikali ya kaunti kukabiliana na changamoto inayoongezeka ya usimamizi wa taka katika jiji hilo la pwani. Mwaka jana, Gavana Abdulswamad Nassir alianzisha mpango wa majaribio ulioshirikisha mashirika ya kijamii yanayongozwa na vijana (CBOs) pamoja na waku-sanyaji binafsi wa taka ili kuboresha ufanisi, kupanua huduma za ukusanyaji wa taka na kuimarisha usafi kote Mombasa. Kaunti hiyo huzalisha zaidi ya tani 1,200 za taka ngumu kila siku. Hata hivyo, ni takribani asilimia 52 pekee ya taka hizo zinazokusanywa, huku karibu nusu zikibaki bila kukusanywa, hali inayosababisha hatari kubwa kwa mazingira na afya ya umma. Ili kuimarisha mazoea ya uwajibikaji katika usimamizi wa taka, KEPRO kwa kushirikiana na Idara ya

Mazingira ya Kaunti, iliendesha kampeni ya uhamasishaji wa watumiaji iliyowalenga wazalishaji, waokotaji taka, kaya na wakazi. Kampeni hiyo ililenga kuongeza uelewa kuhusu Kanuni za Uwajibikaji wa Mtengenezaji kwa Bidhaa Zake Baada ya Matumizi (EPR) na kuwahamasisha wadau katika mnyororo mzima wa thamani wa taka kukumbatia misingi ya

uchumi mzunguko inayohimiza upunguzaji wa taka, matumizi tena na urejelezaji. Kanuni za EPR, zilizochapishwa katika Gazeti Rasmi la Serikali mwezi Novemba 2024, zinapanua wajibu wa wazalishaji hadi katika mzungumu mzima wa maisha ya bidhaa na vifungashio vyao. Kanuni hizo zinatoa mfumo wa kuanzisha na kuendesha mipango ya lazima ya EPR huku zikitekeleza kanuni ya "mchafuzi hulipa". Mkurugenzi wa Bodi ya KEPRO, Elidy Wangeci, alisisitiza umuhimu wa kuondoka katika mfumo wa jadi wa usimamizi wa taka unaotegemea matumizi na utupaji wa bidhaa baada ya kutumika, na kuelekea katika uchumi mzunguko unaoweka kipaumbele katika

kupunguza taka, kutumia tena na kurejeleza. Alibainisha kuwa mojawapo ya vikwazo vikubwa katika kufanikisha uchumi mzunguko ni usimamizi duni wa taka katika ngazi ya kaya, hasa kutokana na kutotenganishwa kwa taka zinapotoka chanzo chake. Kwa mujibu wa Wangeci, wakazi wengi bado wanaona usimamizi wa taka kuwa jukumu la waku-sanyaji taka pekee, jambo linalofanya iwe vigumu kurejesha malighafi zinazoweza kurejelewa kwa ufanisi na kwa njia endelevu. "Tunalenga kuhakikisha tunawaeleza wananchi kwamba taka ni jukumu lao. Na kuna fursa nyingi katika sekta ya usimamizi wa taka," alisema Wangeci.

Aliongeza: "Kuna msemu maarufu unaosema taka ni pesa. Tunataka watu wafahamu hilo, watunze mazingira yao na kukumbatia uchumi mzunguko ili tuwe na uwajibikaji katika namna tunavyosimamia taka na jinsi zinavyorejelewa." Wangeci pia aliipongeza serikali kwa kujitolea kutekeleza Sheria ya Usimamizi Endelevu wa Taka ya mwaka 2022 pamoja na Kanuni za EPR, akisema mfumo huo wa sera unatoa mwongozo wazi wa usimamizi wa taka nchini. "Serikali imefanya kazi nzuri sana. Siwezi kusema kwamba imeshindwa katika utekelezaji kwa sababu kupitia kanuni hizi, imeweka mwongozo wa wazi kuhusu wajibu wa kila mmoja na kile kinachopaswa kufanywa," alisema. Afisa Mkuu wa Kaunti anayesimamia Mazingira na Usimamizi wa Taka Ngumu, Hamid Shehan, alisema lengo kuu la mpango huo ni kuwajengea wakazi hisia ya uwajibikaji binafsi katika usimamizi wa taka. "Tulichogundua ni kwamba kila mtu anajaribu kumtwika mwingine jukumu," alisema. Shehan alieleza kuwa serikali ya kaunti inaendelea kuwabadilisha waokotaji taka kutoka sekta isiyo rasmi kuwa wafanyakazi walio-pangwa na kurasimishwa zaidi, ambao watakuwa na nafasi muhimu katika ukusanyaji, utenganishaji na urejelezaji wa taka. Alibainisha kuwa moja ya changamoto kuu ni uhamasishaji wa umma kuhusu kutenganisha taka katika chanzo chake, kwani wakazi wengi wanaona tayari wanachangia usimamizi wa taka kwa kuzitupa katika maeneo ya kawaida ya ukusanyaji.

