Serikali imezindua awamu ya usaidizi wa biashara chini ya mpango wa National Youth Opportunities Towards Advancement (NYOTA), na kutoa zaidi ya Shilingi bilioni 3 kwa zaidi ya vijana wajasiriamali 122,000 kote nchini. Kila mnufaika atapokea Shilingi 25,000, na kufanya jumla ya msaada chini ya mpango huo kufikia Shilingi 50,000 kwa kila kijana. “Mpango huu ni mojawapo ya uwekezaji mkubwa zaidi wa Kenya katika ujasiriamali wa vijana. Maelfu ya biashara ndogo kote nchini zimepokea msukumo wa kifedha unaohitajika ili kupanua

shughuli zao na kustawi,” alisema Rais William Ruto. “Hadithi za mafanikio zina-zovutia zinazojitokeza kutoka kila pembe ya nchi ni ushahidi tosha wa kile ambacho NYOTA inaweza kufanikisha. Wale waliodharau Shilingi 25,000 au Shilingi 50,000 wakisema ni kiasi kidogo kisichoweza kuleta mabadiliko wameonekana kuwa na makosa,” aliongeza. Rais alisema serikali ime-jitolea kuhakikisha kuwa vijana sio tu wanaanzisha biashara, bali pia wanazikuza na kuzifanya kuwa endelevu. “Nimeielekeza Wizara ya Ushirika na Maendeleo ya Biashara Ndogo, Ndogo na za Kati (MSME) kuanzisha mfumo wa kitaifa wa utambulisho wa NYOTA ambao utawawezesha wanufaika kupata huduma na motisha za serikali kwa urahisi,” alitangaza. Ili kuimarisha zaidi mpango huo, Rais Ruto alizielekeza taasisi za serikali za ufadhili—Hazina ya Maendeleo ya Biashara ya Vijana, Hazina ya Uwezo, Hazina ya Biashara ya Wanawake na Kenya Industrial Estates—kuanzisha bidhaa maalum ya ukuaji wa NYOTA. “Bidhaa hii itatoa ufadhili wa ziada kwa biashara ambazo tayari zimenufaika na NYOTA, na hivyo kuzisaidia kupanua shughuli zao na kufanikiwa,” alisema. Kiongozi huyo wa Taifa pia alizihimiza serikali za kaunti kupunguza mzigo kwa vijana wajasiriamali. “Nimeimba Baraza la Bajeti na Uchumi la Serikali Mbili pamoja na

Mamlaka ya Ushuru ya Kenya (KRA) ilikusanya rekodi ya Shilingi trilioni 2.844 katika ushuru na mapato ya wakala katika mwaka wa kifedha wa 2025/2026, ikiwa ni ukuaji mkubwa zaidi wa mapato katika miaka ya hivi karibuni huku sekta muhimu za uchumi zikichangia

Mamlaka ya Mapato ya Kenya (KRA) ilikusanya kiasi cha rekodi cha Shilingi trilioni 2.844 kutokana na kodi na mapato mwaka wa fedha wa 2025/2026.

ongezeko la mapato ya serikali. Katika taarifa iliyotolewa kwa vyombo vya habari, KRA ilisema makusanyo hayo yaliongezeka kwa Shilingi bilioni 272.95 kutoka Shilingi trilioni 2.572 zilizokusanywa katika mwaka wa kifedha uliotangulia. Hii ni sawa na kiwango cha ukuaji cha asilimia 10.6, ikilinganishwa na asilimia 6.8 kilichorekodiwa mwaka wa 2024/2025. Mamlaka hiyo ilihusisha utendakazi huo mzuri na ukuaji katika sekta za utengenezaji bidhaa, nishati, huduma za kifedha na bima, Teknolojia ya Habari na Mawasiliano (ICT), pamoja na biashara ya jumla na rejareja. Kwa pamoja, sekta hizi zilichangia asilimia 62 ya mapato yote na zinawakilisha asilimia 27.4 ya Pato la Taifa (GDP) la Kenya kwa thamani ya sasa. Sekta ya utengenezaji bidhaa ndiyo iliyochangia zaidi baada ya kuzalisha ushuru wa Shilingi bilioni 462, kutoka Shilingi bilioni 423 katika mwaka uliotangulia, ikiwa ni asilimia 16.2 ya makusanyo yote. Sekta ya nishati ilifuata kwa kuchangia Shilingi bilioni 445, hasa kutokana na ushuru wa forodha wa mafuta, huku huduma za kifedha na bima zikichangia Shilingi bilioni 320. Sekta ya ICT ilizalisha Shilingi

bilioni 248, huku biashara ya jumla na rejareja ikichangia Shilingi bilioni 288, na hivyo kujikita miongoni mwa walipa ushuru wakuu nchini. Licha ya utendakazi huo mzuri, KRA haikufikia lengo lake la mapato ya Hazina ya Taifa baada ya kukusanya Shilingi trilioni 2.568 dhidi ya lengo la Shilingi trilioni 2.698, na kufanikisha kiwango cha utendakazi cha asilimia 95.2. Mapato ya wakala yaliyokusanywa kwa niaba ya taasisi nyingine za serikali yaliongezeka kwa asilimia 11.2 hadi Shilingi bilioni 276.1, huku mapato ya forodha yakizidi lengo baada ya kukusanya Shilingi bilioni 988.8 dhidi ya lengo la Shilingi bilioni 980.8, sawa na kiwango cha utendakazi cha asilimia 100.8. Mapato ya ndani yaliongezeka kwa asilimia 9.7 hadi Shilingi trilioni 1.851 lakini yakabaki chini ya lengo la Shilingi trilioni 1.991. Miongoni mwa aina kuu za ushuru, makusanyo ya Pay As You Earn (PAYE) yaliongezeka kwa asilimia 6.7 hadi Shilingi bilioni 598.8. Hata hivyo, KRA ilieleza kuwa kasi ya ukuaji ilipunguzwa na kupungua kwa ajira katika sekta rasmi, ambayo mchango wake kwa jumla ya ajira ulipungua hadi asilimia 15.3 mwaka 2025 kutoka asilimia 15.7 mwaka 2022.

Serikali ya Kitaifa imetan-gaza nyongeza ya mishahara kwa watumishi wa umma kote nchini kuanzia mwezi huu wa Julai, huku Waziri wa Utumishi wa Umma, Maendeleo ya Rasilimali Watu na Programu Maalum, Geoffrey Ruku, akisema kuwa marekebisho hayo yatawanufaisha watumishi halali pekee walio kwenye orodha ya mishahara ya serikali. Waziri huyo alisema kuwa nyongeza hiyo ya mishahara itatolewa tu kwa watumishi wa umma waliotibitishwa huku serikali ikiendelea kutekeleza Mfumo wa Kati wa Usimamizi wa Rasilimali Watu (Human Resource System - HRS) usioweza kuchezeza, unaolenga kuondoa wafanyakazi hewa na kuziba mianya katika mfumo wa mishahara. Ruku alieleza kuwa Mfumo huo wa Kati wa Usimamizi wa Rasilimali Watu utaimarisha uadilifu wa mishahara katika wizara, idara za serikali, mashirika ya umma na taasisi nyingine za serikali kwa kuimarisha uthibitishaji wa wafanyakazi, kukuza uwajibikaji na kuondoa udanganyifu katika mfumo wa mishahara. Akizungumza wakati wa Siku ya Tuzo na Taaluma ya Eneo Bunge la Kipkelion Mashariki katika



Waziri wa Utumishi wa Umma Geoffrey Ruku na Mbunge wa Kipkelion Mashariki Joseph Cherorot wanashirikiana na wafanyakazi pamoja na wakazi wa eneo hilo katika hafla ya kuweka jiwe la msingi la Kituo cha ICT cha Londiani; mradi unaolenga kupanua miundombinu ya kidijitali na kuunda fursa za uvumbuzi kwa vijana katika Kaunti ya Kericho.

Shule ya Upili ya Londiani Boys, Kaunti ya Kericho, Ruku alisema mageuzi hayo yanafuatia ukaguzi wa mfumo wa mishahara wa serikali uliobaini kasoro nyingi, zikiwemo malipo haramu ya mishahara, rekodi za wafanyakazi zilizorudiwa na udhaifu katika mifumo iliyokuwepo ya usimamizi wa mishahara ambayo iliruhusu wafanyakazi hewa kubaki kwenye orodha ya mishahara ya serikali. “Nyongeza ya mishahara ya mwezi huu wa Julai itawanufaisha watumishi halali wa umma pekee. Wafanyakazi hewa hawana nafasi

katika mfumo wa mishahara wa serikali chini ya Mfumo wa Kati wa Usimamizi wa Rasilimali Watu,” alisisitiza Ruku. Alibainisha kuwa mageuzi hayo ni sehemu ya juhudi pana za serikali za kuboresha ufanisi katika utumishi wa umma na kuhakikisha matumizi sahihi ya fedha za walipa kodi. Ruku pia alitangaza kuwa serikali itajenga Kituo cha Huduma (Huduma Centre) katika Kaunti Ndogo ya Kipkelion Mashariki ili kusogeza huduma muhimu za serikali karibu na wananchi.

Kwa miaka mingi, wafugaji wa ng'ombe wa maziwa katika Kaunti ya Nandi walishuhudia kwa masikitiko maziwa yakiharibika kutokana na ukosefu wa vifaa vya kutosha vya kuhifadhi na masoko yasiyo ya kuaminika. Leo, hali hiyo inabadilika kutokana na kuanzishwa kwa Kiwanda cha Kusindika Maziwa cha Kabiye, ambacho ni kituo cha kisasa chenye uwezo wa kusindika zaidi ya lita 200,000 za maziwa kwa siku. Kiwanda hicho kilichopo katika Kaunti Ndogo ya Tin-

deret tayari kinabadilisha uchumi wa eneo hilo na kuboresha maisha ya maelfu ya wafugaji wadogo ambao kwa muda mrefu wamekuwa wakikabiliwa na hasara baada ya mavuno, mapato duni na ukosefu wa masoko ya uhakika. Mradi huo ni matokeo ya miaka ya mipango, uwekezaji na ushirikiano kati ya Serikali ya Kaunti ya Nandi, Benki ya Dunia na mashirika ya kitaifa, ikiwemo Mradi wa Kitaifa wa Maendeleo ya Mnyororo wa Thamani wa Kilimo (NAVCDP). Mbali na kutoa soko la uhakika kwa wafugaji, kiwanda hicho kinatarajiwa kuchechea ukuaji wa uchumi, kuunda ajira na kuimarisha mnyororo wa thamani wa sekta ya maziwa katika eneo hilo.



Kiwanda cha kusindika maziwa cha Kabiye katika Kaunti Ndogo ya Tinderet, Kaunti ya Nandi. Kiwanda hiki kina uwezo wa kusindika lita 200,000 kwa siku.

Serikali imewaelekeza watumishi wote wa Umma kusasisha taarifa zao katika Mfuko wa Pensheni wa Watumishi wa Umma (PSSF) kabla ya Agosti 14, 2026, ikiwa ni hatua ya hivi karibuni katika juhudi za kuboresha usimamizi wa pensheni na utoaji wa huduma katika sekta ya umma. Maelekezo hayo yamo katika waraka uliotiwa saini na Katibu Mkuu wa Idara ya Utumishi wa Umma na Maendeleo ya Rasilimali Watu, Dkt. Jane Kere Imbunya, na kuelekezwa kwa Wizara, Idara za Serikali, Tume za Kikatiba, Ofisi Huru, Bodi za Utumishi wa Umma za Kaunti na Serikali za Kaunti. Waraka huo unawataka wanachama wote wa PSSF kusasisha taarifa zao binafsi pamoja na maelezo ya wanufaika wao kupitia Tovuti ya Huduma Binafsi ya Wanachama wa PSSF au programu ya simu ya PSSF. Kama sehemu ya zoezi hilo, wanachama wanatakiwa

kuingia katika Tovuti ya Huduma Binafsi ya Wanachama wa PSSF na kujaza fomu ya usajili pamoja na fomu ya uteuzi wa wanufaika kabla ya tarehe ya mwisho iliyowekwa. Hatua hiyo imekuja siku chache baada ya Tume ya Huduma kwa Walimu (TSC) kutoa maelekezo kama hayo, jambo linaloashiria juhudi za pamoja za Serikali kuhakikisha watumishi wa umma wanadumisha taarifa sahihi na zilizosasishwa za pensheni kama sehemu ya mpango unaoendelea wa kisasa wa usimamizi wa pensheni nchini. Zoezi hilo la usajili linatarajiwa kurahisisha usimamizi wa pensheni na kuhararisha uchakataji wa mafao ya kustaafu kupitia Mfumo mpya wa Usimamizi wa Pensheni (PAS), jukwaa la kidijitali lililobuniwa na PSSF ili kutoa huduma za pensheni kwa haraka zaidi, kwa uwazi zaidi na kwa ufanisi mkubwa. Zoezi hilo linawalenga wanachama 529,635 kutoka sehemu mbalimbali za utumishi wa umma, wakiwemo walimu

332,950 chini ya Tume ya Huduma kwa Walimu (TSC), maafisa 120,084 wa huduma za nidhamu, wafanyakazi 60,322 wa Wizara, Idara, Tume za Kikatiba na Mashirika ya Serikali (MDCAs), pamoja na wafanyakazi 16,279 wa serikali za kaunti. A Akili Unde (AI) si teknolojia inayoibuka tena. Kwa kasi kubwa, imekuwa sehemu muhimu ya miundombinu ambayo mataifa hutumia kutoa huduma za afya, kuboresha kilimo, kuelimisha wananchi, kuzalisha bidhaa viwandani, kusimamia huduma za umma na kuhindana katika uchumi wa dunia. Kenya tayari inaanza kushuhudia mabadiliko hayo.