Serikali imeongeza kasi ya Sutekelezaji wa ajenda yake ya kitaifa ya miundombinu baada ya kulipa mabilioni ya shilingi yali-yokuwa yakidaiwa na wakandarasi wa barabara na kuzindua rasmi mradi wa kisasa wa uboreshaji wa Uwanja wa Ndege wa Kimataifa wa Jomo Kenyatta (JKIA). Maendeleo hayo yalibainika wakati wa kikao cha ngazi ya juu cha kupitia maendeleo ya miradi, kilichoongozwa na Naibu Rais Profesa Kithure Kindiki katika Harambee House Annex jijini Nairobi. Kikao hicho kilimleta pamoja Waziri wa Barabara na Uchukuzi Davis Chirchir na maafisa wakuu wa serikali ili

kutathmini hali ya miradi ya miundombinu kote nchini. Maafisa walipitia maendeleo ya miradi ya ujenzi wa barabara inayoendelea katika kaunti zote 47 na kupokea taarifa kuhusu hatua muhimu zilizofikiwa katika Mradi wa Uboreshaji wa JKIA wenye thamani ya Shilingi bilioni 155, ambao ulianza rasmi wiki hii. Naibu Rais alisema Serikali imelipa Shilingi bilioni 177 za madeni yaliyokuwa yakidaiwa na wakandarasi wa miradi ya barabara iliyokwama kati ya mwaka 2020 na 2021. ujenzi wa takriban kilomita 8,000 za barabara za lami kote nchini. Alielezea mradi wa uboreshaji wa uwanja wa ndege kuwa uwekezaji

mkubwa unaolenga kubadilisha lango kuu la usafiri wa anga nchini Kenya, kuboresha huduma kwa abiria na kuimarisha nafasi ya

nchi kama kitovu cha kikanda cha usafiri na usafirishaji wa mizigo. Kikao hicho pia kiliangazia mpango wa kuanzishwa kwa Mfuko wa Kitaifa wa Miundombinu (NIF), ambao Serikali imesema utatoa ufadhili endelevu kwa miradi ya miundombinu ya maji ambayo imecheleweshwa kwa muda mrefu. Mradi mkubwa wa miundombinu wenye thamani ya Shilingi bilioni 8.3 katika Bandari ya Mombasa, unaotarajiwa kuboresha kwa kiasi kikubwa usafirishaji wa mizigo, usalama na ufanisi wa shughuli katika bandari hiyo yenye shughuli nyingi zaidi nchini, unaendelea kutekelezwa hatua kwa hatua. Mradi huo ni sehemu muhimu ya mpango wa muda mrefu wa Mamlaka ya Bandari Kenya (KPA) wa kuboresha miundombinu, unaolenga kushughulikia ongezeko la mizigo huku ukimarisha muunganisho kati ya bandari, Lango la 18 na 20, Barabara ya Kipevu na Ukanda Mpana wa Kaskazini (Northern Corridor). Akizungumzia taarifa potofu kuhusu mradi huo na wasiwasi uliotolewa kuhusu thamani ya fedha zinazotumika, Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa KPA, Kapteni William Ruto, alisema maendeleo hayo yalitokana na mapendekezo ya Utafiti wa Usimamizi wa Trafiki uliofanywa mwaka 2018 na TradeMark Africa. Alisema utafiti huo ulibaini kuwa korido ya Back of Port Road ilikuwa kikwazo kikubwa cha usafirishaji wa mizigo na ilihitaji suluhisho la usafiri wa ngazi tofauti ili kuboresha utoaji wa mizigo kutoka bandarini na kuondoa migongano ya trafiki. Kapteni Ruto alifafanua kuwa mradi huo si wa kawaida wa ujenzi wa barabara, bali ni kituo kikubwa cha kubadilishia usafiri bandarini kinachohusisha kazi maalumu za uhandisi wa kiraia, miundo, jioteknolojia, umeme, mifereji ya maji na mifumo ya usalama. Mkurugenzi huyo alifichua kuwa mradi huo ulitangazwa kupitia zabuni ya kimataifa ambapo