Katika ngazi ya kikanda, Afrika inakabiliwa na uamuzi muhimu wa kihistoria: kubaki watumiaji wa algoriti, majukwaa na mifumo ya kidijitali iliyobuniwa kwingineko, au kuwa wabunifu, wamiliki na wauzaji wa teknolojia zinazobuniwa barani humo. Miradi hiyo inatarajiwa kuimarisha usalama wa upatikanaji wa maji, kuongeza uwezo wa jamii kukabiliana na mabadiliko

ya tabianchi na kuhakikisha upatikanaji endelevu wa maji kwa jamii ambazo zimekumbwa na uhaba wa muda mrefu kwa miaka mingi. Uzinduzi wa Mradi wa Usambazaji Maji wa Sheli umeleta matumaini mapya kwa wakazi wa eneo hilo, ukiashiria mwanzo wa suluhisho lililosubiriwa kwa muda mrefu la changamoto za maji zinazozikabili vijiji hivyo. Mradi huo unahusisha ujenzi

wa bomba la kilomita nne litakalounganisha Kisima cha Konkona na Kijiji cha Sheli, ujenzi wa mtandao mpana wa usambazaji maji pamoja na uwekaji wa vituo viwili vya kuuza maji na maeneo ya pamoja ya kuchotea maji. Akizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi rasmi wa Ripoti ya Kamati ya Utatuzi wa Migogoro ya Kabla ya Uchaguzi (DRC) wa mwaka 2022 pamoja na Muhtasari wa Kesi (Case Digest) jijini Nairobi, Naibu Jaji Mkuu Philomena Mwilu alisema uimara wa demokrasia unategemea mifumo madhubuti ya ukaguzi na uwiano wa mamlaka hata kabla ya siku ya kupiga kura. “Demokrasia haiendelezwi kwa kupiga kura pekee,” alisema Jaji Mwilu. “Inaendelezwa na imani ya wananchi kwamba kila hatua ya mchakato wa uchaguzi inasi-

mamiwa kwa mujibu wa sheria, inaendeshwa kwa haki, na inafanywa mapitio yasiyo na upendeleo pale migogoro inapojitokeza.” Akikumbusha matokeo muhimu ya kesi ya kupinga uchaguzi wa urais wa mwaka 2017, Naibu Jaji Mkuu alisisitiza kuwa uaminifu wa uchaguzi unapaswa kutathminiwa kwa mtazamo mpana. “Hatimaye, uchaguzi lazima uwe kielelezo halisi cha matakwa ya wananchi kama inavyoelekezwa na Katiba kupitia misingi yake ya uwazi, uaminifu, uthibitishwaji, uwajibikaji, usahihi na ufanisi,” alisema. Akihutubia makamishna wapya wa uchaguzi, Mwilu alitaka IEBC kufikia viwango vya juu vya utendaji katika maandalizi ya uchaguzi mkuu ujao. “Maombi yangu kwenu ni haya: mfanye kazi kwa usahihi mkubwa mnamo 2027 kiasi kwamba kusiwe na kesi yoyote ya kupinga uchaguzi wa urais,” aliwahimiza. Kwa upande wake, Mwenyekiti wa IEBC Erastus Etheke alisema

Kitui na hata sehemu za Machakos wanufaike kiuchumi na kijamii,” alisema Mkuu wa Taifa. Tangazo hilo, lililoungwa mkono na Benki ya Maendeleo ya Afrika (AfDB), linaashiria hatua muhimu katika utekelezaji wa mradi huo. Wizara ya Maji, Usafi wa Mazingira na Umwagiliaji, kwa ushirikiano na AfDB, inatekeleza Awamu ya Kwanza ya Mpango wa Maendeleo ya Maji wa Matumizi Mengi wa Thwake kama mojawapo ya miradi kinara ya Dira ya Kenya 2030. 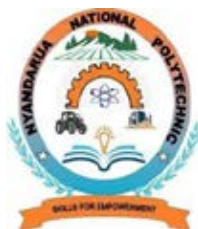

Kenya yazindua mfumo wa kidijitali wa kufuatilia mifugo kufungua milango ya masoko ya kimataifa

Kenya inalenga kuwafunga wafugaji wake fursa za masoko ya kimataifa yenye faida kubwa kupitia uzinduzi wa Mfumo wa Utambuzi na Ufuatiliaji wa Mifugo (ANITRAC), jukwaa la kidijitali na programu ya simu iliyobuniwa na serikali kwa ajili ya kusajili na kufuatilia mifugo kwa kutumia hereni za kielektroniki za RFID. Mfumo huo unageza mifugo kuwa mali inayoweza kuthibitishwa kwa urahisi na kutumika kama dhamana ya kupata mikopo na huduma nyingine za kifedha. Mfumo hutumia hereni mbili maalum; hereni ya kawaida

zaidi kwa kutimiza matakwa ya kimataifa kuhusu ufuatiliaji wa bidhaa,” alisema Kagwe. Waziri huyo alibainisha kuwa masoko ya kimataifa yana zidi kuhitaji bidhaa za mifugo zinazoweza kufuatiliwa kwa urahisi, ikiwemo taarifa kuhusu asili yake, historia ya chanjo zilizotolewa na rekodi za matibabu ya magonjwa, ili kuhakikisha usalama na uwazi katika mnyororo mzima wa usambazaji. Mpango unaoungwa mkono na serikali wafufua sekta ya kahawa ya Vihiga iliyokuwa ikiyumba

Kwa miongo kadhaa, kahawa ilikuwa fahari ya familia nyingi katika Kaunti ya Vihiga. Mapato yaliyotokana na zao hilo yaligharamia ada za shule, kujenga nyumba na kuendesha maisha ya familia nyingi, na hivyo kulifanya kuwa mojawapo ya vyanzo vya uhakika vya riziki katika eneo hilo. Hata hivyo, bei za kahawa katika soko la dunia zili-poporomoka katika miaka ya 1990 na mwanzoni mwa miaka ya 2000, maelfu ya wakulima walikata miti yao ya kahawa au kuacha mashamba yao kabisa, wakiambiwa kuwa zao hilo halikuwa tena na faida ya kiuchumi. Leo, simulizi hilo lina-badilika. Katika maeneo mbalimbali ya kaunti hiyo, miche mipya ya kahawa inachukua nafasi ya mashamba yaliyotelekezwa, vyama vya ushirika vinapata wanachama wapya, na wakulima wanaanza tena kuona kahawa kama njia ya uhakika ya kufikia ustawi wa kiuchumi. Mabadiliko hayo yanasukumwa na Mpango wa Kitaifa wa Kufufua Sekta ya Kahawa, ushirikiano unaohusisha serikali ya kitaifa, Serikali ya Kaunti ya Vihiga, Muungano Mpya wa Vyama vya Ushirika vya Wakulima wa Kahawa Kenya (New KPCU), Taasisi ya Utafiti wa Kahawa (CRI) na vyama vya ushirika vya eneo

hilo. Mpango huo unalenga kurejesha uzalishaji wa kahawa kupitia usambazaji wa miche iliyothibitishwa, mafunzo kwa wakulima, huduma bora za ugani na kuboresha upatikanaji wa masoko. Akizungumza katika kongamano la Mpango wa Kufufua Sekta ya Kahawa mjini Vihiga, Gavana Dkt. Wilber Ottichilo alisisitiza kujitolea kwa serikali ya kaunti kurejesha kilimo cha kahawa kama shughuli muhimu ya kiuchumi. “Wakulima wetu wanastahili kuwa na zao lenye faida. Tutaendelea kusambaza miche iliyothibitishwa, kuimarisha vyama vya ushirika na kupanua huduma za ugani ili kila mkulima mwenye nia aweze kunufaika na mpango huu wa kufufua kahawa,” alisema gavana huyo. Kenya bado ni mojawapo ya wazalishaji wakuu duniani wa kahawa bora aina ya Arabica,