wakandarasi waliwasilisha zabuni zenye thamani kati ya Shilingi bilioni 8.3 na Shilingi bilioni 9.6. Mkataba huo ulitolewa kwa ubia wa kampuni za M/s Stecol Corporation na Miliki Development Company kwa thamani ya Shilingi bilioni 9.6 baada ya kuibuka kama mzabuni aliyekidhi masharti yote na kutoa bei ya chini zaidi. “Bei hiyo iko ndani ya viwango vya soko, na hata naweza kusema ni nafuu. Kwa mujibu wa mshauri

wetu wa mradi, ni nafuu zaidi. KPA inapata thamani halisi ya fedha. Tatizo pekee ni kwamba tuliuita mradi wa barabara badala ya kuuia mradi mkubwa wa miundombinu tunaofunga bandarini,” alisema Kapteni Ruto. Mradi huo, ambao sasa umekamilika kwa asilimia 50, unatarajiwa kukamilika mwezi Machi 2027. Unajumuisha barabara ya njia mbili yenye urefu wa kilomita 1.8, ikiwemo mita 704 za njia ya juu

450,000

Mradi huo pia unahusisha uchimbaji katika Kilima cha Kipevu, hatua inayohitaji kukatwa kwa takriban mita za ujazo 450,000 za miamba

(viaduct) inayoungwa mkono na misingi ya nguzo zilizochimbwa ardhini na mihimili ya saruji iliyoimarishwa, ikiwa na urefu wa hadi mita 15 kutoka usawa wa ardhi ili kuruhusu usafiri salama wa mizigo mizito ya bandarini. “Viaduct ni tofauti na daraja la kawaida kwa kuwa ni muundo unaofanana na daraja lakini unaopita juu ya eneo kubwa la ardhi ambalo linaweza kuwa na miundombinu mingine chini yake,” alieleza mhandisi mshauri wa mradi, Eng. Stephen Wasike. “Kuna kiwango cha juu kinachoruhusiwa unapokaribia bomba la mafuta kwa sababu ni bomba linalotumika kusafirisha bidhaa za petroli, na hilo lilitulazimisha kuinua zaidi mradi huo. Pia tulilazimika kupita juu ya kituo cha KPA kinachojulikana kama One-Stop Centre, ambacho kina shughuli nyingi muhimu na hakiwezi kubomolewa. Hivyo tulijenga viaduct juu yake,” aliongeza Eng. Wasike. Mradi huo pia unahusisha ujenzi wa mizunguko miwili mikubwa ya barabara, njia za kuingilia na kutoka pamoja na miundombinu mingine ya usimamizi wa trafiki, na hivyo kuunda mfumo jumuiishi wa usafiri wa ngazi tofauti. Aidha, mradi huo unahusisha uchimbaji wa Kilima cha Kipevu, unaohitaji kuondolewa kwa takriban mita za ujazo 450,000 za miamba na kujaza mita za ujazo 150,000 za udongo ulioandaliwa kitaalamu. Ili kuimarisha mteremko uliokatwa na kulinda miundombinu muhimu iliyo karibu, mradi huo unajumuisha ujenzi wa ukuta wa kuzuia mmomonyoko wenye urefu wa mita 265 wa Geosynthetic Mechanically Stabilised Earth (GMSE), ulioundwa kuzuia maporomoko ya ardhi karibu na matangi ya kuhifadhi mafuta ya Kampuni ya Kenya Pipeline. yasiyo rasmi na kujifunza binafsi. RPL, ambayo ni mpango wa kitaifa unaoongozwa na Mamlaka ya Kitaifa ya Sifa za Elimu Kenya (KNQA) kwa ushirikiano na Idara ya Serikali ya TVET, huwasaidia wafanyakazi wa sekta isiyo rasmi—hasa wale

Pikipiki za umeme zaimarika waendeshaji wa pikipiki wakihama kutoka zile za petroli