huku sekta hiyo ikitegemezwa na zaidi ya watu milioni sita moja kwa moja na kwa njia zisizo za moja kwa moja. Wakulima wadogo huzalisha karibu asilimia 70 ya kahawa nchini, maharagwe yanayojulikana kwa ubora wake wa hali ya juu na ladha ya kipekee. Ingawa Vihiga ilikuwa mojawapo ya maeneo muhimu ya uzalishaji wa kahawa hapo awali, kushuka kwa bei, magonjwa ya mazao, mabadiliko ya tabianchi na changamoto za kifedha kulisababisha wakulima wengi kuachana na zao hilo. Hata hivyo, msaada mpya kutoka serikalini na kuongezeka kwa bei za kahawa kwa mkulima sasa kunabadilisha hali hiyo. Katika Chama cha Wakulima wa Kahawa cha Wamondo Coffee Growers Society Limited kilichoanzishwa mwaka 1955, dalili za kuimarika kwa sekta hiyo zinaonekana wazi.

Mwenyekiti wa chama hicho, Gibson Atsiaya, anasema ushirika huo unaendelea kujijenga upya baada ya miaka mingi ya kupungua kwa uzalishaji na wana-chama. “Wakulima wengi walitekeza kahawa wakati bei zilishuka na uzalishaji ukawa mgumu. Leo kahawa imekuwa na faida tena, na tunawahimiza wakulima kurejea kwenye zao hili,” alisema. Ili kuhakikisha uwazi, Atsiaya alieleza kuwa wana-chama wapya hulipa ada ya usajili ya Sh500 na kununua hisa za thamani ya Sh1,500, huku malipo yote yakiwekwa moja kwa moja katika Benki ya Ushirika kupitia nambari rasmi ya Pay Bill. Alikanusha madai kuwa fedha hizo hutumika kununua miche ya kahawa, akieleza kuwa miche iliyothibitishwa hutolewa bure kupitia mipango ya serikali na New KPCU kabla ya kusambazwa kwa wakulima waliosajiliwa. Mbali na kusambaza miche, chama hicho huwapatia wakulima mafunzo kuhusu maandalizi ya mashamba, matumizi ya samadi, mbinu sahihi za upandaji, usimamizi wa mazao na utunzaji wa kahawa baada ya kuvunwa. Wakulima pia hupata fursa ya kutembelea maeneo yenye mafanikio katika kilimo cha kahawa ili kujifunza mbinu za kisasa za uzalishaji. Hamasa mpya miongoni mwa wakulima imechochewa na ongezeko kubwa la bei ya kahawa.

Hii ni ishara kubwa ya imani kwa kaunti yetu na utambuzi wa hatua kubwa tulizopiga katika kuifanya Uasin Gishu kuwa kitovu cha ubora, biashara na fursa,” alisema.

Bii alisema serikali ya kaunti itashirikiana kwa karibu na wadau wote kuhakikisha sherehe hizo zinaandaliwa kwa mafanikio na pia kutoa jukwaa la kuitangaza Uasin Gishu kama eneo bora la uwekezaji, ubunifu na utalii. “Tutafanya kazi kwa pamoja na wadau wote kuhakikisha kuwa sherehe za mwaka huu za Siku ya Mashujaa zinakuwa za heshima, za kukumbukwa na zinazokisi roho ya taifa letu kubwa,” aliongeza. Gavana huyo pia aliwataka wakazi na viongozi kubaini watu waliotoa mchango wa kipekee katika sekta za kilimo, elimu, biashara, utumishi wa umma na maendeleo ya jamii ili watambuliwe wakati wa sherehe hizo za kitaifa. Hata hivyo, sherehe za kitaifa za Siku ya Mashujaa za mwaka 2026 zimehamishwa kutoka

Uwanja wa Kamariny katika Kaunti ya Elgeyo Marakwet hadi Uwanja wa Kipchoge Keino mjini Eldoret baada ya kubainika kuwa ujenzi wa Kamariny ulikuwa umechelewa na hivyo uwezekano wa kukamilika kwa wakati kwa hafla hiyo kuwa mdogo. Waziri wa Usalama wa Ndani na Utawala wa Kitaifa, Kipchumba Murkomen, akizungumza katika hafla tofauti, aliwahakikishia wakazi wa Elgeyo Marakwet kuwa kuhamishwa kwa sherehe za mwaka huu hakutabadilisha dhamira ya serikali ya kukamilisha ujenzi wa kihistoria wa Uwanja wa Kamariny ulioko lten. Murkomen alisema ujenzi wa uwanja huo utaendelea kama ilivyopangwa, akisisitiza kuwa uamuzi wa kuhamisha sherehe hizo ulifanywa ili kuhakiki-

sha hafla ya kitaifa inafanyika katika eneo ambalo liko tayari. Gavana huyo pia aliwaonya wafanyakazi wa kaunti dhidi ya kuchelewa kazini au kuripoti wakiwa wamelewa, akiieleza bodi hiyo kuchukua hatua kali za kinidhamu dhidi ya wanaorudia makosa hayo, ikiwemo kufutwa kazi inapobidi. Aidha, aliwataka maafisa wa utekelezaji wa sheria za kaunti kuwahudumia wafanyabiashara kwa weledi, haki na heshima wanapotekeleza sheria za kaunti. Wakati huo huo, aliwahimiza wafanyabiashara kushirikiana na maafisa wa kaunti kwa kufanya biashara katika maeneo yaliyotengwa na kuzingatia kanuni za kaunti. “Tumewapandisha vyeo zaidi ya wafanyakazi 1,400 ili kuwapa motisha. Kwa upande wao, tunatarajia kujituma, nidhamu na utoaji wa huduma bora kwa wananchi wa Uasin Gishu,” alisema Bii. Gavana huyo alieleza imani yake kuwa bodi mpya itaimarisha utoaji wa huduma za umma kwa kukuza taaluma, uwajibikaji na ufanisi katika serikali ya kaunti. Hafla hiyo ilisimamiwa na Jaji wa Mahakama Kuu ya Eldoret, John Chigiti, na kuhudhuriwa na Spika wa Bunge la Kaunti ya Uasin Gishu Philip Muigei, Katibu wa Kaunti Philip Meli pamoja na maafisa wengine waandamizi wa serikali ya kaunti.

Isaboke alisema maandalizi ya mashindano hayo ya bara yanaenda mbali zaidi ya uwanja wa soka, akieleza kuwa AFCON 2027 ni fursa ya kuharakisha mageuzi

ya kidijitali na kuunda nafasi mpya kwa vijana wa Kenya katika ubunifu wa maudhui, utangazaji na biashara za mtandaoni. Katibu huyo, ambaye hivi karibuni aliongoza kikao cha pamoja cha kamati elekezi kilichowaleta pamoja wadau wakuu wa sekta hiyo kujadili utayari wa mawasiliano na muun-

ganisho wa mtandao, alisema serikali inalenga kuyafanya mashindano hayo kuwa hatua muhimu ya mageuzi katika uchumi wa kidijitali wa nchi. “Tunajenga uti wa mgongo wa kidijitali ambao utahakikisha kila bao, kila shangwe na kila tukio linaonyeshwa kwa wakati halisi kwa ulimwengu

mzima,” alisema Isaboke. Aliongeza kuwa wakati vigogo wa soka la Afrika watakapowasili nchini Kenya, urithi wa AFCON 2027 hautapimwa tu kwa mabao na mataji bali pia kwa uimara wa miundombinu ya kidijitali itakayowekwa kwa manufaa ya vizazi vijavyo. Kwa mujibu wa Isaboke, serikali inaona mashindano hayo kama kichocho cha uwekezaji katika sekta ya mawasiliano, huku lengo la muda mrefu likiwa kuimarisha uchumi wa kidijitali wa Kenya na kufungua fursa mpya kwa vijana. Alisema kipaumbele kikuu ni kuhakikisha mitandao ya Kenya ina uwezo wa kushughulikia kiwango kikubwa cha data kitakachozalishwa na tukio la kimataifa la michezo, ambapo maelfu ya mashabiki, watangazaji, wafanyabiashara na wageni wataunganishwa kwa wakati mmoja. Mabadiliko ya Kenya kuelekea matumizi ya mitandao ya kasi ya juu yanaendelea

kushika kasi, huku takwimu za Mamlaka ya Mawasiliano Kenya (CA) zikionyesha kuwa kufikia Juni 2025, huduma za 5G zili kuwa zimefikia asilimia 30 ya idadi ya watu, huku huduma za 4G zikifikia asilimia 97.3. Kufikia Septemba 2025, watumiaji wa 5G walikuwa wakitumia wastani wa gigabaiti 40 za data kwa mwezi, ikilinganishwa na wastani wa gigabaiti 14.1 kwa watumiaji wa 4G. Alisema takwimu hizo zinaonyesha ongezeko la mahitaji ya muunganisho wa kasi ya juu na umuhimu wa kujenga mitandao yenye uwezo wa kuhimili shughuli zinazozidi kuhitaji matumizi makubwa ya data. “Kwa AFCON 2027, teknolojia ya 5G itawezesha mazingira ya mashindano yaliyoimarishwa kidijitali, kuanzia ushirikishwaji wa mashabiki kwa wakati halisi hadi utangazaji na shughuli za vyombo vya habari bila hitilafu,” alisema.

Wakulima Lugari wakumbatia ufugaji nyuki mabadiliko ya tabianchi yakiathiri mahindi

Kwa vizazi vingi, kilimo cha mahindi kimekuwa uti wa mgongo wa maisha ya wakazi wa Kaunti Ndogo ya Lugari, Kaunti ya Kakamega. Hata hivyo, mabadiliko ya tabianchi, kupungua kwa rutuba ya udongo na kuongezeka kwa gharama za uzalishaji vimeendelea kupunguza faida ya wakulima, hali iliyowasukuma wengi wao kuanza kufuga nyuki kwa kutumia mbinu za kisasa kama njia mbadala endelevu na yenye faida kubwa. Shughuli hiyo inabadilisha mapato ya kaya huku ikichangia uhifadhi wa mazingira. Katika maeneo mbalimbali ya kaunti ndogo hiyo, mizinga ya kisasa inaendelea kuanzishwa kando ya mashamba ya mahindi, huku wakulima wakikumbatia ufugaji wa nyuki kama chanzo cha ziada cha mapato ambacho kinahitaji ardhi ndogo, nguvu kazi chache na gharama nafuu za uzalishaji. Shughuli hiyo pia inachangia kurejesha bioanuwai, kwani wakulima wanahifadhi miti ya asili na kupanda miti na mimea yenye maua ambayo hutoa lishe kwa nyuki. Peter Wekesa, mkulima kutoka Wadi ya Lumakanda, alianza kufuga nyuki miaka mitatu iliyopita baada ya kuhudhuria mafunzo yaliyoandaliwa na Serikali ya Kaunti ya Kakamega. “Nilianza na mizinga mitano ya Kenya Top Bar,

na leo ninamiliki mizinga 25. Katika kila msimu wa uvunaji, ninapata kati ya kilo 200 na 300 za asali ambazo huuzwa kwa wafanyabiashara wa eneo hili na wasindikaji wa asali. Mapato hayo yamenisaidia kulipa karo ya watoto wangu, kuboresha makazi yangu na kuwekeza katika shughuli nyingine za kilimo,” alisema. Kwa sasa, kilo moja ya asali huuzwa kati ya Sh600 na Sh900 kutegemea ubora wake na mahitaji ya soko, jambo linaloufanya ufugaji wa nyuki

kuwa mojawapo ya shughuli zenye faida kubwa kwa wakulima wadogo katika eneo hilo. Tofauti na kilimo cha mahindi ambacho kimeathiriwa kwa kiasi kikubwa na mvua zisizotabirika na vipindi virefu vya ukame, ufugaji wa nyuki una uwezo mkubwa wa kusta-himili athari za mabadiliko ya tabianchi. Mbali na kuzalisha asali, nyuki wana mchango mkubwa katika uchavushaji wa mazao kama vile parachichi, maharagwe, alizeti, maboga na mboga za asili, hali inayooongeza mavuno na kuboresha ubora wa mazao.

Mary Nanjala, mfugaji mwingine wa nyuki kutoka Wadi ya Chekalini, alisema shughuli hiyo imebadilisha mtazamo wa wakulima kuhusu uhifadhi wa mazingira. “Kabla sijaanza kufuga nyuki, sikuwa nikiifikiria sana kuhusu umuhimu wa kuhifadhi miti ya asili. Sasa ninaelewa kuwa misitu yenye afya na mimea yenye maua ni muhimu kwa uzalishaji wa asali. Tumepanda miti zaidi na kupunguza ukataji holela wa miti kwa sababu nyuki wanategemea mazingira hayo,” alisema. Kwa mujibu wa Afisa wa Kilimo wa Kaunti Ndogo ya Lugari,

Kakai Wekesa, ufugaji wa kisasa wa nyuki unaendelea kupata umaarufu huku wakulima wakibadilisha vyanzo vyao vya mapato na kukumbatia kilimo kinachozingatia mabadiliko ya tabianchi.

“Ufugaji wa nyuki unazalisha ajira, unaongeza mapato ya kaya na kuboresha uchavushaji wa mazao. Pia unachangia uhifadhi wa mazingira kwa sababu wakulima wanahifadhi miti na kupunguza shughuli zinazoharibu makazi ya nyuki,” alisema afisa huyo.

Ili kuunga mkono shughuli hiyo inayokua kwa kasi, Serikali ya Kaunti ya Kakamega kupitia Idara ya Kilimo na Maendeleo ya Mifugo imeongeza mafunzo kwa wakulima kuhusu usimamizi wa kisasa wa mizinga, uanzishaji wa makundi ya nyuki, uvunaji wa asali, uongezaji thamani na masoko.

Kaunti hiyo pia imesambaza mizinga ya kisasa, mavazi ya kujikinga na vifaa vya kuvunia asali kwa vikundi vya wakulima vilivyojipanga ili kuongeza uzalishaji na kupunguza hasara baada ya mavuno.