Kelele ya kawaida ya pikipiki zinazotumia petroli inaendelea kutoweka taratibu katika mitaa ya Nyeri, ikibadilishwa na mlio wa chini wa pikipiki za umeme. Kadri bei za mafuta zinavyoendelea kupanda na Wakenya kutafuta njia mbadala za usafiri zilizo nafuu, pikipiki za umeme zinaibuka kama suluhisho la vitendo, zikitoa gharama nafuu za uendeshaji, gharama ndogo za matengenezo na mazingira safi zaidi. Mabadiliko kutoka kwa matumizi ya petroli kwenda kwenye umeme si mtindo tu bali pia ni hitaji muhimu. Pikipiki za umeme ni sehemu ya mabadiliko haya, zikiahidi kutokuwa na uzalishaji wa hewa chafu na kutoa njia bora na rafiki kwa

mazingira ya usafiri. Tofauti na pikipiki za kawaida zinazotegemea injini za mwako na kutoa gesi hatari, pikipiki za umeme hutumia betri za lithia-ion zinazoweza kuchajiwa tena na ambazo hazitoi moshi wa kutolea nje. Katika maeneo ya mijini ambako msongamano wa magari na uchafuzi wa mazingira umeongezeka, pikipiki za umeme zinaonekana kuwa mbadala safi na tulivu zaidi. Uwezo wake wa kupunguza uchafuzi wa mazingira katika maeneo yenye watu wengi umeifanya kuwa maarufu katika sehemu nyingi. Pikipiki nyingi za umeme zina nguvu ya papo kwa hapo (instant torque), jambo lina-lowezesha kuongeza mwendo kwa haraka na kwa urahisi bila kubadilisha gia. Hii huwapa waendeshaji uzoefu wa kipekee na wenye mwendaji wa haraka. Baadhi ya miundo ya kiwango cha juu hata inalingana na utendaji wa pikipiki za

kawaida, kwa kufikia kasi ya zaidi ya maili 100 kwa saa, hivyo kuwa chaguo bora kwa wanaotafuta nguvu pamoja na uendelevu wa mazingira. Aidha, kwa kuwa zina sehemu chache zinazohama, pikipiki za umeme zinahitaji matengenezo machache kuliko zile zinazotumia petroli.

Hakuna haja ya kubadilisha mafuta ya injini au kushughulikia matatizo magumu ya kiufundi yanayohusiana na injini, jambo linalozifanya kuwa rahisi na nafuu zaidi kutunza kwa muda mrefu. Kiini cha mabadiliko haya ni kampuni ya Zeno Motors Limited, ambayo imepanua shughuli zake kwa kasi katika Kaunti ya Nyeri tangu ilipoanza shughuli mwishoni mwa mwaka 2024. Kilichoanza na pikipiki tatu pekee za umeme sasa kimekua hadi kufikia meli ya pikipiki 120 zinazofanya kazi kote kauntini kufikia mwaka 2026, ishara wazi kwamba usafiri wa umeme unaendelea kukubalika kwa kasi. Kwa mujibu wa Kelvin Wamae, muuzaji wa Zeno Motors

mjini Nyeri, kampuni hiyo ilichochea na haja ya kutoa mbadala wa kiuchumi kwa pikipiki za kawaida zinazotumia petroli. “Msukumo ulitokana na manufaa ya kiuchumi ya pikipiki hizi za umeme kwa sababu bei ya mafuta imeendelea kupanda. Watu sasa wanakumbatia usafiri wa umeme kwa sababu unawasaidia kuokoa fedha,” alisema Wamae. Wateja wakuu wa kampuni hiyo ni waendeshaji wa pikipiki za kawaida wanaotaka kuhama kutoka kwa matumizi ya petroli. Wengi wao ni vijana wa kiume wenye umri wa kati ya miaka 25 na 35, ambao hutegemea pikipiki kama chanzo chao kikuu cha riziki za kila siku. Kwa waendeshaji hawa, kivutio kikubwa zaidi ni gharama nafuu. Tofauti na pikipiki za petroli zinazohitaji kujazwa mafuta mara kwa mara na matengenezo ya gharama kubwa, pikipiki za umeme hupunguza kwa kiasi kikubwa gharama za uendeshaji. Wamae anaeleza kuwa wanaendeshaji wanaweza kusafiri takriban kilomita 50 baada ya kutumia karibu Sh100 pekee kuchaji betri, jambo linalozifanya kuwa nafuu zaidi kwa safari ndefu.