Maafisa wa kaunti wanasema mpango huo ni sehemu ya juhudi pana za kuendeleza kilimo kinachozingatia mabadiliko ya tabianchi, kumariha usalama wa chakula na kubadilisha vyanzo vya riziki vijijini kwa kuhamasisha shughuli ambazo ni endelevu kwa mazingira na zenye manufaa kiuchumi. Wataalamu wa mazingira wanaeleza kuwa idadi nzuri ya nyuki ni muhimu kwa uhifadhi wa bioanuwai na uzalishaji wa chakula, huku karibu theluthi moja ya mazao ya chakula yakitegemea uchavushaji unaofanywa na wadudu.

Vijana zaidi Marsabit wafaidika mgao wa Mpango wa Nyota ukiongezeka hadi Sh41m

Kaunti ya Marsabit imepokea ongezeko la mgao chini ya Mpango wa Nyota wa serikali kufuatia kuongezeka kwa mahitaji kutoka kwa vijana wanaotafuta ruzuku za kuanzisha biashara. Akizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi wa Awamu ya Pili ya Mpango wa Nyota katika Uwanja wa Marsabit, Katibu Mkuu wa Wizara ya Usalama wa Ndani, Dkt. Raymond Omollo, alisema mgao wa kaunti hiyo umeongezeka kutoka Sh37 milioni zilizotolewa katika awamu ya kwanza hadi Sh41 milioni katika awamu ya pili ili

kuwajumuisha wanufaika zaidi. Dkt. Omollo alihusisha ongezeko hilo na idadi inayoongezeka ya vijana wanaoonyesha nia ya kujiunga na mpango huo baada ya kushuhudia matokeo na mafanikio yake. “Mahitaji ya Mpango wa Nyota yameongezeka kwa kiwango kikubwa. Hapo awali, vijana wengi hawakuwa na uhakika kama mpango huo ulikuwa wa kweli, lakini baada ya kuona wenzao wakipokea ruzuku na kuanzisha biashara, wengi zaidi wamejitokeza kutuma maombi,” alisema. Katibu huyo alisema serikali imeongeza idadi ya wanufaika katika Kaunti ya Marsabit, huku mpango

huo ukilenga kuwafikia kati ya vijana 70 na 84 katika kila wadi kati ya wadi 20 za kaunti hiyo. Aliongeza kuwa Mpango wa Nyota umeundwa kusaidia vijana kushinda mojawapo ya vikwazo vikubwa vya ujasiri-

amali, ambacho ni ukosefu wa mtaji wa kuanzisha biashara, suala ambalo serikali ya Kenya Kwanza imeazimia kulitatua. Mpango huo, unaowalenga vijana wenye umri wa kati ya miaka 18 na 29, huku ukiongeza kikomo hadi

miaka 35 kwa watu wanaoishi na ulemavu, huwapatia wanufaika ruzuku ya Sh25,000 kila mmoja. Fedha hizo zinajumuisha Sh23,000 za kusaidia biashara na Sh2,000 zinazowekwa moja kwa moja katika akaunti ya mnufaika kama akiba kwa lengo la kuhamasisha utamaduni wa kuweka akiba. Dkt. Omollo alisema serikali imewawezesha wanufaika kwa kuwapatia mafunzo ya ujuzi wa biashara na ushauri elekezi, huku ufuatiliaji wa karibu ukiendelea kufanywa ili kuhakikisha fedha hizo zinawekezwa katika shughuli endelevu za kuzalisha mapato. Licha ya kuongezeka kwa mgao huo, Dkt. Omollo aliwahimiza vijana kuchangamkia programu nyingine za serikali za ufadhili ili kupata mtaji wa ziada wa kukuza biashara zao. “Mpango wa Nyota ni mojawapo tu ya programu za serikali za kuwawezesha wananchi kiuchumi. Vijana wanaohitaji mtaji zaidi wanapaswa pia kuchunguza fursa za fedha nyingine za serikali ili kukuza biashara zao,” alisema.

Serikali yazindua mpango wa Sh 465b kupunguza gharama za lishe ya mifugo

Serikali inapanga kutekeleza Mkakati wa Kitaifa wa Lishe ya Mifugo wenye thamani ya Sh465 bilioni unaolenga kupunguza gharama kubwa za chakula cha mifugo, kushusha gharama za uzalishaji wa mifugo na kuimarisha usalama wa chakula pamoja na ushindani wa Kenya katika masoko ya kikanda. Akizungumza wakati wa ufunguzi wa Kongamano na Maonesho ya Afrika ya Lishe ya Mifugo (AFEC) 2026 mjini Nairobi, Mkuu wa Kitengo cha Lishe ya Mifugo katika Idara ya Serikali ya Maendeleo ya Mifugo, Newton Kariuki, alisema chakula cha mifugo huchangia hadi asilimia 80 ya gharama za uzalishaji wa mifugo, hivyo kufanya upatikanaji wa chakula bora na cha gharama nafuu kuwa muhimu katika kuongeza uzalishaji wa maziwa, nyama na mayai. Kariuki alisema serikali inashirikiana na Chama cha Watengenezaji wa Chakula cha Mifugo Kenya (AKEFEMA) pamoja na wadau wengine kushughulikia changamoto sugu zinazoikabili sekta ya lishe ya mifugo. Alisema mkakati huo wa miaka 10 unalenga kuongeza uzalishaji wa chakula na malisho ya mifugo, kuimarisha uwezo wa ndani wa utengenezaji wa chakula cha mifugo na kuboresha tija katika sekta ya mifugo. Mkakati huo unakamilisha Mpango Mkuu wa Mifugo unaoelekeza uwekezaji katika sekta hiyo kulingana na maeneo ya kiikolojia ya kilimo. Kariuki alibainisha kuwa Kenya inakabiliwa na upungufu wa asilimia 60 wa malighafi za kutengenezea chakula cha mifugo, hali inayowalazimu watengenezaji kutegemea

uagizaji wa bidhaa kutoka nje ambao ni ghali na unaoathiriwa na ushuru pamoja na misukosuko ya minyororo ya ugavi duniani. Ili kupunguza utegemezi huo, mkakati huo unahamasisha uzalishaji wa ndani wa viambato muhimu vya chakula cha mifugo kupitia kilimo cha mkataba, huku ukiwahimiza watengenezaji kutumia motisha za msamaha wa ushuru za Jumuiya ya Afrika Mashariki ili kupunguza gharama za malighafi zinazoagizwa kutoka nje.