Samurai's Sh 13.1b loan to upskill 15, 000 automotive technicians

About 15,000 technicians will be trained under the National Automotive Sector Development Project, under the State Department for Industry, to addresses industrial skills gaps and technological constraints.

Under the technical training and technology transfer component, the project that has benefitted from the Shs.13.1 Billion Samurai Loan Facility, will see benefiting Technical and Vocational Education and Training Institutions supported through curriculum updates and instructor capacity building.

In collaboration with Japanese automotive training institutions, the capacity building that targets youth and women will see a number gain skills through apprenticeships with Original Parts Manufacturers.

The fund is also expected to enhance capacity of the training institutions, and establishment of Research and Development laboratories focused on hybrid and clean technologies

The National Automotive Sector Development Project

Implementation Unit, led by Project Coordinator Paul Kinyanjui and Director for Industries Gideon Oele, sitting at Nakuru based Kenya Industrial Training Institute (KITI) noted that the funds management framework under development would form a guide to the funds administration.

The team, that has collaborated with the National Treasury, is also expected to develop the Operation Manuals for the project, that rolls out this financial year.

“The funds are meant for short courses and skill upgrading. The beneficiaries will also be assisted to undertake Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) certification tests and examinations,” added Mr. Oele.

KITI Director Eng. Simiyu Wabwire lauded the rollout of the funds, noting that the institution was strategically positioned to serve as a center of excellence in automotive innovations and studies.

“We need to encourage local manufacturing of parts to go into assembly. The Original Equipment Manufacturers also need to set base here in this country for us to feel the changes in

the automotive sectors as making of cars in Kenya is possible and is happening,” he noted.

President William Ruto has already assented to the Shs.22.1 billion deal with the Japanese Government, with the lion's share of Shs.13.1Billion being channeled for the revamping of the automotive sector.

The Sh 13.1 billion funding will support among others: expansion and modernization of vehicle assembly operations; development of local automotive parts manufacturing; financing for approved purchasers of locally assembled vehicles; support for dealers transitioning from imported used vehicles to locally assembled new vehicles; and growth of local supplier networks and value chains.

Industry Principal Secretary Dr. Juma Mukhwana, announced the rollout noting that “Kenya's automotive industry has recorded substantial growth over the last five years. Annual vehicle production has increased from approximately 7,000 units to over 20,000 units, while motorcycle production now exceeds 200,000 units annually.”

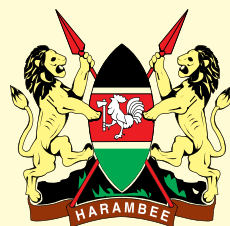

Akizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi wa Kituo cha Ununuzi wa Chai cha Cheptenybei katika Wadi ya Litein, Kaunti Ndogo ya Bureti, Gavana Dkt. Waziri wa Maji, Usafi wa Mazingira na Umwagiliaji, Mhandisi Eric Mugaa, alizindua rasmi mradi huo akiwa pamoja na Mbunge wa Yatta Robert Basil, Afisa Mkuu Mtendaji wa Wakala wa Maendeleo ya Maji wa Tanathi (Tanathi Water Works Development Agency) Sammy Naporos, pamoja na viongozi wengine wa kitaifa na kaunti. Mradi huo unatarajiwa kutoa maji safi, ya kuanika na huduma bora za usafi wa mazingira kwa takriban wakazi 60,000 katika maeneo ya Kitui,

Matuu, Wote, Kithimani, Sofia, Ndalani, Huduma ya Kitaifa kwa Vijana (NYS) na maeneo jirani. Aidha, utaimarisha kwa kiwango kikubwa usalama wa maji na kuboresha maisha ya wananchi. Akizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi huo, Mhandisi Mugaa alithibitisha upya dhamira ya Serikali ya kuwezesha katika miundombinu ya kimkakati ya maji ili kuhakikisha kila Mkenya anapata maji salama na ya gharama nafuu. Alisisitiza kuwa upatikanaji wa maji ya uhakika ni muhimu katika kuboresha afya ya umma, kusaidia shughuli za kilimo na biashara, na kuharakisha maendeleo ya kijamii na kiuchumi nchini.