Serikali pia inaanzisha Akiba ya Kitaifa ya Kimkakati ya Chakula cha Mifugo kwa ajili ya kuhifadhi nyasi kavu, silaji na malisho wakati wa misimu ya ziada kwa

matumizi wakati wa ukame. Aidha, mpango wa “Wadi Moja, Malisho Moja” unalenga kuzalisha tani metri 300,000 za malisho makavu kila mwaka ifikapo 2028 katika wadi 1,450 nchini. Kariuki alitoa wito wa kufanyika kwa mijadala inayotegemea sayansi kuhusu matumizi ya viambato vya chakula cha mifugo vilivyoboreshwa kwa teknolojia ya vinasaba (GM), akisema bioteknolojia inaweza kusaidia kupunguza gharama za uzalishaji na kuboresha upatikanaji wa chakula cha mifugo huku ikidumisha viwango vya usalama wa kibayolojia. Pia alieleza wasiwasi kuhusu uwezo wa chakula cha mifugo kilichochakachuliwa na kisicho na lebo sahihi, akitaka utekelezaji mkali wa viwango vya ubora pamoja na uwekezaji zaidi katika uundaji sahihi wa lishe ya mifugo, ufuatiliaji wa kidijitali wa ubora wa chakula, uzalishaji wa malisho unaozingatia mabadiliko ya tabianchi na matumizi ya vyanzo mbadala vya protini kama mabuu ya nzi aina ya Black Soldier Fly. “Wakulima wanastahili kupata chakula bora cha mifugo kwa sababu walaji wanastahili bidhaa salama za mifugo. Kile ambacho wanyama wanakula hatimaye huingia kwenye meza zetu,” alisema. Kariuki alizihimiza serikali za kaunti kuweka kipaumbele katika uzalishaji wa chakula na malisho ya mifugo katika mipango yao ya maendeleo, akiongeza kuwa lishe bora ya mifugo ndiyo msingi wa sekta yenye tija. Alieleza kuwa ukuaji wa uzalishaji wa maziwa nchini umetokana na sera zinazounga mkono sekta hiyo, uwekezaji wa kibiashara katika tasnia ya maziwa, programu bora za uboreshaji wa

mifugo, huduma za uhimilishaji wa kisasa, mbolea ya ruzuku iliyoongeza uzalishaji wa malisho na kuongezeka kwa mahitaji ya bidhaa za maziwa. Wakati huo huo, Mwenyekiti wa AKEFEMA, Joseph Karuri, alisema kuongeza uzalishaji wa ndani wa viambato vya chakula cha mifugo ndiyo suluhisho endelevu zaidi la kupunguza gharama za lishe ya mifugo. Alibainisha kuwa sekta ya mifugo inachangia takriban asilimia tatu ya Pato la Taifa (GDP) la Kenya na asilimia 40 ya pato la sekta ya kilimo, huku ikisaidia mamilioni ya wananchi kujiipatia riziki. “Kwa sasa Kenya huzalisha takriban tani metri milioni 2.5 za chakula cha mifugo kilichochanganywa kila mwaka, huku sekta ya kuku ikichangia asilimia 60 ya matumizi ya chakula cha mifugo cha kibiashara na sekta ya maziwa asilimia 29,” aliongeza. Karuri alisema zaidi ya asilimia 80 ya viambato muhimu vya chakula cha mifugo, ikiwemo soya, mashudu ya alizeti na mashudu ya pamba, huagizwa kutoka nje, jambo linalowaweka watengenezaji katika hatari ya kuyumba kwa masoko ya kimataifa. Alikaribisha Mpango wa Serikali wa Msamaha wa Ushuru unaoruhusu watengenezaji wanaostahili kuagiza viambato vya chakula cha mifugo bila kulipa ushuru, lakini akasisitiza kuwa kuongeza uzalishaji wa ndani wa mahindi ya njano, soya, alizeti na kanola kupitia kilimo cha mkataba kutatoa suluhisho la kudumu. “Ikiwa tutazalisha malighafi hizi hapa nchini, bei ya chakula cha mifugo itashuka kwa kiwango kikubwa kwa sababu malighafi huchangia kati ya asilimia 70 na 80 ya gharama za uzalishaji,” alisema.

Kenya imeweka historia kwa kuandaa duru ya Afrika ya Mashindano ya Kombe la Dunia ya Upigaji makasia yaliyofanyika katika Mto Sagana, Kaunti ya Murang’a, baada ya siku tatu za ushindani mkali. Mashindano hayo yaliwakutanisha timu 61 kutoka mataifa mbalimbali duniani, hatua iliyoweka alama muhimu kwani Kenya imekuwa nchi ya kwanza barani Afrika kuandaa duru ya mashindano hayo ya hadhi ya kimataifa. Timu ya Kenya iling’ara kwa kutoa matokeo bora, huku timu ya wanawake ikijizolea medali za dhahabu, fedha na shaba katika makundi mbalimbali, isipokuwa katika kundi la mseto ambapo Uganda

ilitwaa medali ya dhahabu. Akizungumza wakati wa hafla ya utoaji wa tuzo, Mweka Hazina wa Shirikisho la Upigaji makasia Kenya, Ibrahim Mwangi, aliisifu Timu ya Kenya kwa utendaji wake wa kipekee na kuipongeza serikali kupitia Wizara ya Michezo kwa kuendelea kuunga mkono maendeleo ya michezo nchini. “Katika makundi yote, Kenya ilifanya vizuri sana. Timu ya wasichana ilishinda medali za dhahabu, fedha na shaba katika makundi yote isipokuwa kundi la mseto ambapo Uganda ilichukua dhahabu,” alisema, akibainisha kuwa serikali imekuwa mstari wa mbele katika kuendelea michezo nchini. Wanariadha wa Kenya Jamal Nasir na Alissa Kariuki mwenye umri wa miaka 14 walieleza kuridhishwa na matokeo yao

na kuwataka vijana wengi zaidi kujihusisha na michezo ya majini. “Katika kundi la wanawake wa Afrika tulishika nafasi ya pili, huku katika kundi la mseto tukimaliza katika nafasi ya tatu,” alisema Kariuki, akihimiza vijana wengi zaidi kukumbatia michezo ya majini.

Viongozi wa dunia wa mchezo wa upigaji makasia waliipongeza Kenya kwa kufanikiwa kuandaa mashindano hayo, huku wakitoa wito kwa mataifa mengi zaidi kushiriki ili kuharakisha ukuaji wa mchezo huo barani Afrika na kwingineko duniani. Mashindano hayo yalivutia

watazamaji kutoka sehemu mbalimbali za nchi waliokuja kushuhudia na kusherehekea mafanikio ya Timu ya Kenya, jambo lililoonyesha kuongezeka kwa hamasa ya mchezo huo nchini. Angeline Choni, ambaye alikuwa akihudhuria mashindano ya upigaji makasia kwa mara ya kwanza, alisema,

Serikali imewahakikishia Wakenya kuwa usambazaji wa bidhaa za petroli nchini umeendelea kuwa thabiti licha ya mvutano unaoongezeka Mashariki ya Kati ambao umevuruga masoko ya kimataifa ya mafuta na kuongeza wasiwasi kuhusu bei za mafuta duniani. Waziri wa Nishati na Petroli, Opiyo Wandayi, alisema mashambulizi dhidi ya meli za kibiashara karibu na Mlango-Bahari wa Hormuz yamepunguza idadi ya meli za mafuta zinazopita katika eneo hilo na kuongeza kuyumba kwa masoko ya nishati duniani, lakini hayajaathiri upatikanaji wa mafuta nchini Kenya. “Usambazaji wa mafuta nchini Kenya umeendelea kuwa thabiti wakati wote. Kila shehena iliyopangwa imewasili na kupakuliwa kwa wakati unaofaa, na mafuta yameendelea kupatikana katika vituo vya mafuta kote nchini,” alisema Wandayi. Alieleza kuwa uthabiti huo umetokana na mpango wa usambazaji wa mafuta wa Serikali kwa Serikali (G2G), ambao umeiwezesha Kenya kupata shehena za petroli kutoka maeneo mbalimbali ya upakiaji nje ya Ukanda wa Ghuba huku ikidumisha usambazaji usiokatizwa.

Kwa mujibu wa Waziri huyo, mpango huo umeilinda nchi dhidi ya ongezeko la gharama za usafirishaji na bima ambazo zimeathiri mataifa yanayotegemea ununuzi wa papo kwa papo na zabuni za wazi. “Kenya imeendelea kulipa gharama zilezile za usafirishaji na ada maalum zilizowekwa. Mfumo huu wa gharama zisizobadilika umewezesha kudhibiti gharama za kuingiza mafuta nchini, kuhakikisha shehena zinawasili kwa ratiba iliyopangwa na kuruhusu wasambazaji kupata mafuta kutoka maeneo mbadala bila kuhamishia gharama hizo za ziada kwa watumiaji wa Kenya,” alisema. Akizungumza jijini Nairobi, Wandayi alibainisha kuwa manufaa ya mpango wa G2G huonekana zaidi wakati wa misukosuko katika masoko

ya kimataifa, kwani huweze nchi kudumisha usalama wa upatikanaji wa mafuta hata wakati bei za mafuta duniani zinapobadilika. Hata hivyo, alikiri kuwa mvutano mpya katika eneo la Mashariki ya Kati umechangia kupanda kwa viwango vya kimataifa vya bei ya mafuta ghafi, hali ambayo huenda ikaathiri mizunguko ijayo ya upan-gaji wa bei za mafuta nchini. Waziri huyo alisema wizara itaendelea kushirikiana kwa karibu na wadau wa sekta hiyo ili kuhakikisha upati-

Aliwahakikishia madereva, waendeshaji wa usafiri wa umma, watengenezaji bidhaa, wakulima, wawekezaji na watumiaji wengine kuwa akiba ya kutosha ya mafuta ipo nchini kote. “Maendeleo ya kimataifa hayajaathiri upatikanaji wa bidhaa za petroli nchini mwetu. Mafuta yanaendelea kupatikana kwa urahisi kote nchini, yakisaidiwa na akiba ya kutosha ya kitaifa, mfumo imara na unaofanya kazi kikamilifu wa uagizaji na usambazaji wa mafuta, pamoja na mafanikio endelevu ya mpango wa usambazaji wa mafuta wa Serikali kwa Serikali,” alisema. Wandayi alisema mfumo wa G2G umeimarisha usalama wa nishati nchini kwa kuongeza utabirika wa usambazaji, kuimarisha uimara wa mnyororo wa ugavi wa petroli na kupunguza shinikizo kwa mahitaji ya fedha za kigeni nchini. Aliongeza kuwa uwekezaji wa serikali katika kuimarisha sekta ya petroli umeongeza uwezo wa nchi kustahimili misukosuko ya nje na kudumisha usambazaji wa mafuta unaotegemewa licha ya kuyumba kwa masoko ya kimataifa.

Ufufuaji wa Nzoia wazaa matunda kwa wakulima

■ Kampuni ya Sukari ya Nzoia imelipa zaidi ya Sh700 milioni kwa wakulima tangu irejee shughuli zake mwaka huu, huku kiwanda hicho kikiripoti kuimarika kwa uzalishaji, malipo ya haraka kwa wakulima na uwekezaji mkubwa unao-lenga kurejesha utendaji wake. Mkurugenzi Mtendaji (CEO) wa kampuni hiyo, Sohan Sharma, alisema kampuni imeingiza karibu Sh900 milioni katika uchumi wa Kaunti ya Bungoma tangu ilipoanza tena shughuli zake, huku wakulima sasa wakilipwa ndani ya wiki mbili baada ya kuwasilisha miwa yao. Sharma alisema kampuni ilitekeleza mpango mkubwa wa ukarabati baada ya kuchukua usimamizi wa kiwanda hicho mwezi Mei 2025. Kazi hizo zilijumuisha ukarabati wa sehemu ya awali ya kusaga miwa, kitengo cha usagaji, kitengo cha kuchemshia sukari, boilers, mitambo ya turbine, mifumo ya umeme, vifaa vya udhibiti wa mitambo pamoja na miundombinu mingine ya kiraia.

Alisema kiwanda kilianza tena shughuli za kusaga miwa Januari 2026 na tangu wakati huo kime-shachakata zaidi ya tani 292,980 za miwa. Mkurugenzi huyo alieleza kuwa ingawa kiwanda kina uwezo wa kusaga tani 3,000 za miwa kwa siku, kwa sasa kinachakata wastani wa tani 1,900 kwa siku. Aliongeza kuwa uwekezaji katika vifaa vipya ume-boresha kwa kiasi kikubwa ufanisi wa usagaji, huku uwiano wa upotevu ukishuka kutoka kati ya asilimia 17 na 21 hadi asilimia 10. Sharma alihusisha sehemu ya mafanikio hayo na kuanzishwa kwa Mfumo wa Kidijitali wa Upimaji wa Uzito (Smart Weighment System) pamoja na Mfumo wa Udhhibiti wa Kielektroniki (Distributed Control System), akisema teknolojia hizo zimeondoa uwezekano wa udanganyifu katika daraja la kupimia miwa na kuwawezesha wakulima kupokea ujumbe mfupi wa simu (SMS) unaothibitisha mara moja kuwasilishwa kwa miwa yao.

Vijana 7,000 wapokea fedha za biashara

■ Zaidi ya vijana 7,000 kutoka kaunti za Murang'a, Nyeri na Kirinyaga wamepokea ufadhili wa kuanzisha biashara chini ya awamu ya pili ya Mpango wa Kitaifa wa Fursa za Vijana kwa Maendeleo (NYOTA), mpango wa serikali unaolenga kukabiliana na ukosefu wa ajira kwa vijana kupitia ujasiriamali. Jumla ya wanufaika 7,055 — wakiwemo 2,988 kutoka Murang'a, 1,828 kutoka Kirinyaga na 2,239 kutoka Nyeri — walipokea msaada wa kifedha katika hafla ya utoaji wa fedha iliyofanyika katika Uwanja wa Ihura, Kaunti ya Murang'a. Akizungumza wakati wa hafla hiyo, Waziri wa Ardhi, Alice Wahome, alisema Kaunti ya Murang'a ilitengewa Sh74.7 milioni katika awamu ya pili ya utoaji wa fedha. Kati ya wanufaika hao, 2,278

waliokuwa tayari katika mpango huo walipokea awamu yao ya pili ya ufadhili, huku wanufaika wapya 710 wakipokea mgao wa wao kwanza. Aliwahimiza vijana kutumia fedha hizo kwa busara kwa kuwekeza katika biashara zitakazoboresha maisha yao na kuunda nafasi za ajira, huku wakiepuka ulevi, matumizi ya dawa za kulevya, uhuni na maandamano haramu. “Nawahimiza vijana wetu kutumia fedha hizi kuanzisha na kukua biashara ambazo zitabadilisha maisha yao. Jiepusheni na ulevi, matumizi ya dawa za kulevya, uhuni na maandamano haramu, na badala yake mjikite katika kujenga maisha bora kwa ajili yenu na jamii zenu,” alisema Wahome. Kaunti ya Kirinyaga ilipokea Sh45.7 milioni, ambapo wanufaika 1,267 waliokuwa tayari katika mpango huo walipokea awamu yao ya pili ya ufadhili.
